Newport-on-Tay and Wormit are in Fife. This was a 19th century ferry port for Dundee. The Tay bridges saw the towns bypassed but increased accessibility transformed them into suburbs of Dundee and commuter towns.

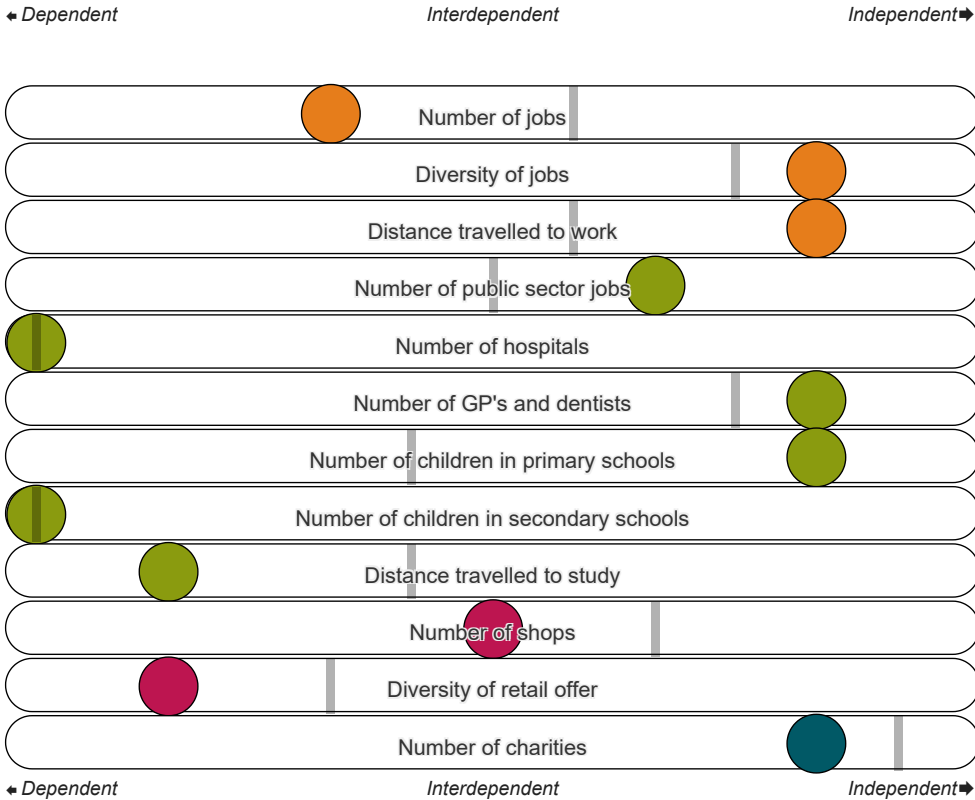
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Newport-on-Tay and Wormit is an interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Newport-on-Tay and Wormit is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Newport-on-Tay and Wormit is grouped with 2 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Newport-on-Tay and Wormit differs most from its group in the distance travelled to study.

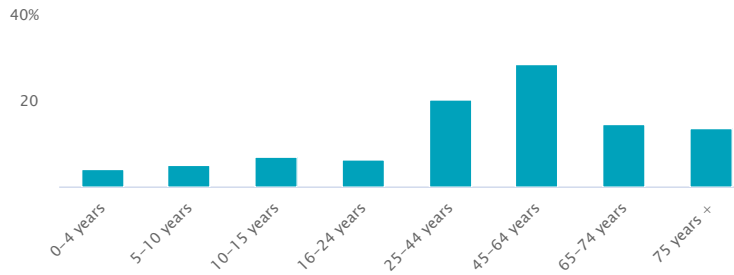

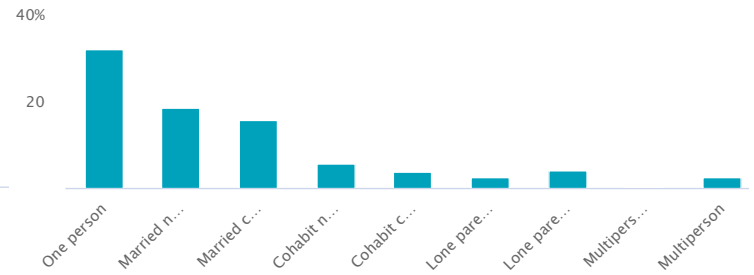

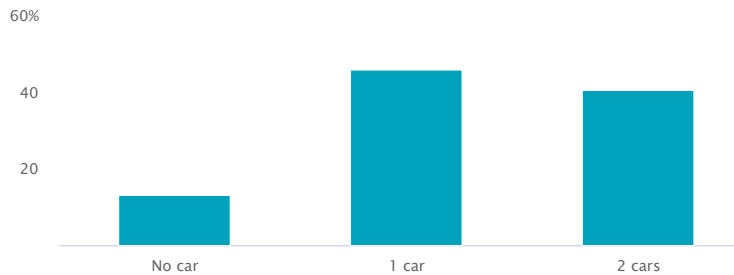

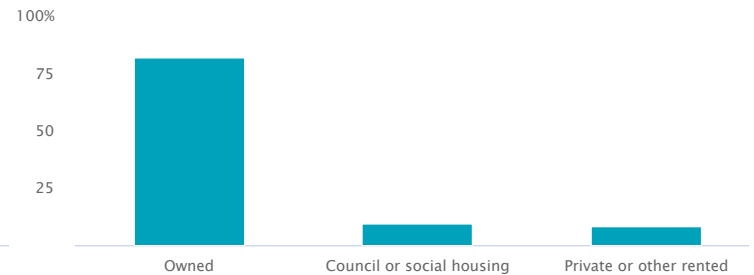

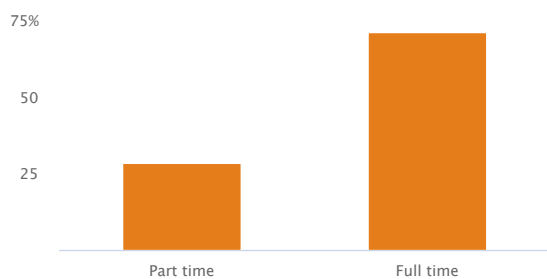

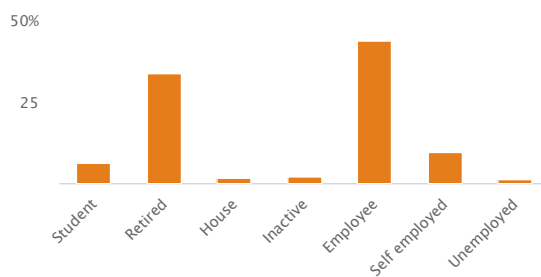
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



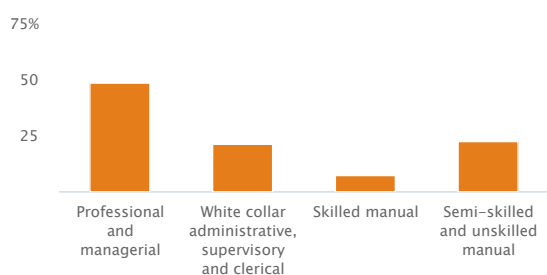
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

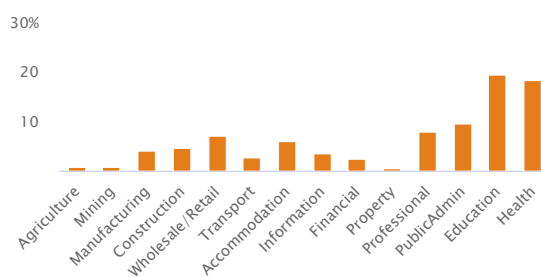


Social Grade

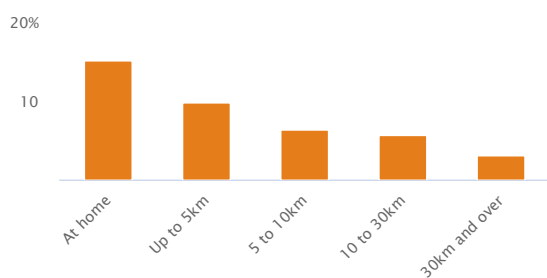
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

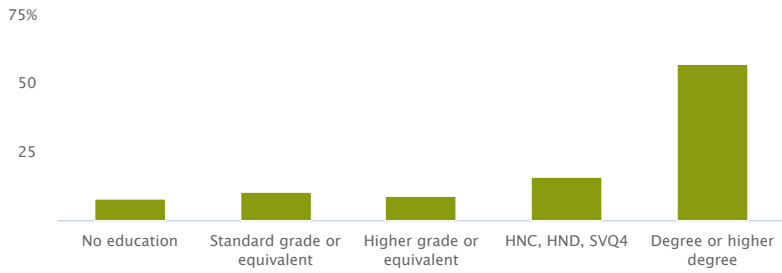


Distance travelled to work

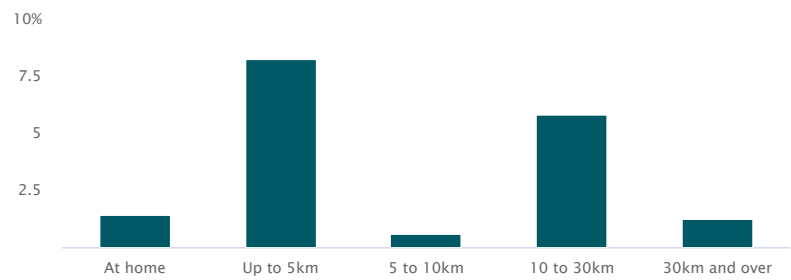
