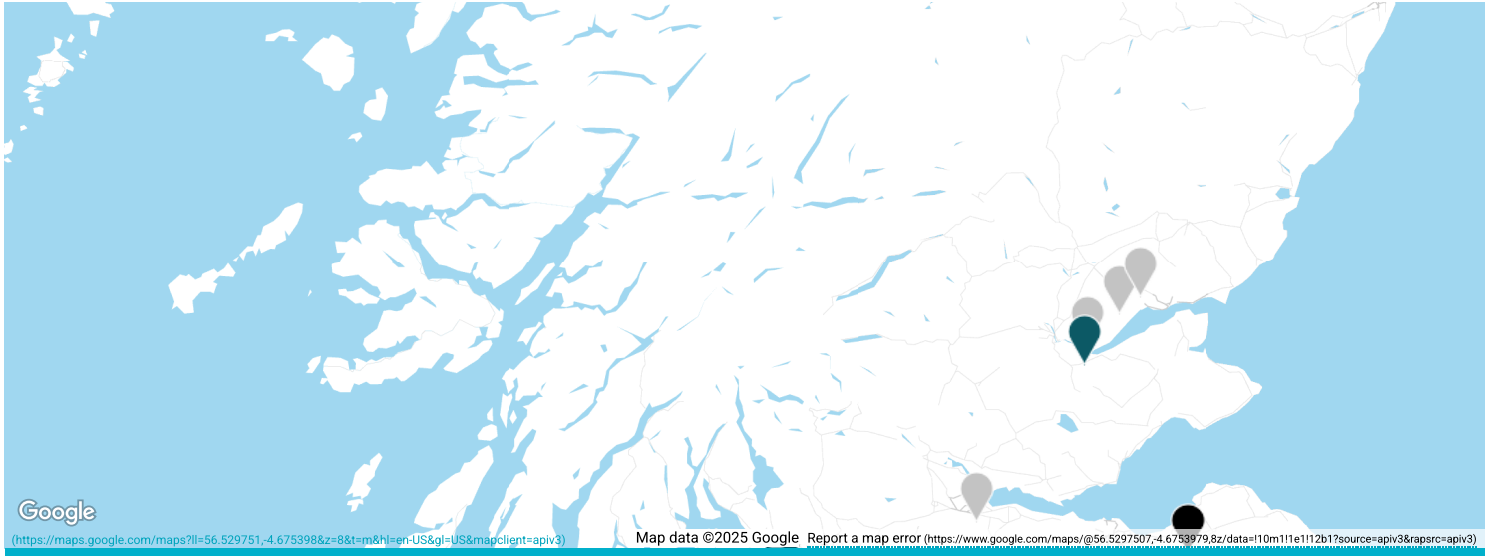




Pencaitland

Pencaitland is in East Lothian. It is an historic town. The Glenkinchie distillery is a key industry in the town. Many residents are commuters.

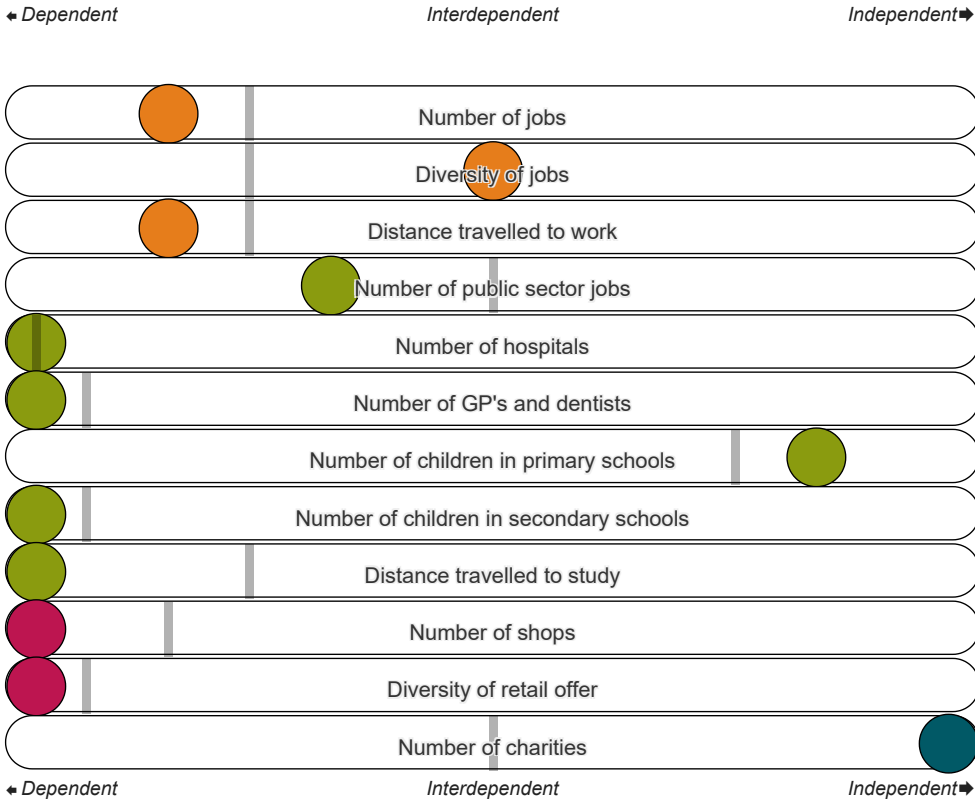
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Pencaitland is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Pencaitland is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

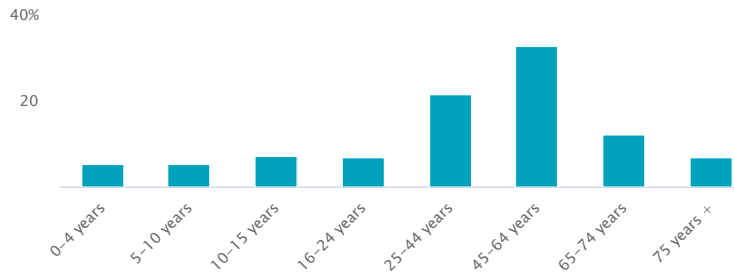

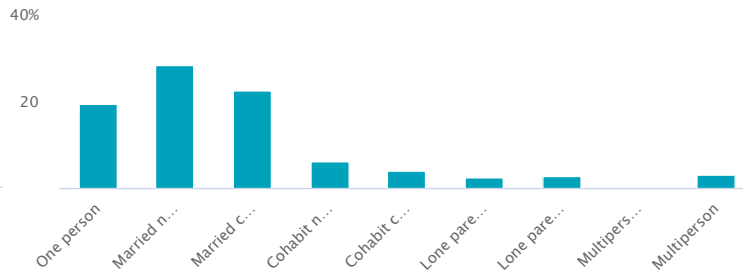

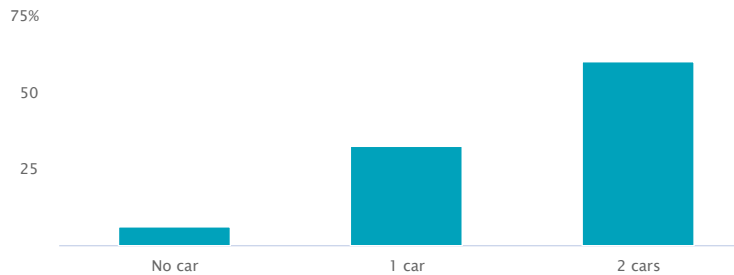

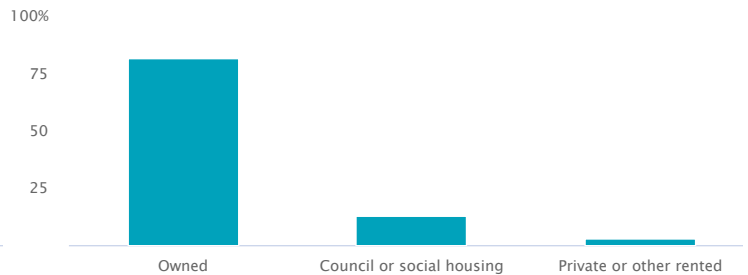
Household composition

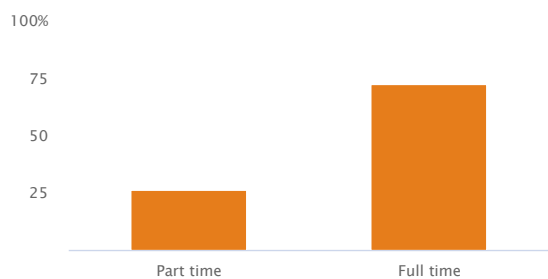

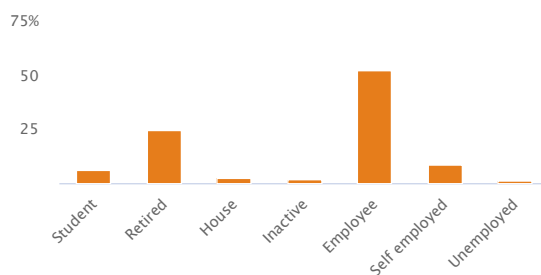
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



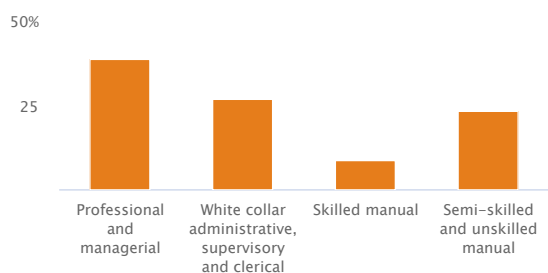
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

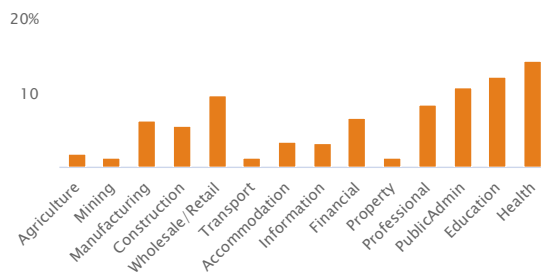


Social Grade

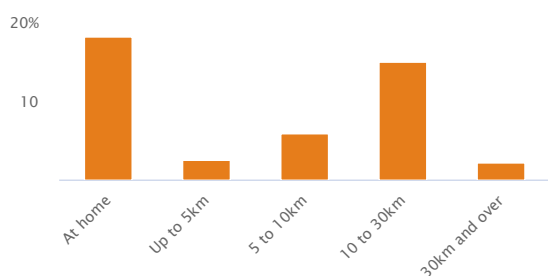
(% households aged 16-64)

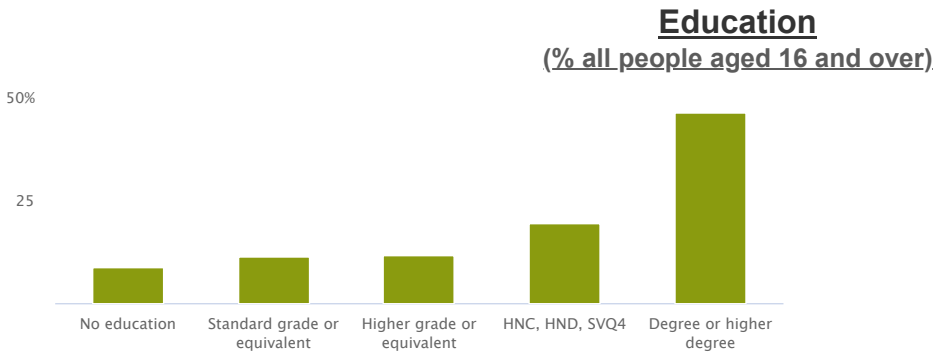


Sector Diversity

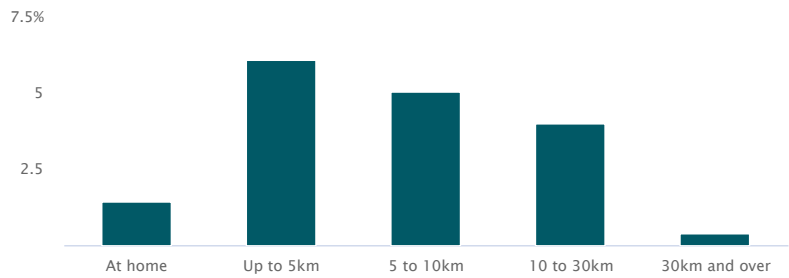
