Prestonpans in East Lothian is probably best known for the Battle of Prestonpans in 1745. It dates from the 1600s and was a burgh. As the name suggests it produced salt. It was also know for pottery and brewing. Prestongrange was the port and it traded with Hanseatic League countries. Coal was found early and developed commercially most recently at Prestongrange Colliery which closed in 1962. Much new public housing was built in the town and more recently new private housing has been built with most residents commuting.


In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.












Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation






