Springfield is in Fife. Its origins were in the linen industry. New low cost housing has slightly increased the population. It is proximate to Stratheden Hospital and other local employers include the Deer Centre and the porridge oat processing factory. It also benefits from a station.

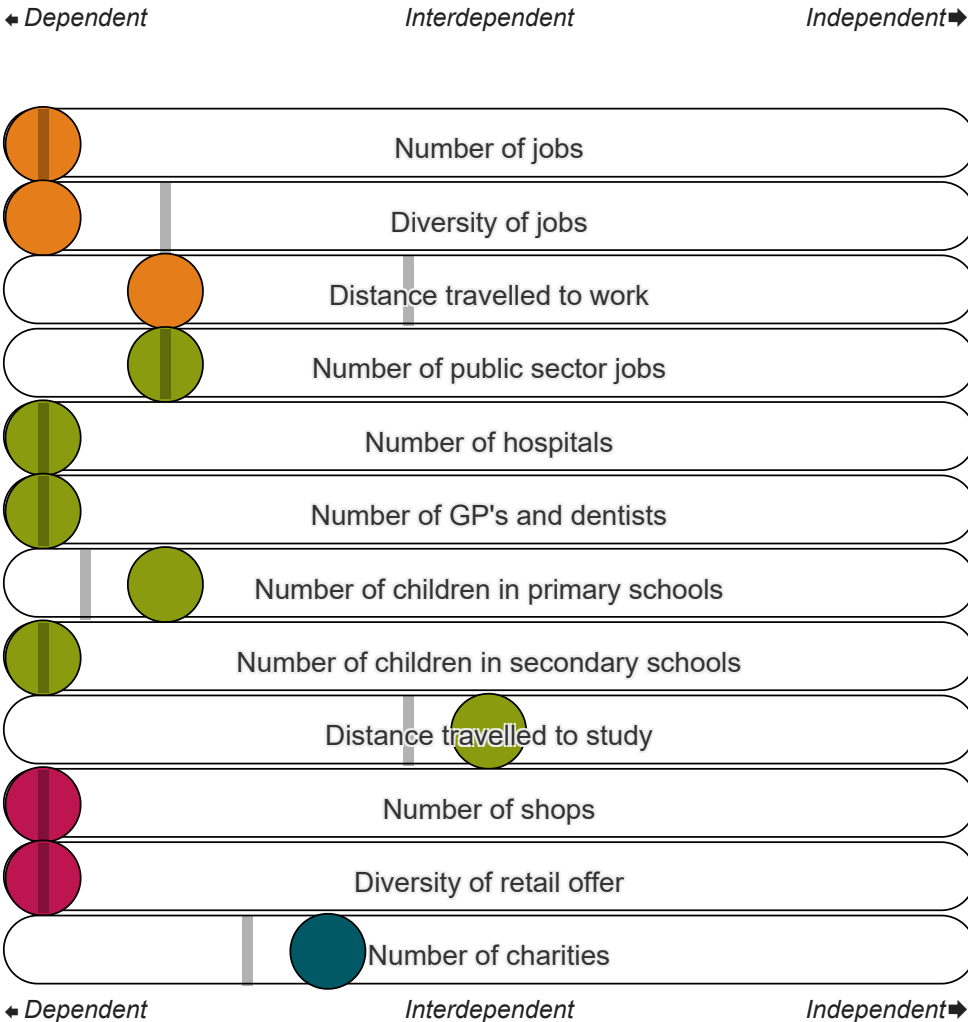
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

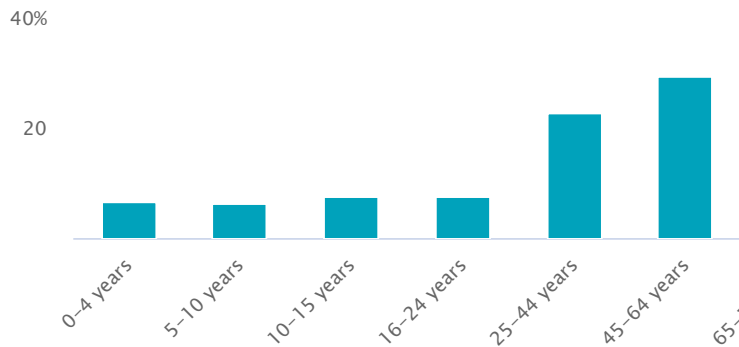
Springfield differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

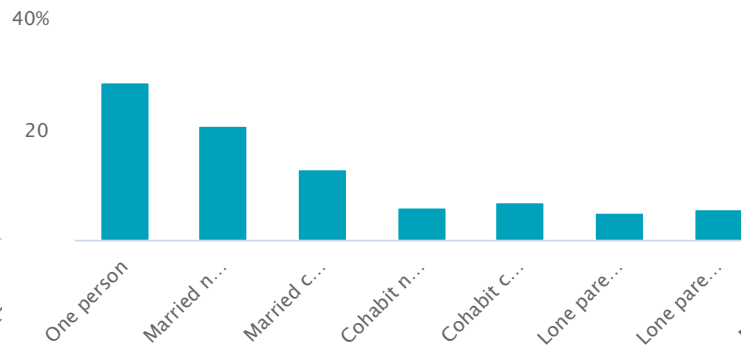

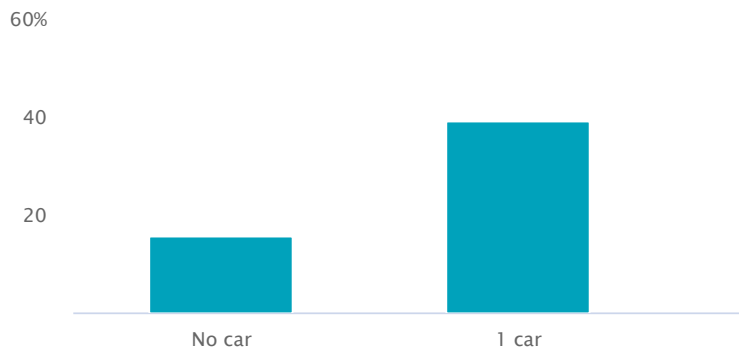

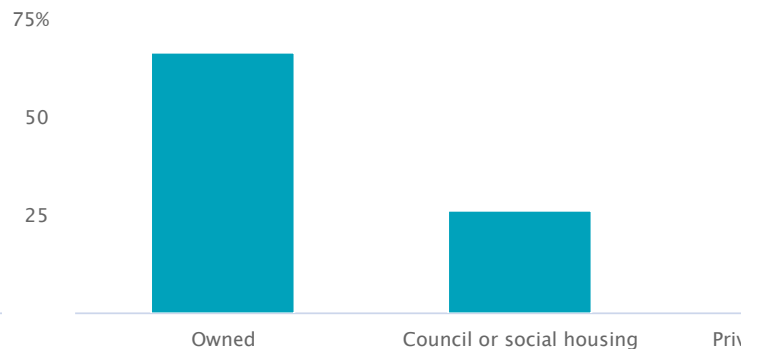
Household composition

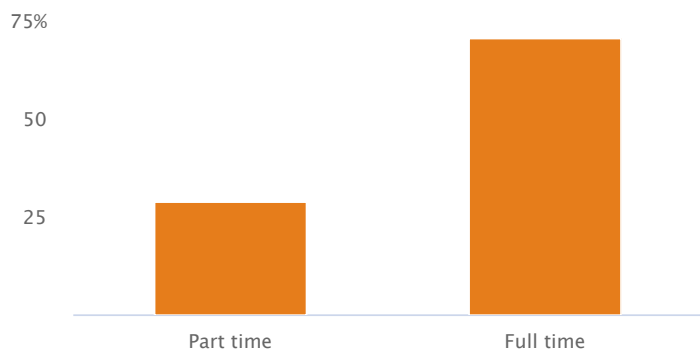

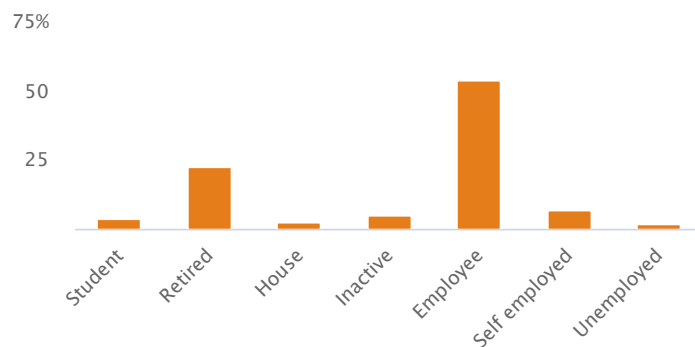
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



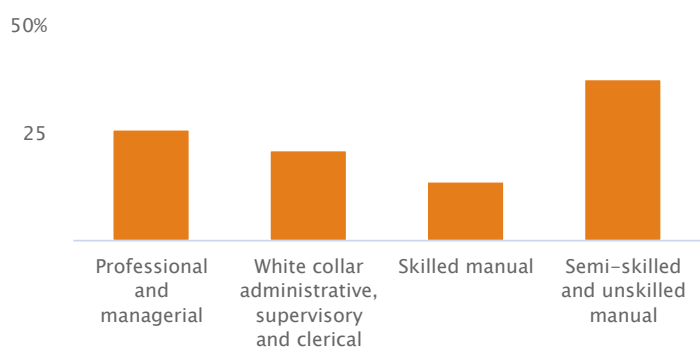
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

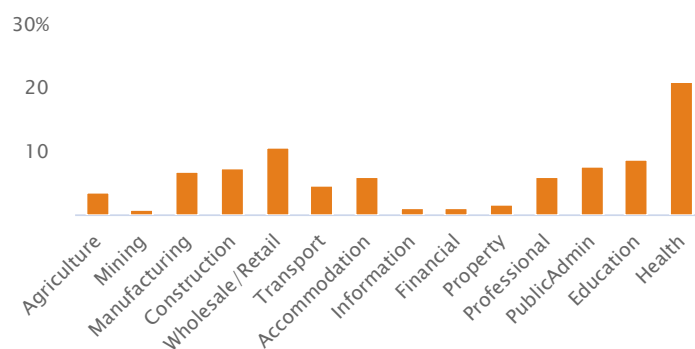

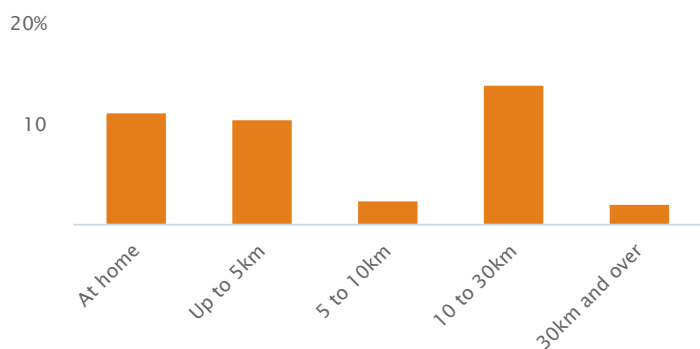
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

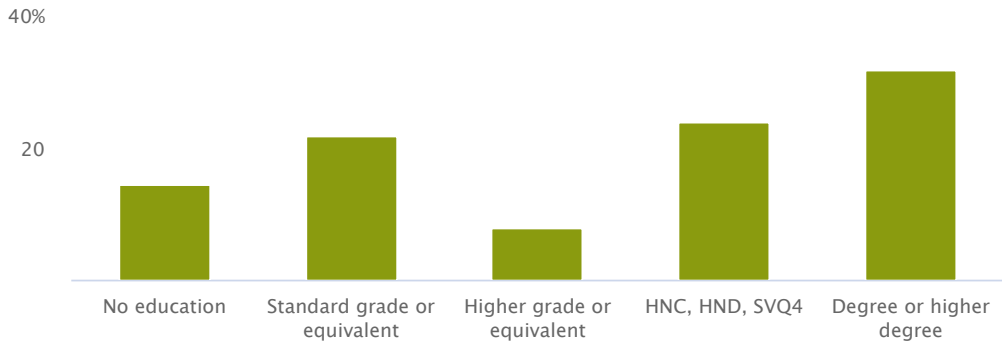


Distance travelled to work

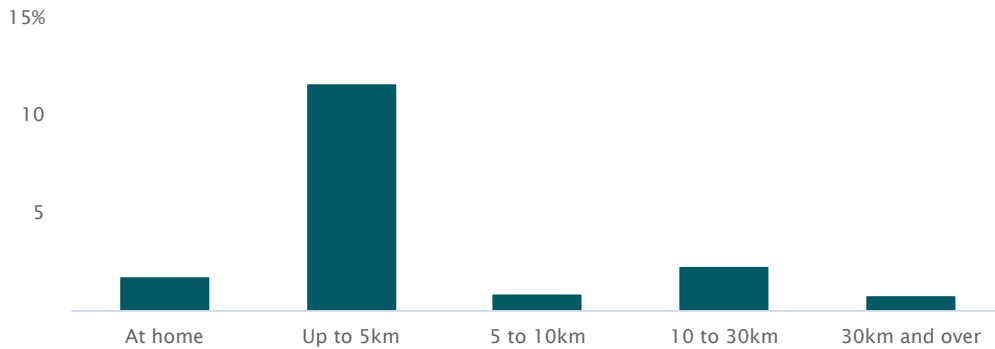
