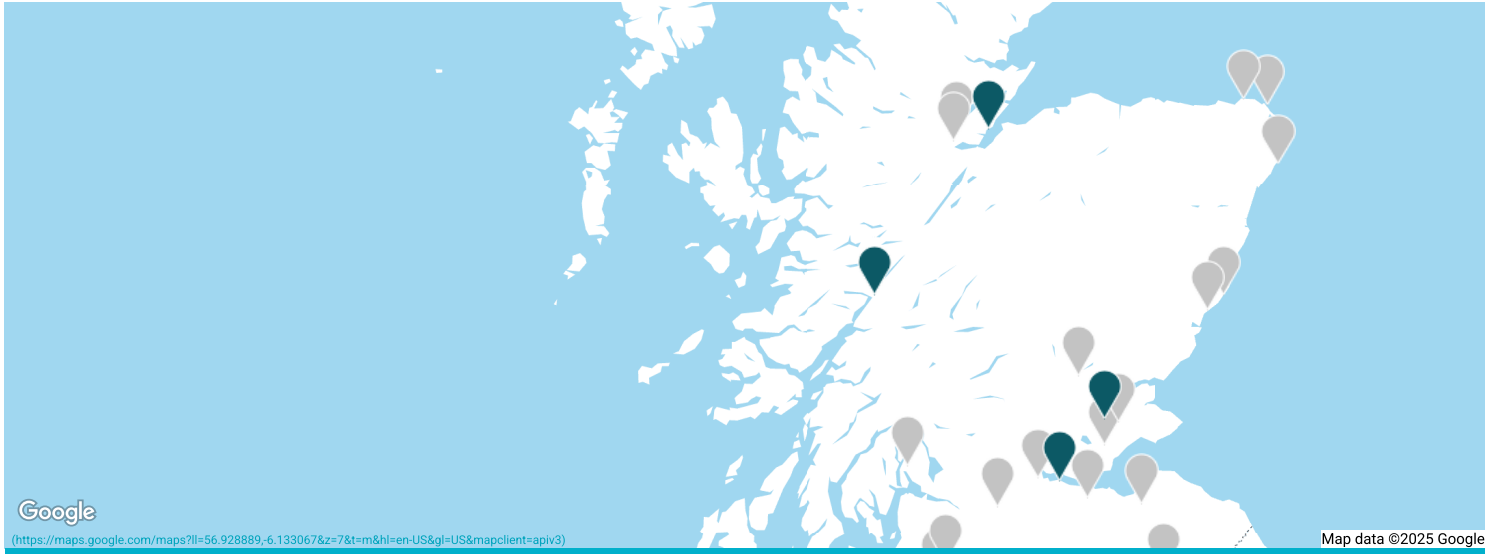




Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank

Margaidh Ur, Lacasdal and Bruach Mairi or Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank is in Eilean Siar. It was given locality status not due to recent expansion but because the three scattered crofting townships operate as a wider community. They have become increasingly drawn into the orbit of Stornoway and empty plots have been redeveloped with new houses.

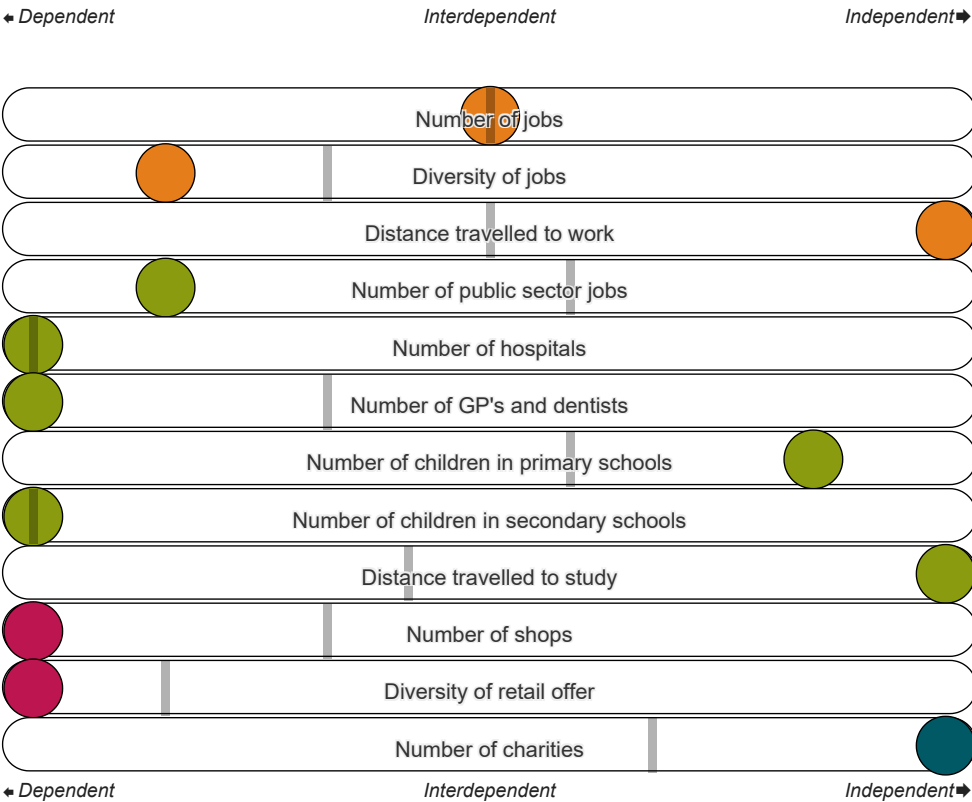
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank is an interdependent to dependent town.

Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

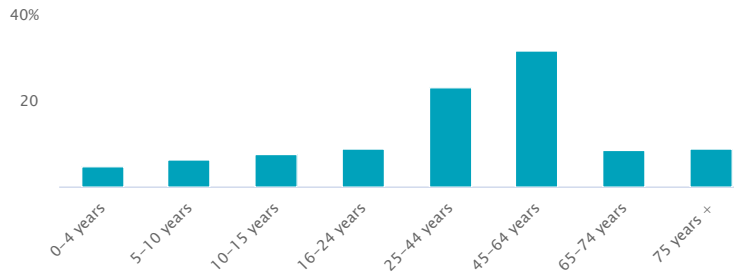
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Newmarket, Laxdale and Marybank differs most from its group in the number of shops, and GP's and dentists.

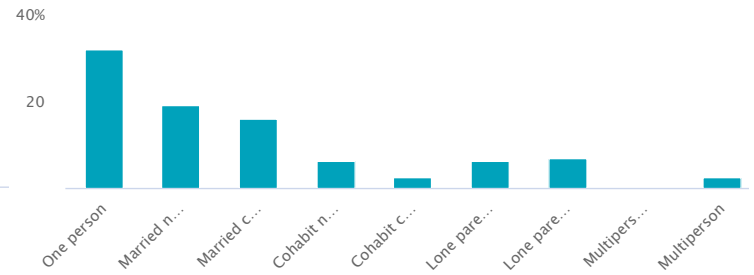

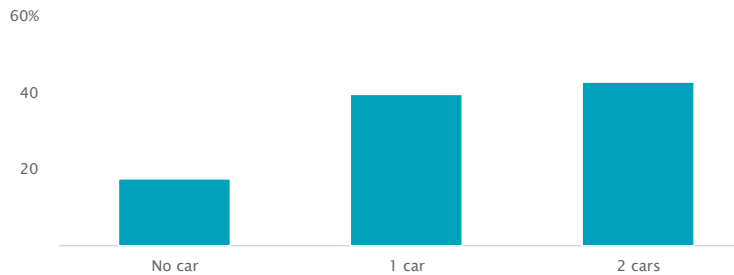

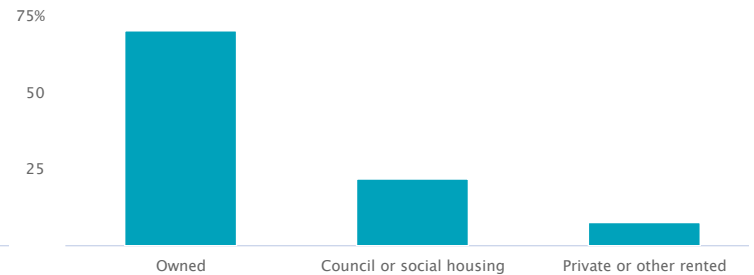
Household composition

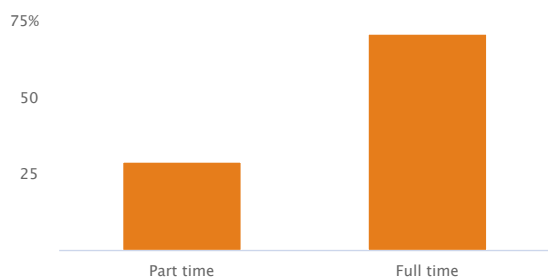

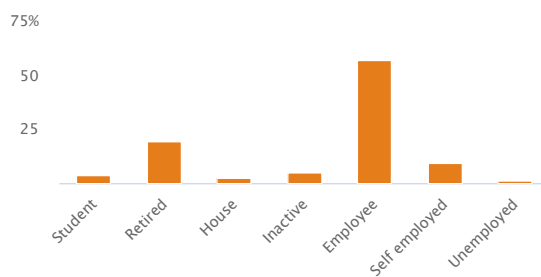
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



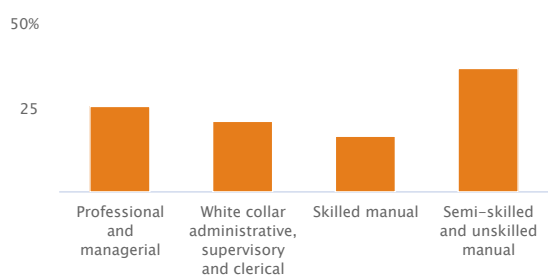
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

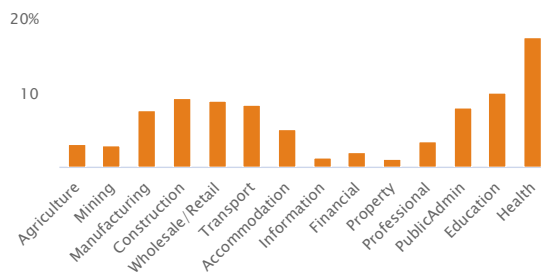

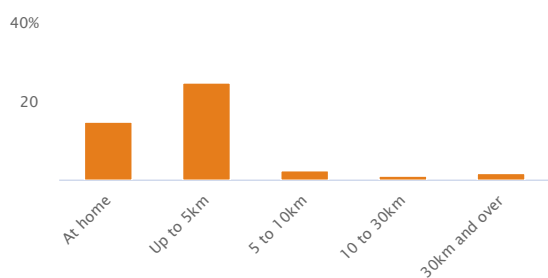
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

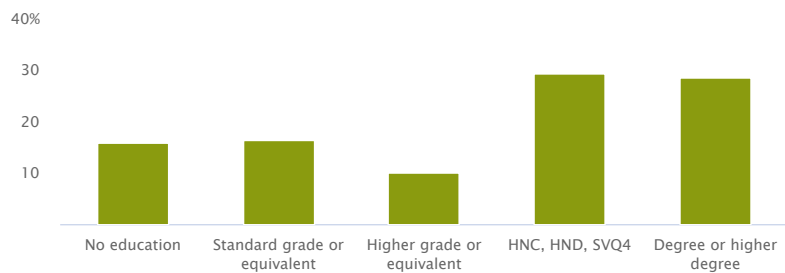


Distance travelled to work

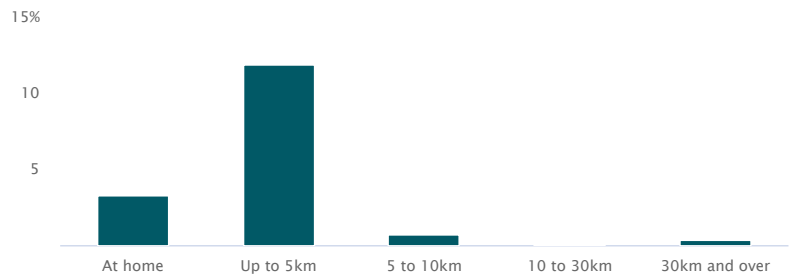
