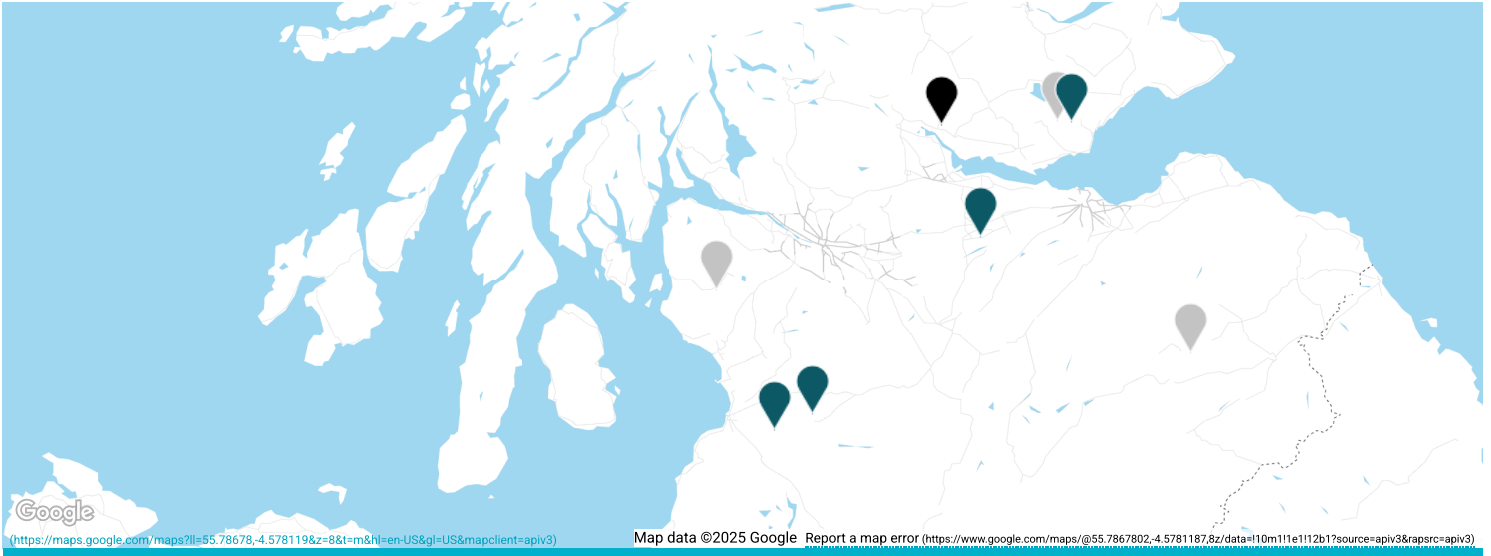




Sauchie

Sauchie is in Clackmannanshire. It was a former mining and brickmaking town. It is an accessible commuter town for Stirling, Falkirk and Edinburgh.

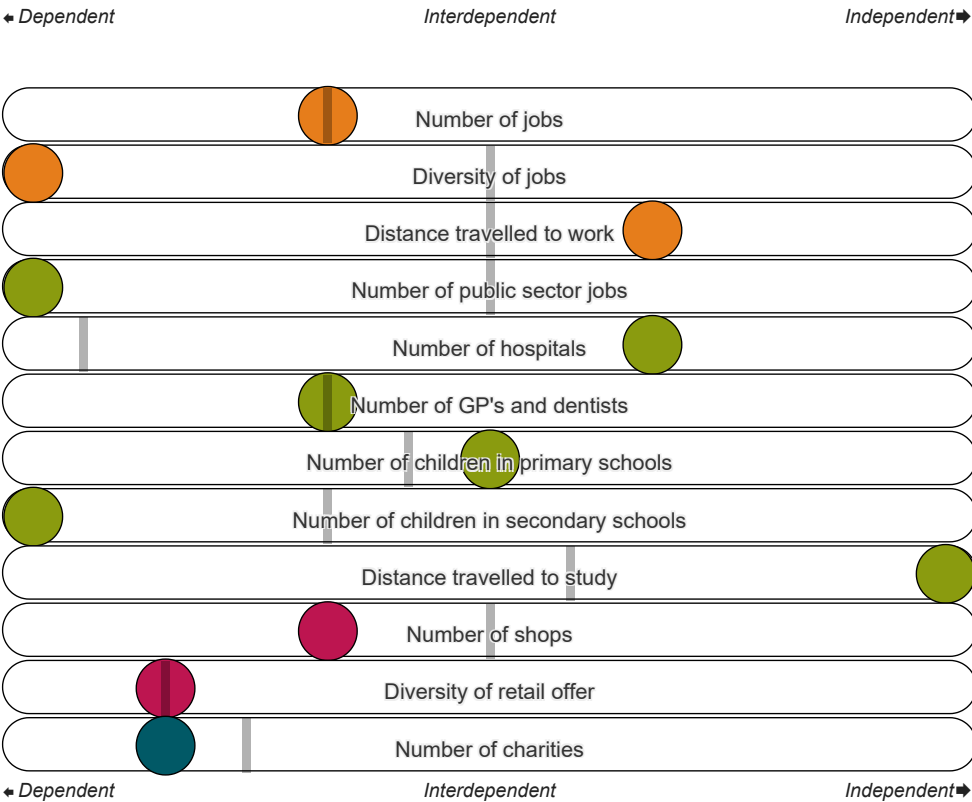
In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Sauchie is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

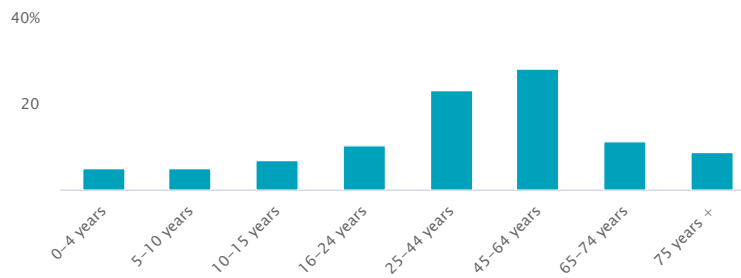
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Sauchie is grouped with 7 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Sauchie differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools, and public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

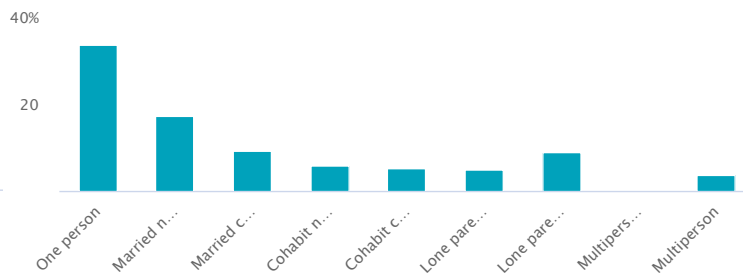

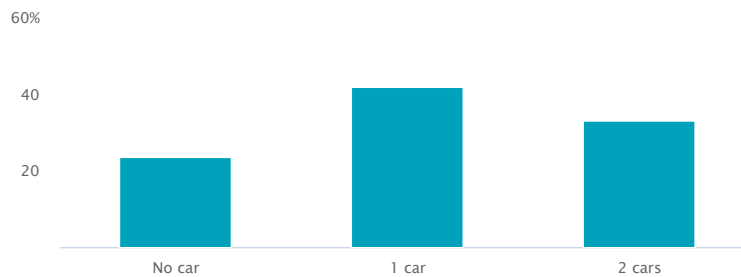

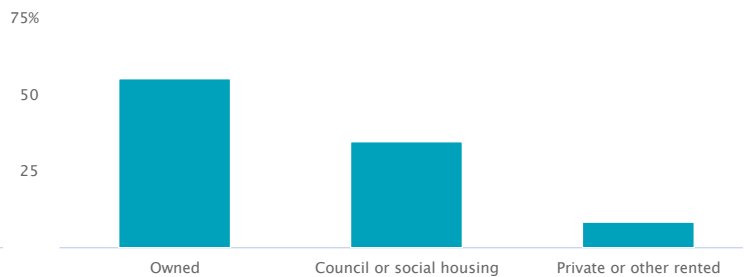
Household composition

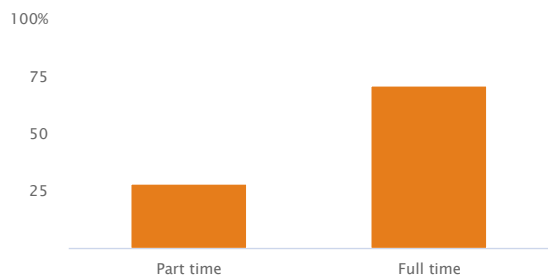

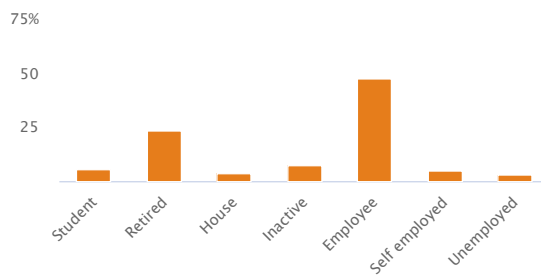
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



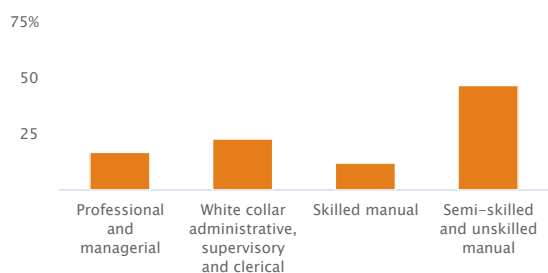
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

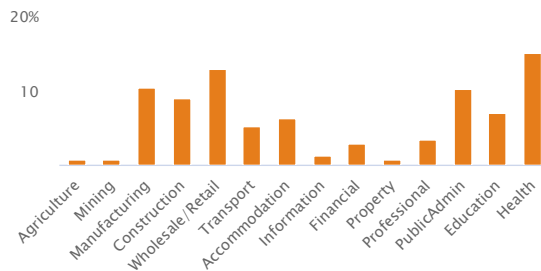

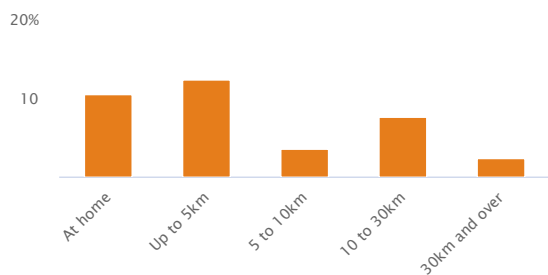
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

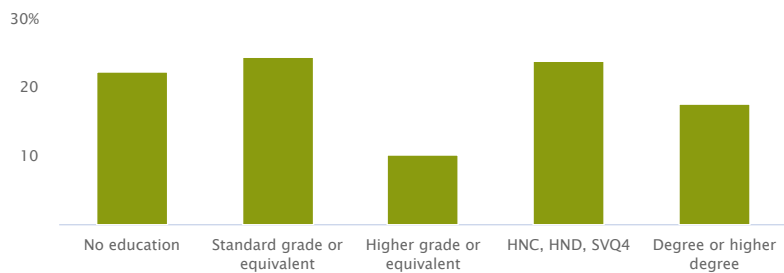


Distance travelled to work

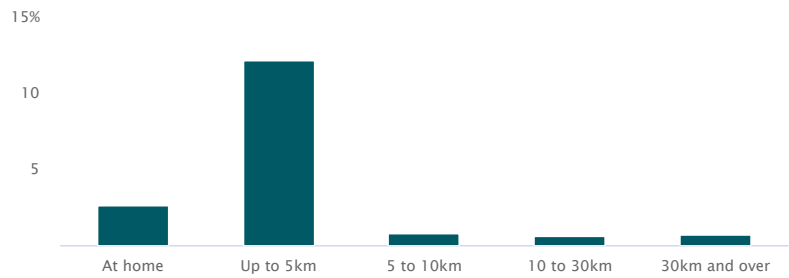
