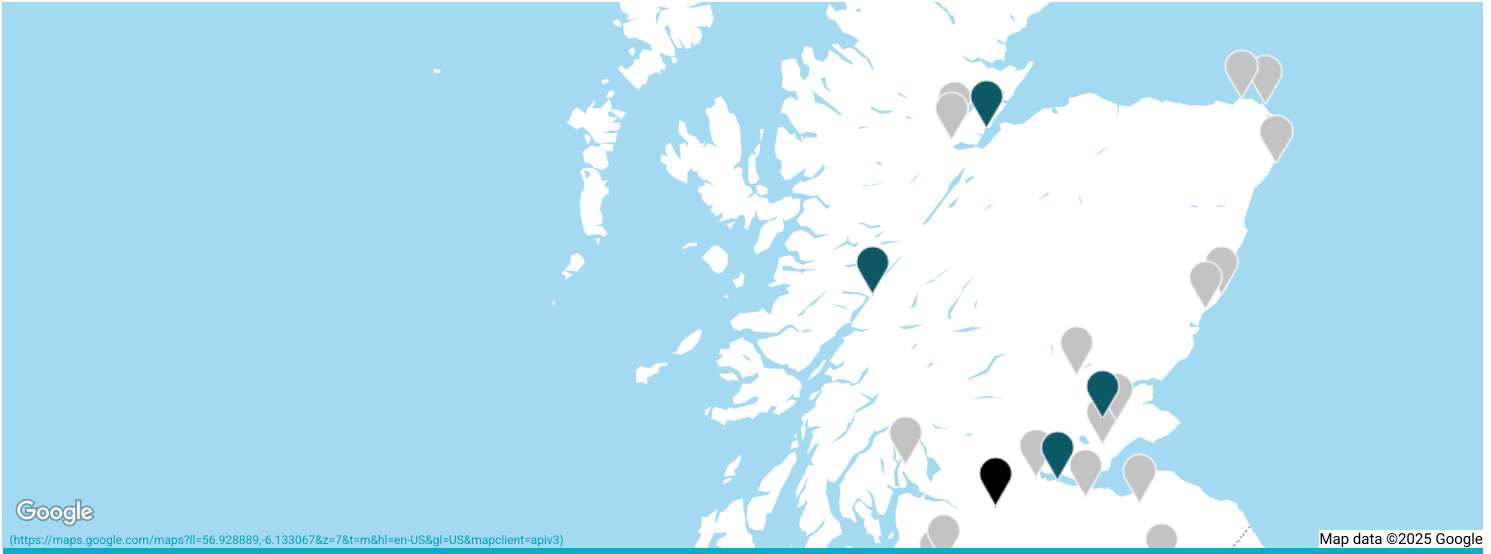




Muirhead

Muirhead is located in North Lanarkshire. Once a mining town with brickmaking and distilling the town is now a dormitory town.

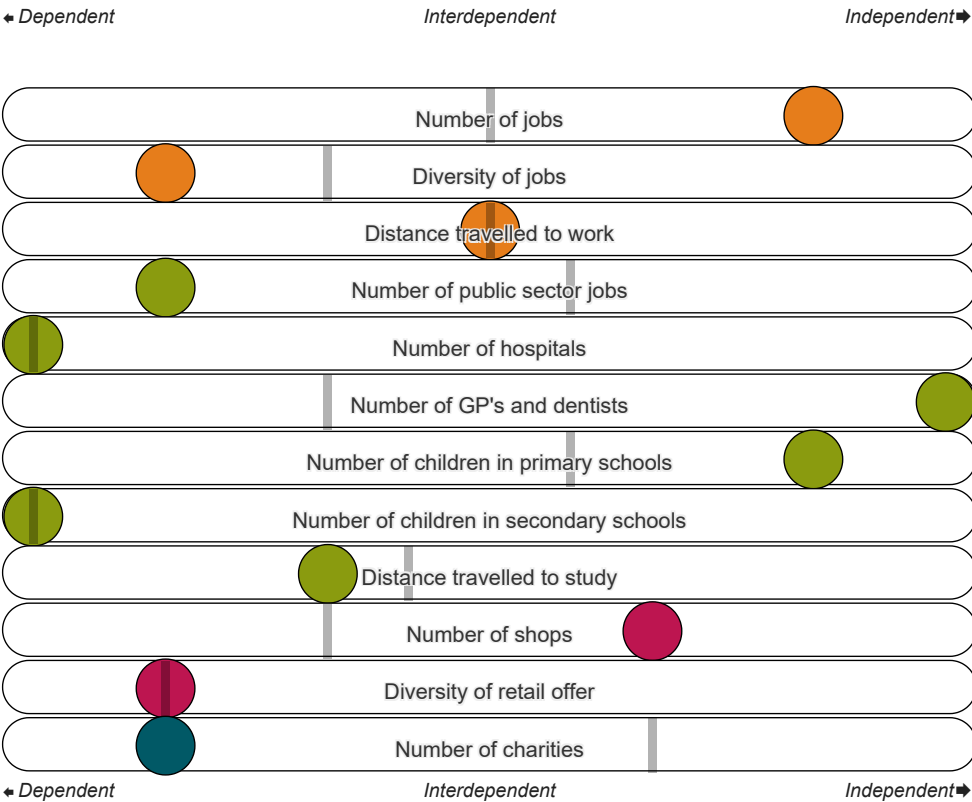
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Muirhead is an interdependent to dependent town.

Inter-relationships



Muirhead is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Muirhead is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists. Muirhead differs most from its group in the number of charities, and public sector jobs.

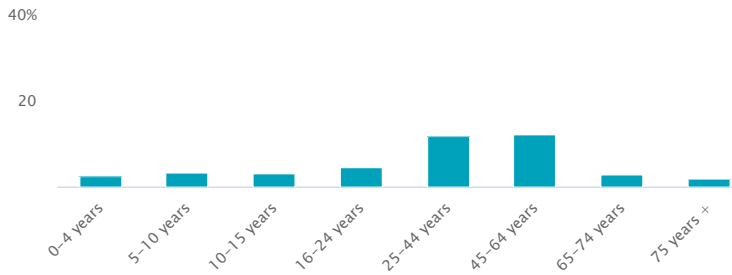

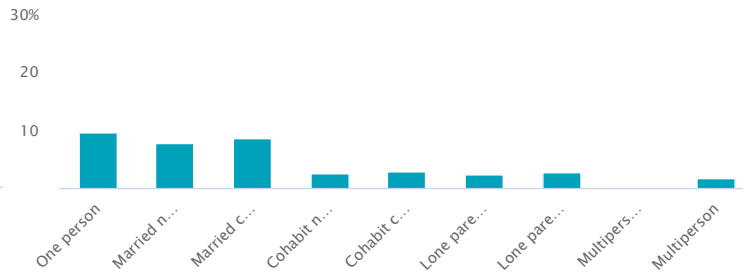

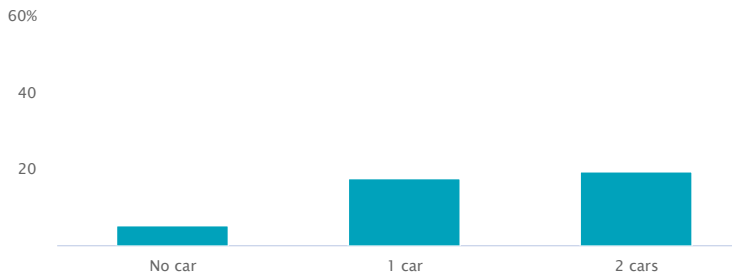

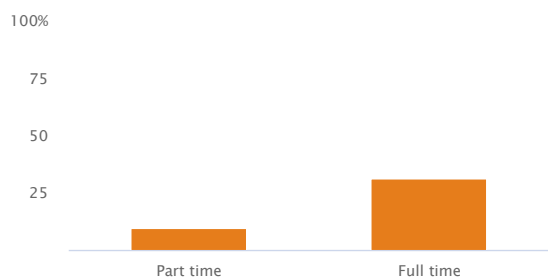

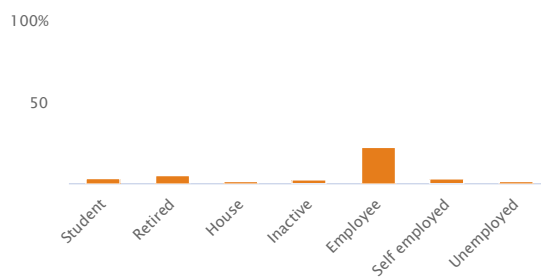
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



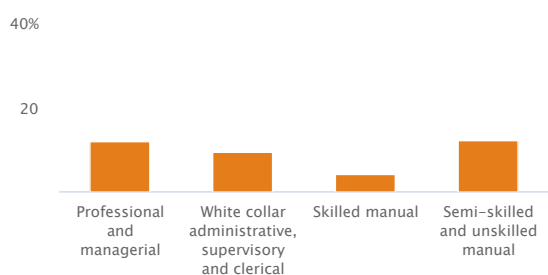
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

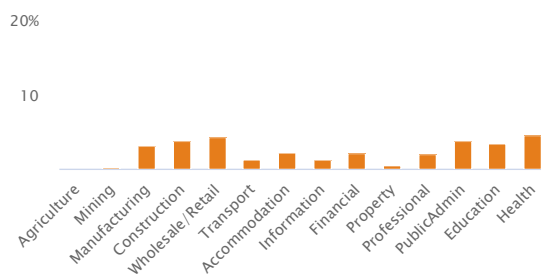

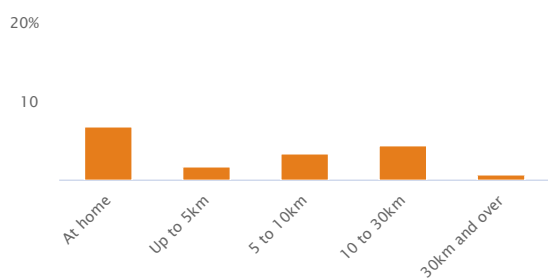
(% households aged 16-64)



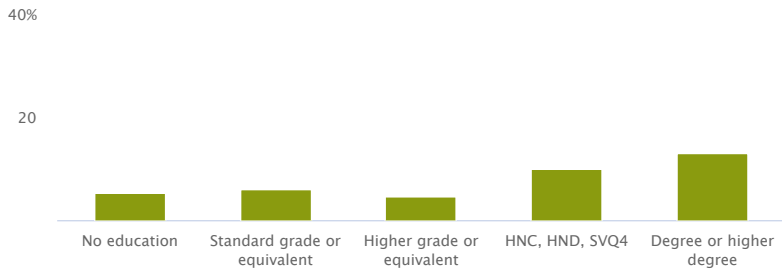
Sector Diversity

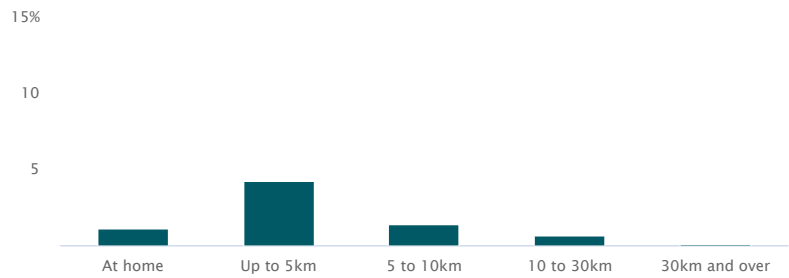
