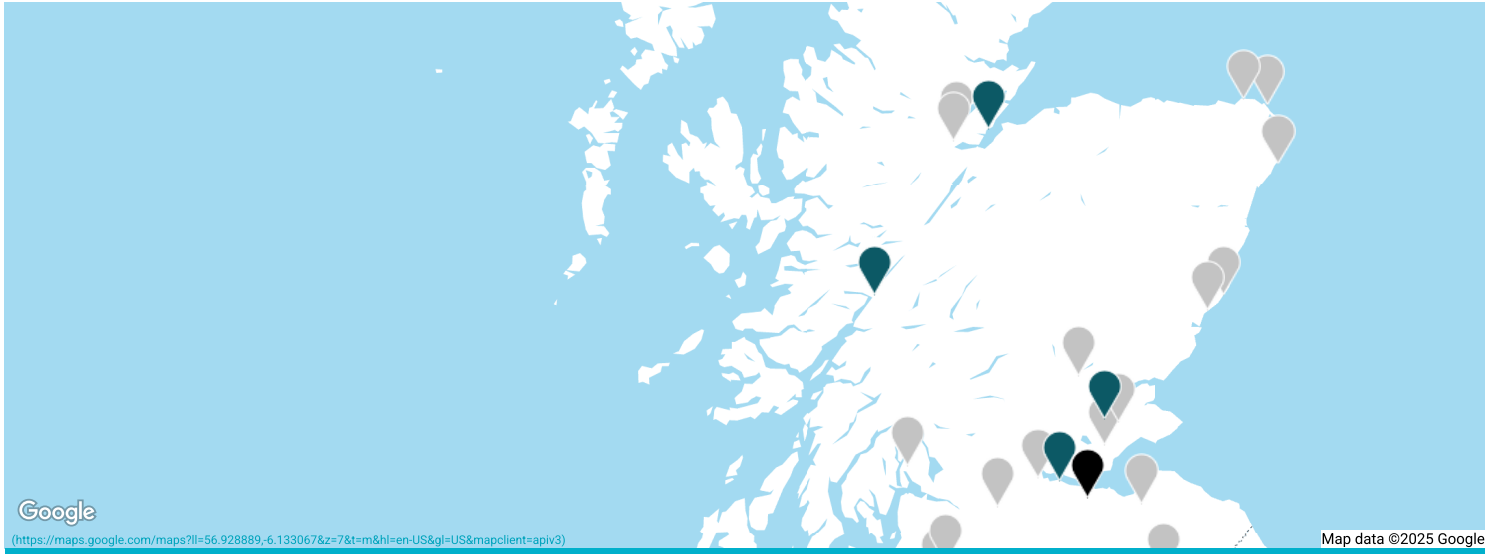




Newbridge and Ratho Station

Newbridge and Ratho Station is in the City of Edinburgh and is a suburb of Edinburgh. It has limited services. Ratho Station has warehousing (including storage) and local industries including the BenRiach Distillery Bond Exova materials testing. Activities associated with Edinburgh airport include Fedex, conference venues and airport parking.

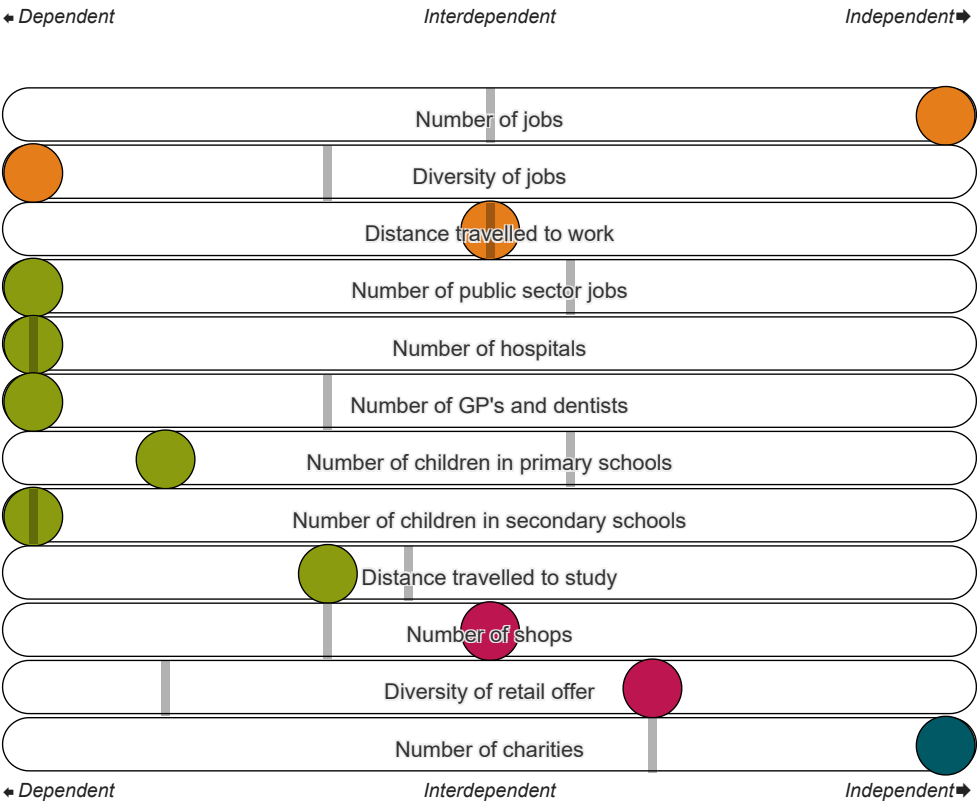
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Newbridge and Ratho Station is an interdependent to dependent town.

Inter-relationships



Newbridge and Ratho Station is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Newbridge and Ratho Station is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, and shops. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer. Newbridge and Ratho Station differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists; and the diversity of jobs.

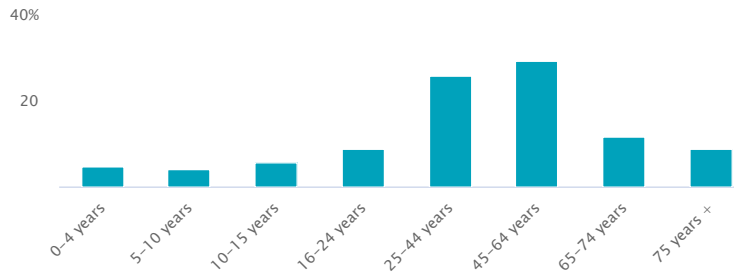

Population change 2011 to 2022**-3%**

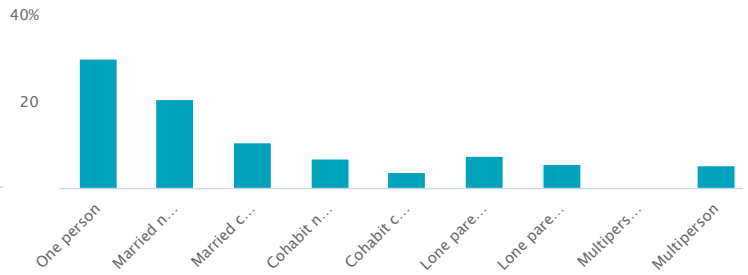

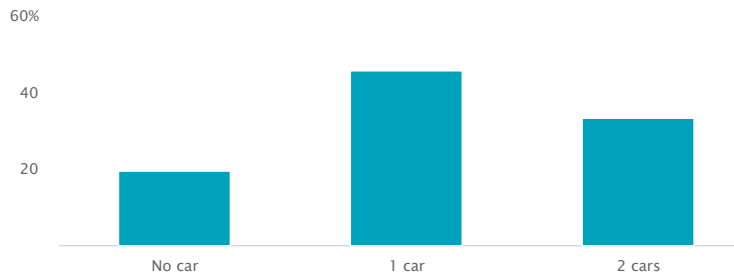

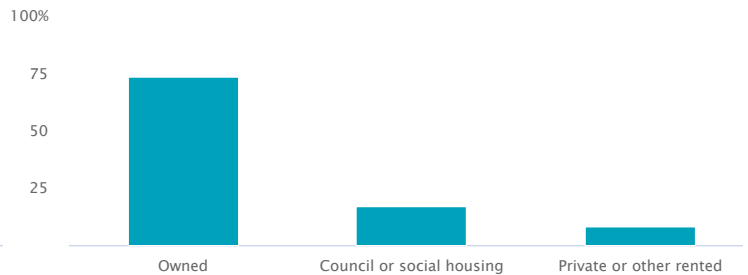
Household composition

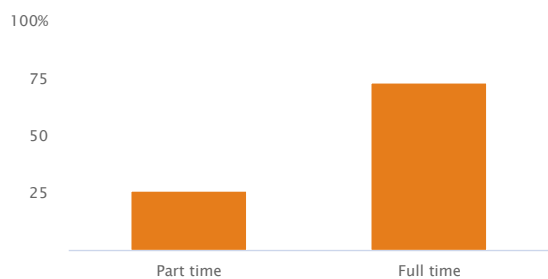

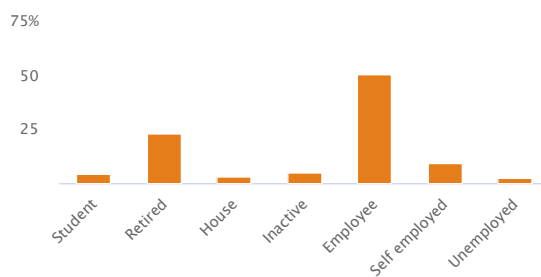
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



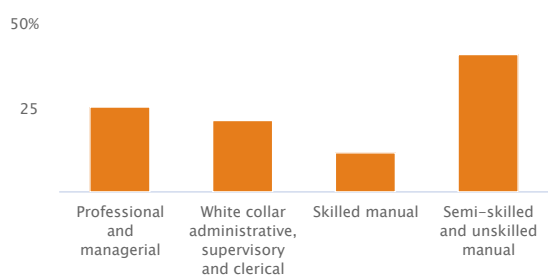
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

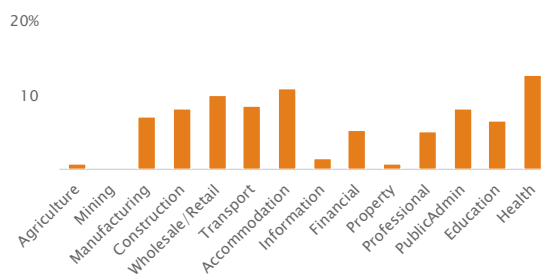

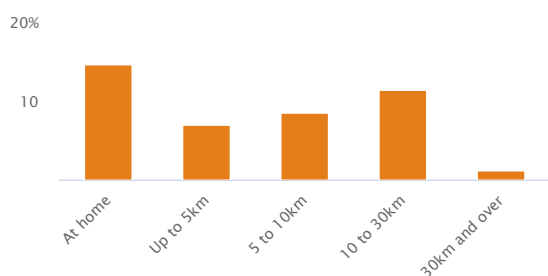
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

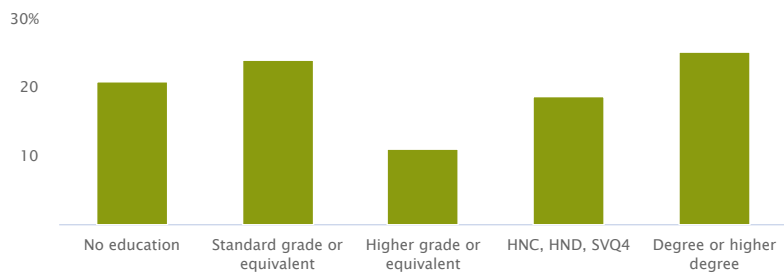


Distance travelled to work

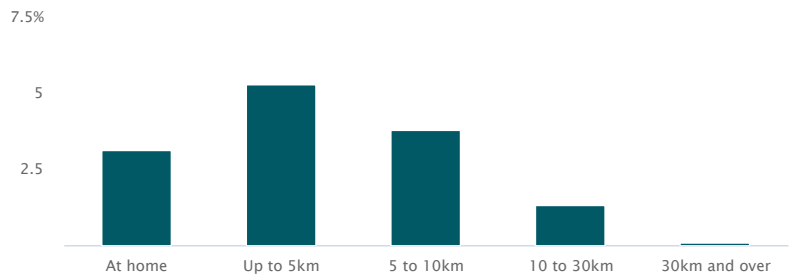
