Reddingmuirhead is in Falkirk. It is adjacent to Polmont Young Offenders Institution. Private housing is being expanded in the area. Reddingmuirhead is increasingly becoming a suburb of Falkirk.

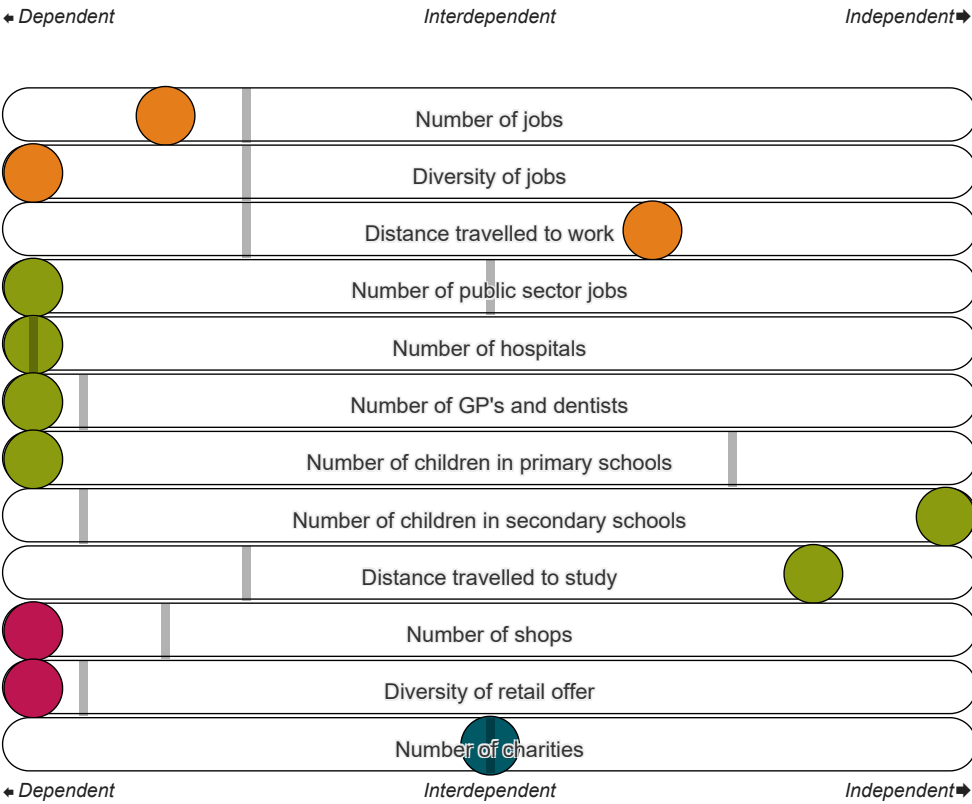
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Reddingmuirhead is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Reddingmuirhead is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in secondary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Reddingmuirhead differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

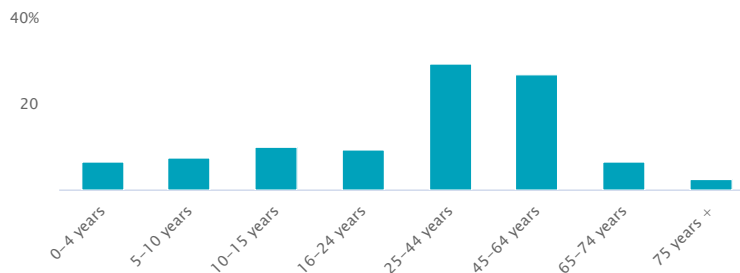

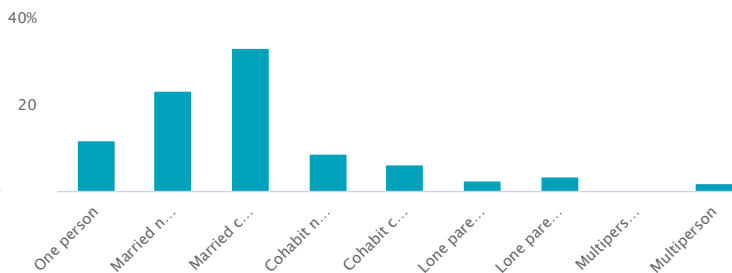

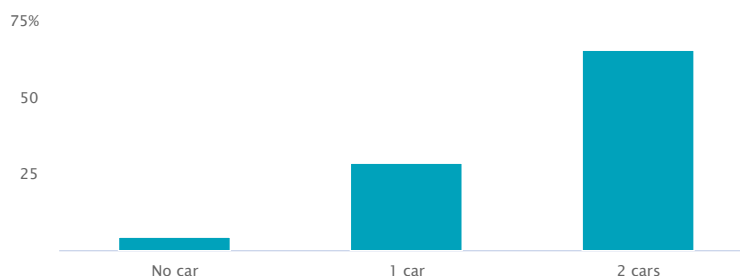

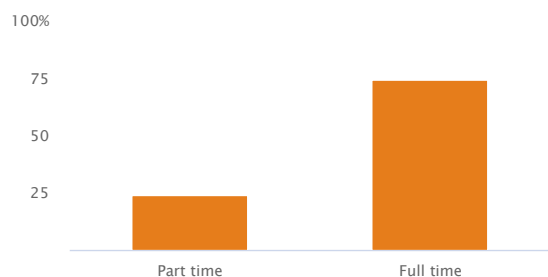

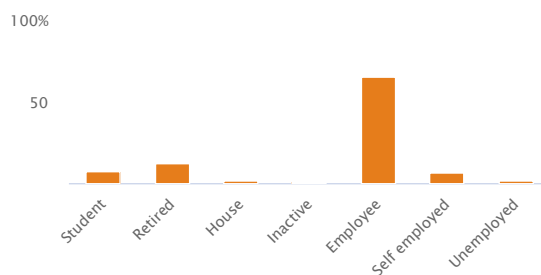
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



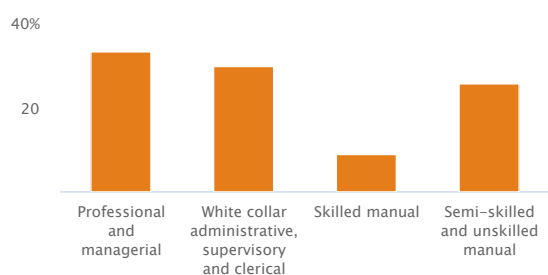
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

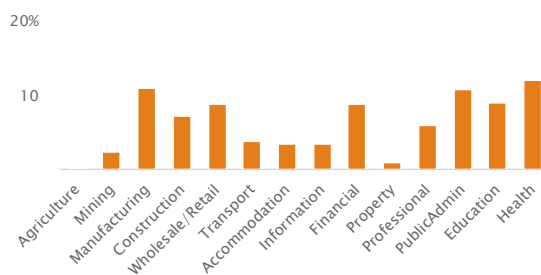

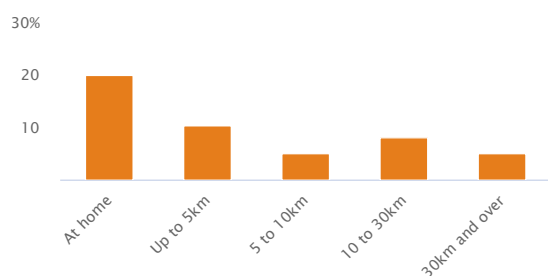

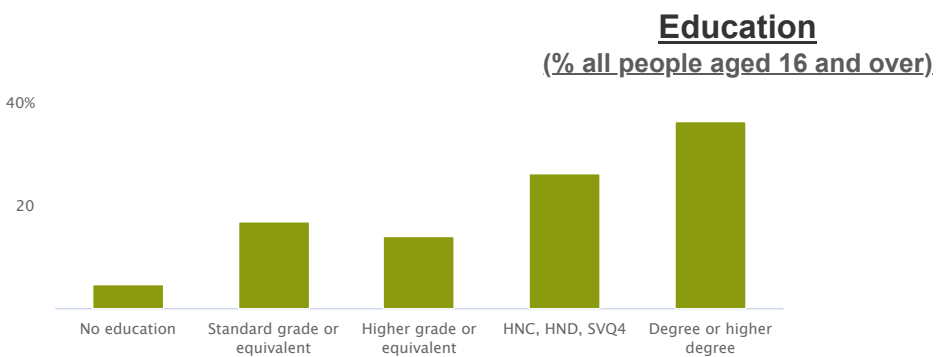


Sector Diversity

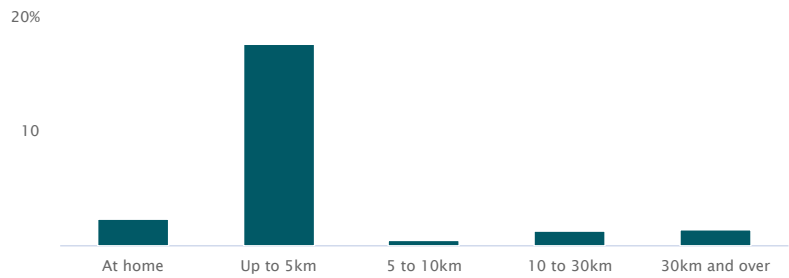
