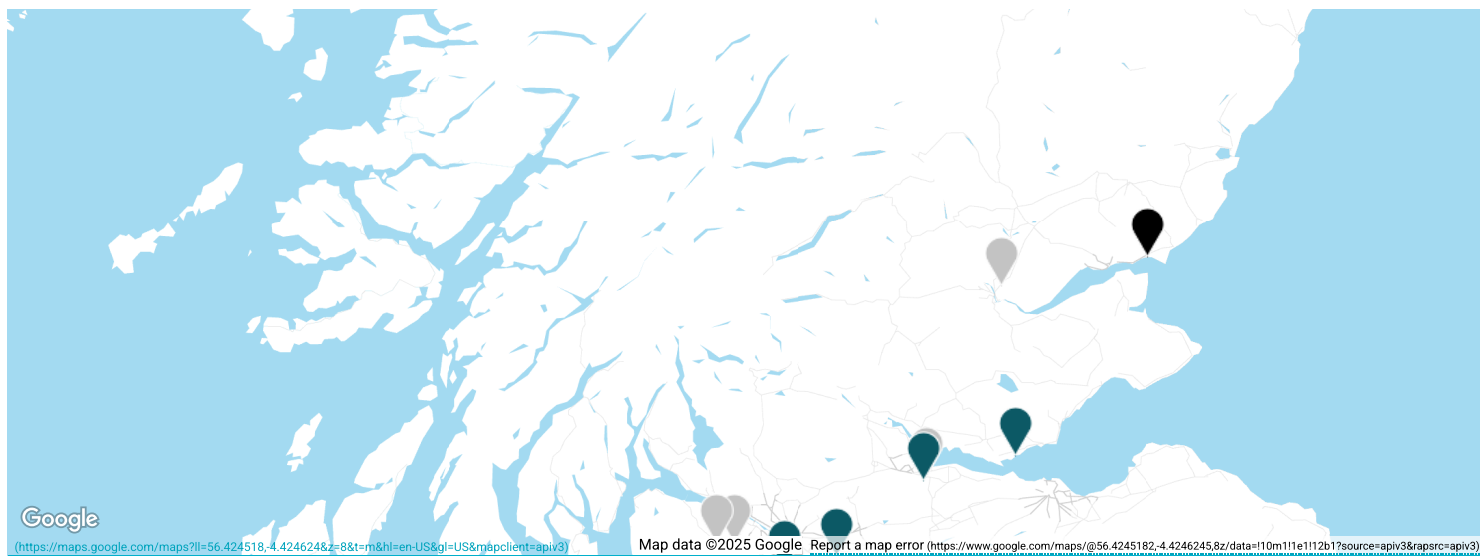




# Monifieth

Monifieth in Angus expanded as a town in relation to the expansion of Dundee. Today it retains close connections with Dundee with most residents commuting to the city.

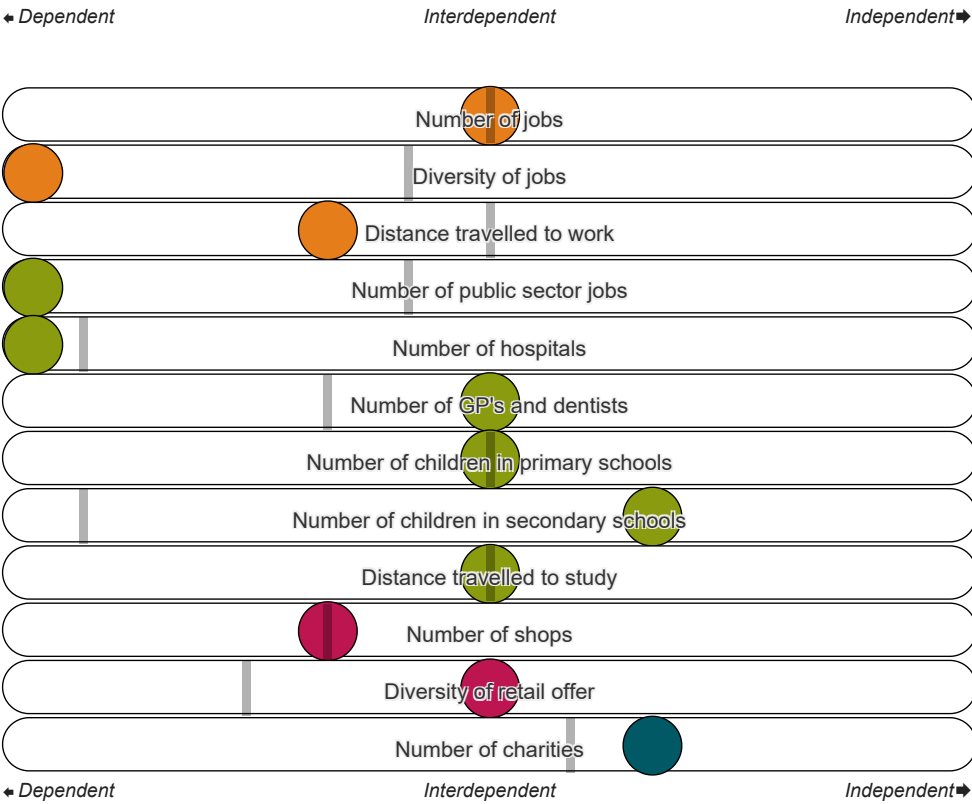
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

# Inter-relationships



Monifieth is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Monifieth is grouped with 10 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. Monifieth differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

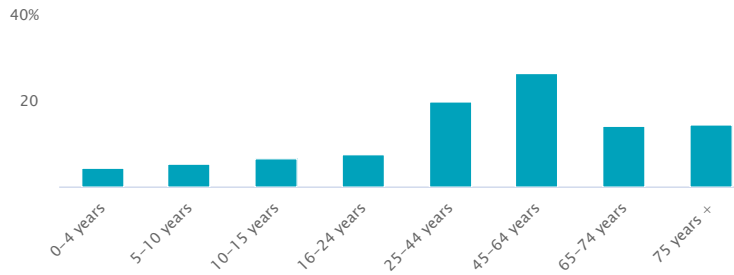

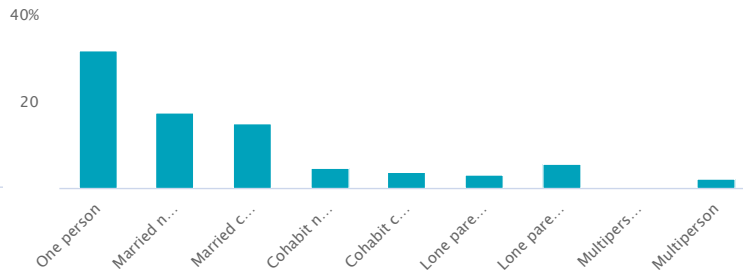

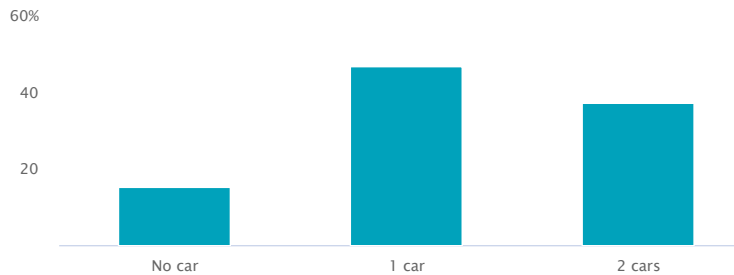

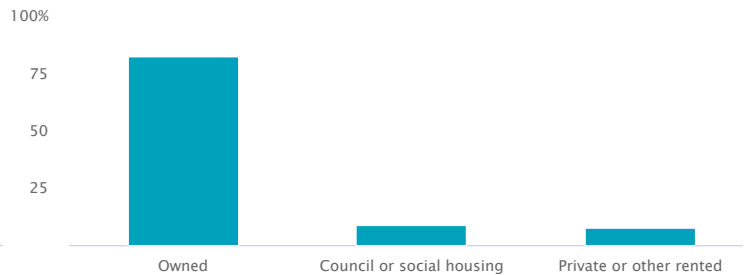

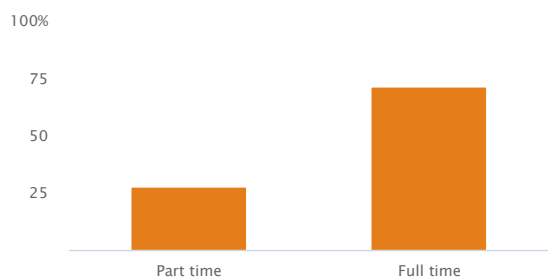

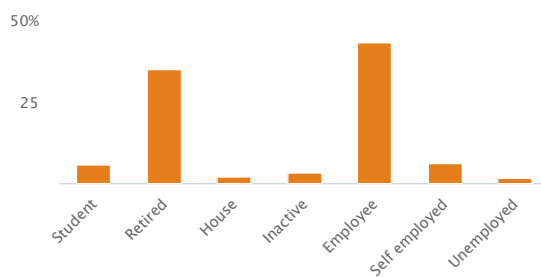
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



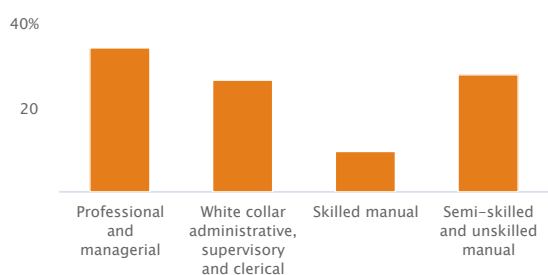
## Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

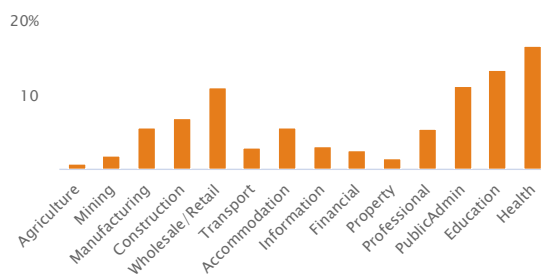


## Social Grade

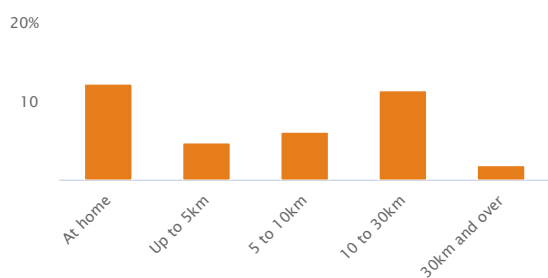
(% households aged 16-64)

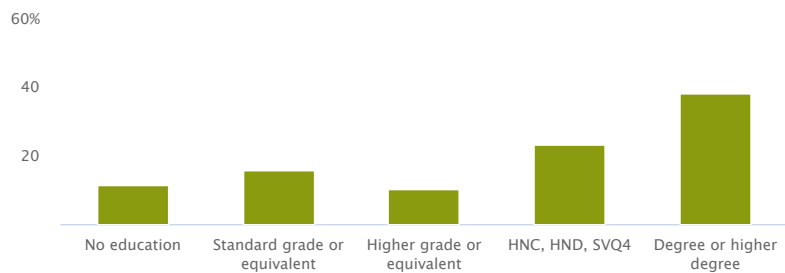

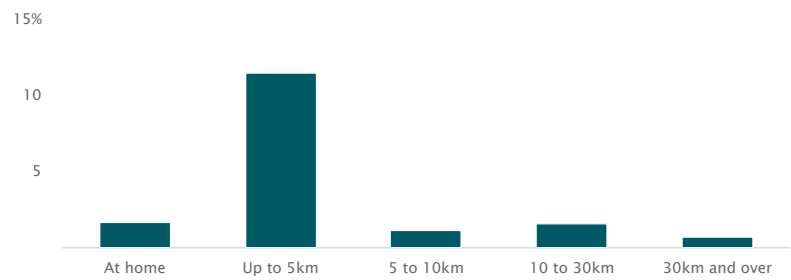
