Moodiesburn is in North Lanarkshire. Moodiesburn is a former 20th century mining settlement. Public housing was built to house miners. Stoneyetts psychiatric hospital also provided local employment but the site has been redveloped by Devro, collagen manufacturers and the most significant industry in Moodiesburn. New private housing has been built in Moodiesburn, much of it for commuters.


In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.















Sector Diversity




