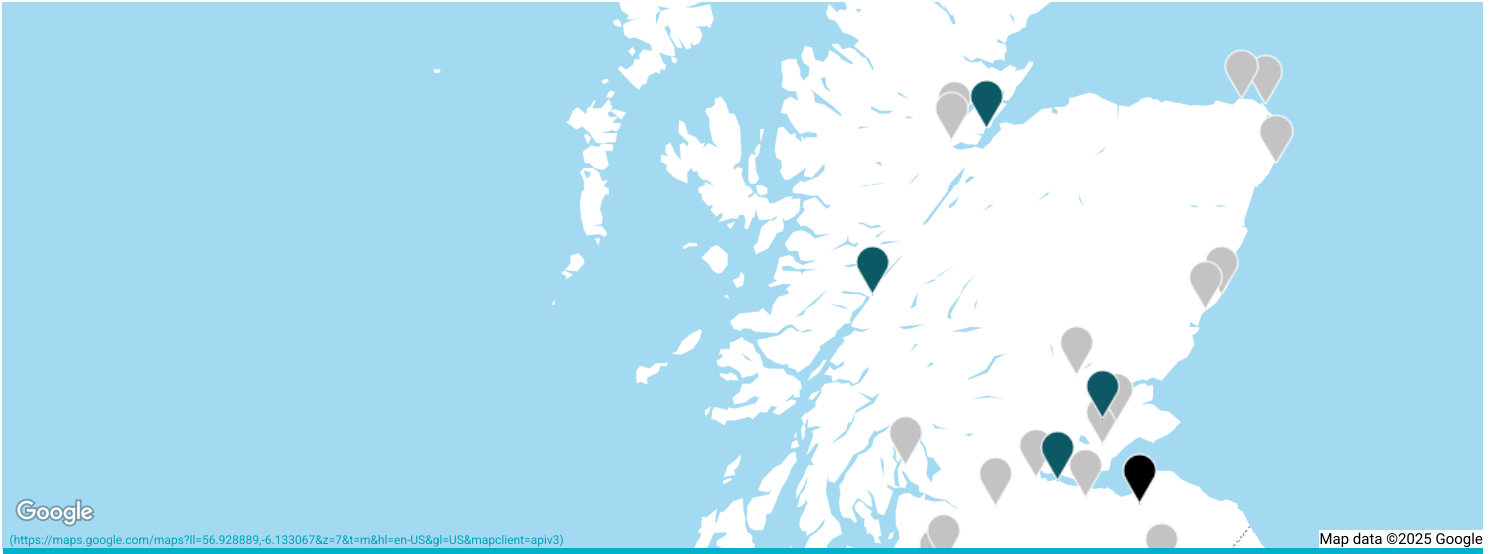




Ormiston

Ormiston is located in East Lothian. It was a planned village but the project was an economic failure. In the 20th century mining resulted in the development of the settlement. Today it is a residential town surrounded by agriculture and with some local services.

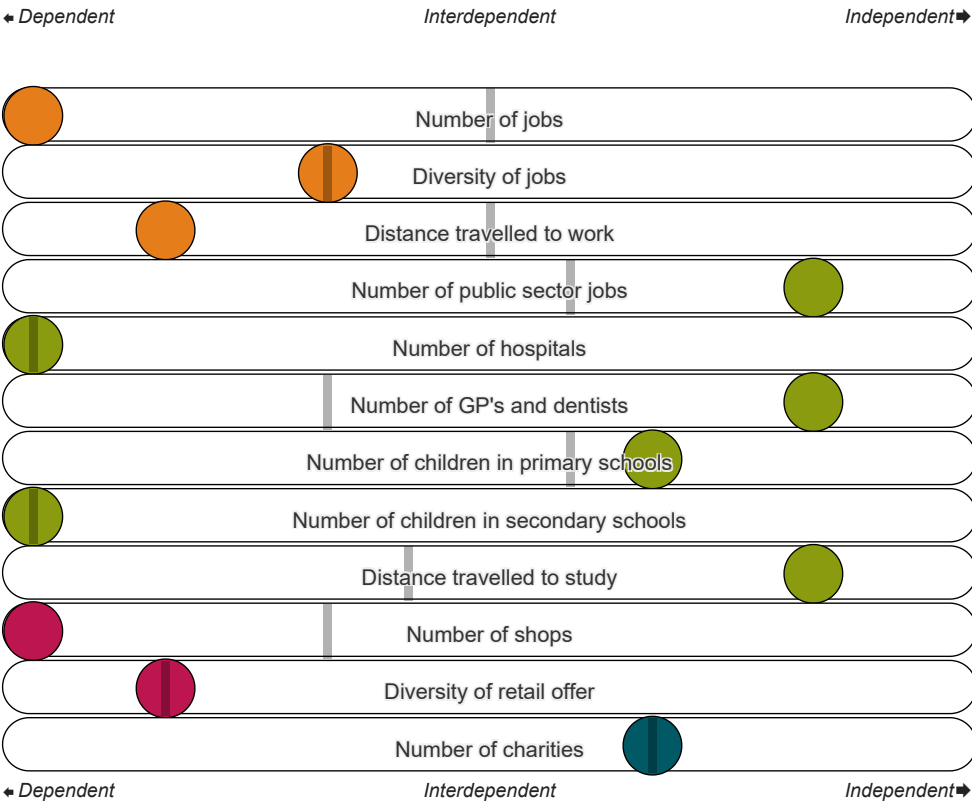
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Ormiston is an interdependent to dependent town.

Inter-relationships



Ormiston is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Ormiston is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Ormiston differs most from its group in the number of jobs, and shops.

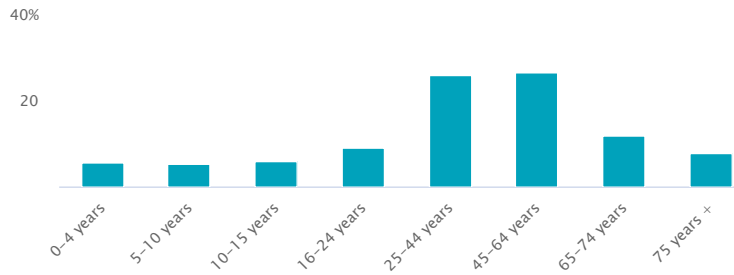

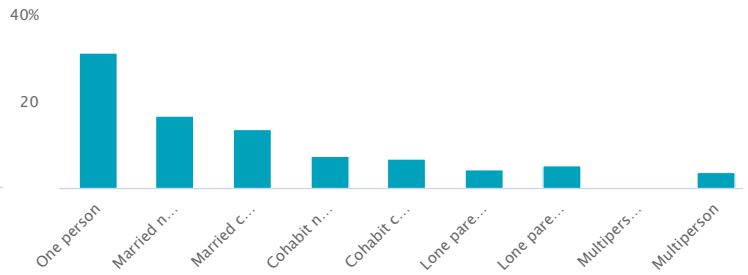

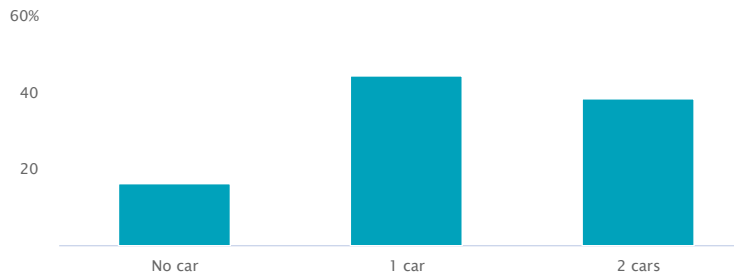

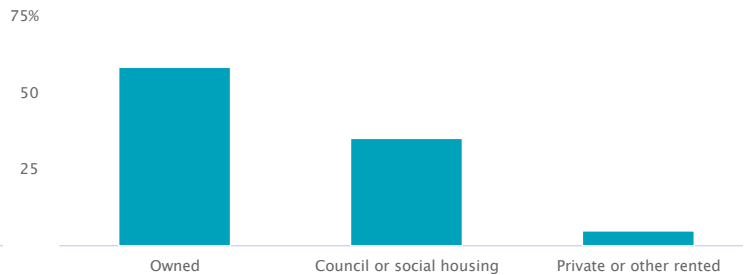
Household composition

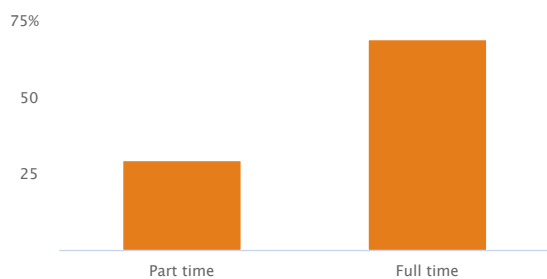

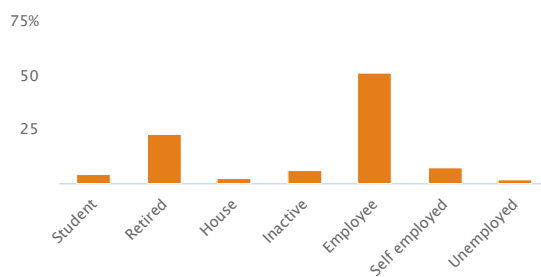
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



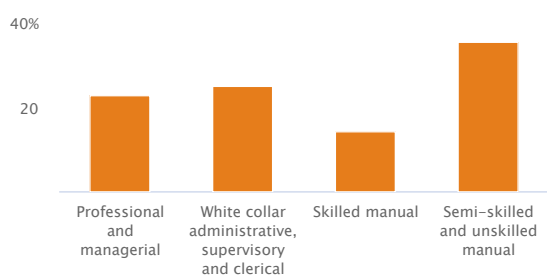
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

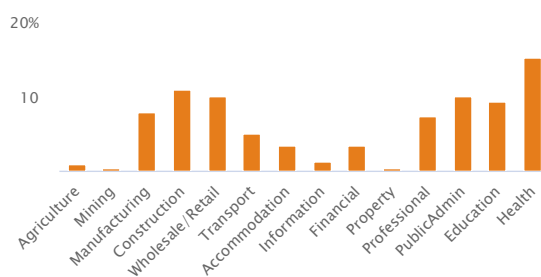

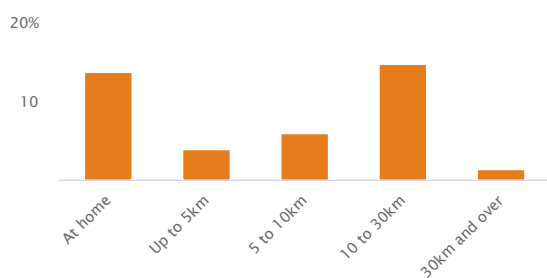
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

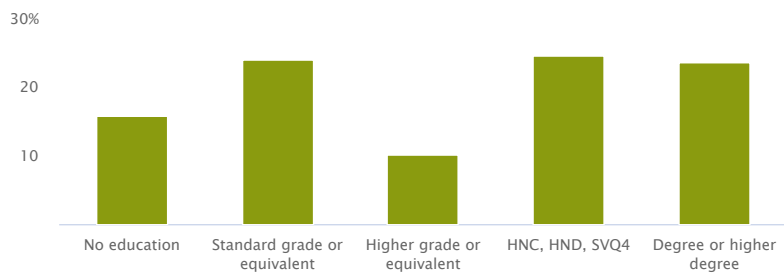


Distance travelled to work

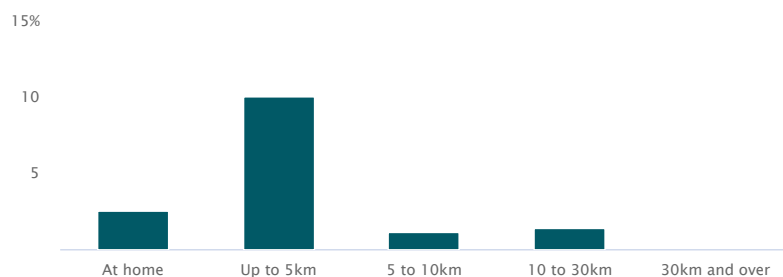
