The university has expanded its student numbers over the las t 40 years with new building on the North Haugh.


St Andrews has a large student population, with many living in privately rented accommodation with other students. Many are in part time work in the accommodation and food service sectors. This shows that a significant part of the workforce is likely to be made up of those working alongside their studies. Many are reliant on walking, cycling, or public transport to move around, with a comparably small proportion of the population owning cars.

Population change 2011 to 2022






#### **Employment type**

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




#### **Occupation**

(% aged 16-74)




#### **Social Grade**




