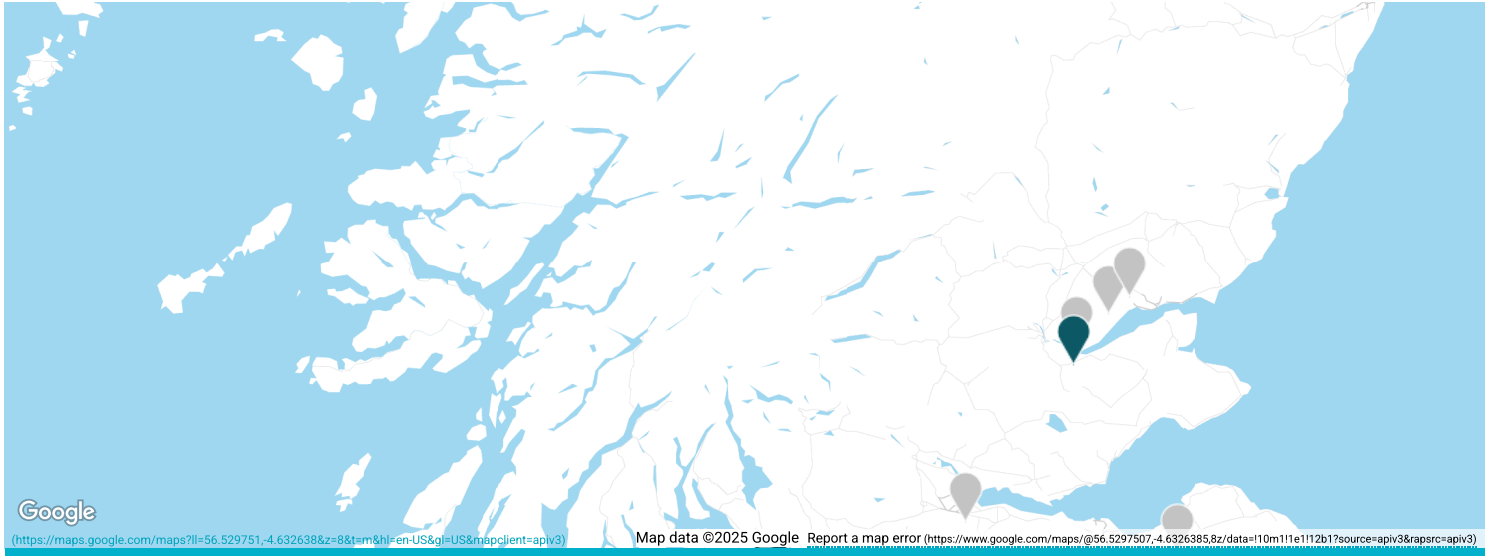




Morningside

Morningside is in North Lanarkshire. It developed as a mining village with an ironworks and engaged with railway development. Recently it has been regenerated as a residential town with new housing for families.

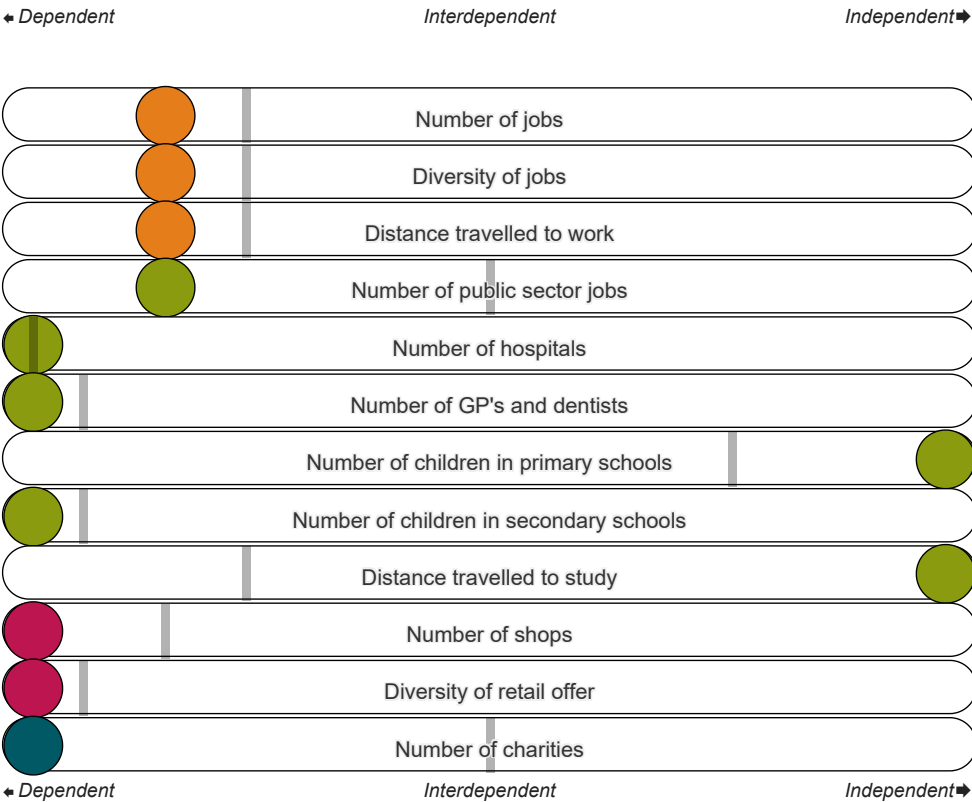
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Morningside is a dependent to interdependent town.

Morningside is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

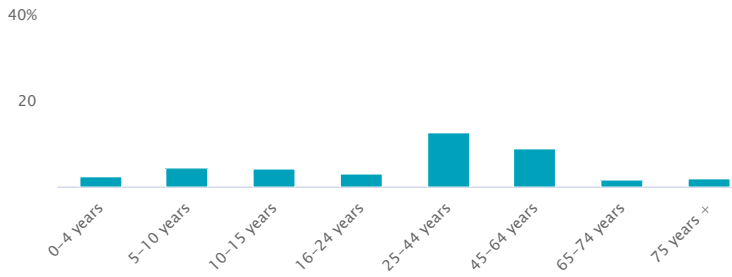
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Morningside is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Morningside differs most from its group in the number of charities.

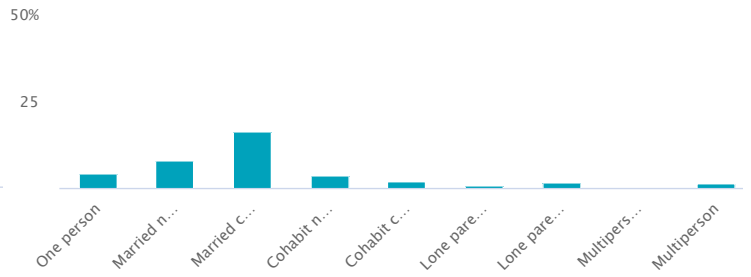

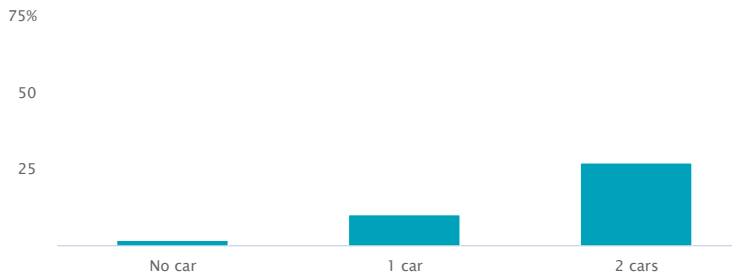
Age

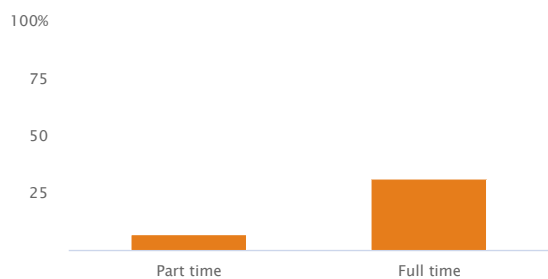

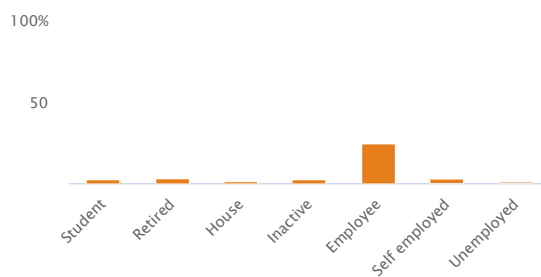
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



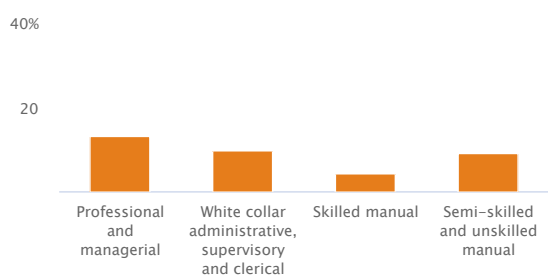
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

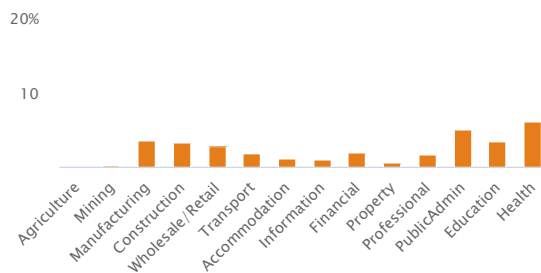

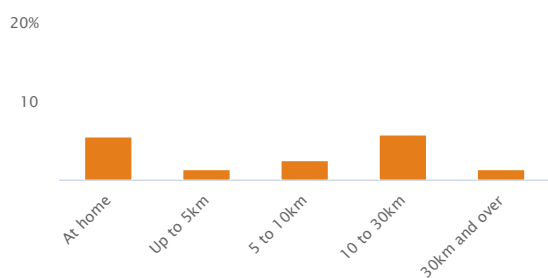
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

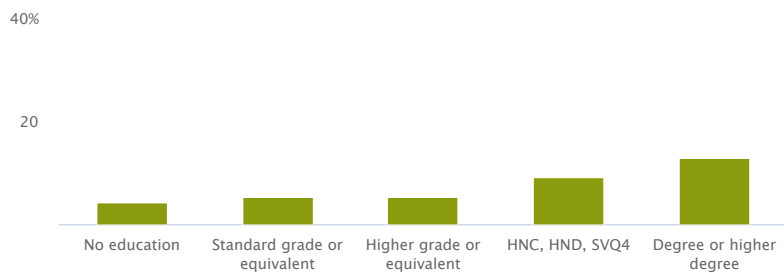


Distance travelled to work

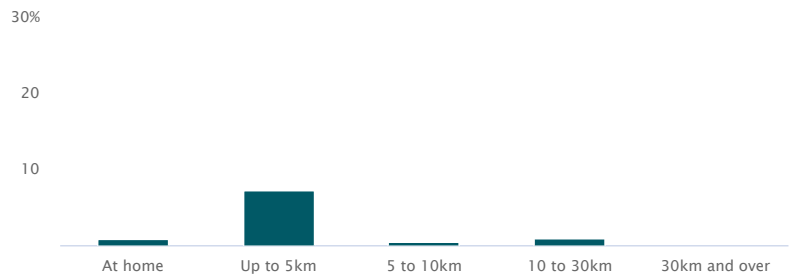
