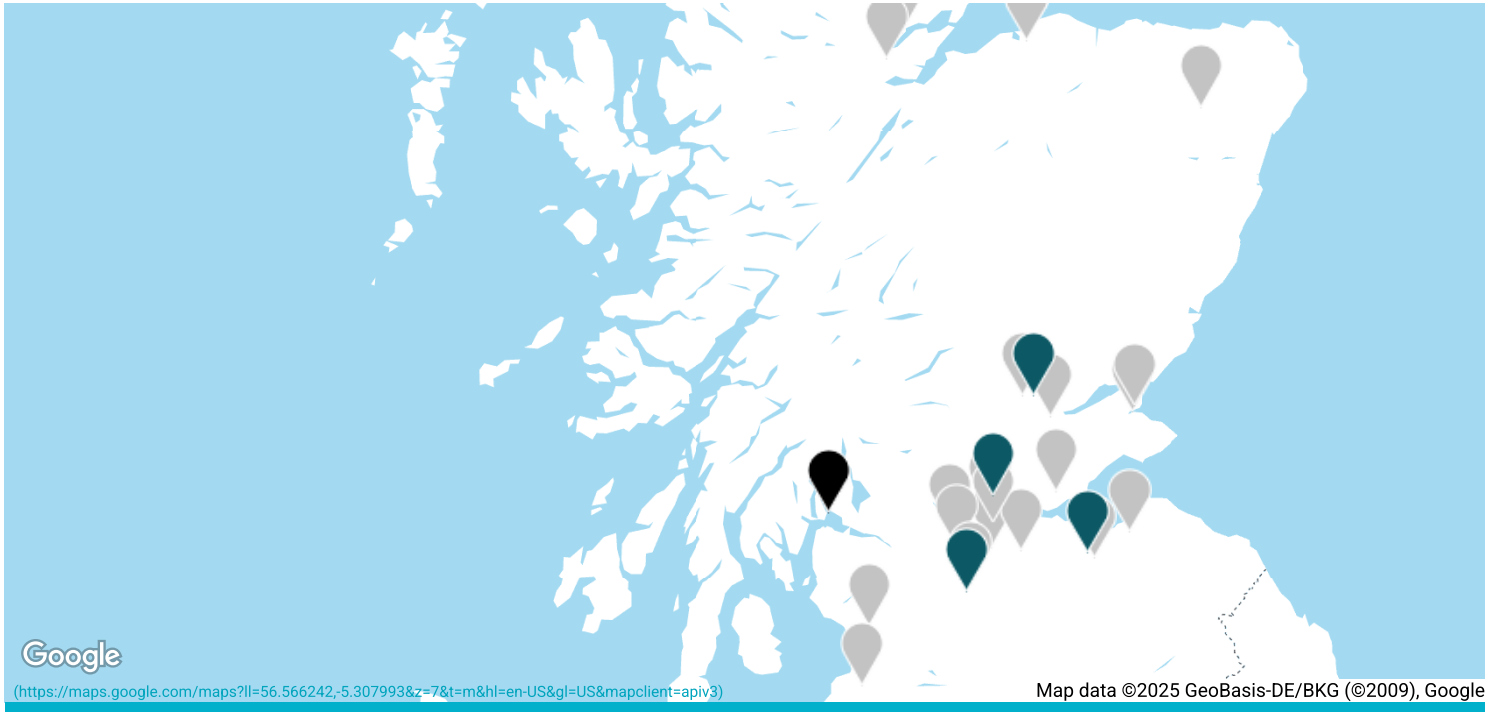




Rosneath

Rosneath is in Argyll and Bute. It is a coastal town. It was established as a WW2 naval base. Today marine services and leisure yachting are a key focus. There is a close by residential caravan park.

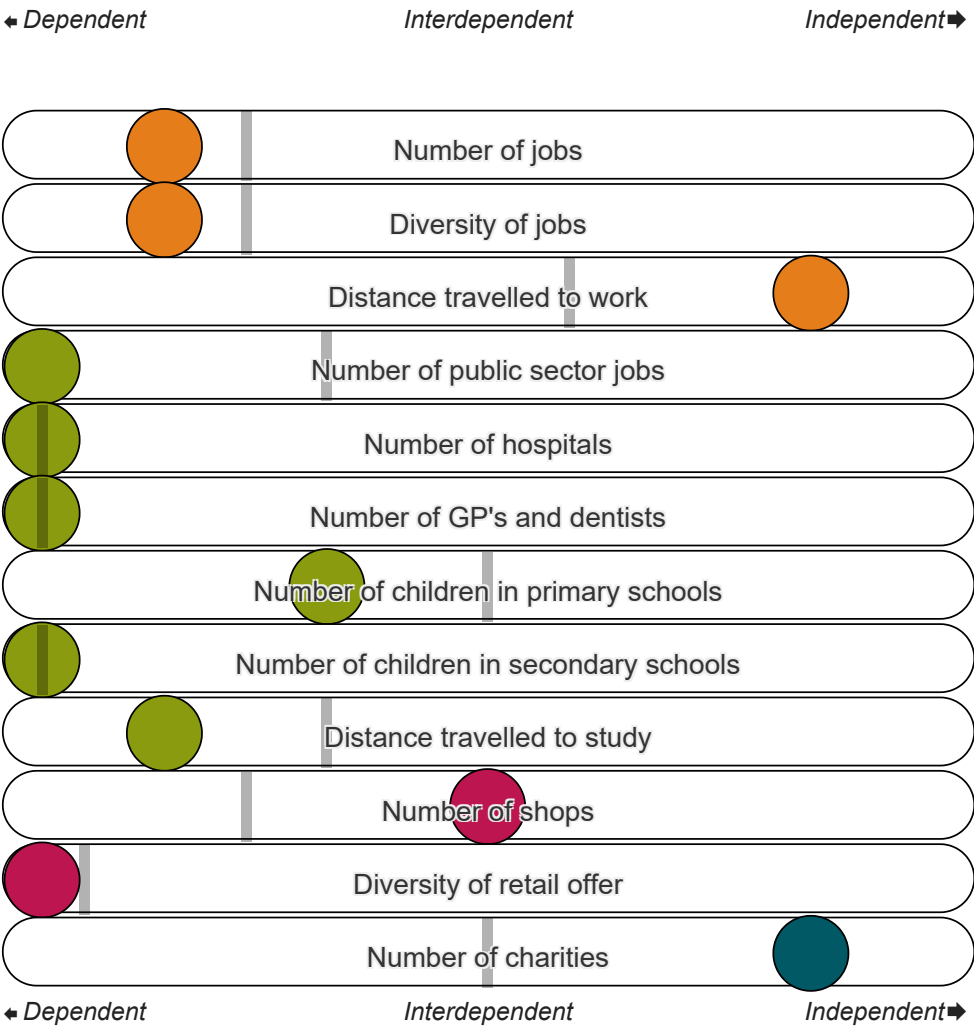
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

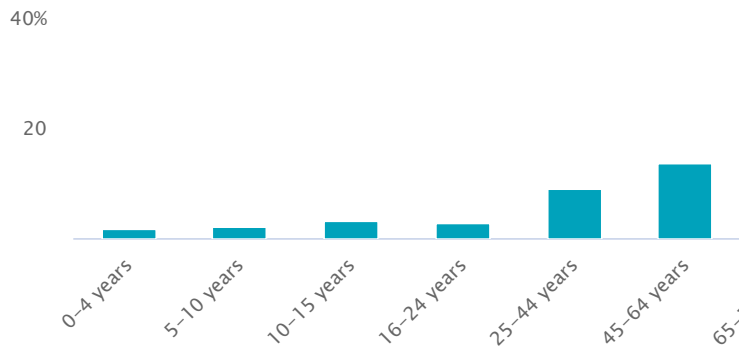
It differs in terms of the number of charities, and shops. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Rosneath differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs.

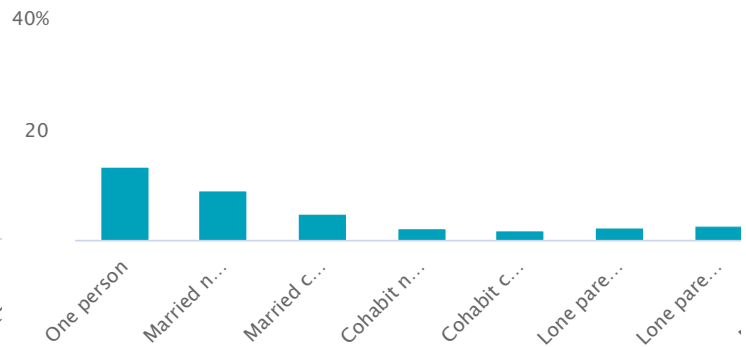

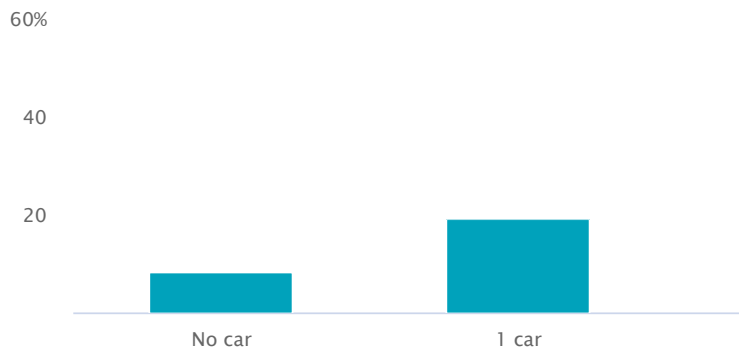

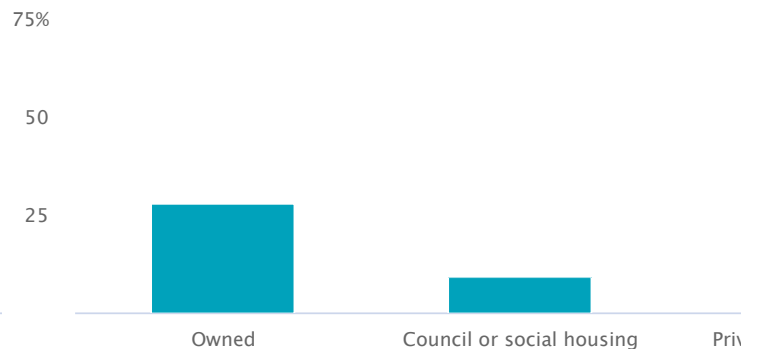
Household composition

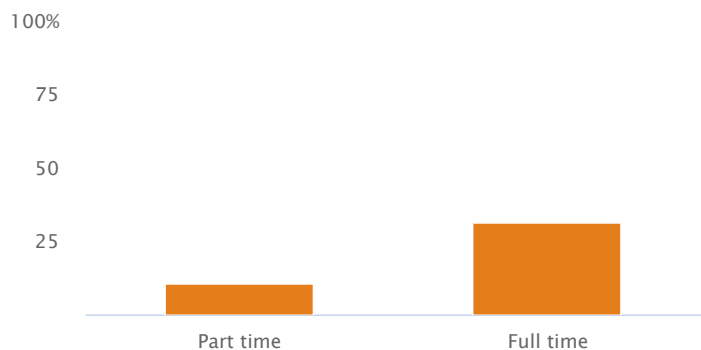

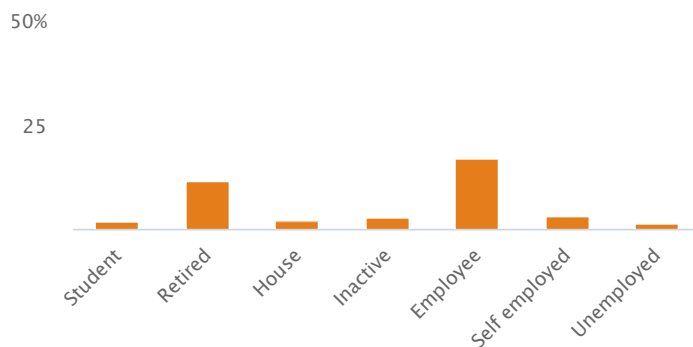
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



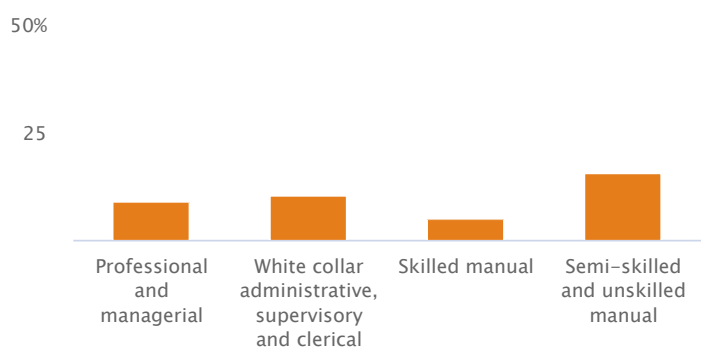
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

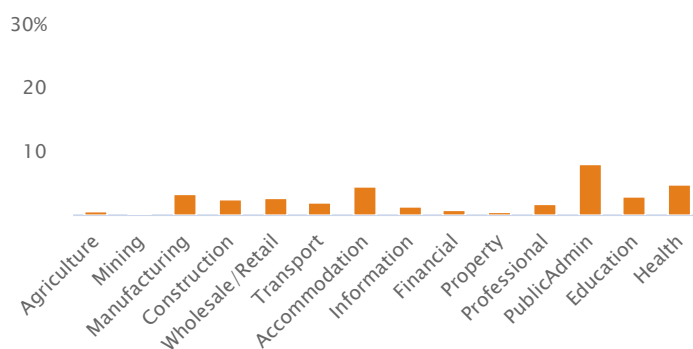

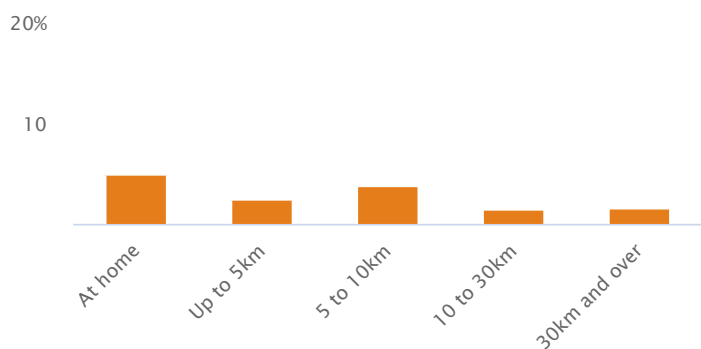
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

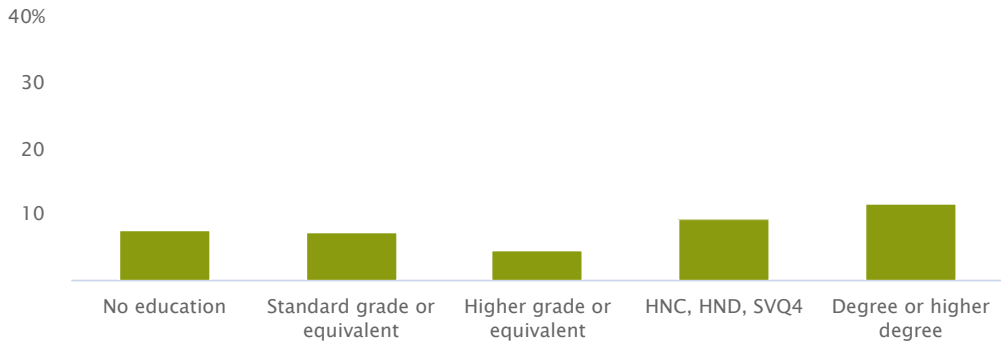


Distance travelled to work

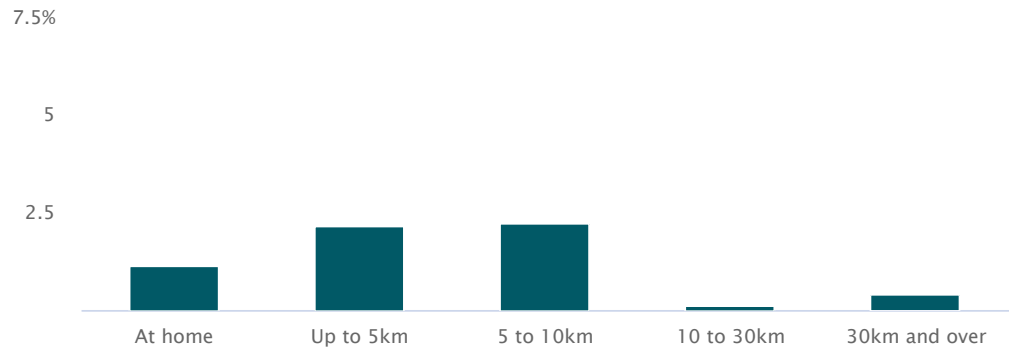


Number of people per shop
