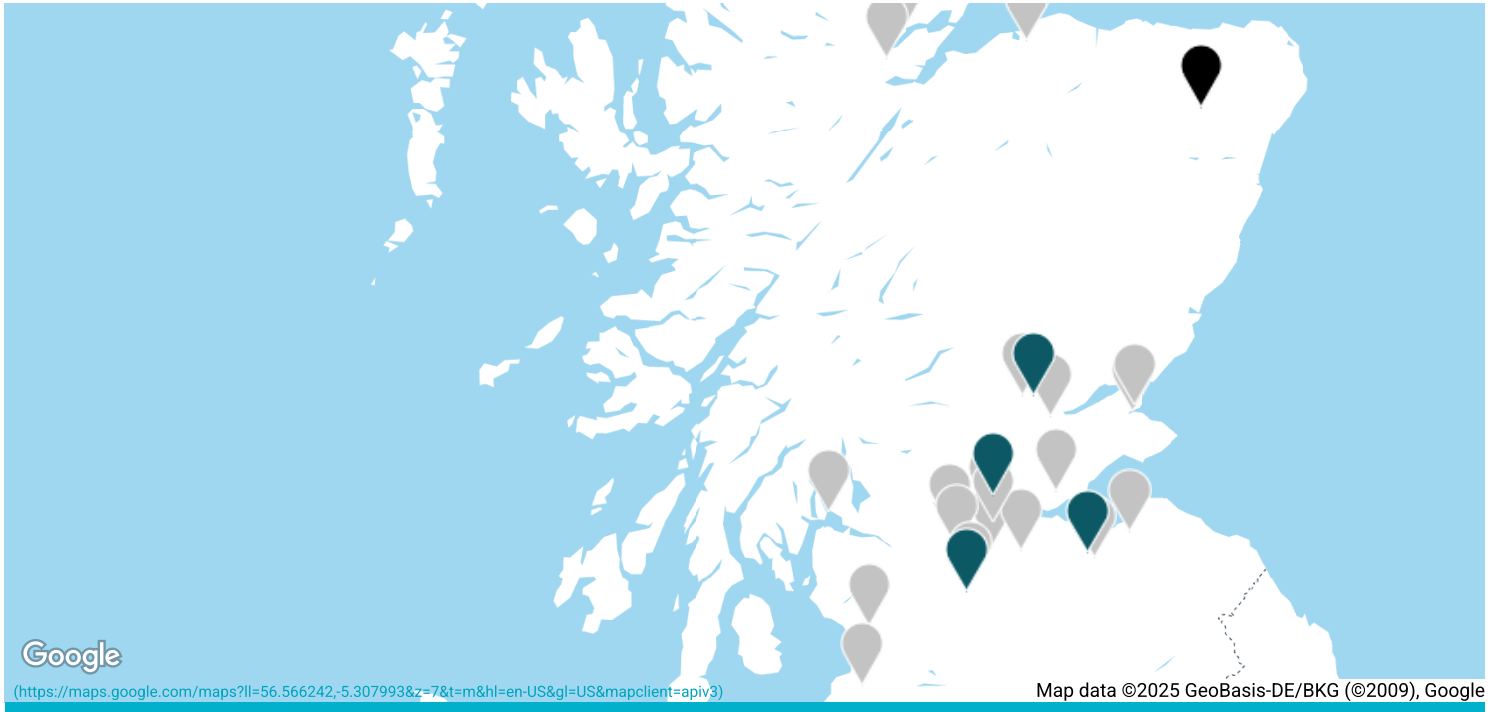




Rothienorman

Rothienorman is in Aberdeenshire. Its origins are as an estate village. An investment in some new build to include affordable and social housing has seen a small expansion in the population.

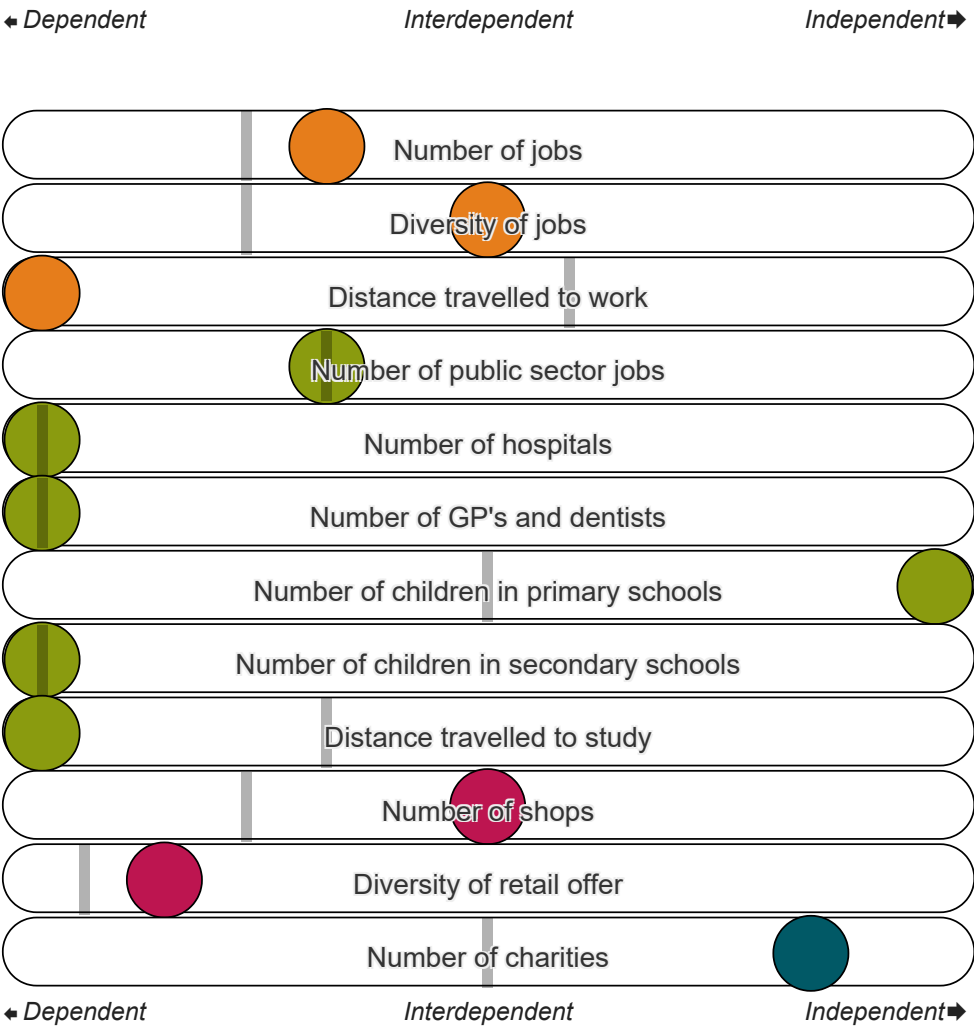
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Rothienorman is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Rothienorman is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

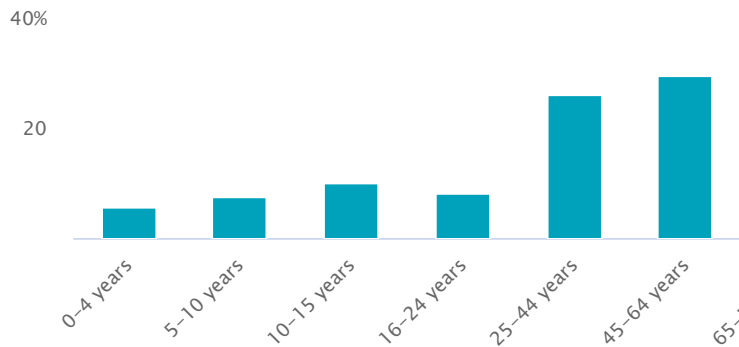
It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, and shops. Rothienorman differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

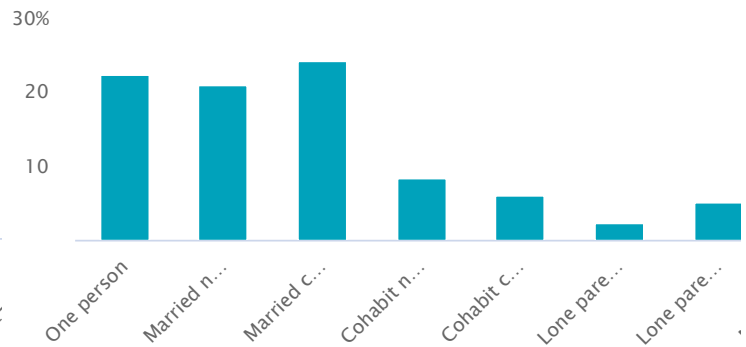

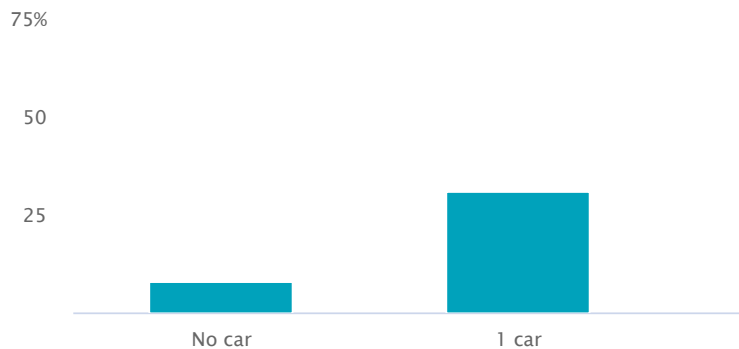

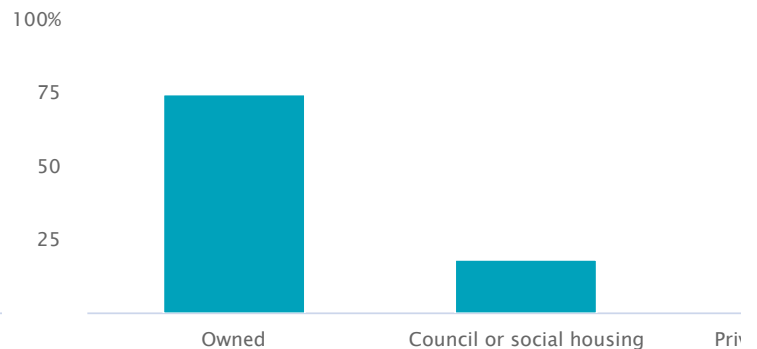
Household composition

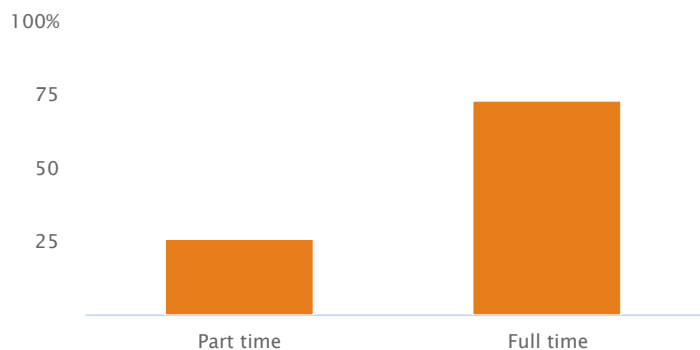

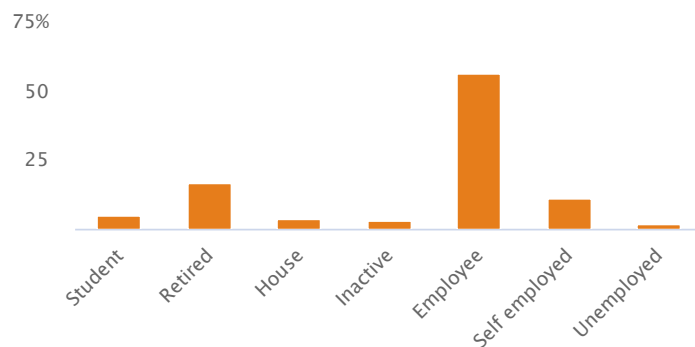
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



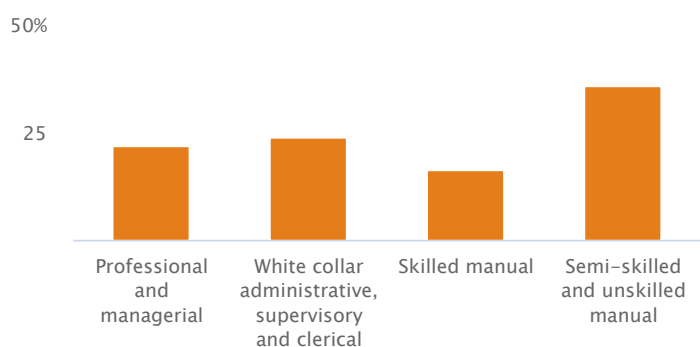
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

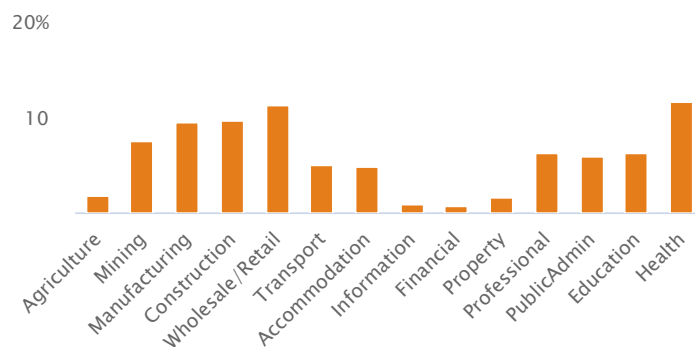


Social Grade

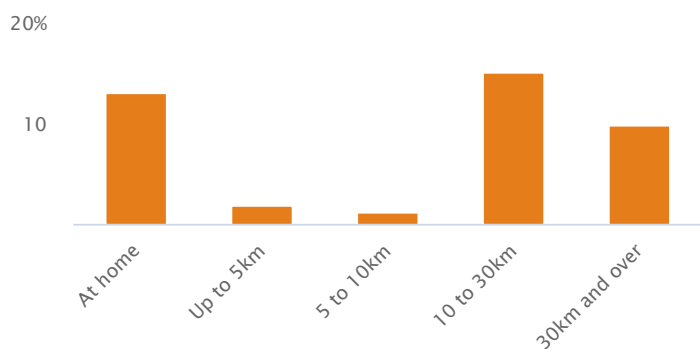
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

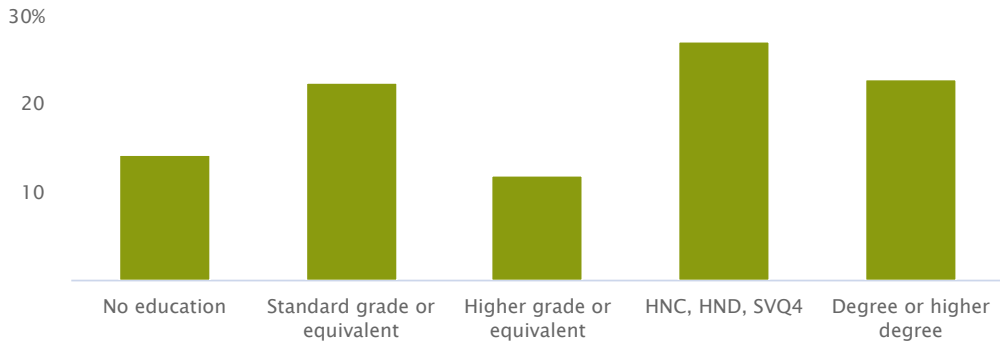


Distance travelled to work

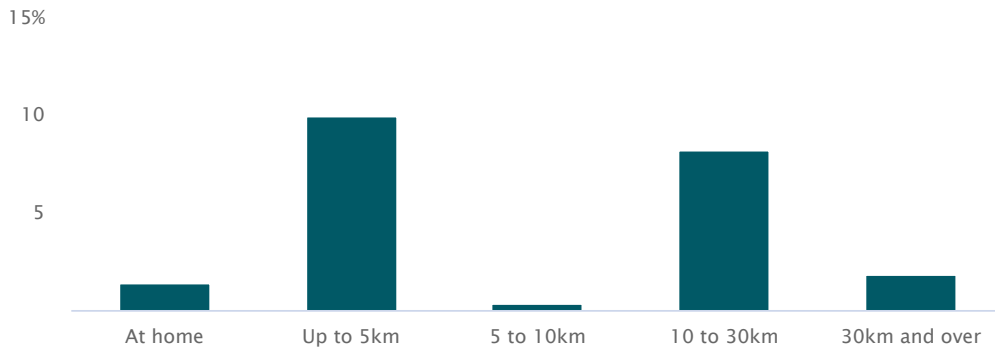
