Mosstodloch is in Moray. It is dominated by sawmilling and the timber industry.

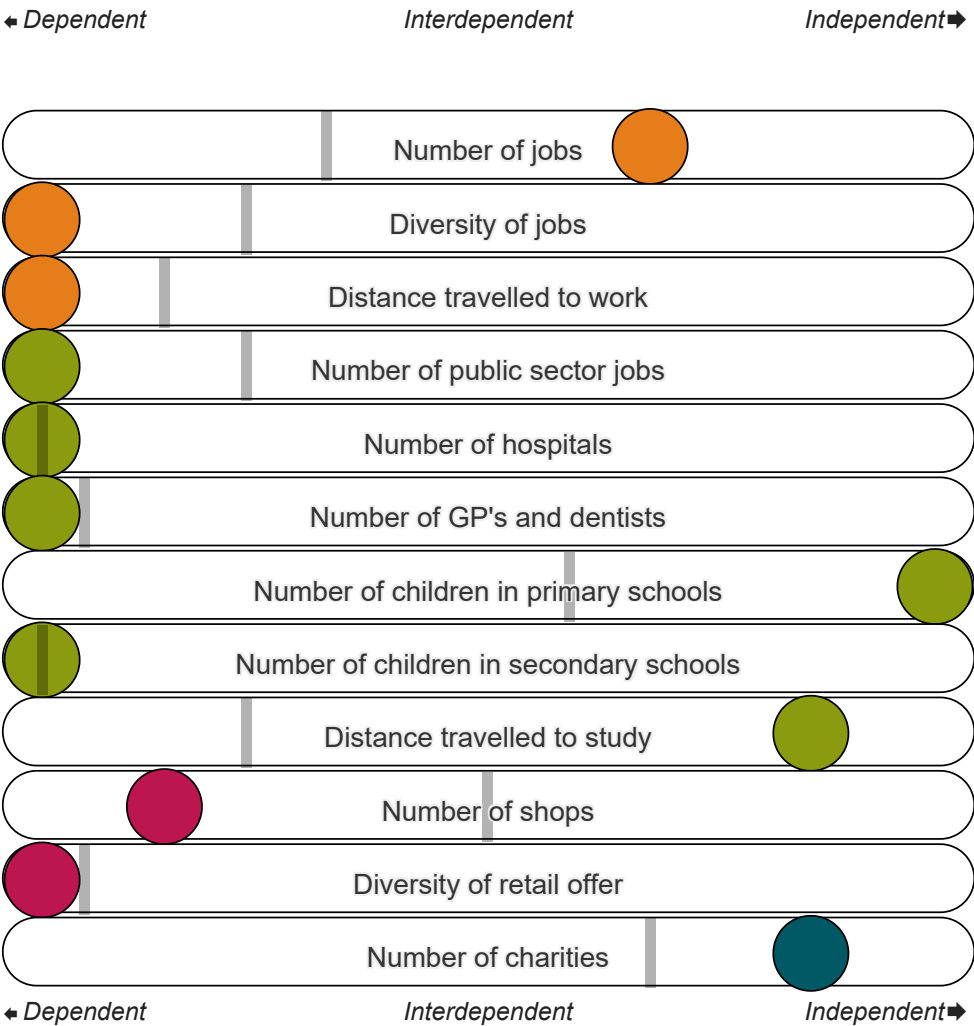
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Mosstodloch is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aberchirder](#), [Carnwath](#), [Eastriggs](#), and [Kincardine](#).

Mosstodloch is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Mosstodloch is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Mosstodloch differs most from its group in the number of shops.

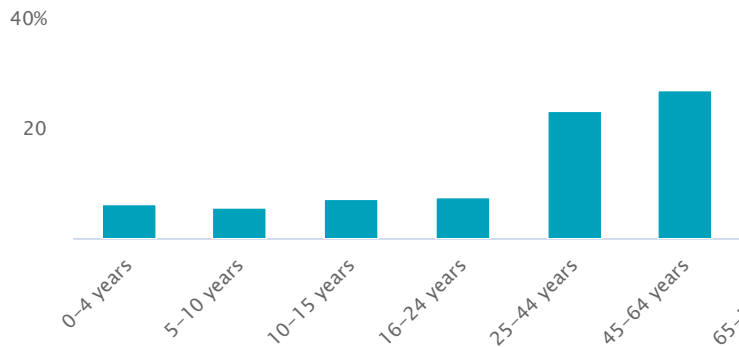

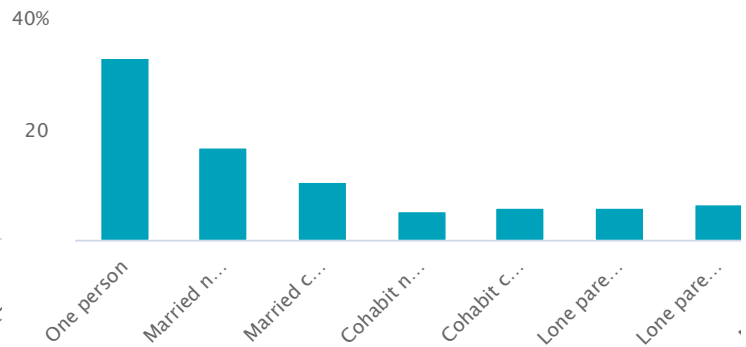

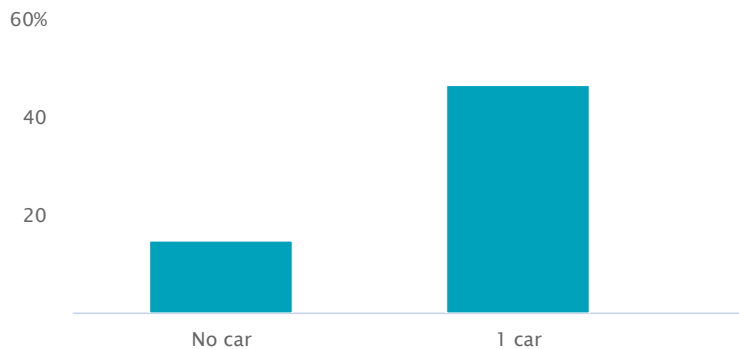

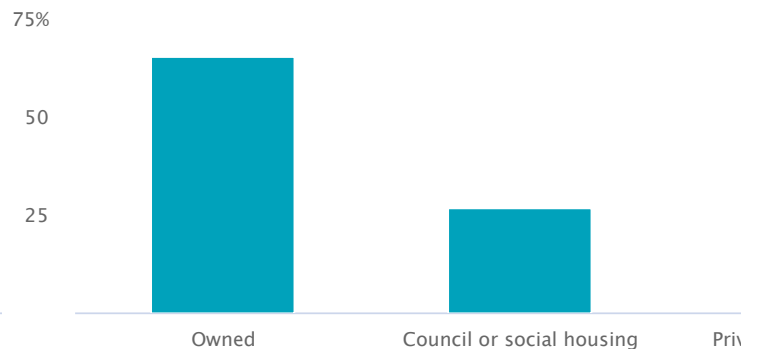

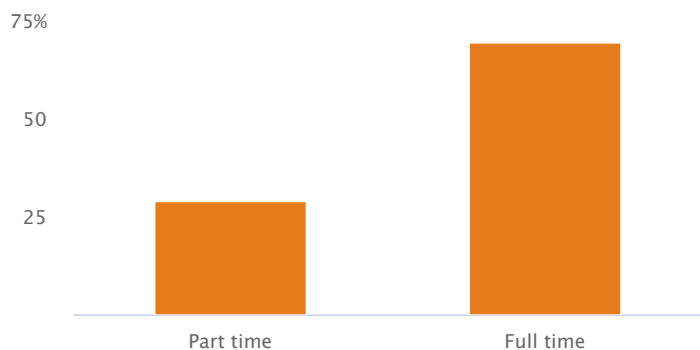

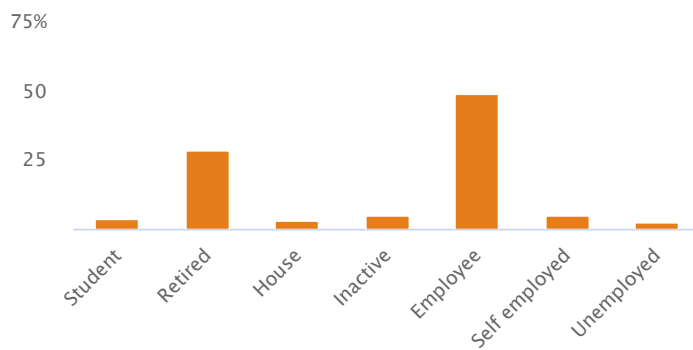
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



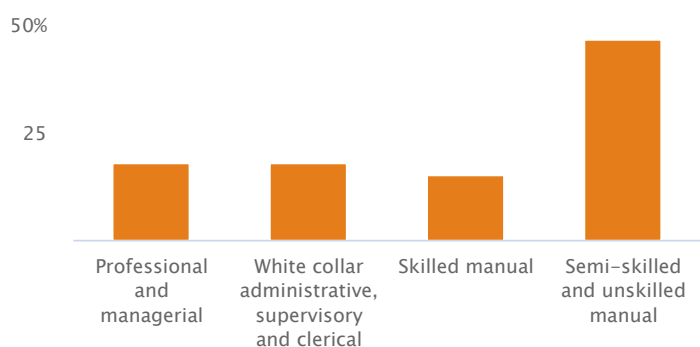
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

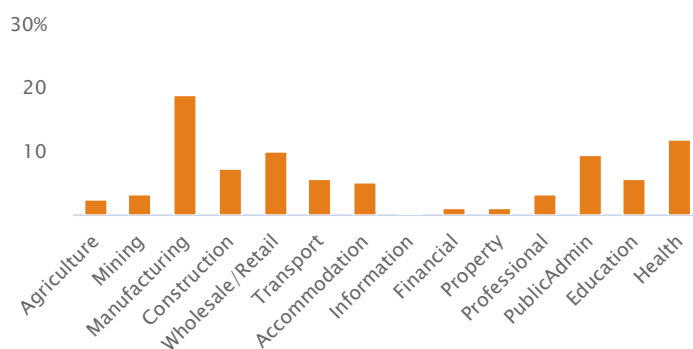

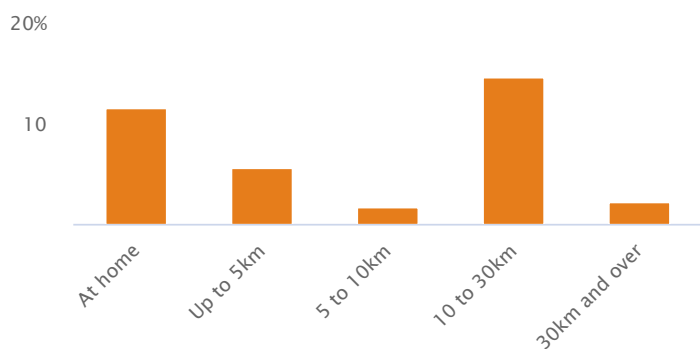
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

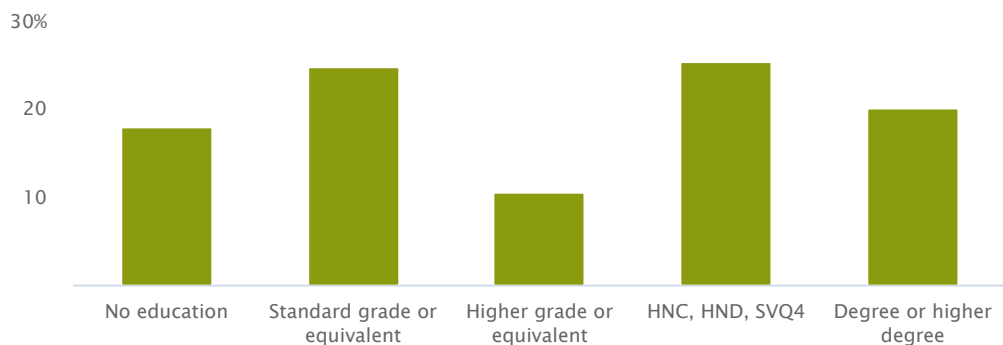


Distance travelled to work

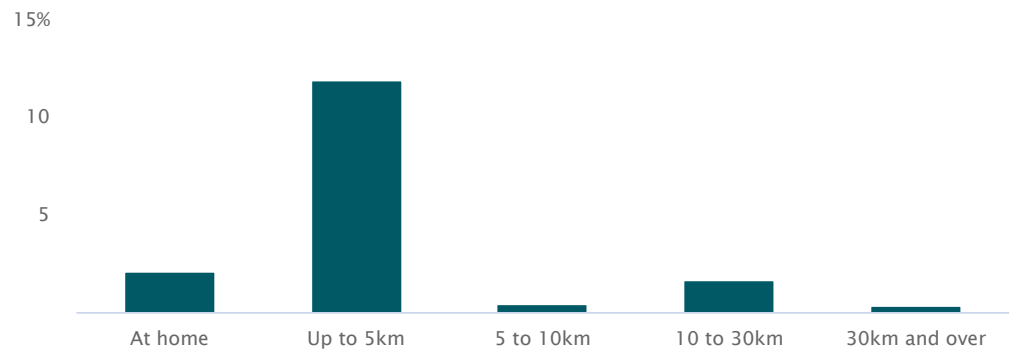
