Milton of Leys is in Highland. It is a greenfield new suburban town for Inverness. Building is still ongoing both of houses and services.



Its most similar towns are Cove Bay, East Calder, Kingswells, and Kirkliston.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work








