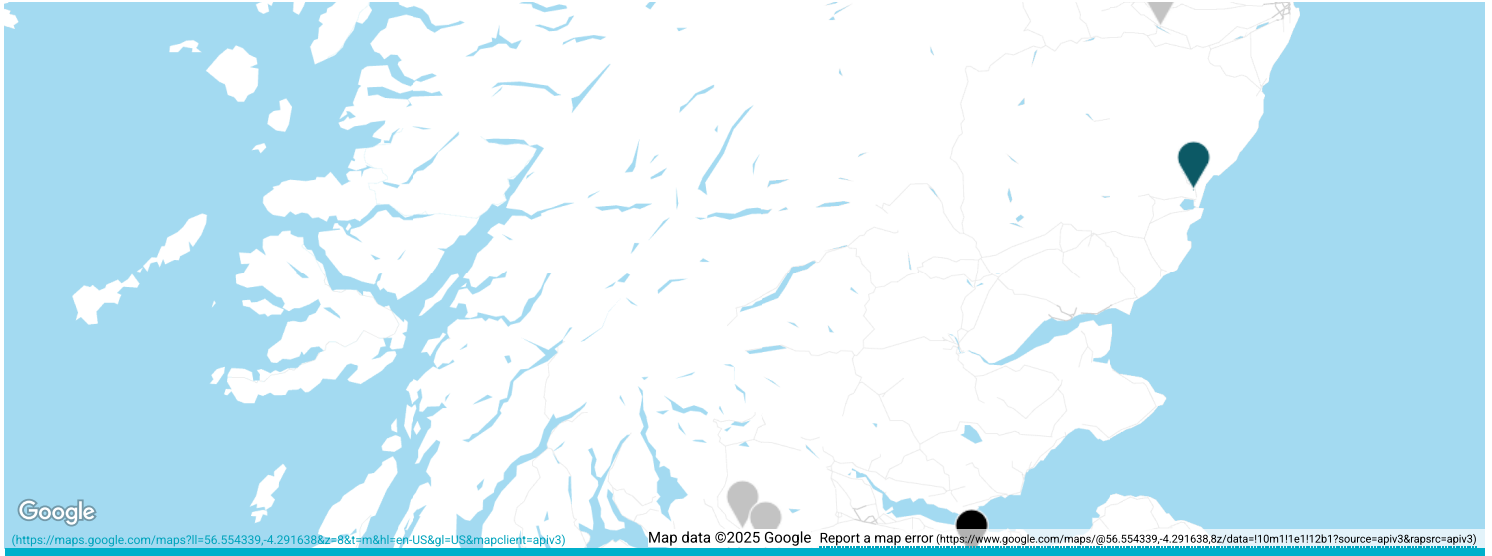




Ratho

Ratho is in City of Edinburgh and is a commuter town for Edinburgh. It was a stone working village with a whinstone quarry. The Edinburgh International Climbing Arena is located in the former quarry. It is located on the Union Canal and has recent private housing estates.

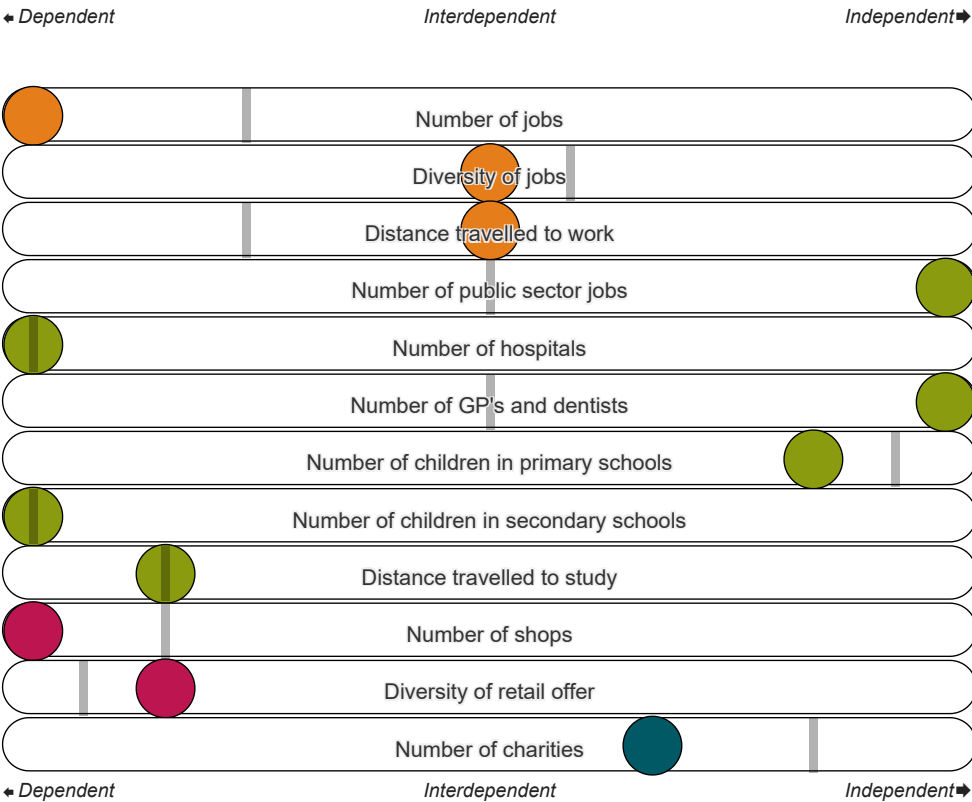
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Ratho is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Ratho is grouped with 8 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Ratho differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

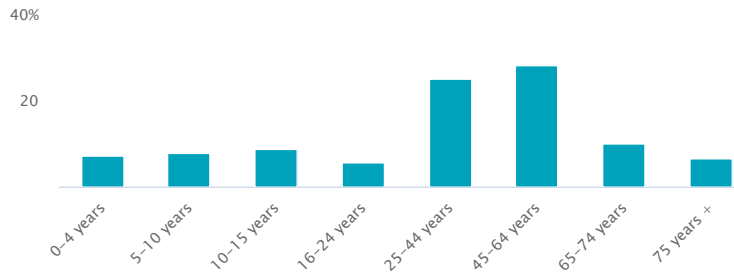

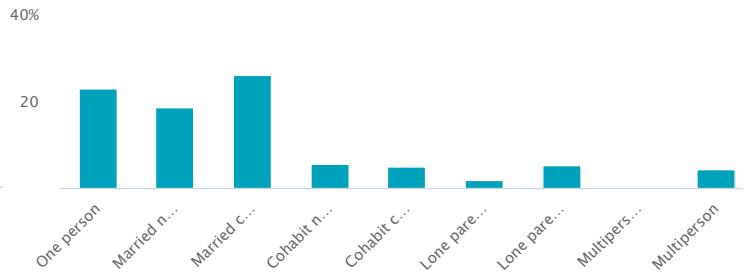

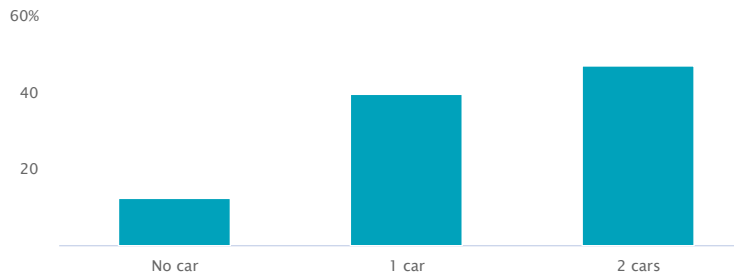

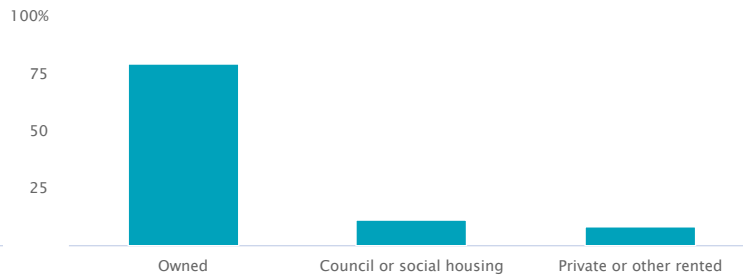
Household composition

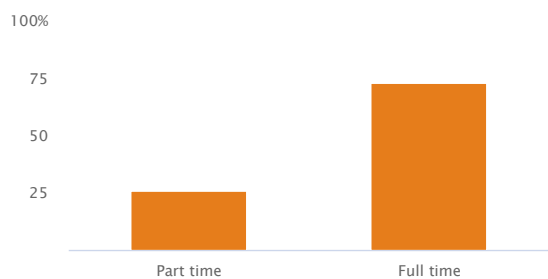

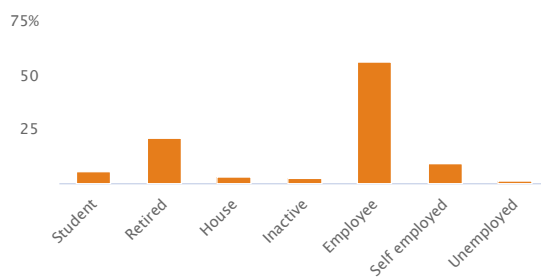
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



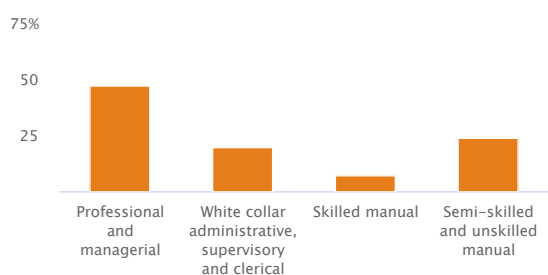
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

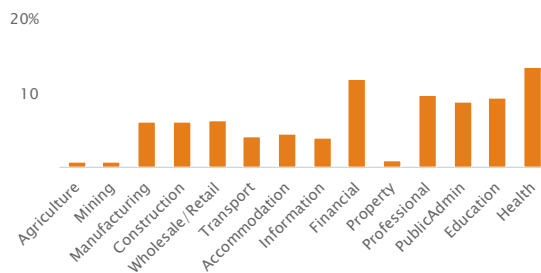


Social Grade

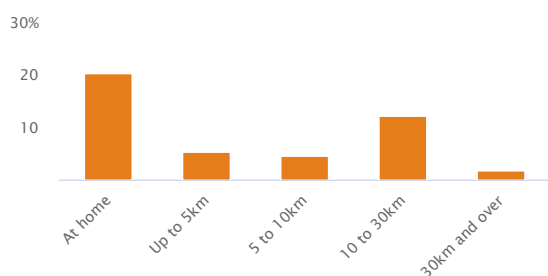
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

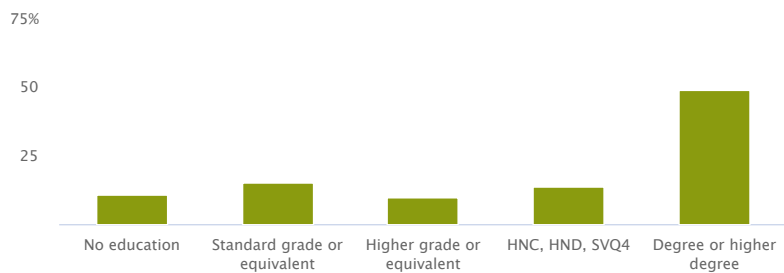


Distance travelled to work

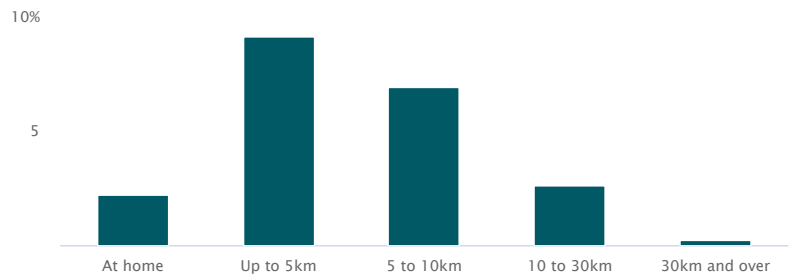
