Rutherglen is located in South Lanarkshire. It was in historic times a burgh and trading centre with horse fairs and an industrial profile. It has now been drawn into the greater Glasgow conurbation and is a suburb of the city. The town retains and industrial profile with a number of industrial estates with small munfacturers, construction sector plants and haulage companies (including Clydemill Industrial Estate) and also Muller Milk and Ingredients.


In large towns such as this, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Rutherglen is an interdependent to independent town.

Its most similar towns are Falkirk, Kilmarnock, Larkhall, and Montrose.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation




