It was given locality status not due to recent expansion but because the three scattered crofting townships operate as a wider community. They have become increasingly drawn into the orbit of Stornoway and empty plots have been redeveloped with new houses.


In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Its most similar towns are Auchtermuchty, Avoch, Banavie and Corpach, and Bo'ness.






Employment type

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)




