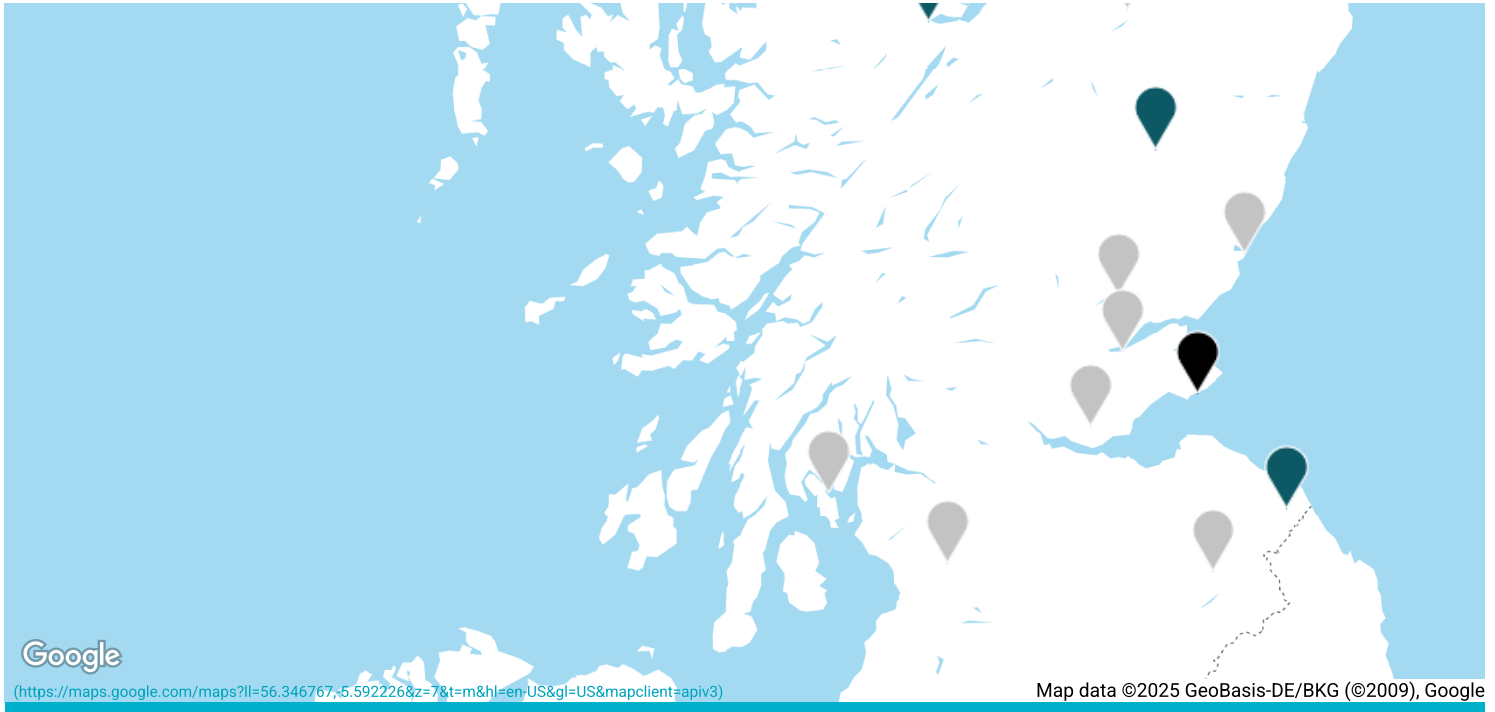

St Monans is in Fife. It developed on the site of a Christian shrine for St Monein. Traditional industries included salt pans and fishing. Today tourism, boat building, fishing and fish smoking and processing are key to the local economy.

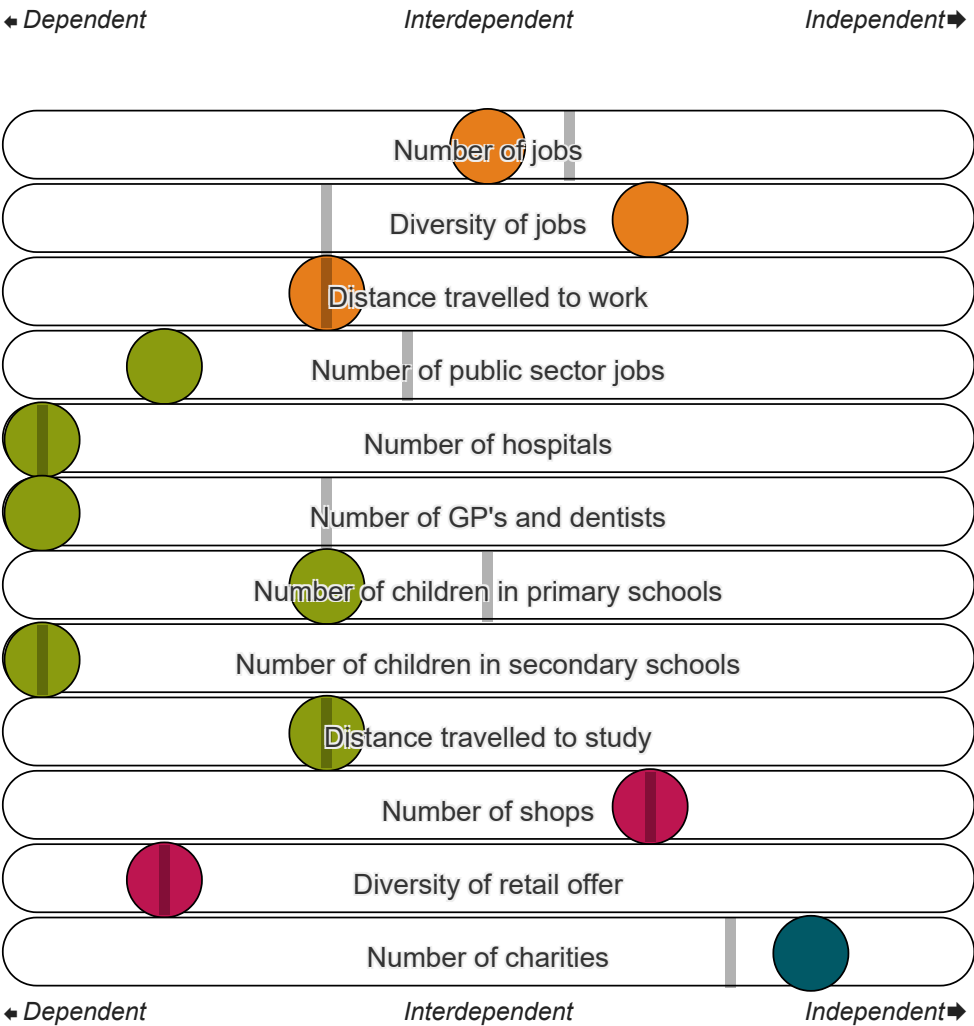
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

St Monans is an interdependent to dependent town.

St Monans is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, St Monans is grouped with 15 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. St Monans differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

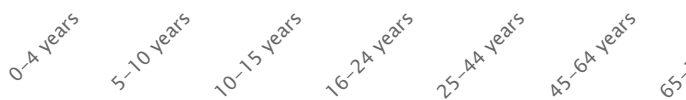

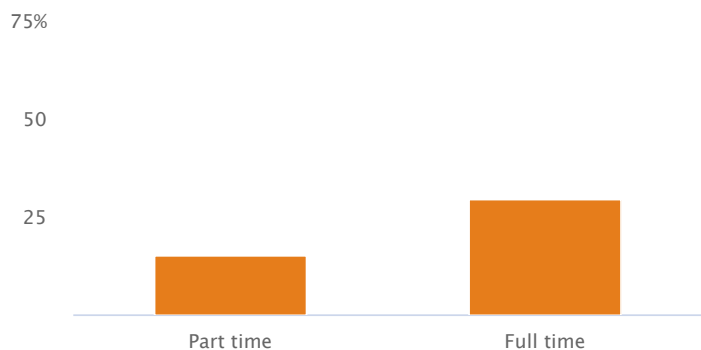

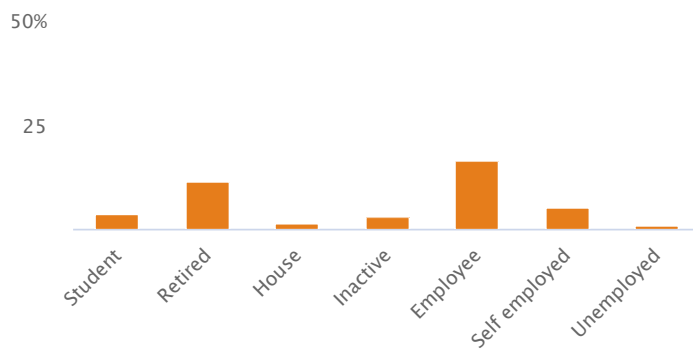
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



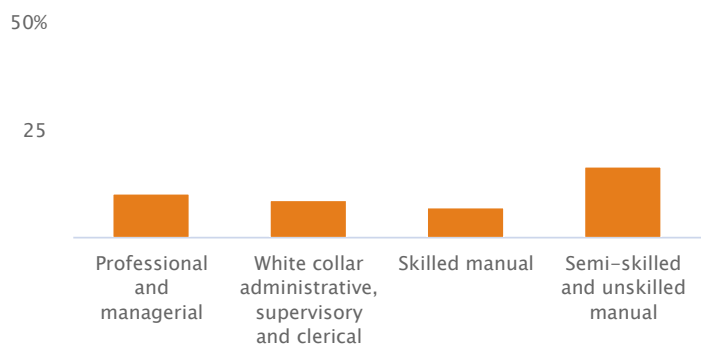
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

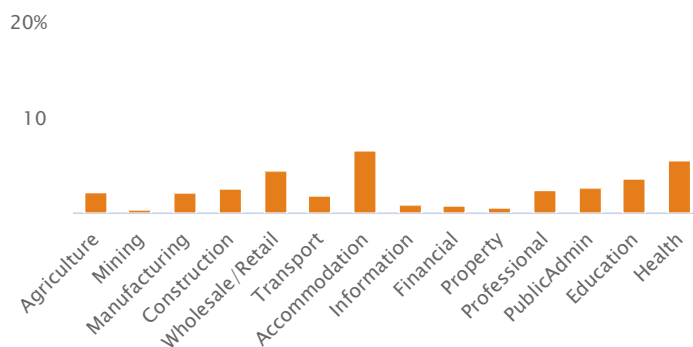


Social Grade

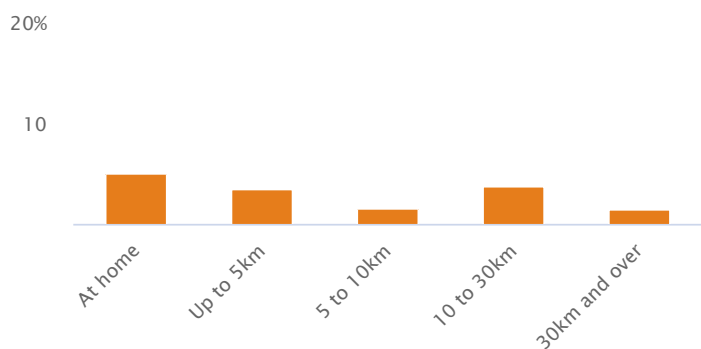
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

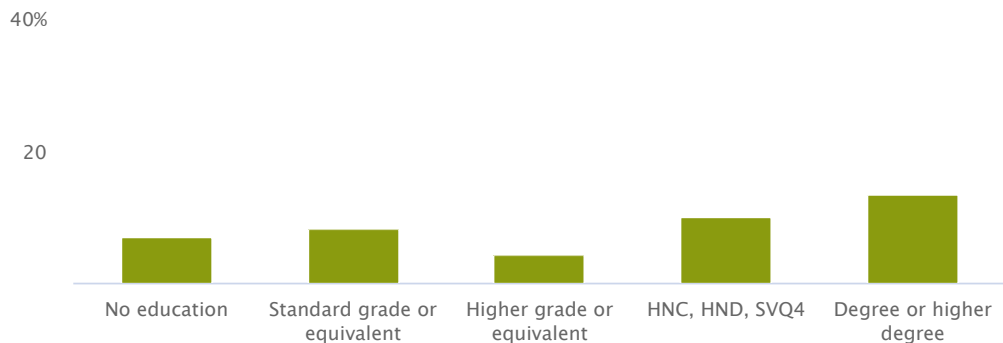


Distance travelled to work

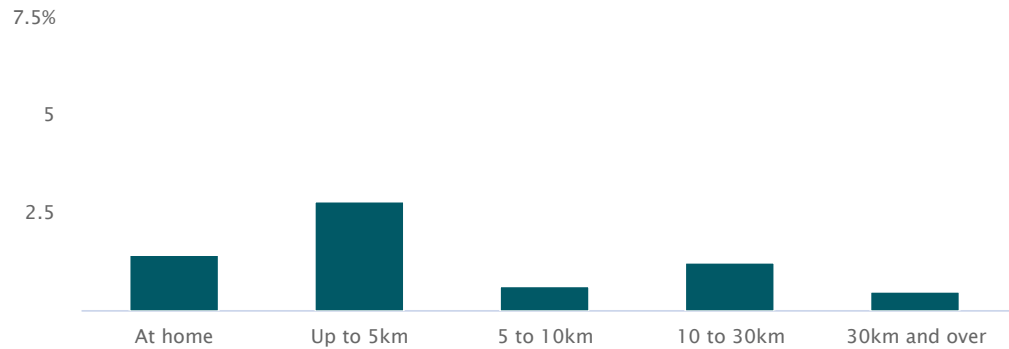
