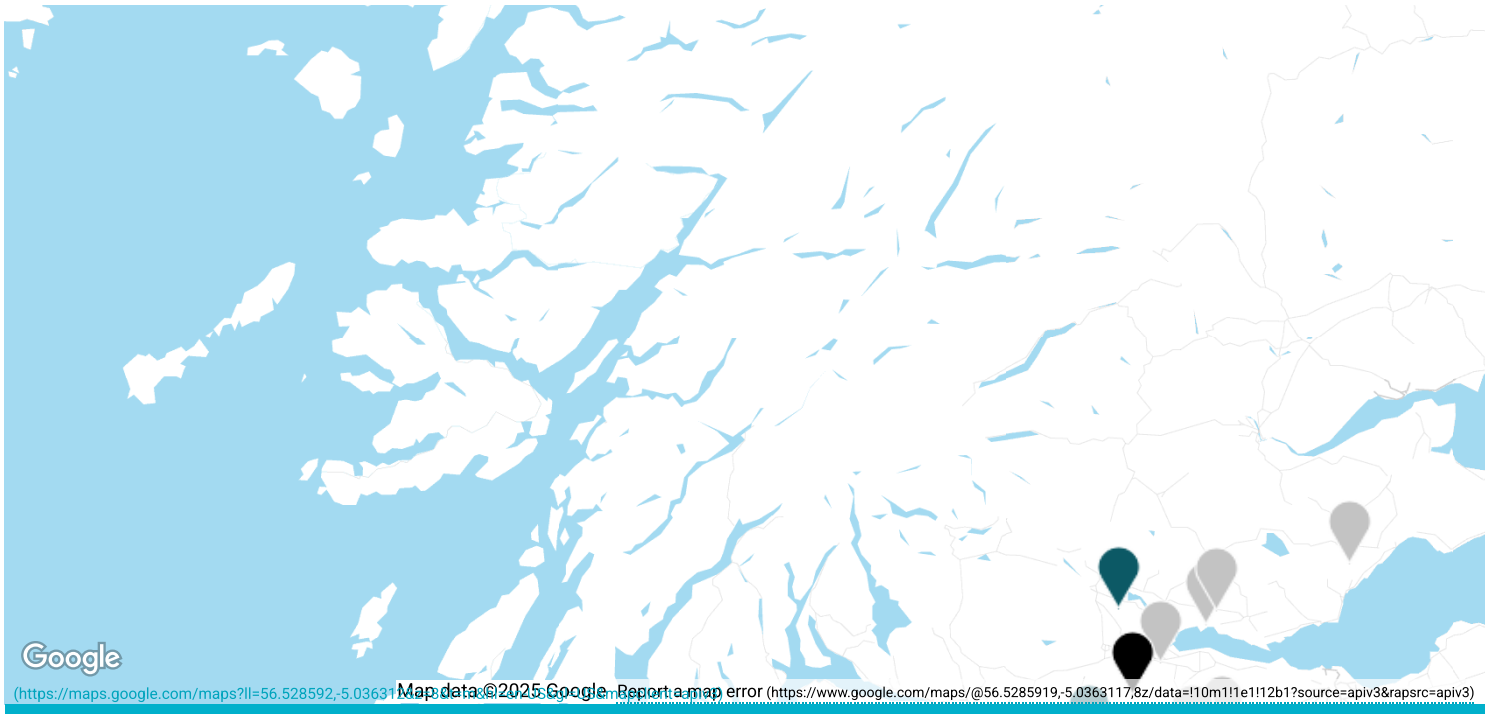




Slamannan

Slammanan is in Falkirk. In the early 19th century with agricultural improvement the town of Slammanan became a local service centre for the surrounding agricultural area. The coming of the railway and the discovery of coal led to a rapid expansion of the town in the 19th century. By the 1920s the pits were exhausted. Today it is a commuter settlement.

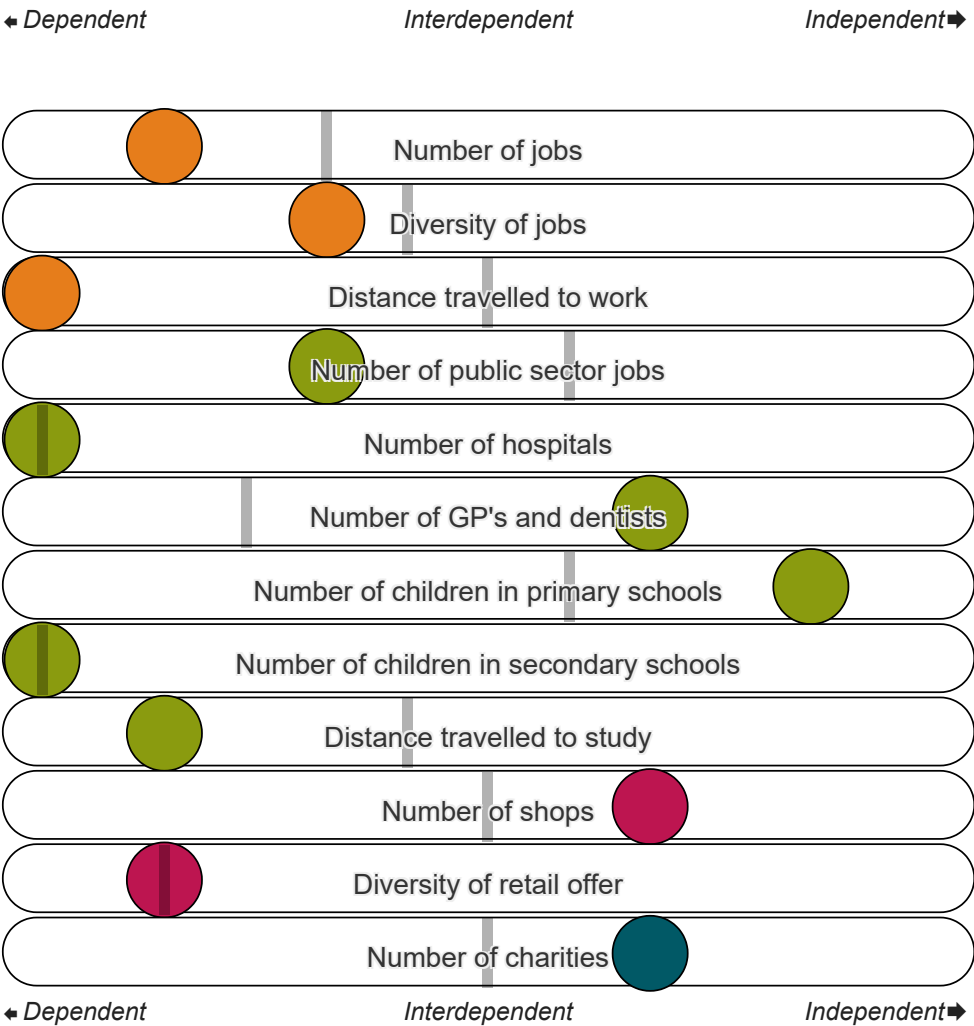
In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Slamannan is an interdependent to dependent town.

Slamannan is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Slamannan is grouped with 13 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of GP's and dentists. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Slamannan differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

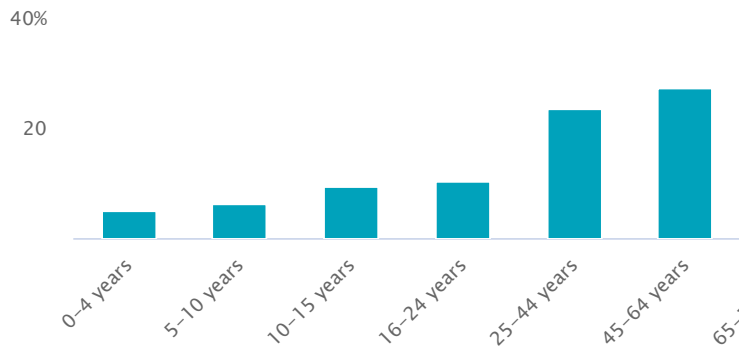

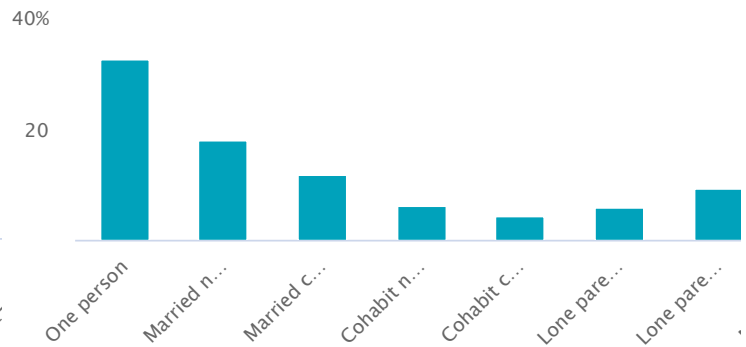

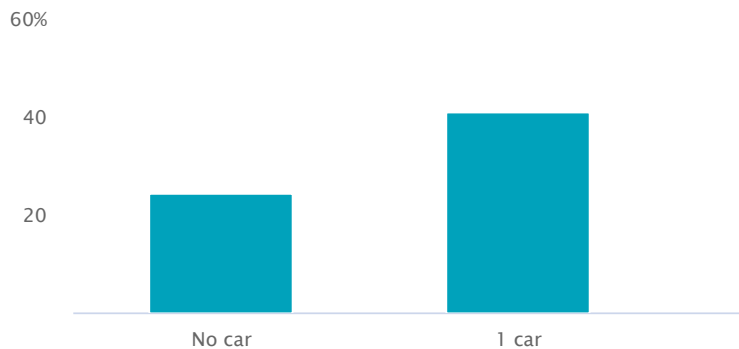

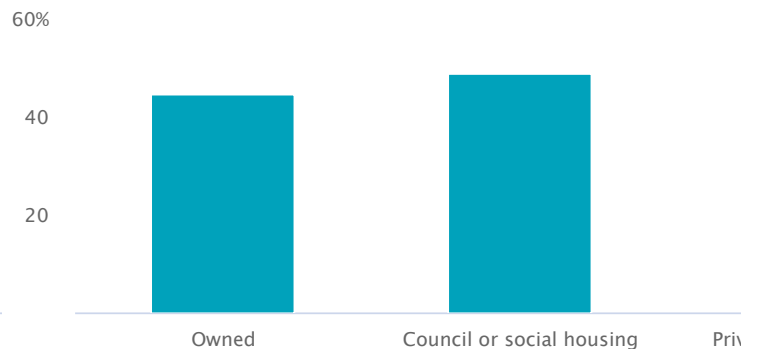

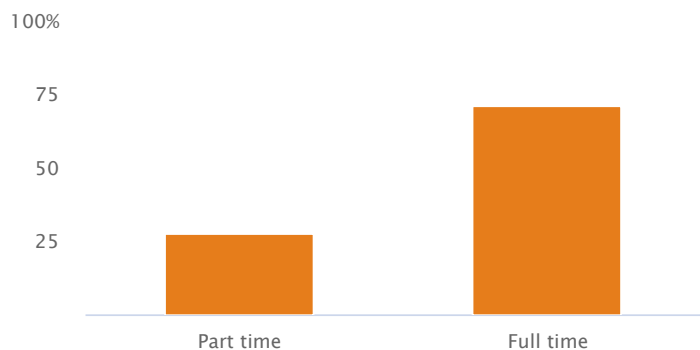

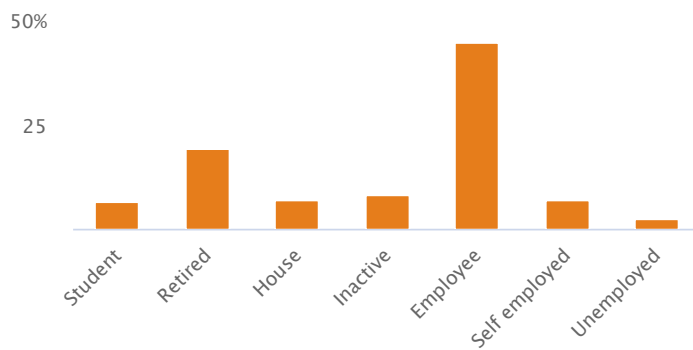
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



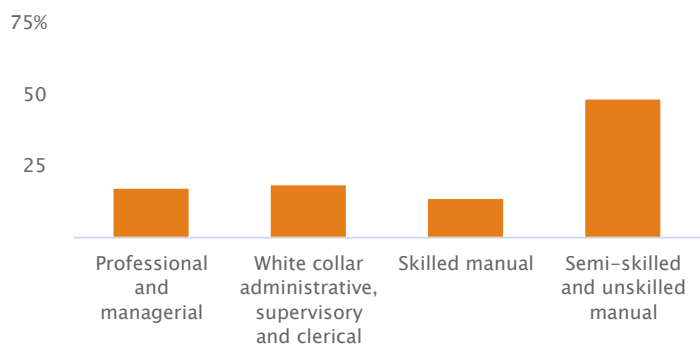
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)



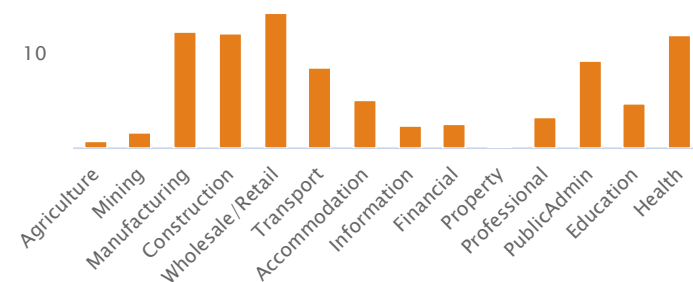
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)



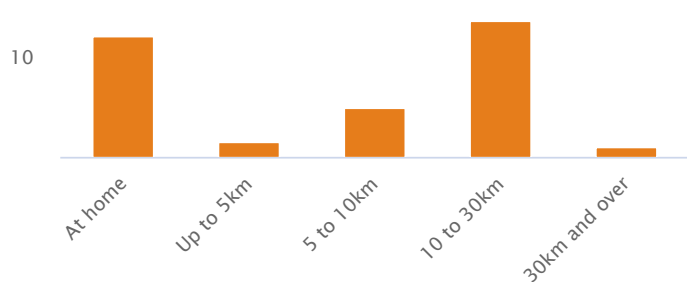

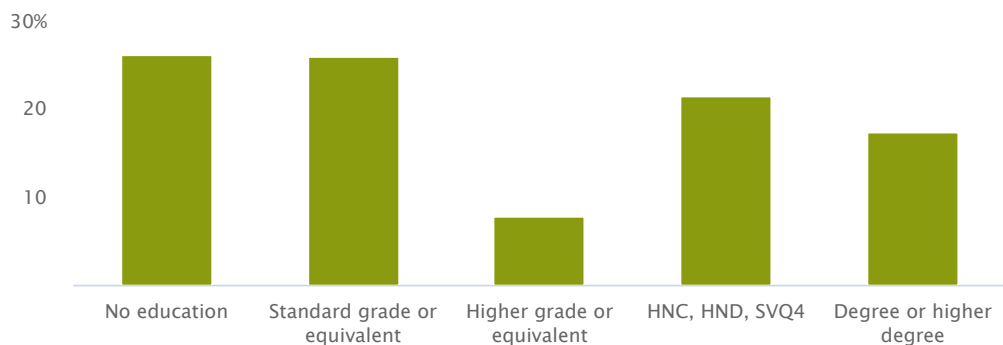
Distance travelled to work

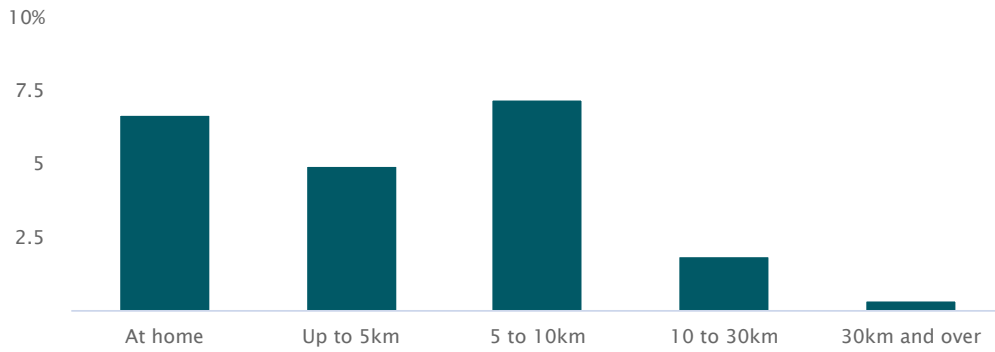
