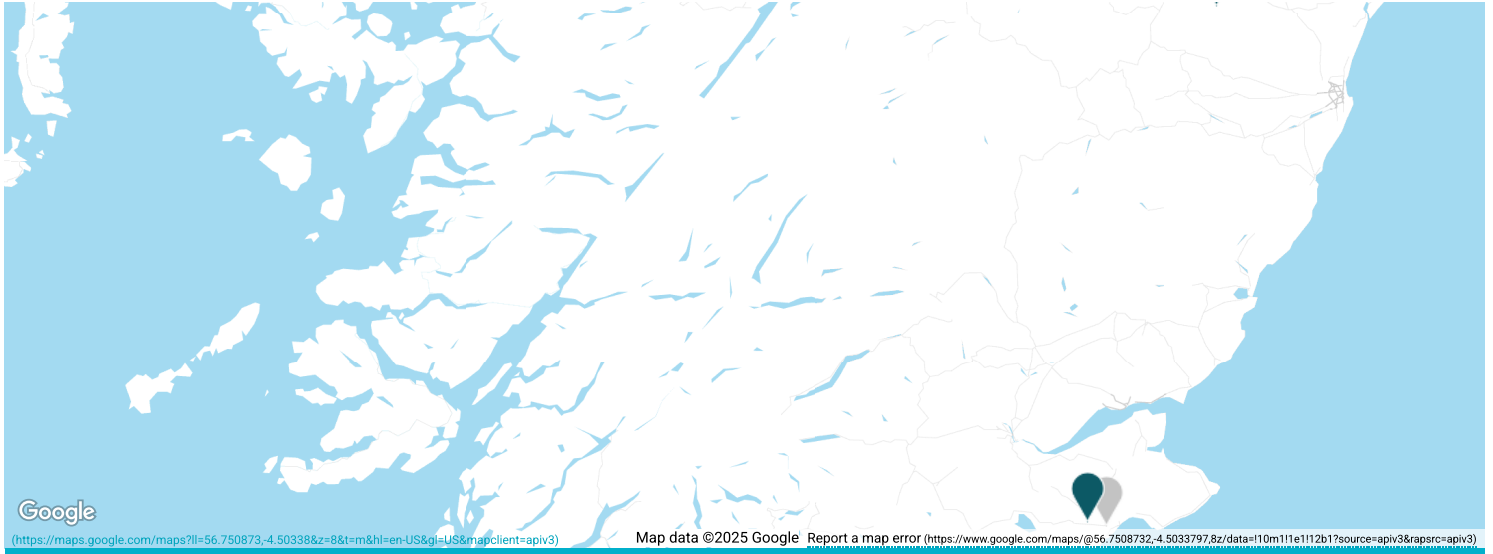




Smithton

Smithton is near Culloden in Highland. It developed as a commuter settlement for Inverness with public housing. Increasingly private estates have been built and a new business park developed.

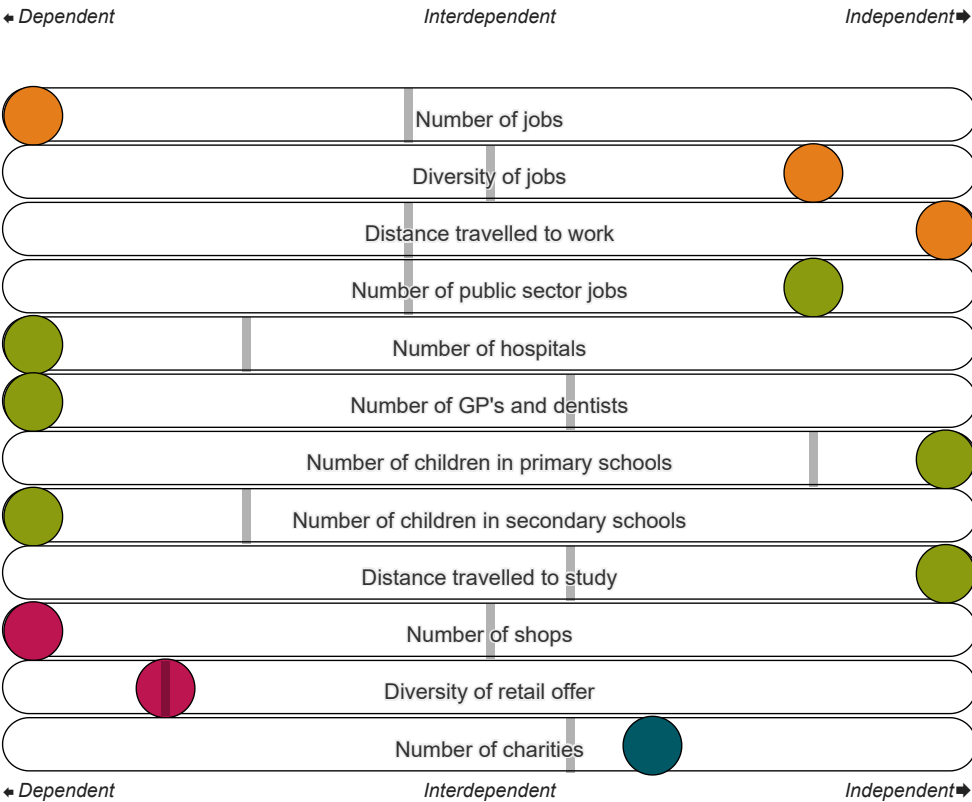
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Smithton is an interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Smithton is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Smithton is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Smithton differs most from its group in the number of hospitals, jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists.

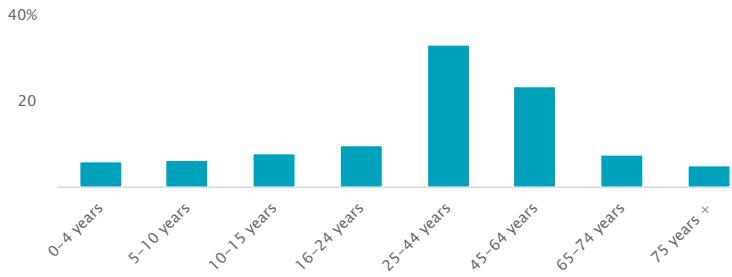

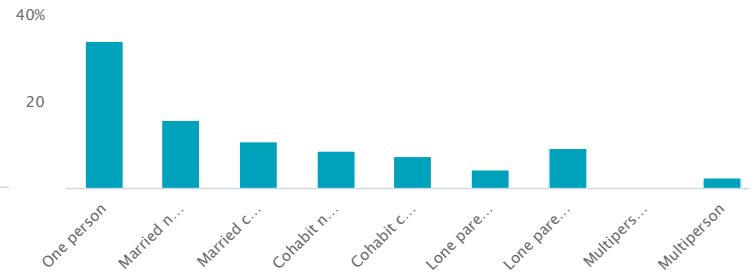

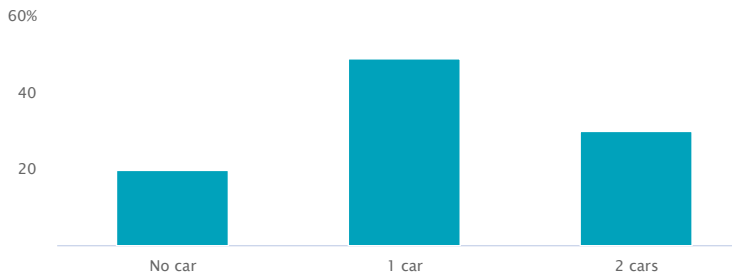

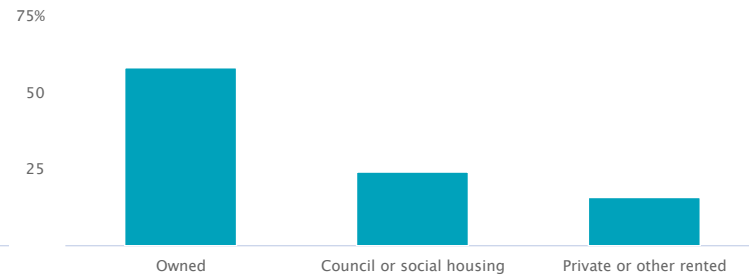

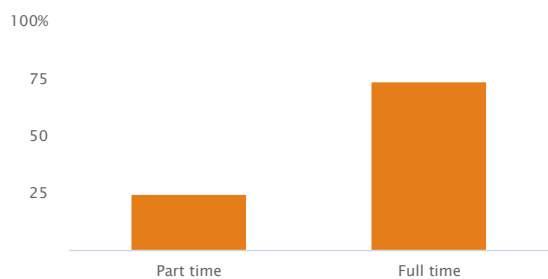

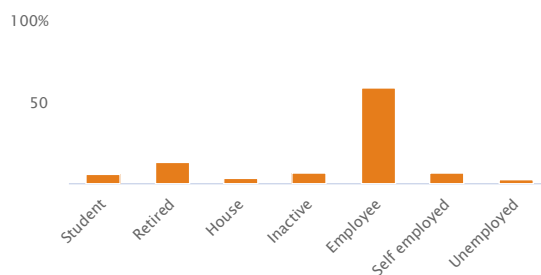
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



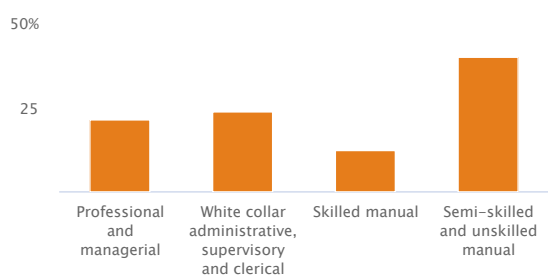
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

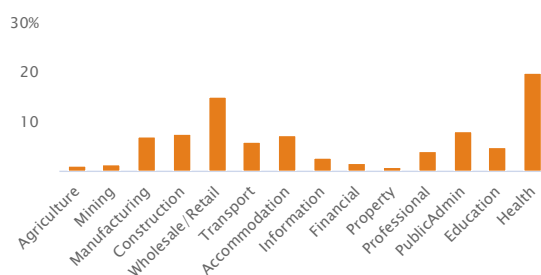

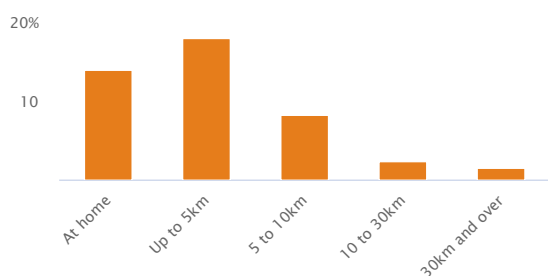
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

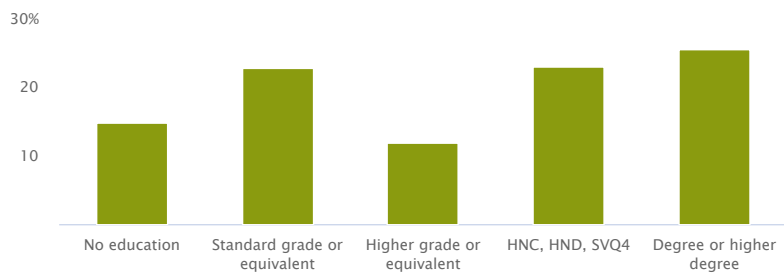


Distance travelled to work

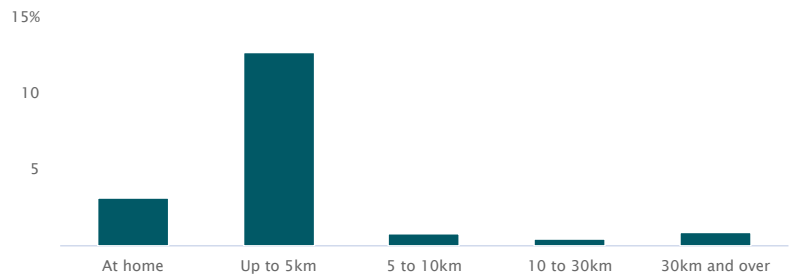
