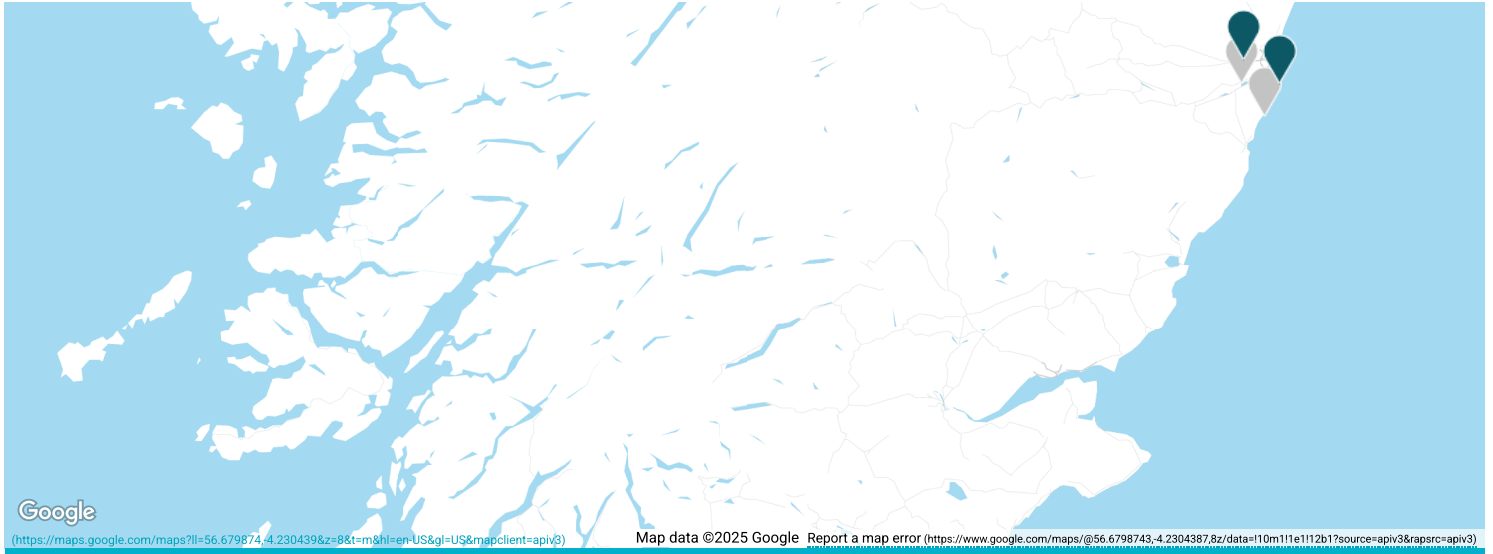




Milton of Leys

Milton of Leys is in Highland. It is a greenfield new suburban town for Inverness. Building is still ongoing both of houses and services.

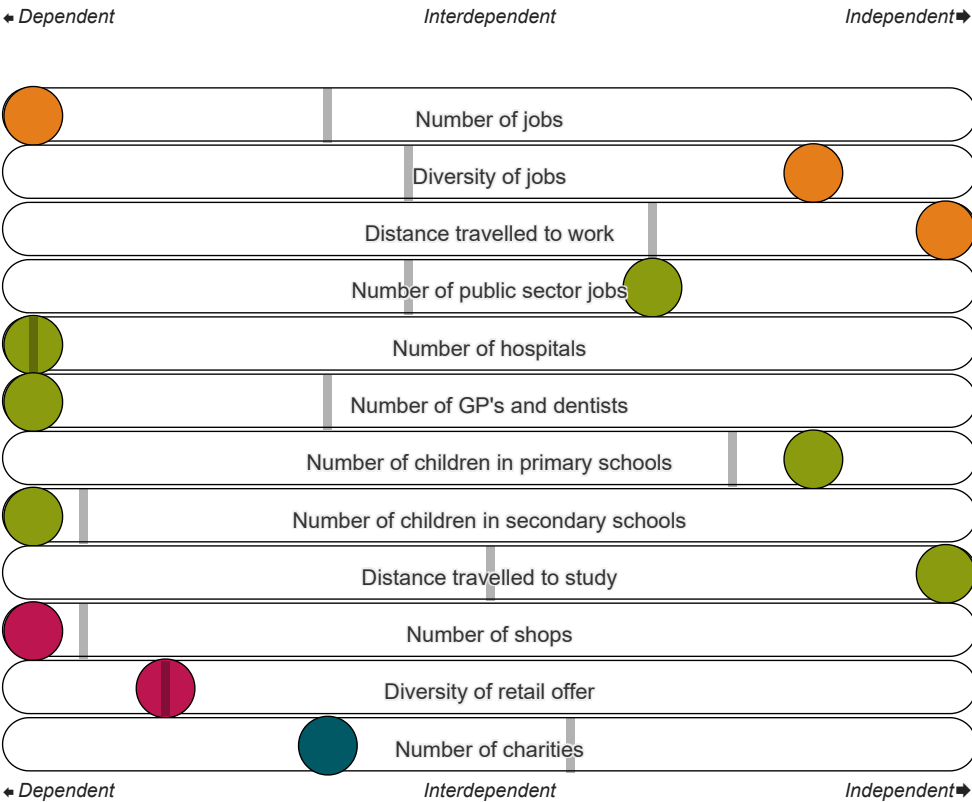

Milton of Leys is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

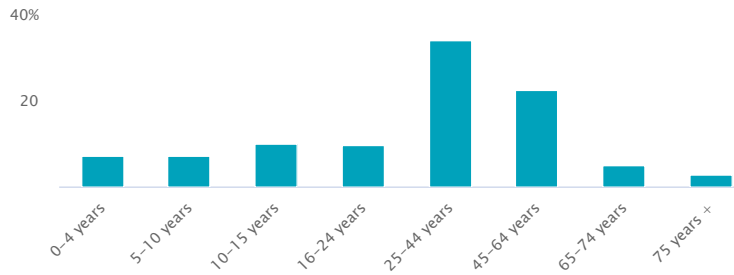

It differs in terms of the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Milton of Leys differs most from its group in the number of jobs, and GP's and dentists.

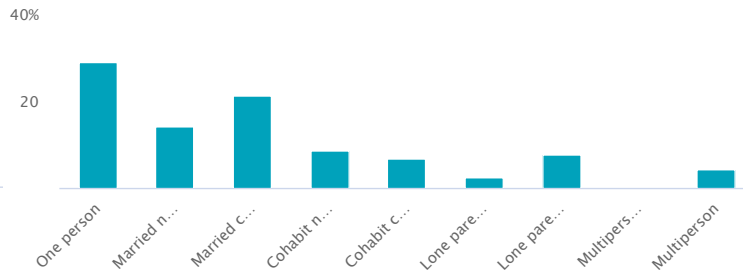

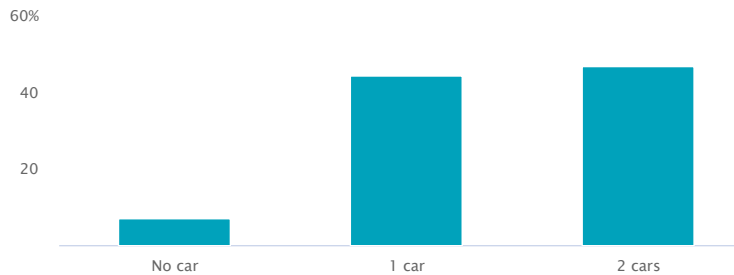

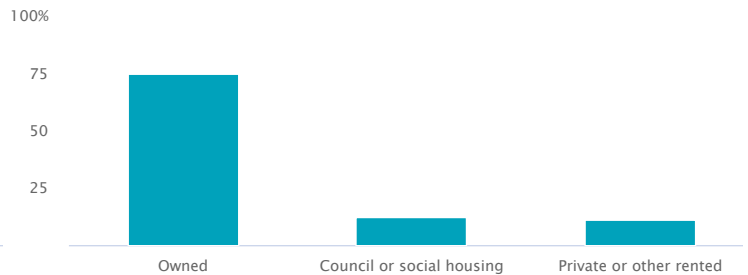
Household composition

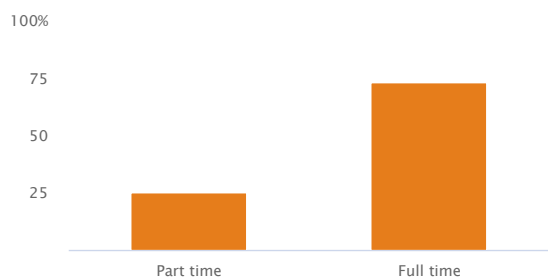

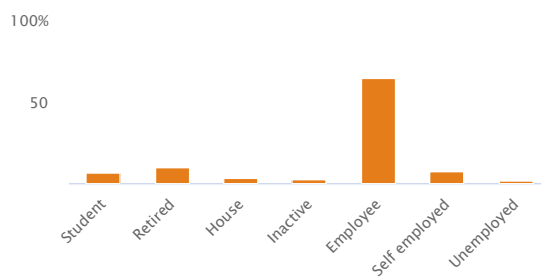
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



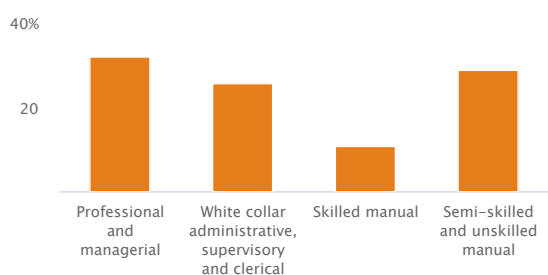
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

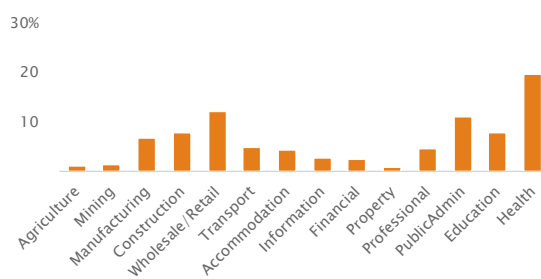

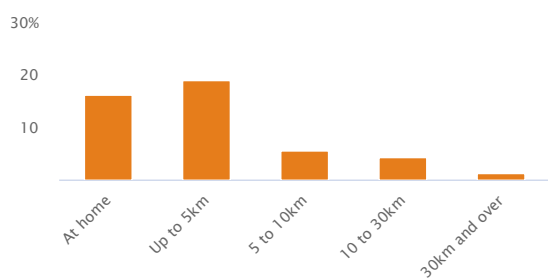
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

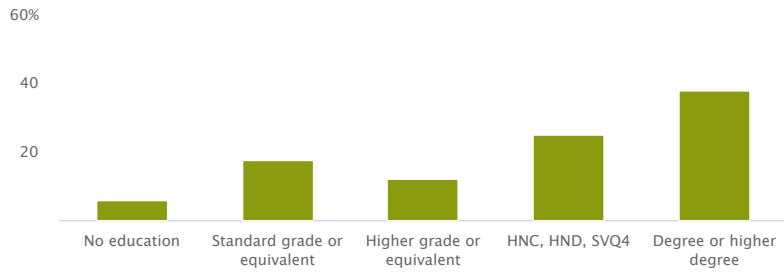


Distance travelled to work

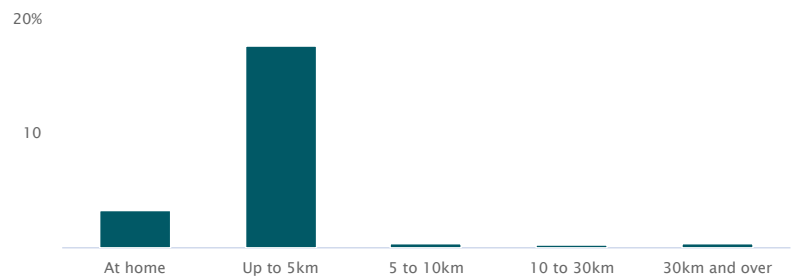
