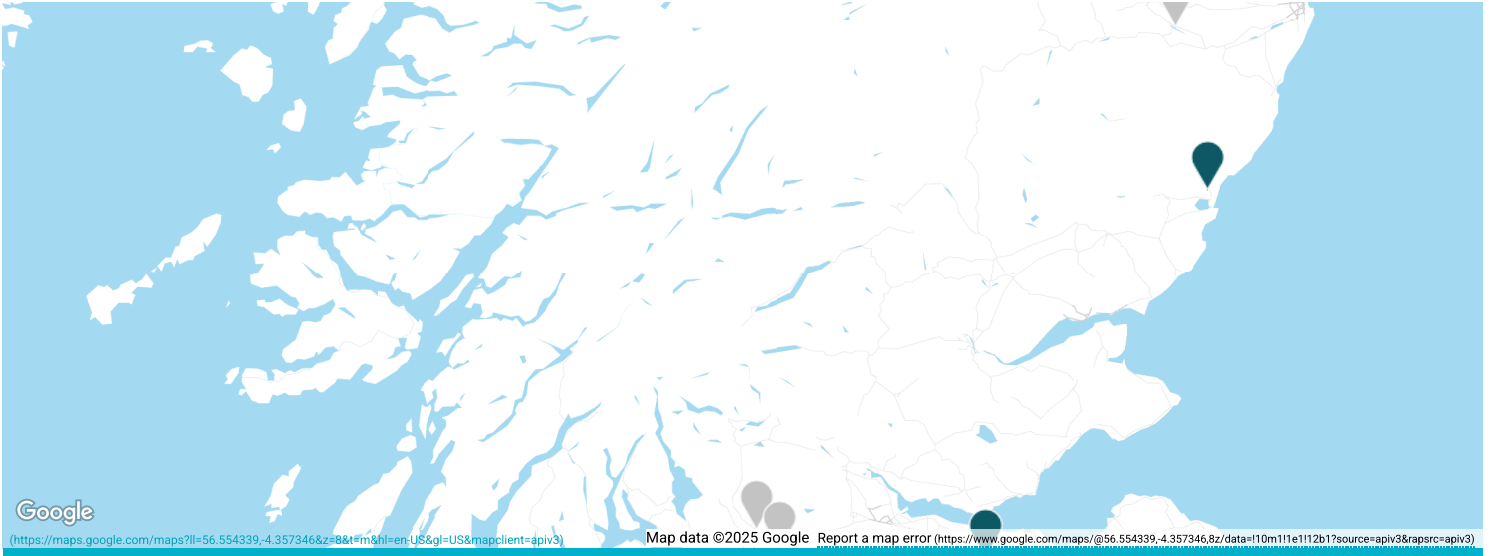




Pitmedden

Pitmedden is in Aberdeenshire. A small rural town it expanded with the oil boom. New houses were built and it is a commuter settlement.

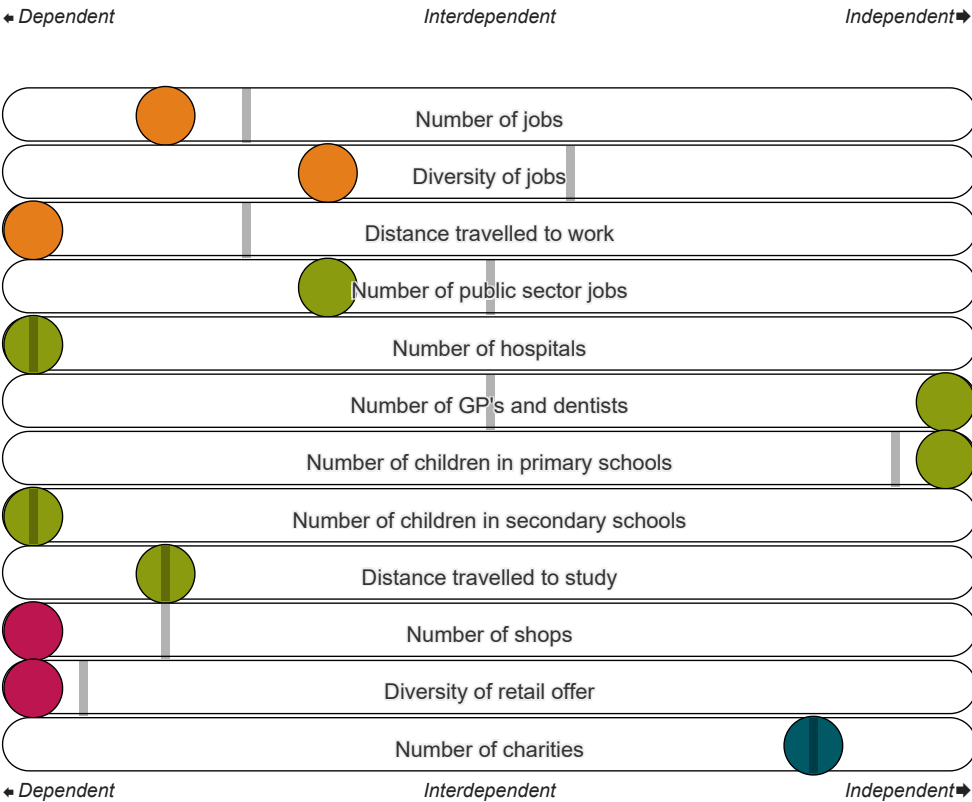
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Pitmedden is grouped with 8 other towns. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of GP's and dentists. Pitmedden differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

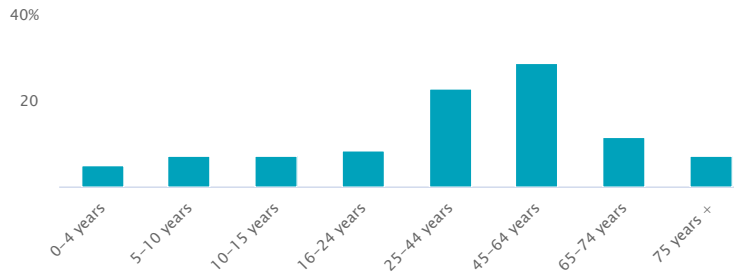

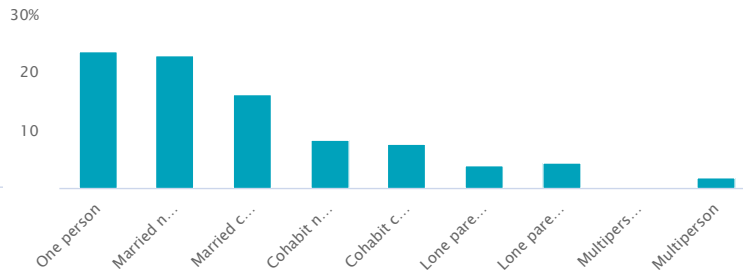

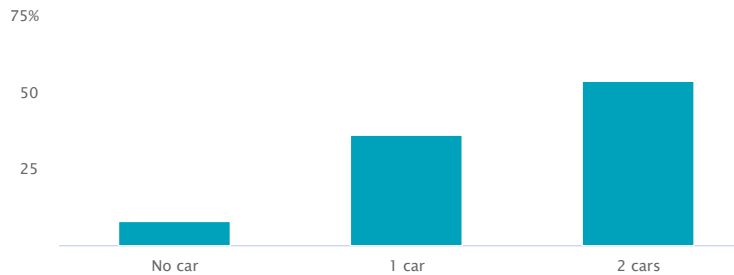

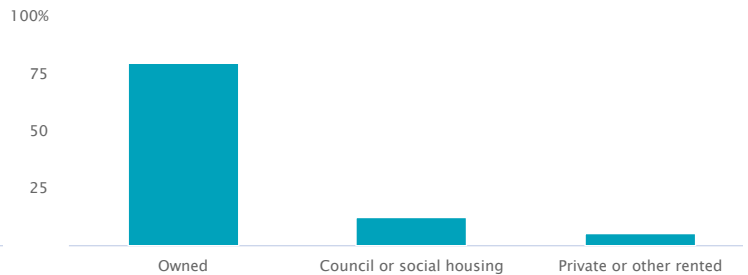
Household composition

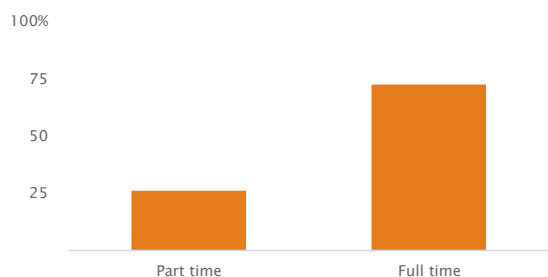

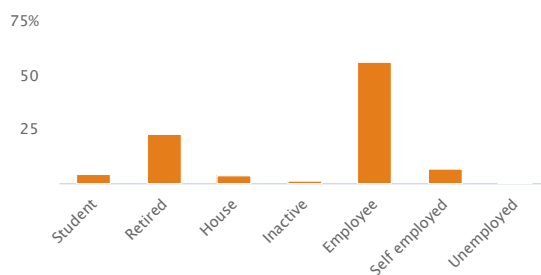
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



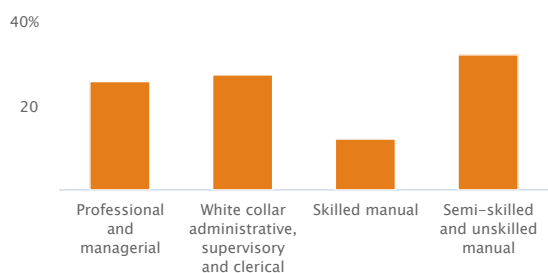
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

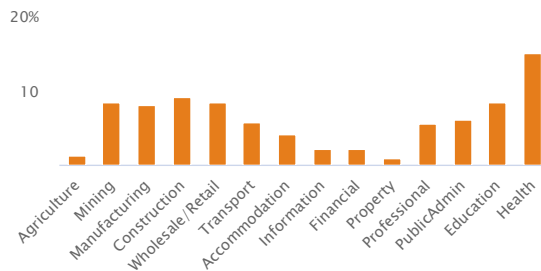


Social Grade

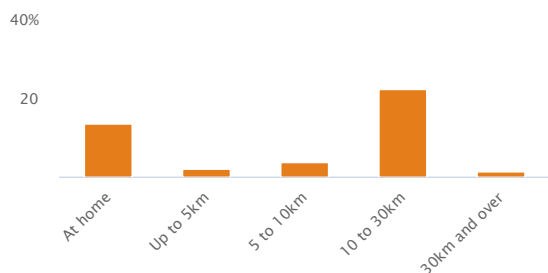
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

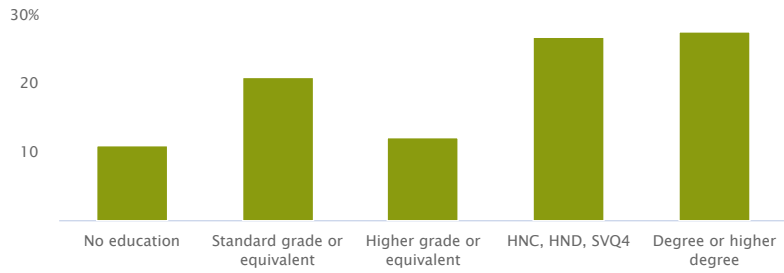


Distance travelled to work

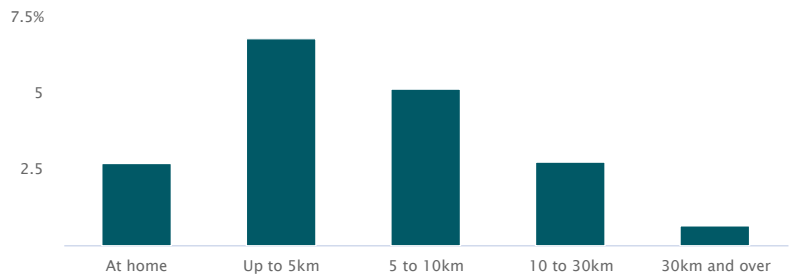
