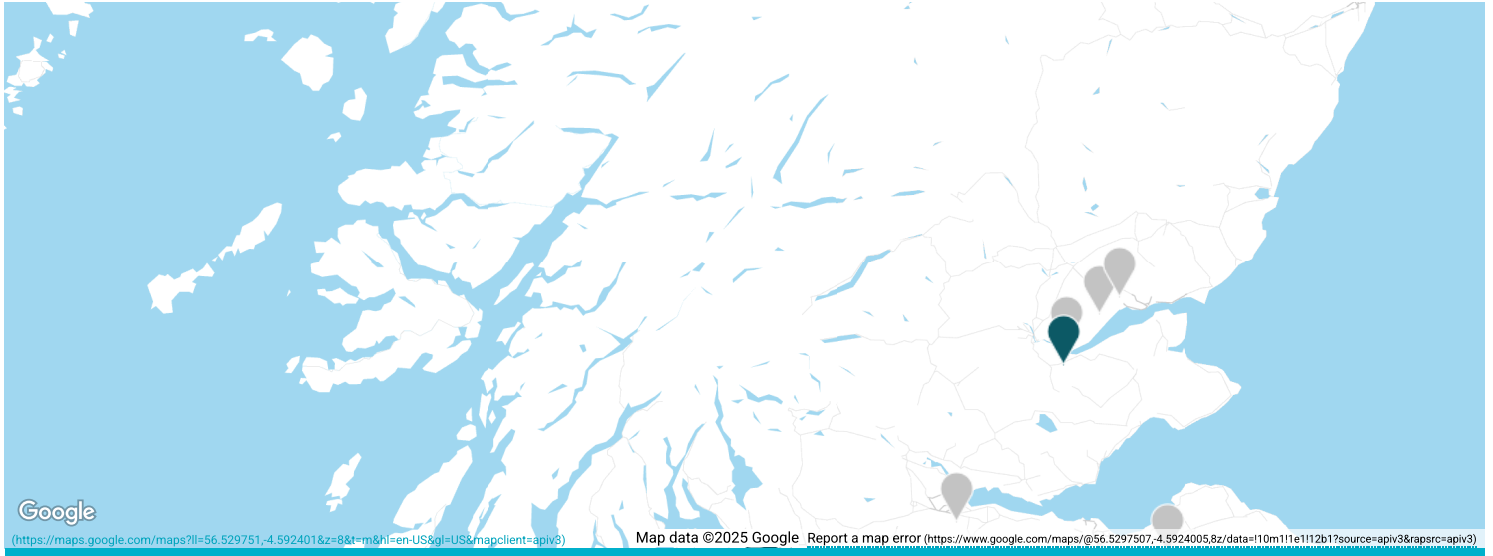




Monkton

Monkton is in Ayrshire. Originally Monkton had spinning and corn mills. Its proximity to Prestwick airport saw development focused on industries supporting aircraft maintenance. It had a number of brownfield sites and these are being developed for new housing.

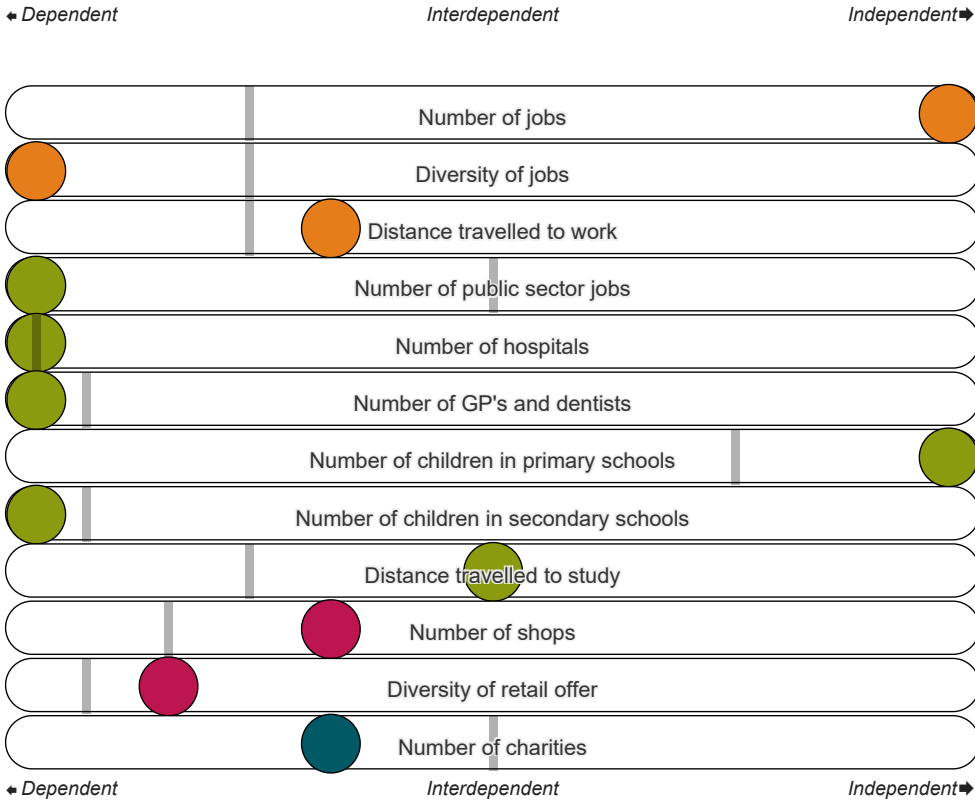
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Monkton is a dependent to interdependent town.

Monkton is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

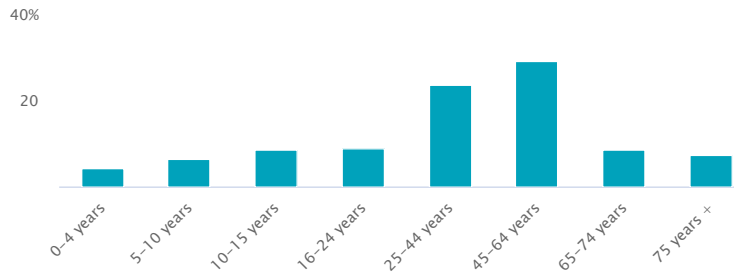
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Monkton is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. Monkton differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

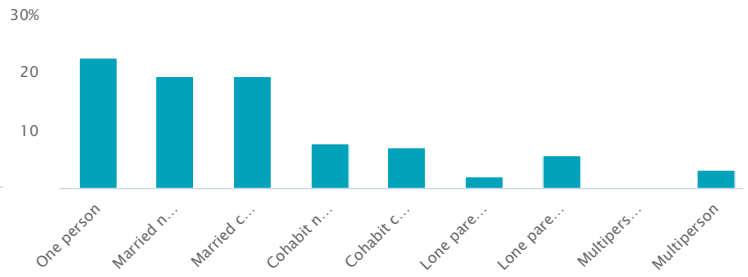

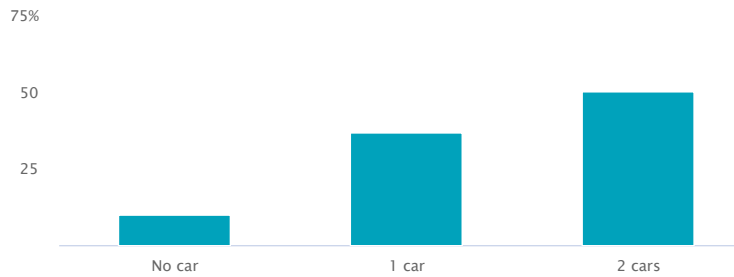

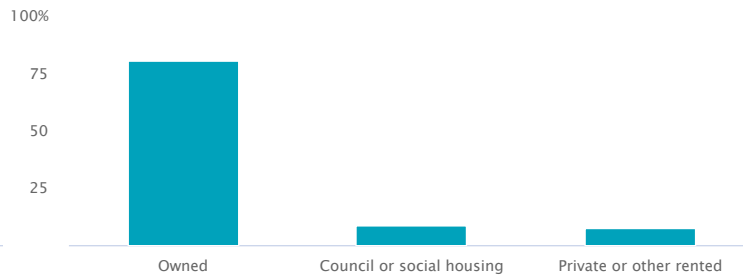
Household composition

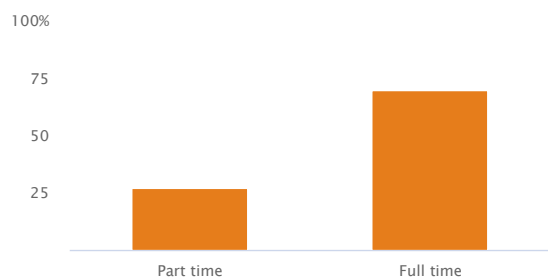

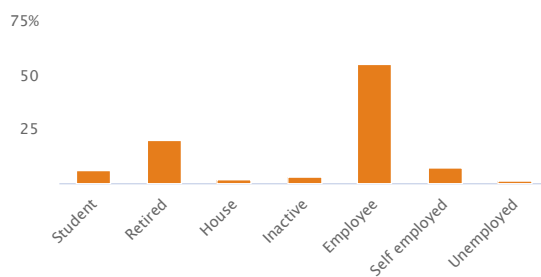
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



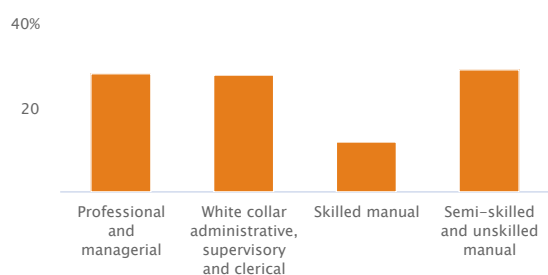
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

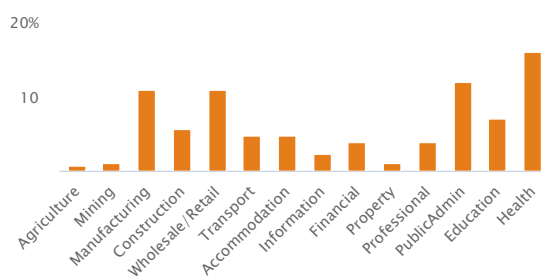


Social Grade

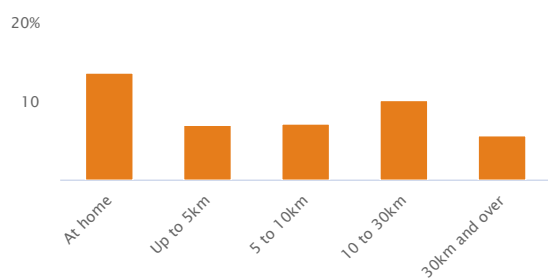
(% households aged 16-64)



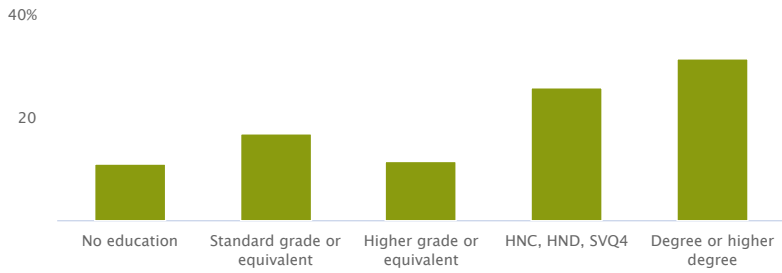
Sector Diversity

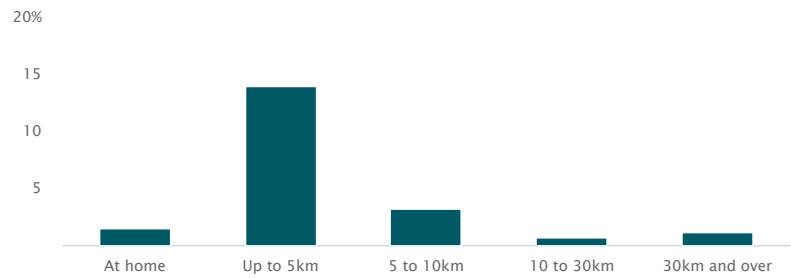
