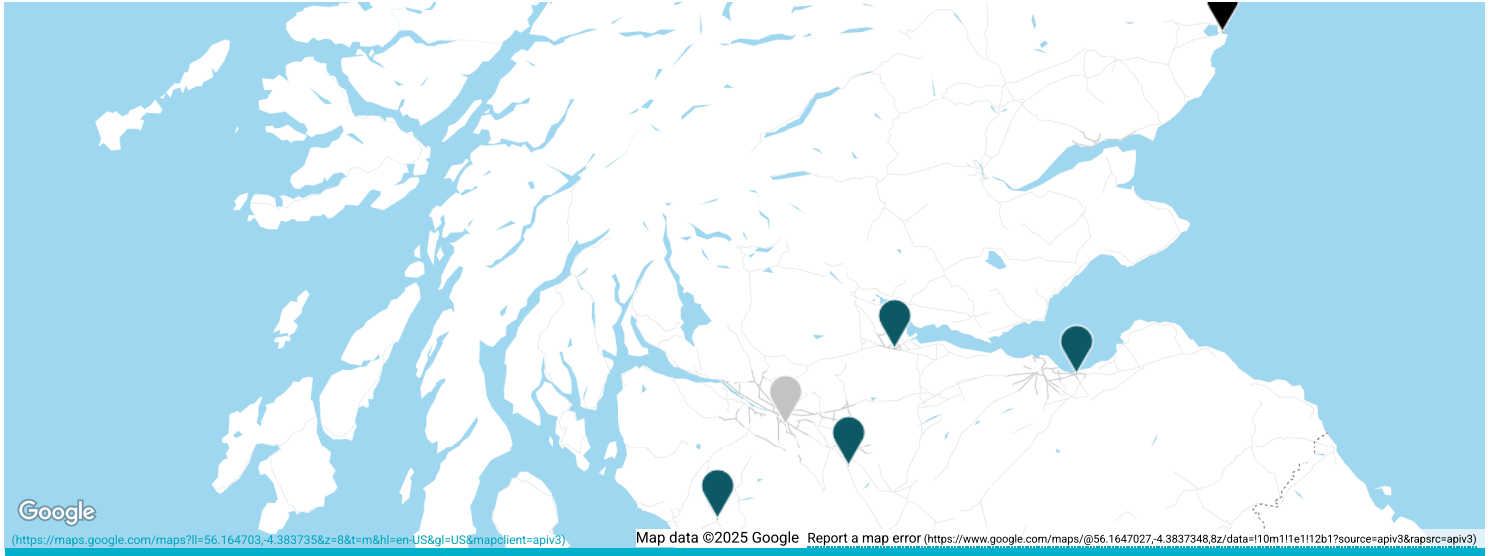




Montrose

Montrose is in Angus. It was seaside town with a natural harbour. It traded local products such as hides and fish. The natural harbour attracted development during the oil boom. Industries today include food processing, engineering, pharmaceuticals (GlaxoSmithKline) and oil related industries.

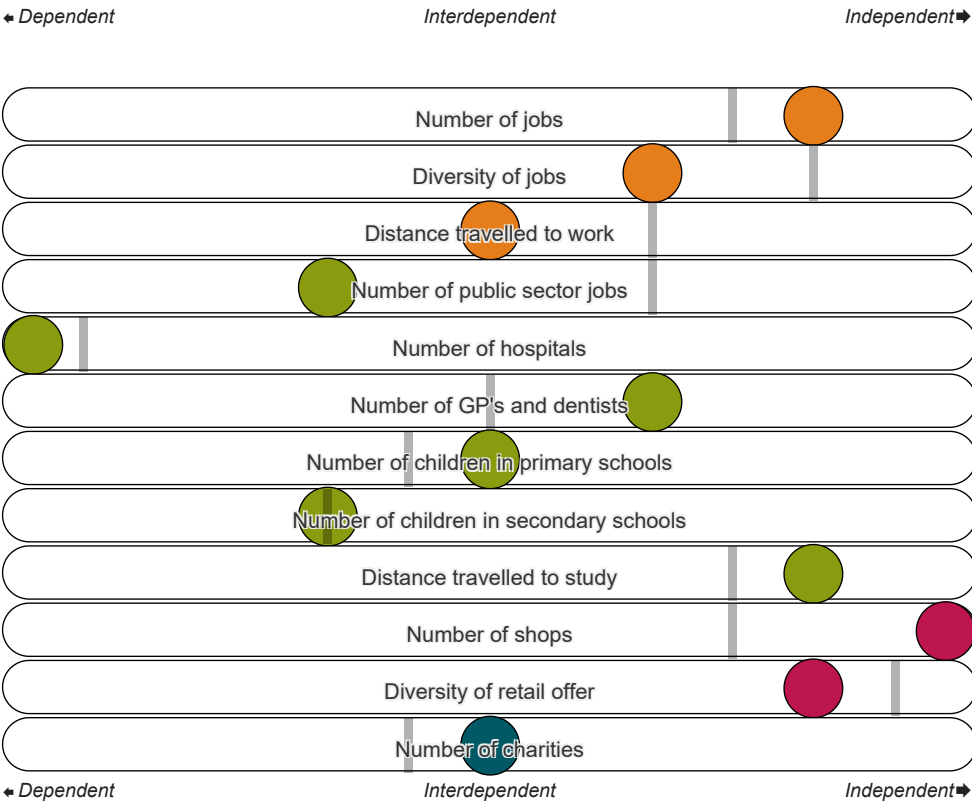
In large towns such as this, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Montrose is an interdependent to independent town.

Montrose is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Montrose is grouped with 5 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of shops. Montrose differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs.

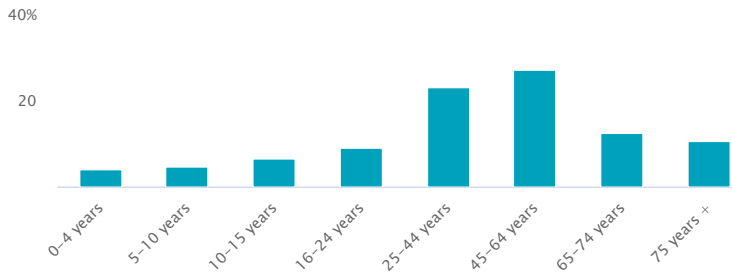

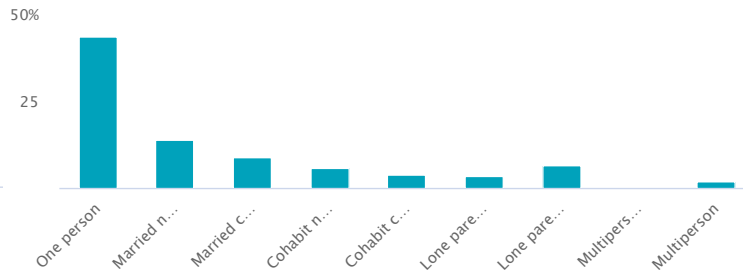

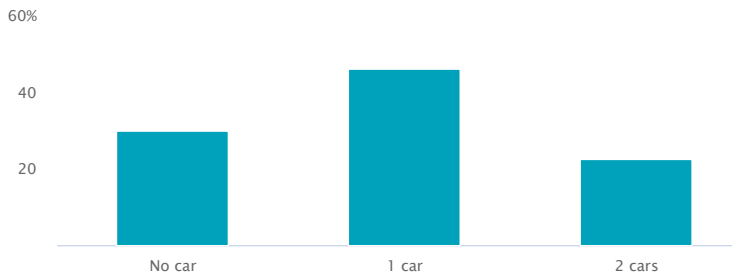

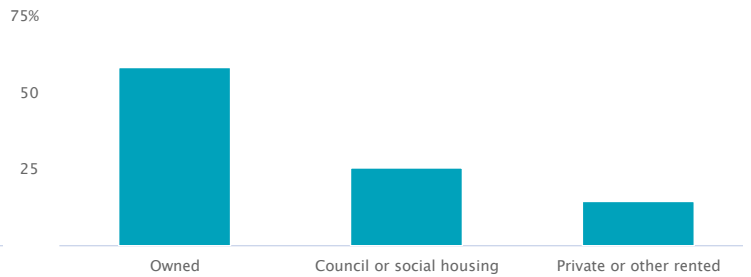
Household composition

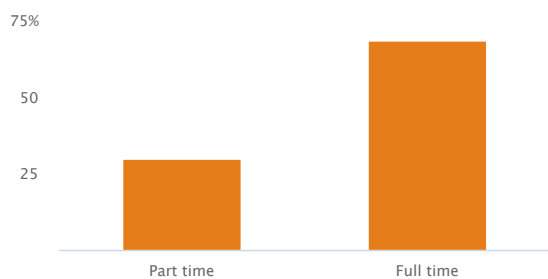

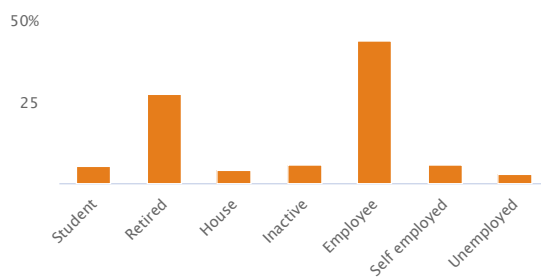
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



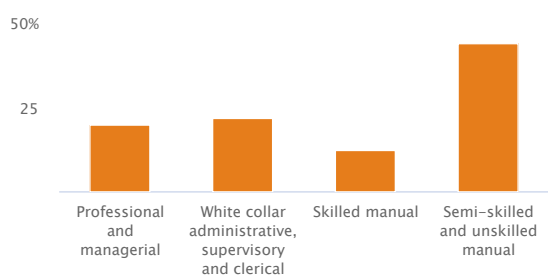
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

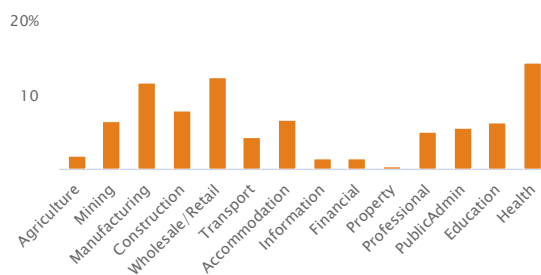

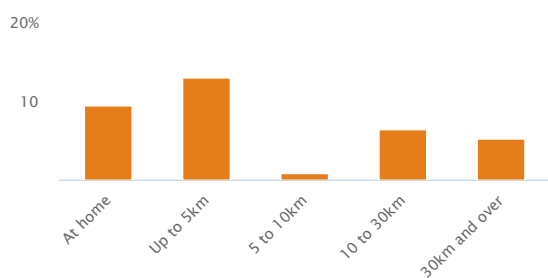
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

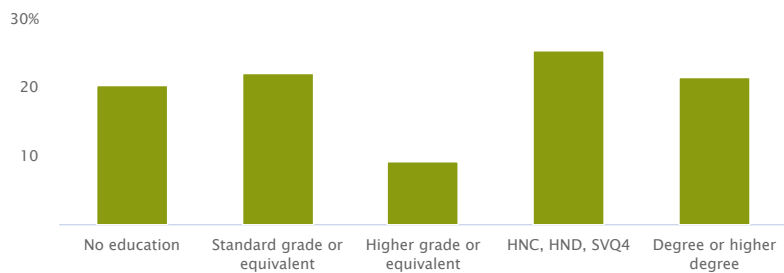


Distance travelled to work

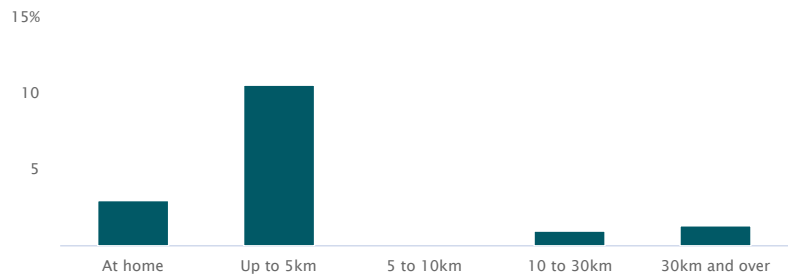
