Sandbank is in Argyll and Bute. It was the site of a gunpowder mill. The US Navy had a base there between 1960 and 1992. Today it has boatyards and is popular for yachting. There is a small industrial estate with service sector and construction sector businesses.

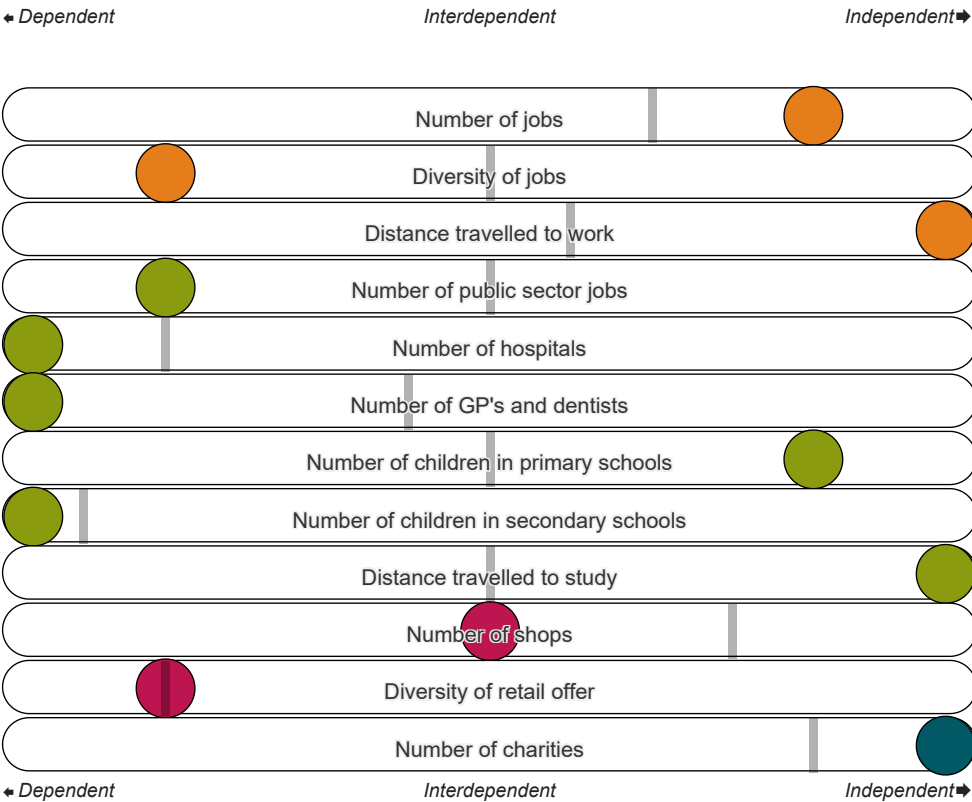
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Sandbank is an interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Sandbank is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Sandbank is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, public sector jobs, and shops. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Sandbank differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

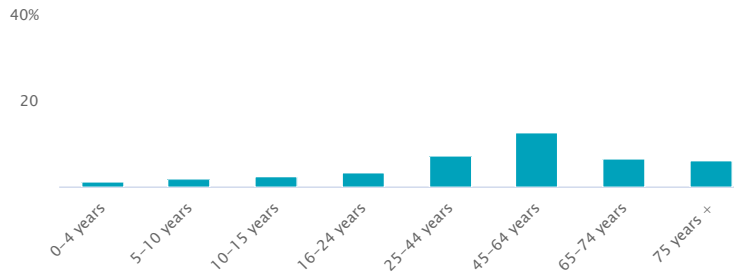

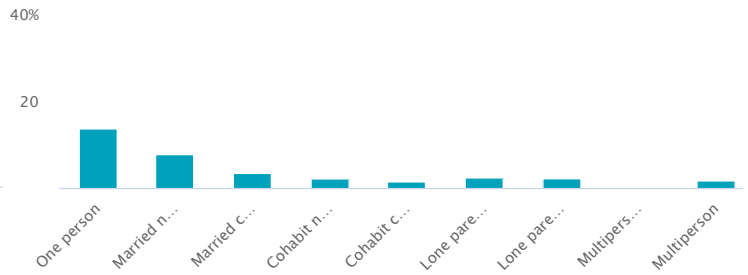

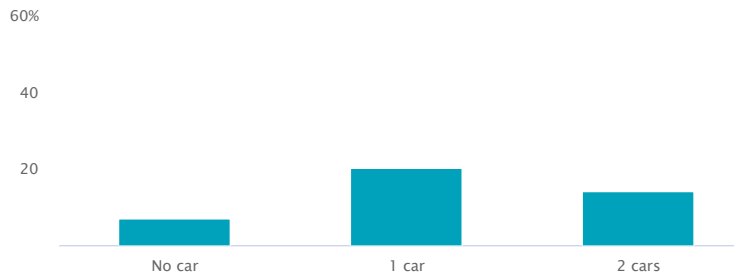

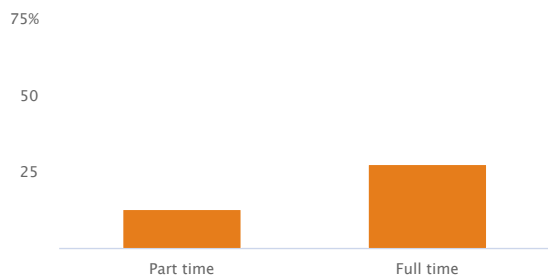

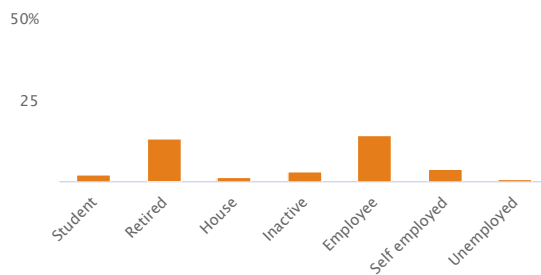
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



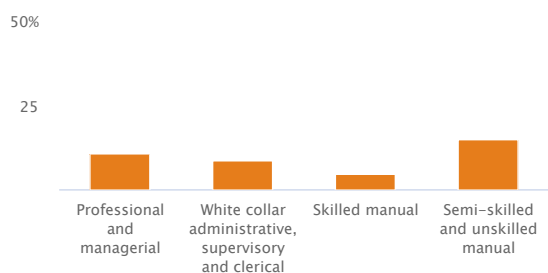
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

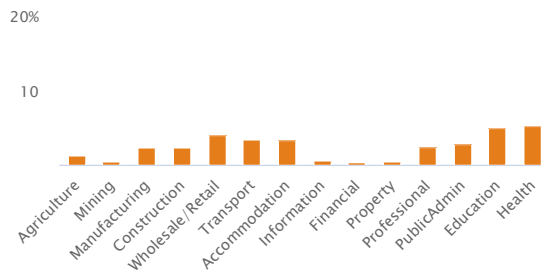

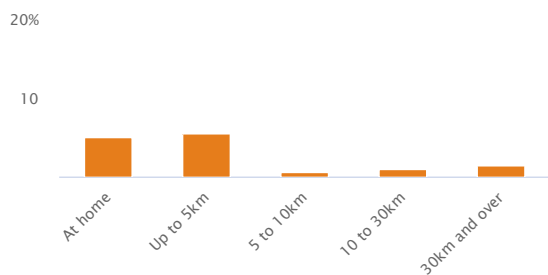
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

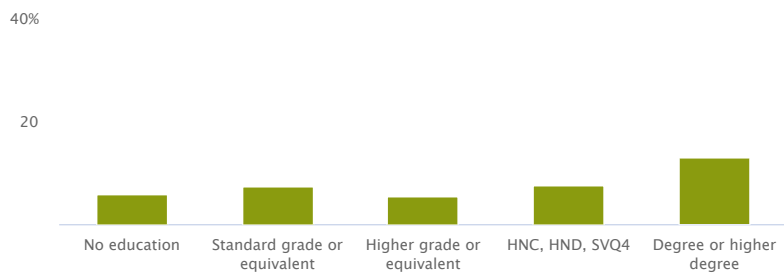


Distance travelled to work

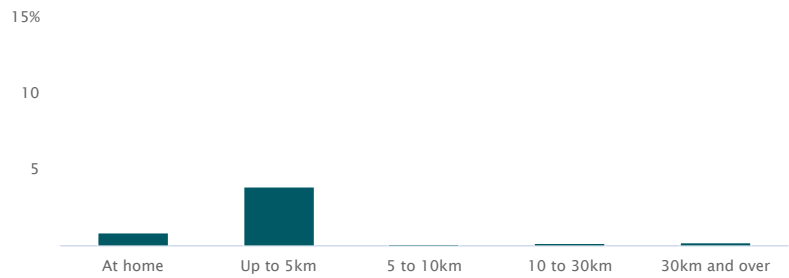
