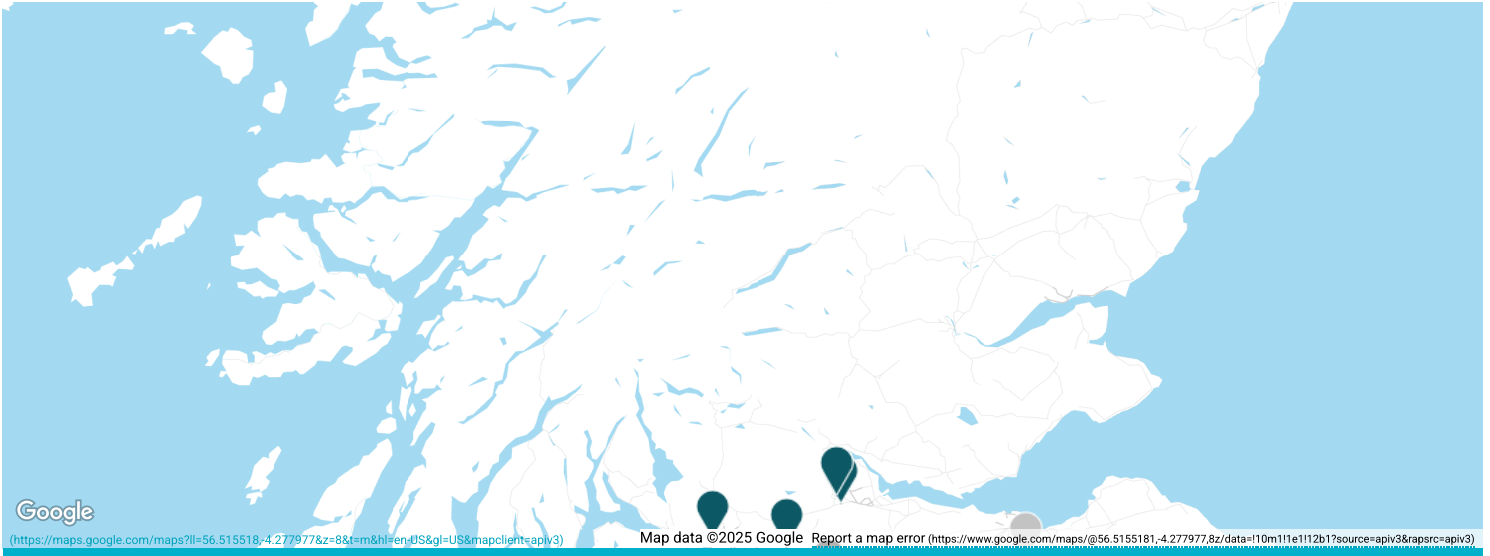




Newarthill

POPULATION **6,952**

Newarthill is in North Lanarkshire. Coal was found here in the mid 19th century and the settlement grew around the mining employment. Residents find employment and services in other nearby centres.

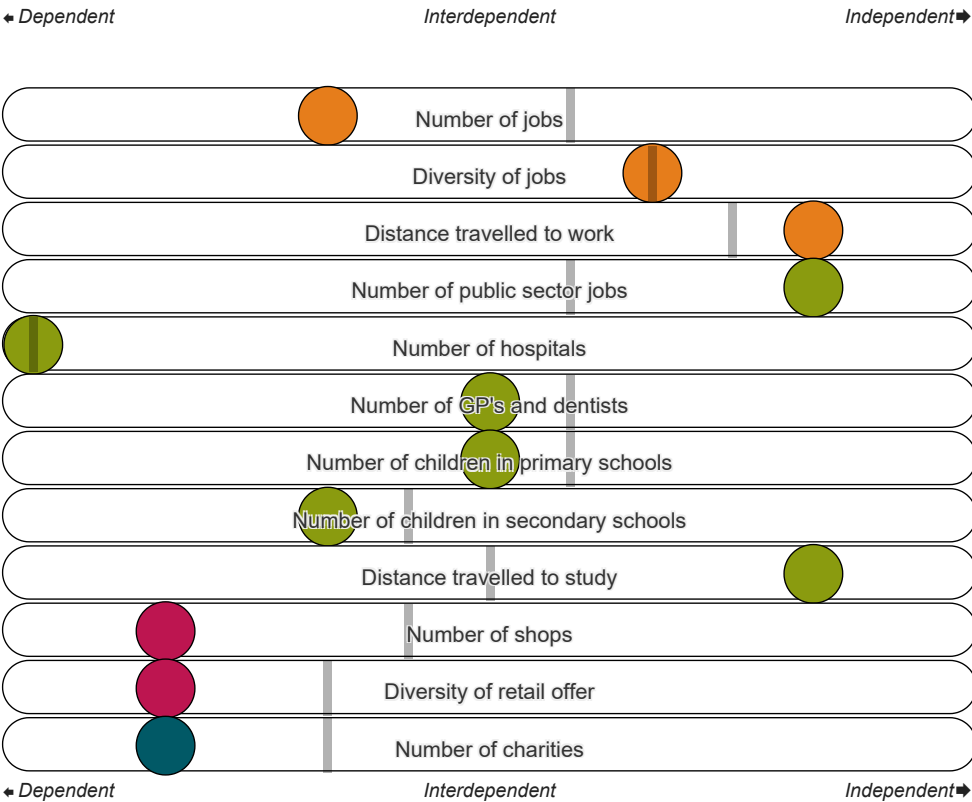
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Newarthill is an interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Newarthill is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Newarthill is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, and GP's and dentists. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Newarthill differs most from its group in the number of shops.

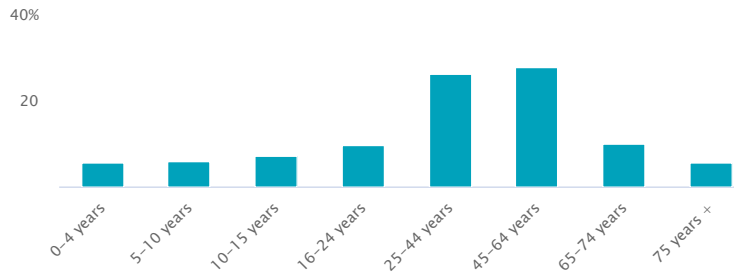

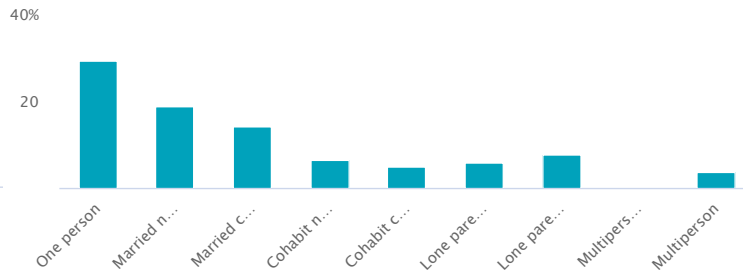

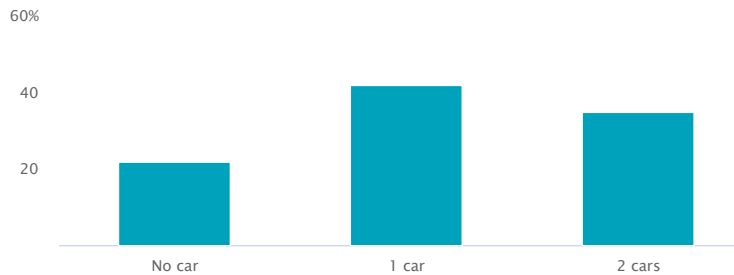

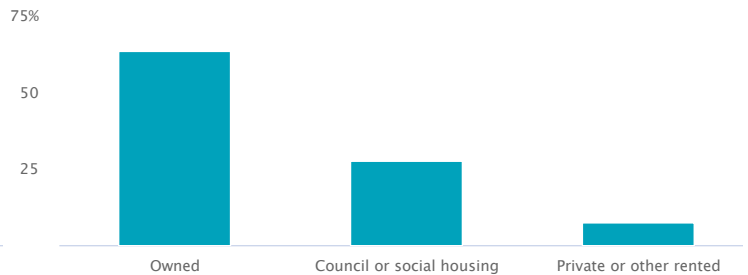

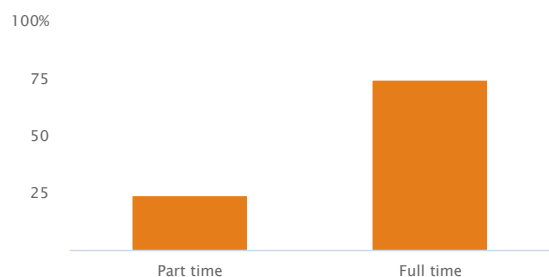

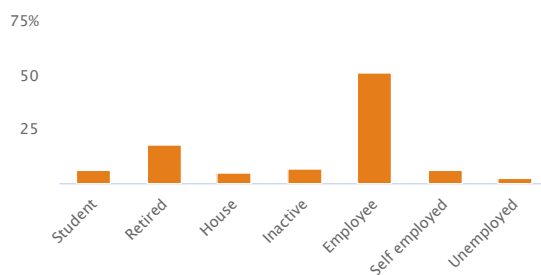
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



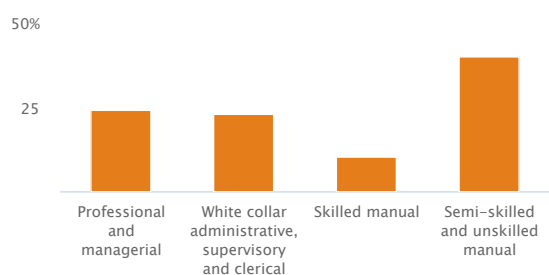
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

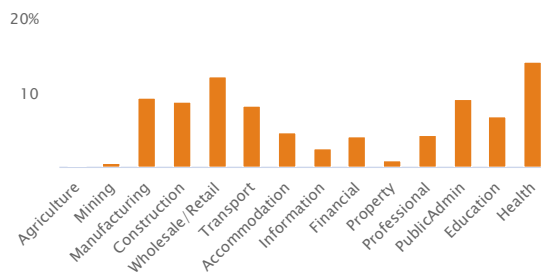

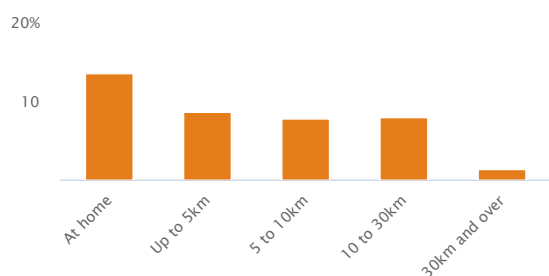
(% households aged 16-64)



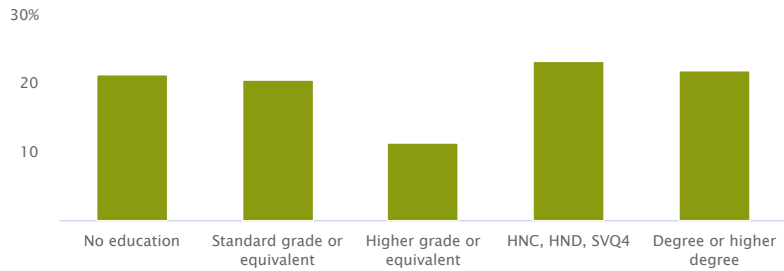
Sector Diversity

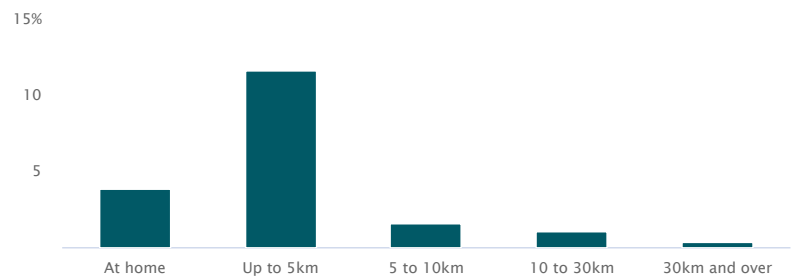
