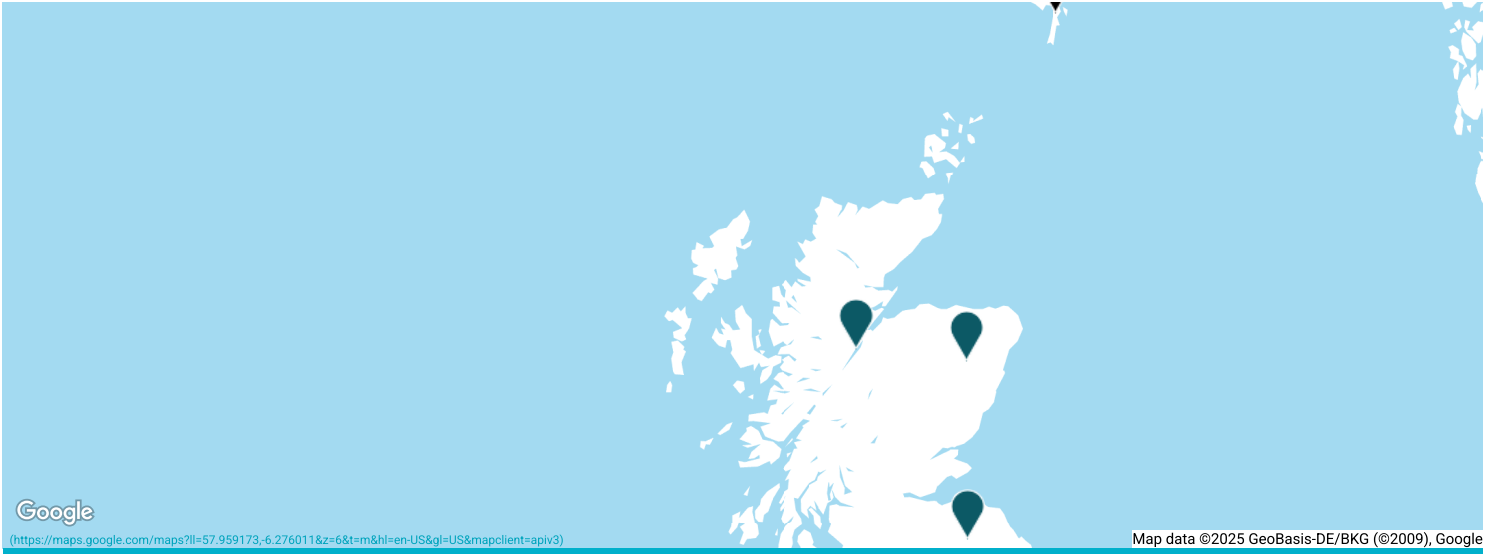




Scalloway

Scalloway in Shetland was the site of the Norse parliament in Shetland. It developed as a fishing town, Marine industries, including an oil depot, boat repair yard and marina, are important today.

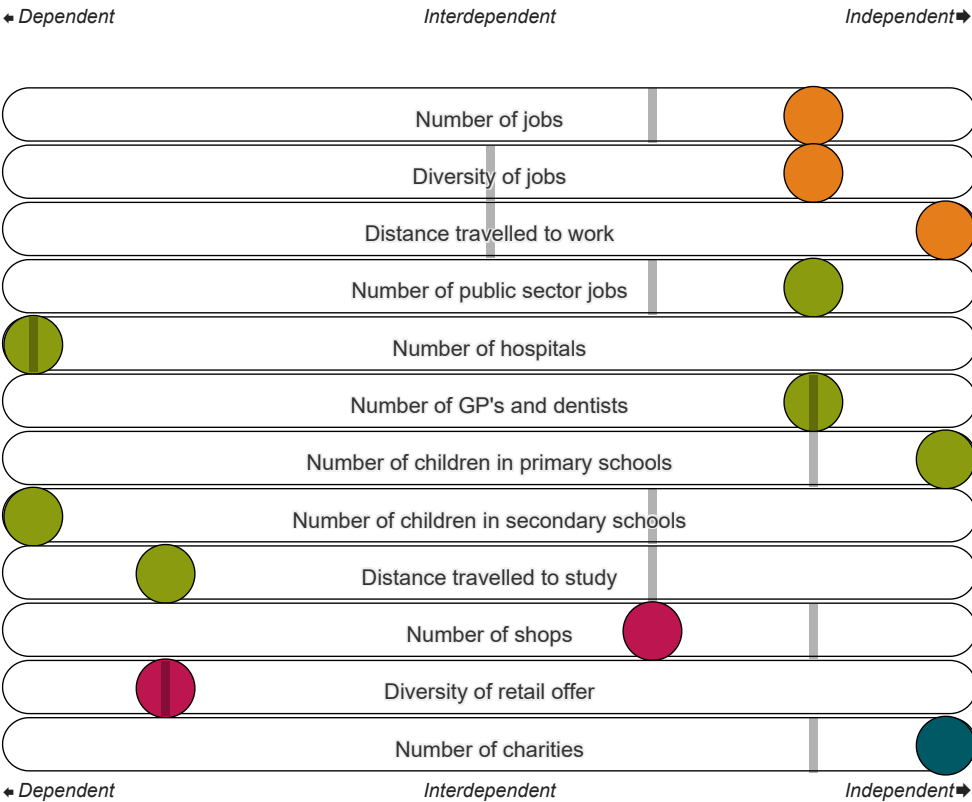
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Scalloway is an interdependent to independent town.

Inter-relationships



Scalloway is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Scalloway is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Scalloway differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools.

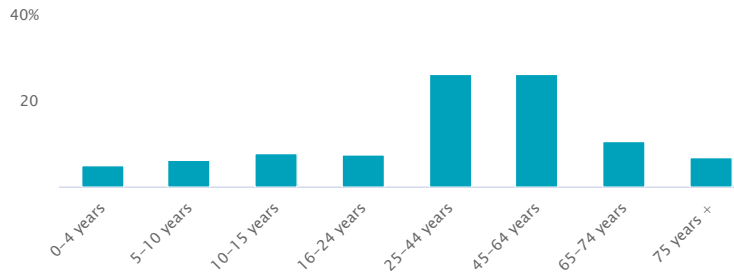

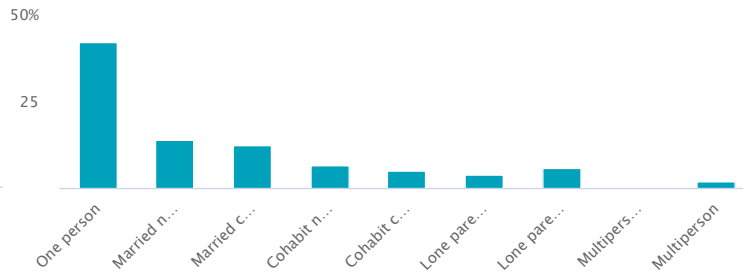

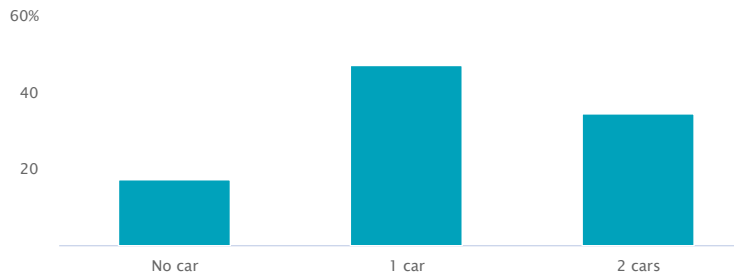

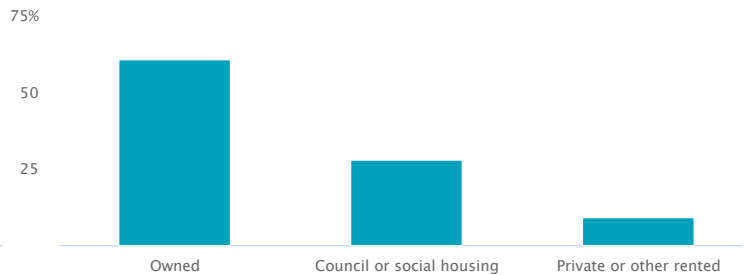

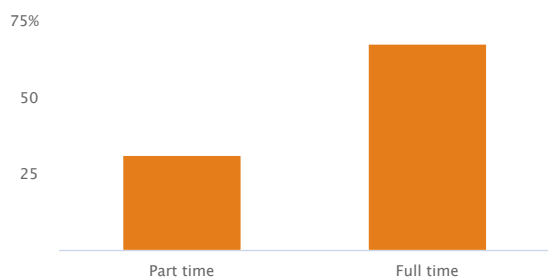

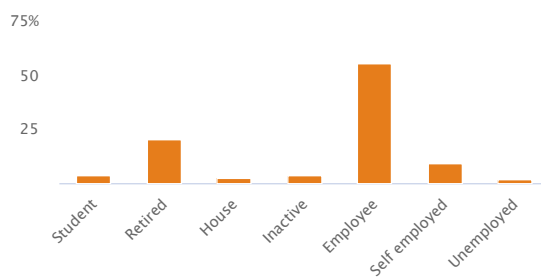
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



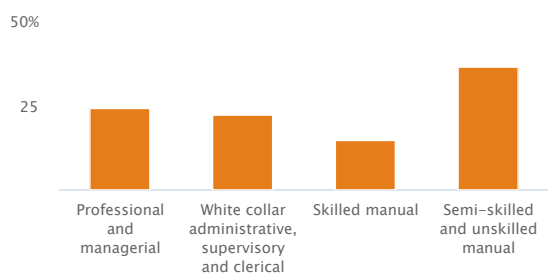
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

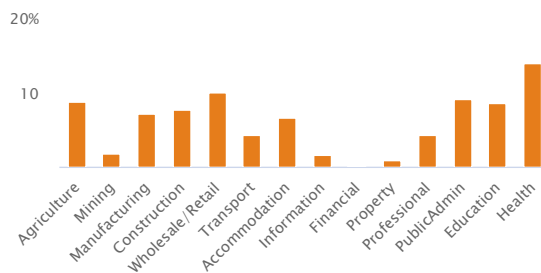

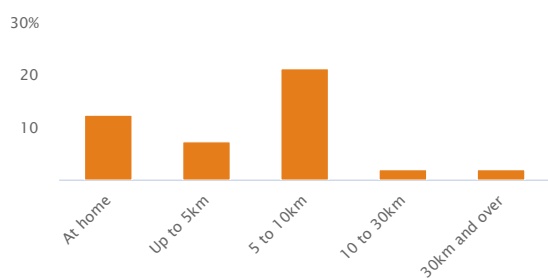
(% households aged 16-64)



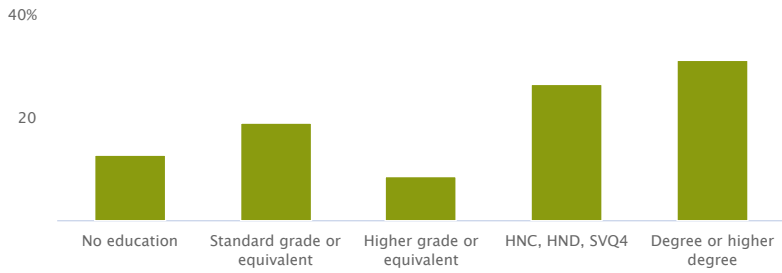
Sector Diversity

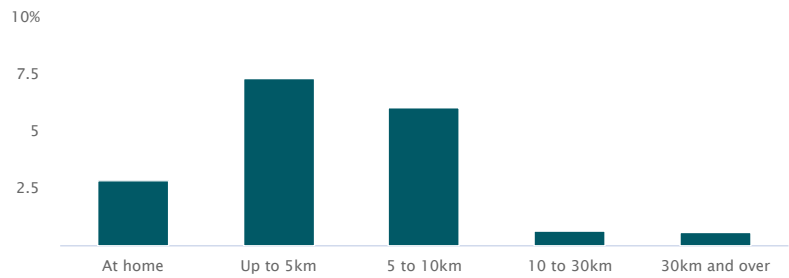
