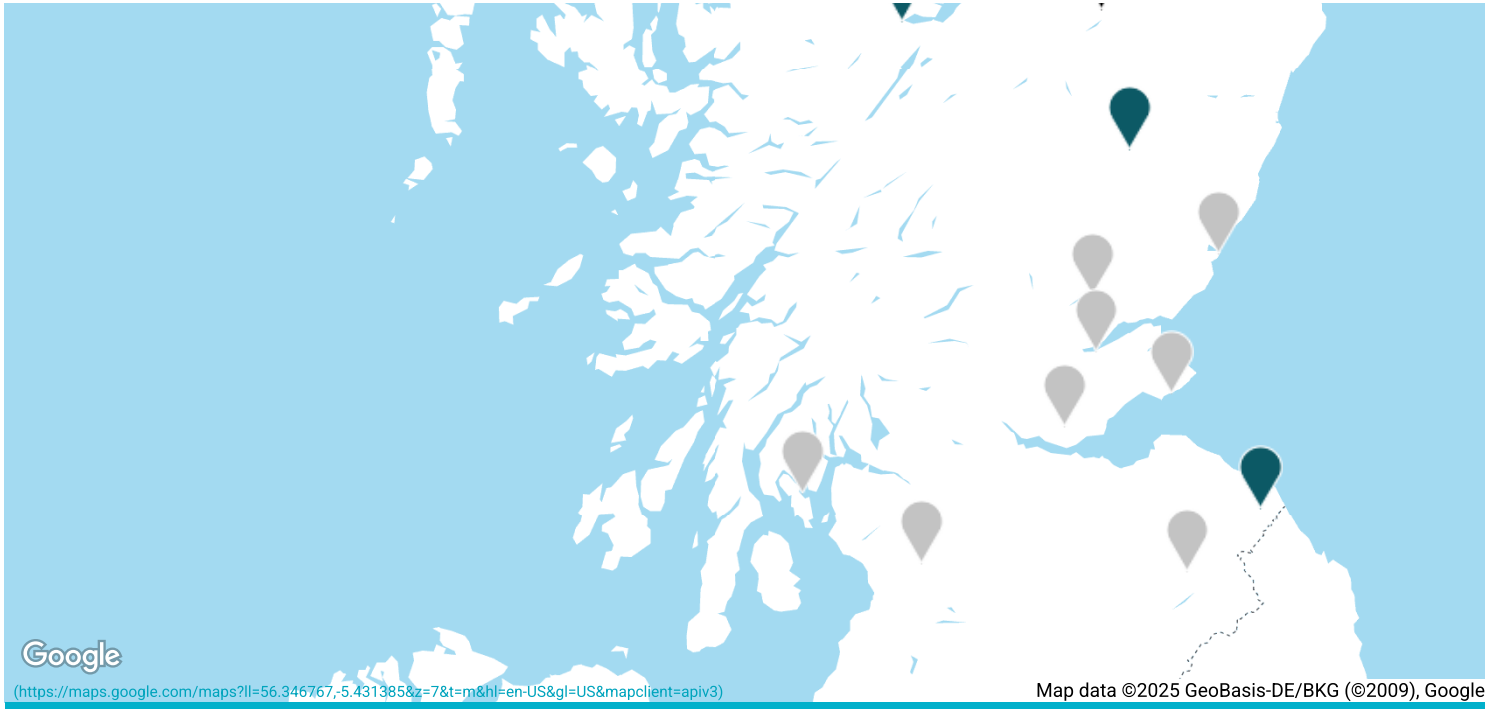

es is in Moray. Roth

es is located in a defensive position and had a castle in the 1200s which villagers would later burn down and use for stone for their houses. Further streets were laid out after 1745. The town is a whisky town with 4 distilleries. An associated biomass plant has been opened. An oil fabrication company is also based in Roth

es and manufactures distillation equipment as well as supplies for the oil industry (Forsyths Ltd).

In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

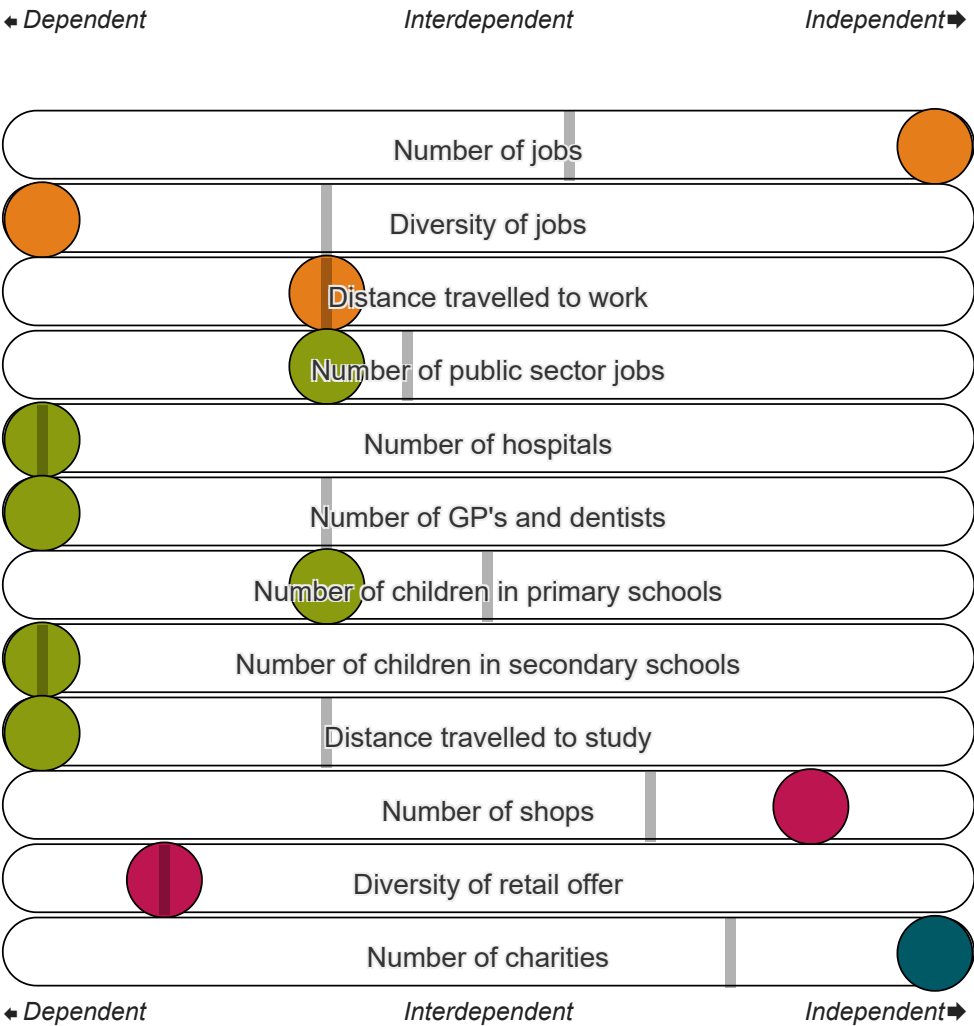

Inter-relationships



Rothes is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Rothes is grouped with 15 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. Rothes differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists; and the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

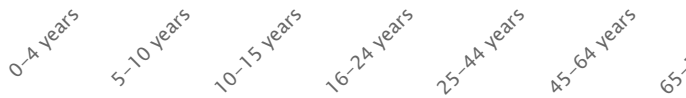

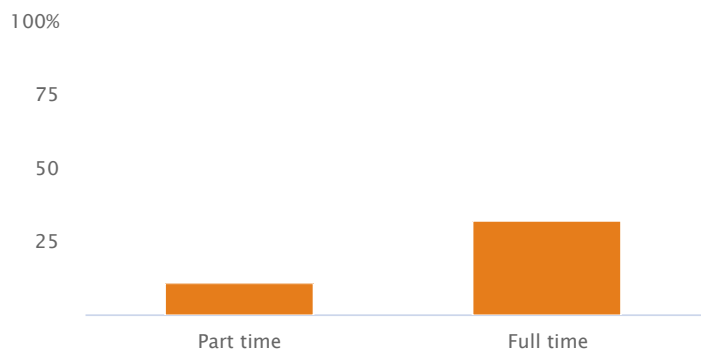

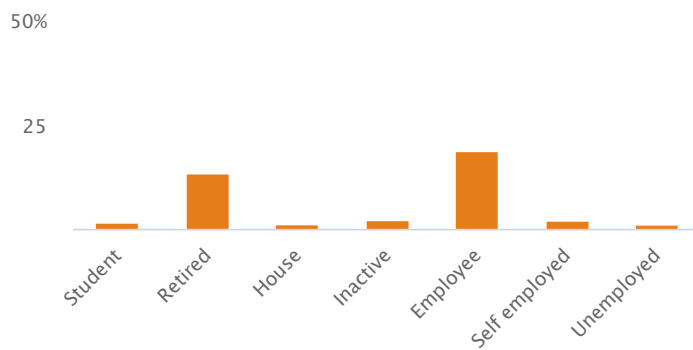
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



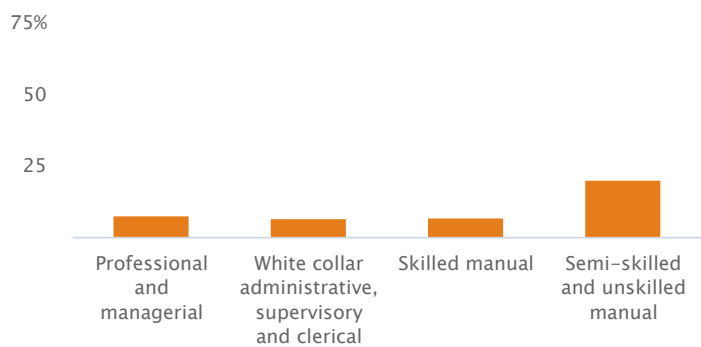
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

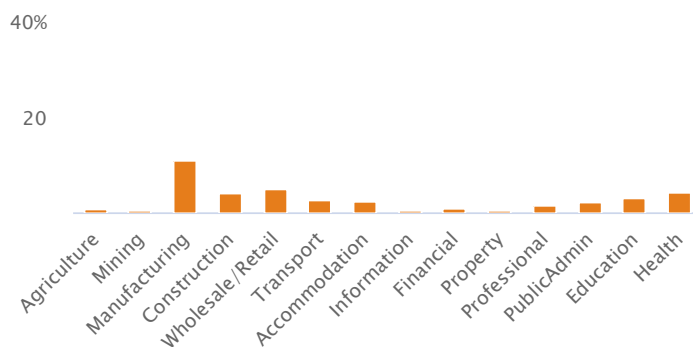

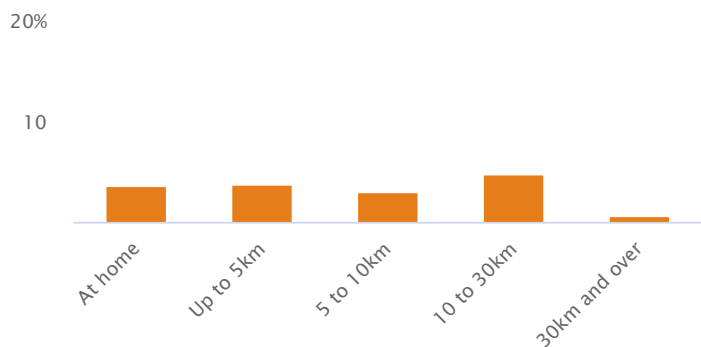
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

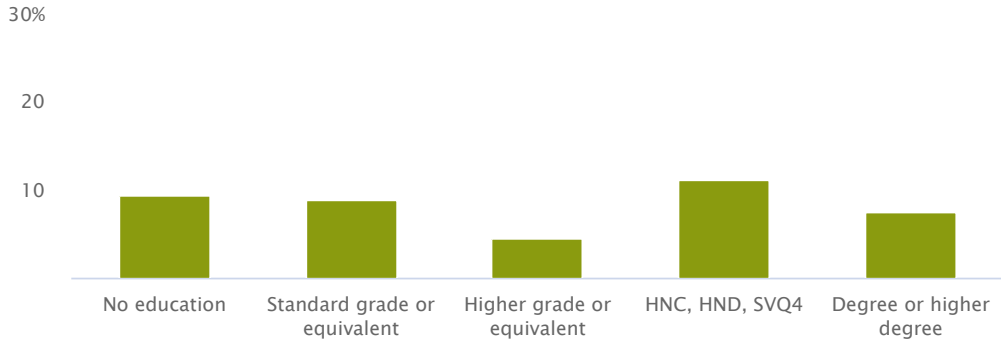


Distance travelled to work

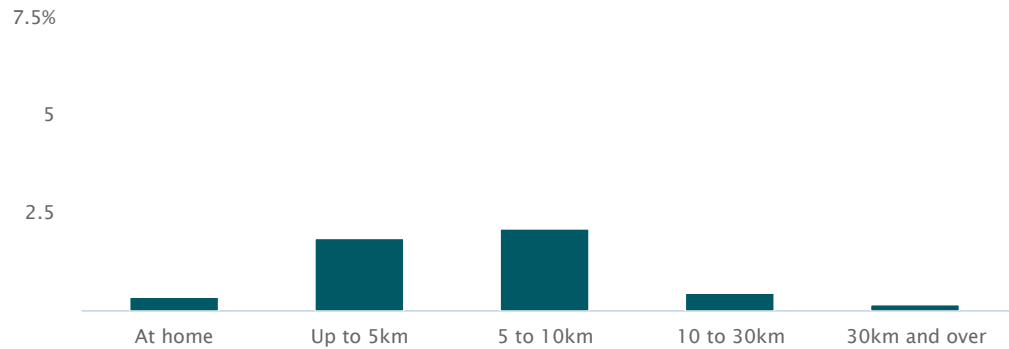
