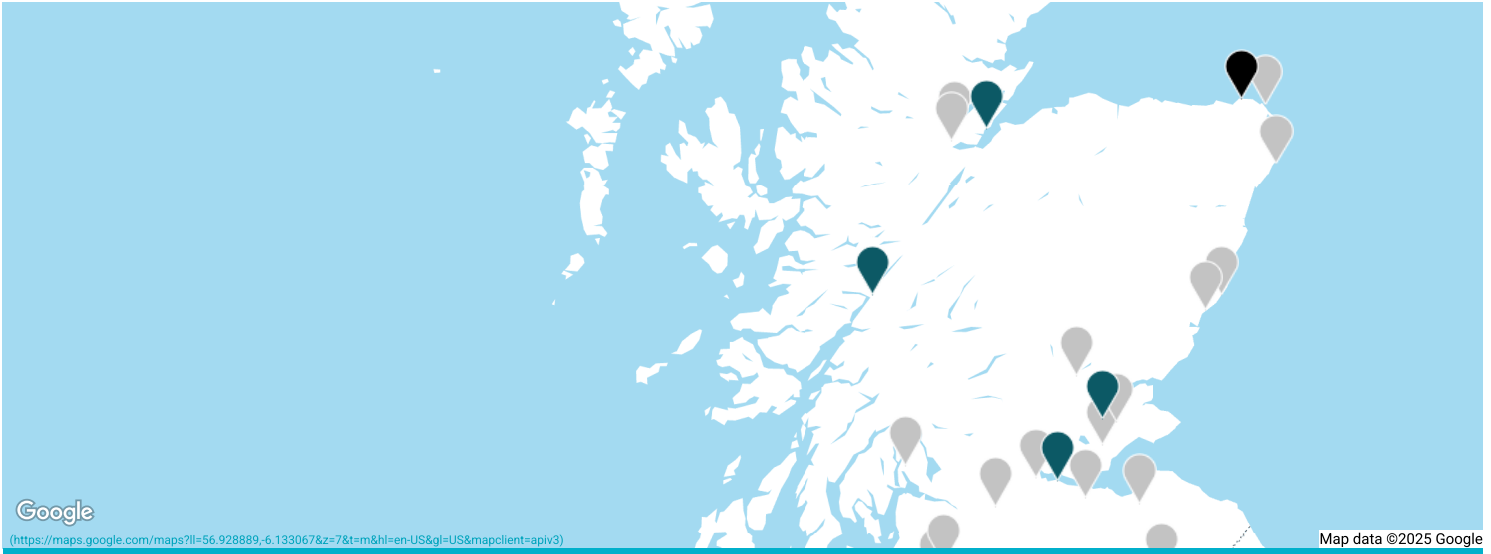




Rosehearty

Rosehearty is in Aberdeenshire. It was a traditional fishing village and part of the herring fleet. It is a tourist centre today although there local service industries (coach operator) and an industrial plant (metal fabrication).

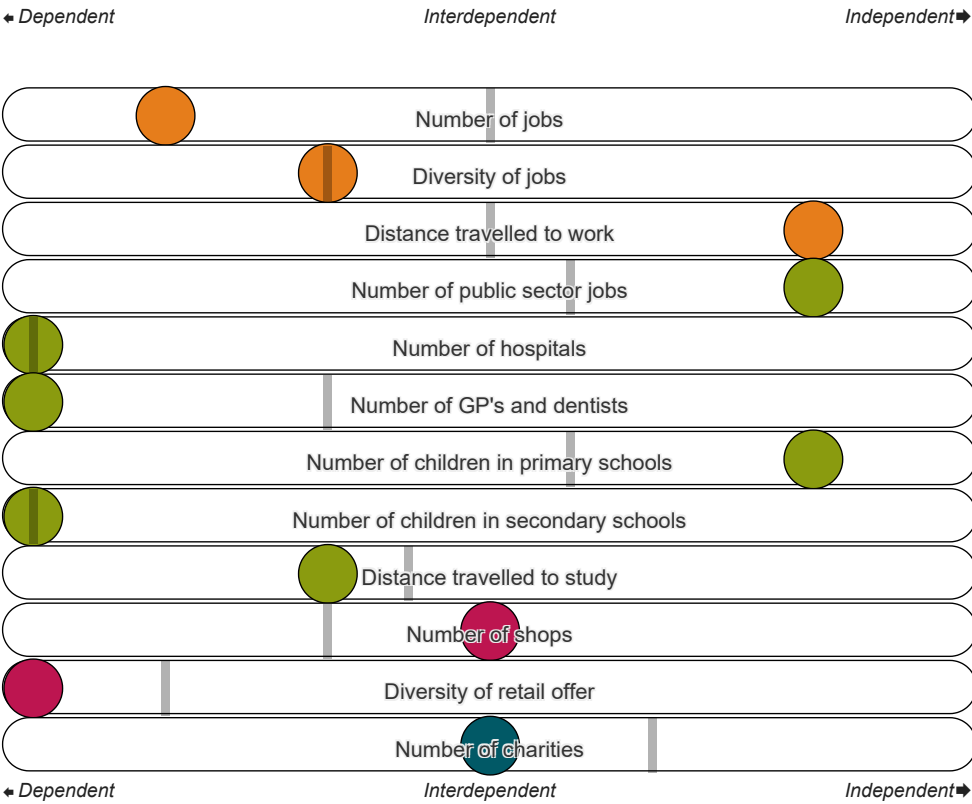
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Rosehearty is an interdependent to dependent town.

Rosehearty is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Rosehearty is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Rosehearty differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

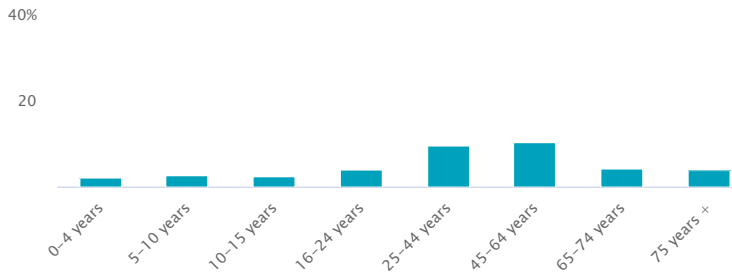

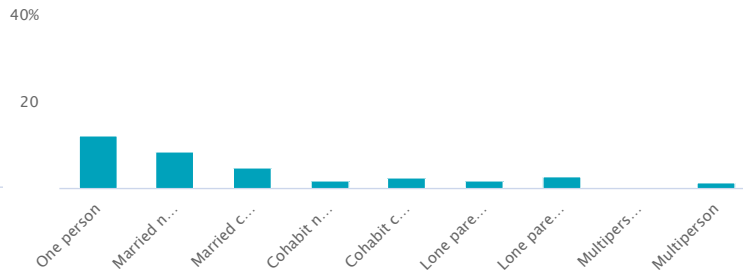

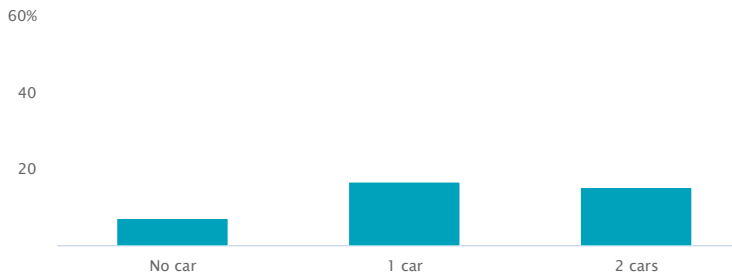

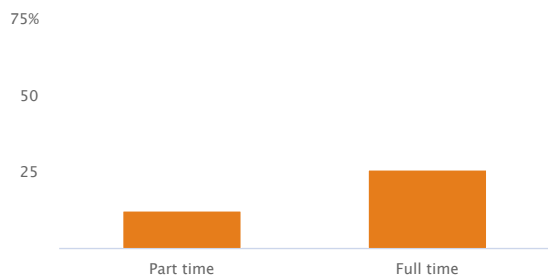

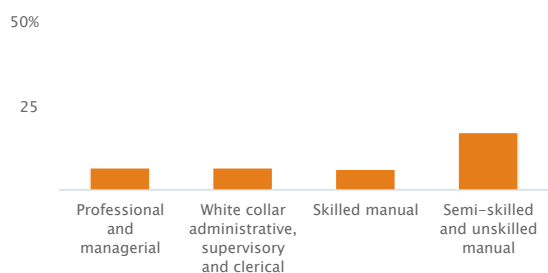
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



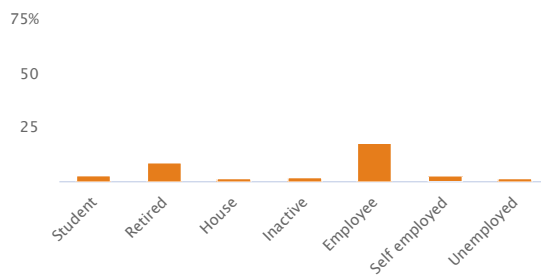
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

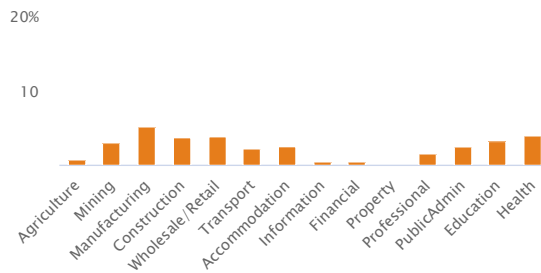

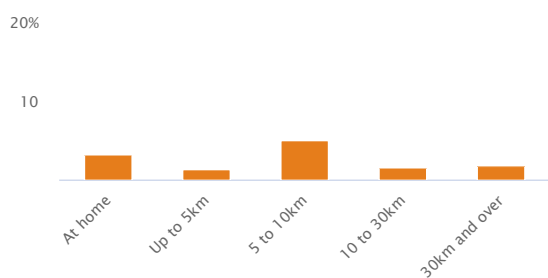

Sector Diversity

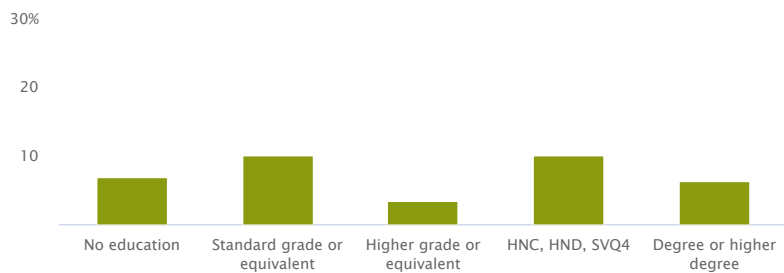


Distance travelled to work

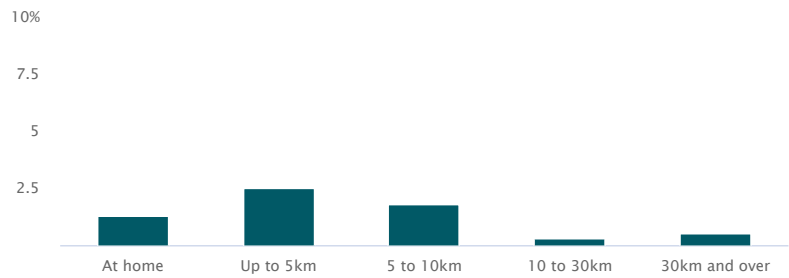
