Portknockie is a Moray town. Fishermen from Cullen are said to have developed the town. It remains a fishing settlement.

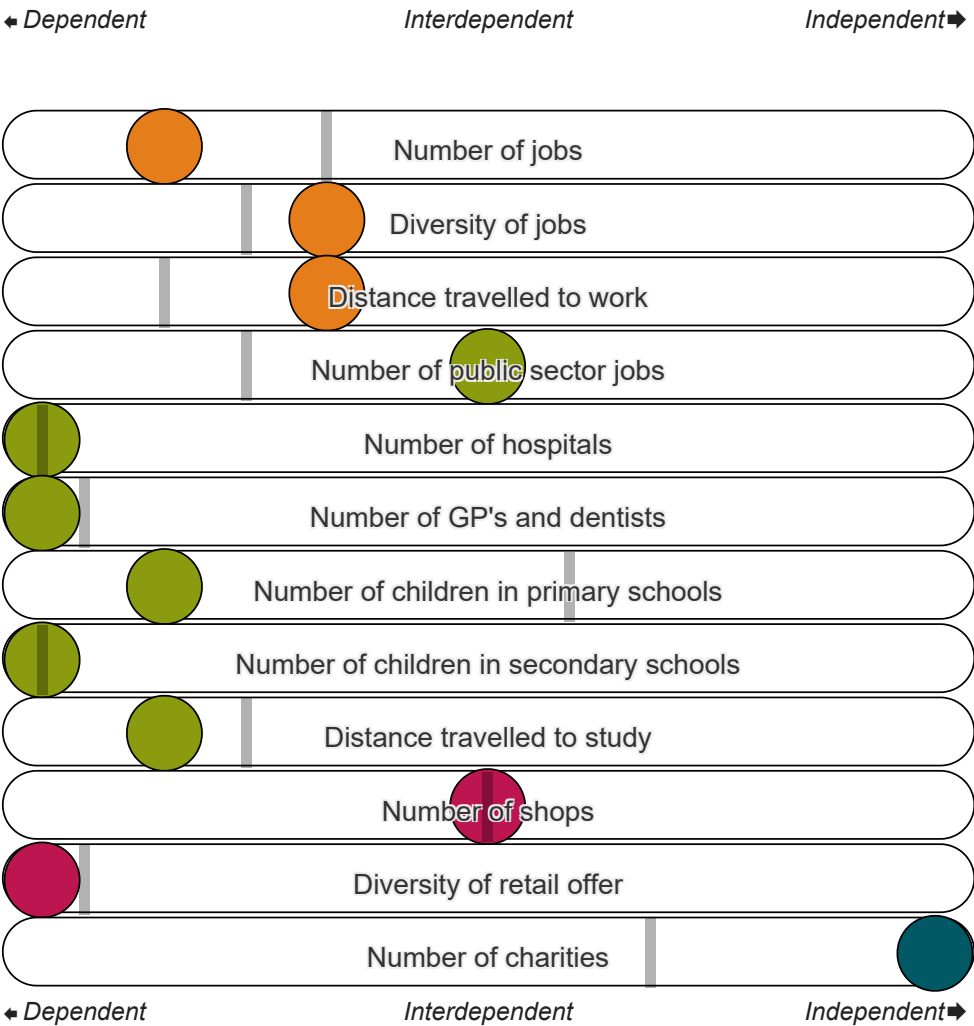
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Portknockie is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aberchirder](#), [Carnwath](#), [Eastriggs](#), and [Kincardine](#).

Inter-relationships



Portknockie is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Portknockie is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and public sector jobs. Portknockie differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools.

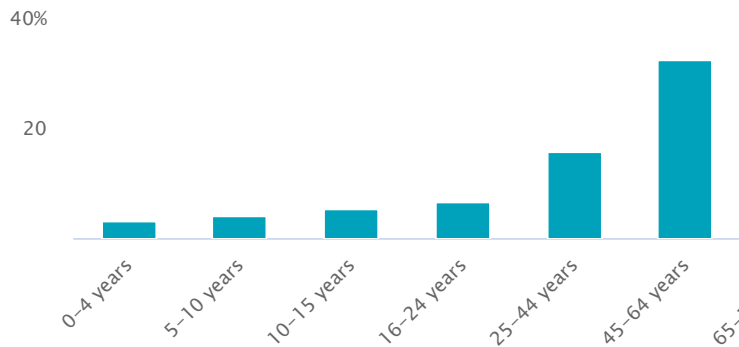

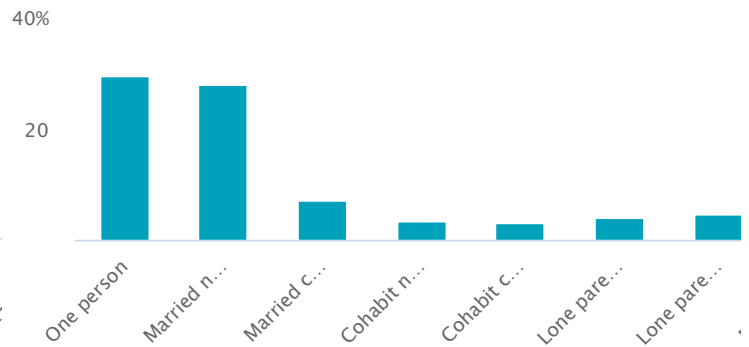

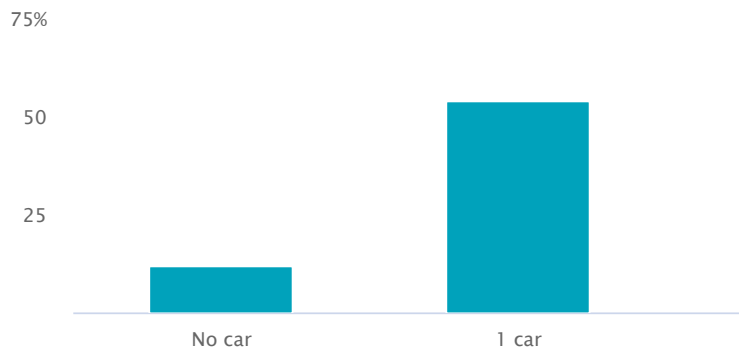

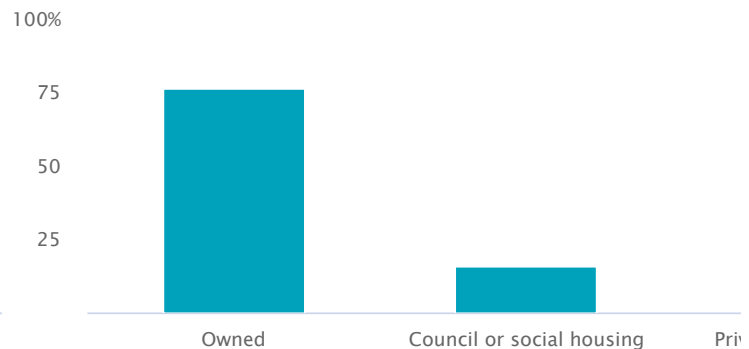
Household composition

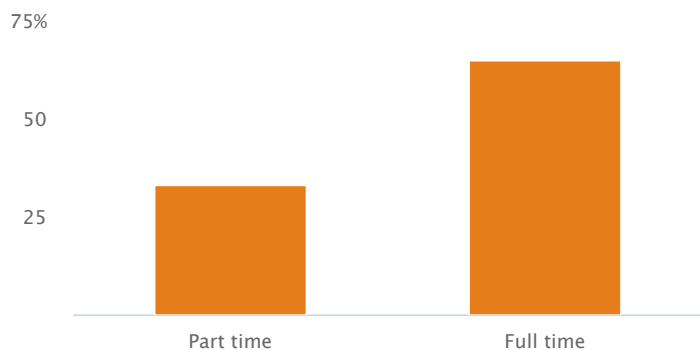

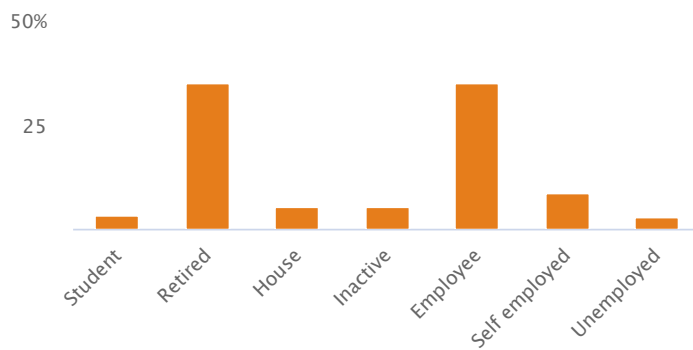
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



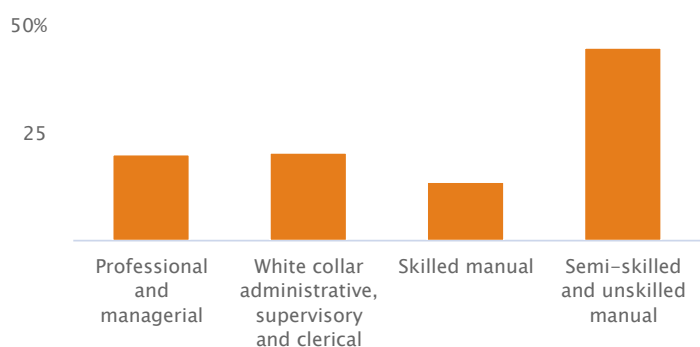
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

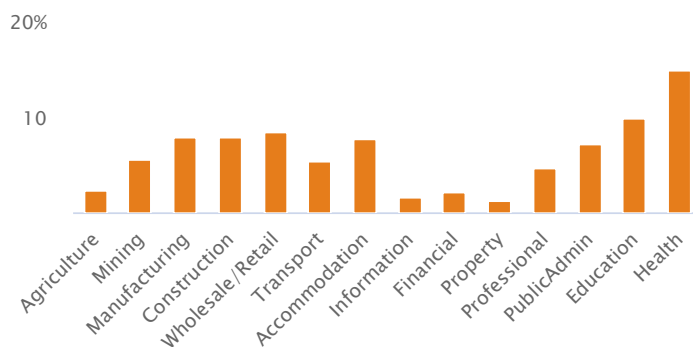


Social Grade

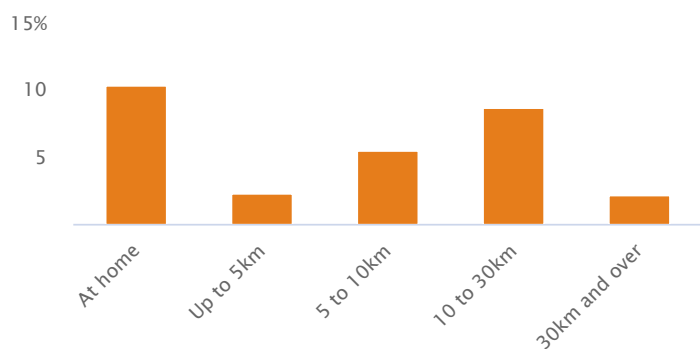
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

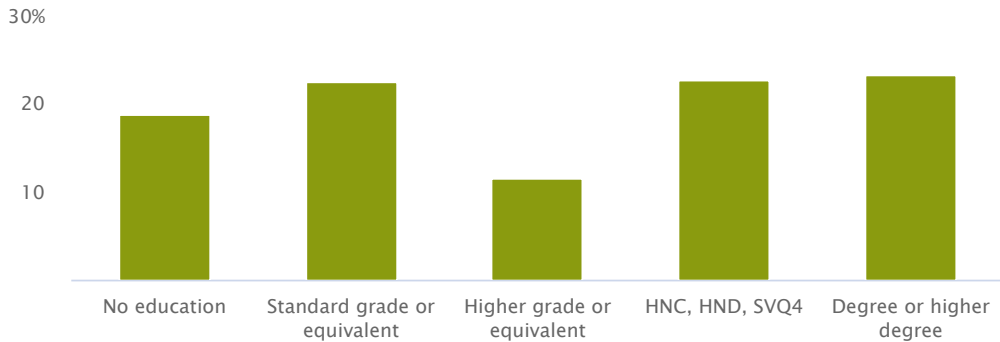


Distance travelled to work

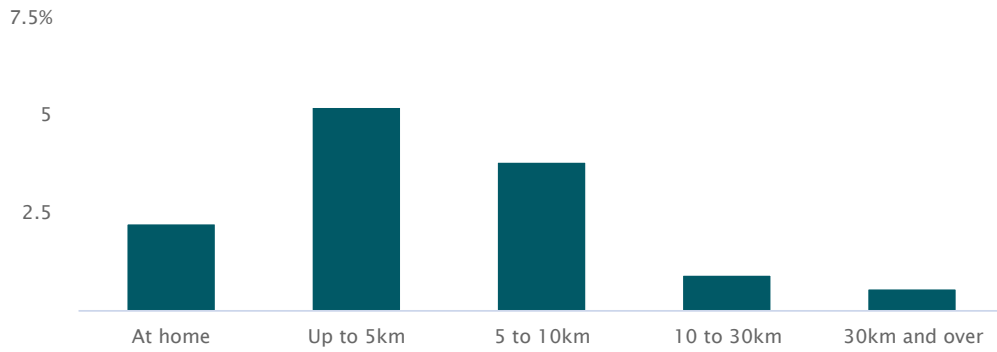


Number of people per shop
