



# Mossblown SOUTH AVRSHIRE

#### POPULATION 2,119

Mossblown is in South Ayrshire. The town developed as a coal mining settlement for the Drumley Colliery but suffered decline after the demise of the coal mine. Auchincruive Scottish Agricultural College is located close to Mossblown.


In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Mossblown is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Addiewell, Allanton, Burnfoot, and Catrine.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Mossblown is grouped with 17 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools. Mossblown differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the distance travelled to study.






#### **Employment type**

(% households aged 16-64)








# **Occupation**

(% aged 16-74)






