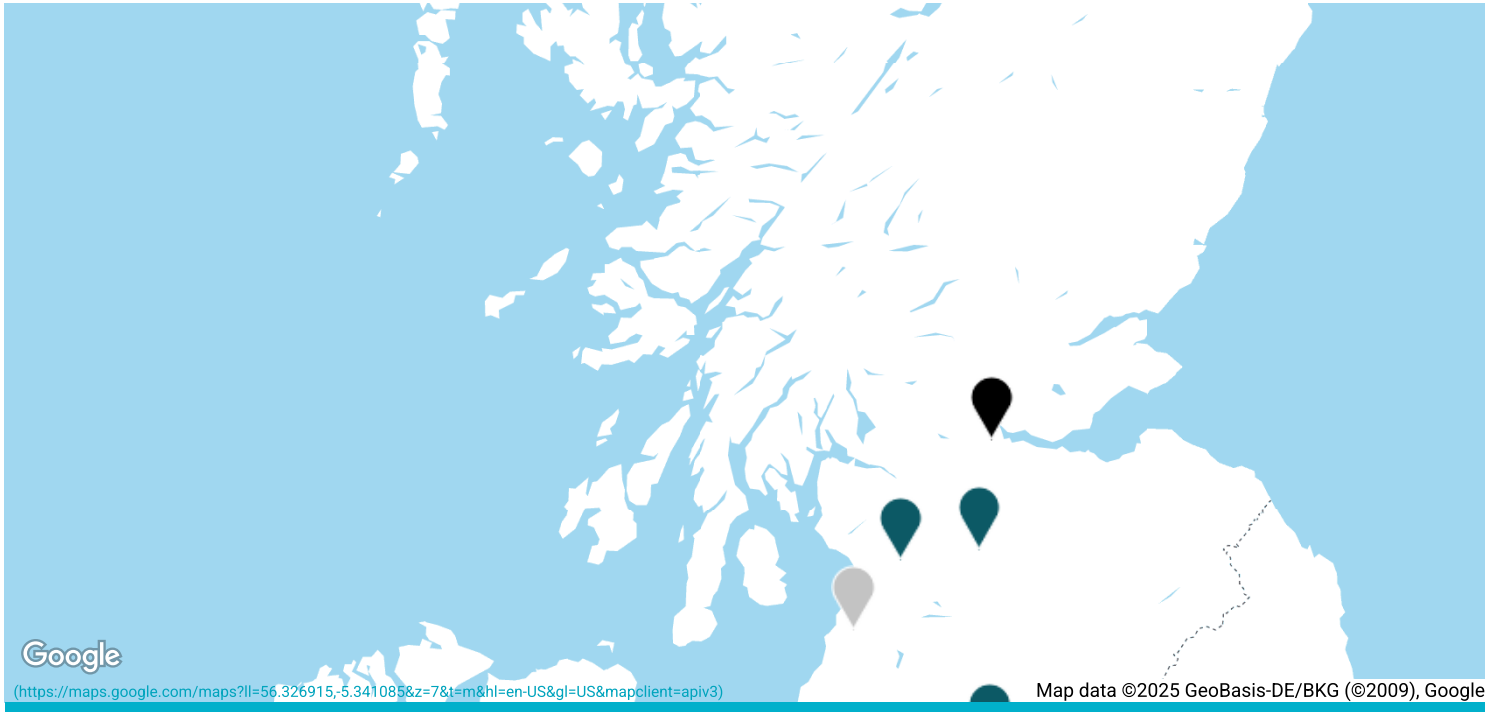




Stenhousemuir

Stenhousemuir is in Falkirk Council area. It has Roman origins. The town however developed in the 18th century when it became home to the 'Falkirk tryst'. McCowans toffee was established in 1992 and despite several changes of ownership remained in operation until 2012. The town is residential with employment in adjoining towns.

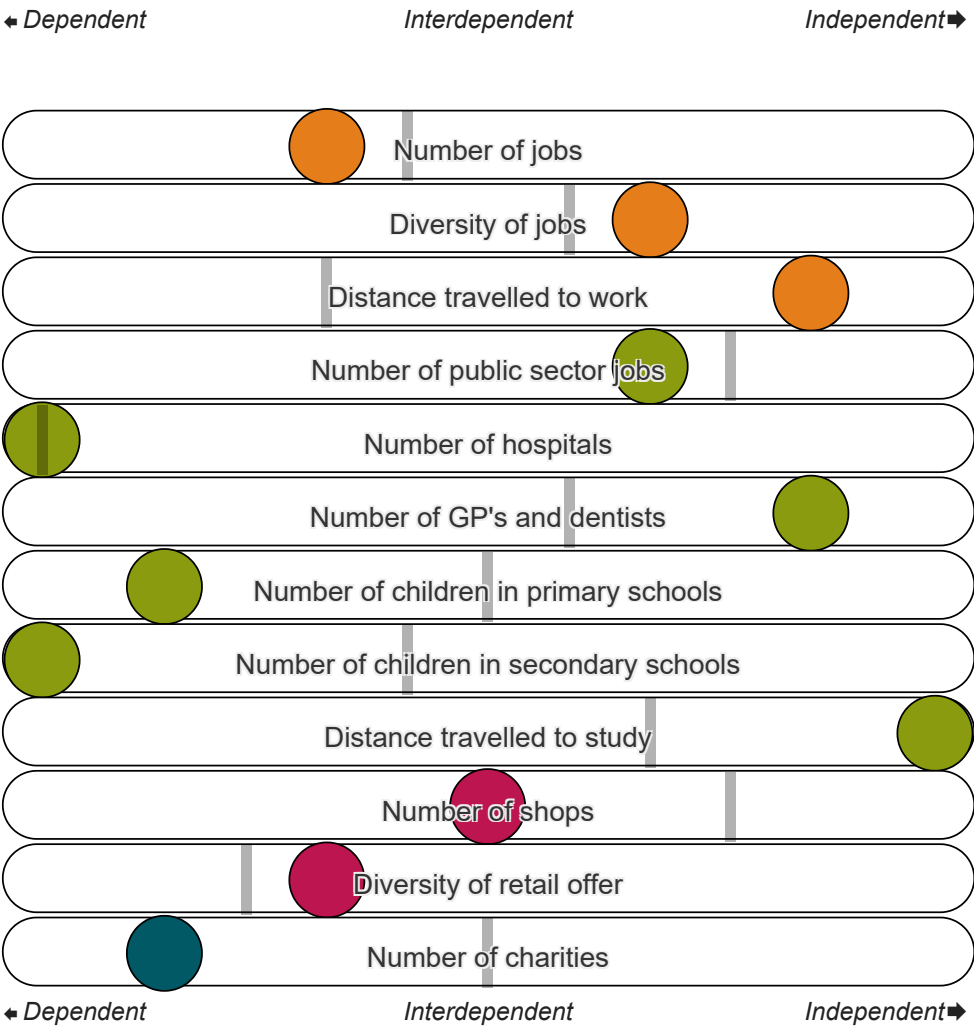
In this medium town, population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Stenhousemuir is an interdependent town.

Stenhousemuir is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Stenhousemuir is grouped with 5 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, jobs, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Stenhousemuir differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools.

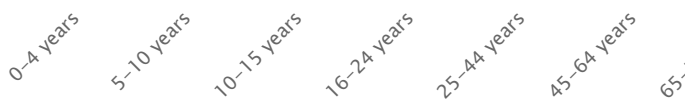

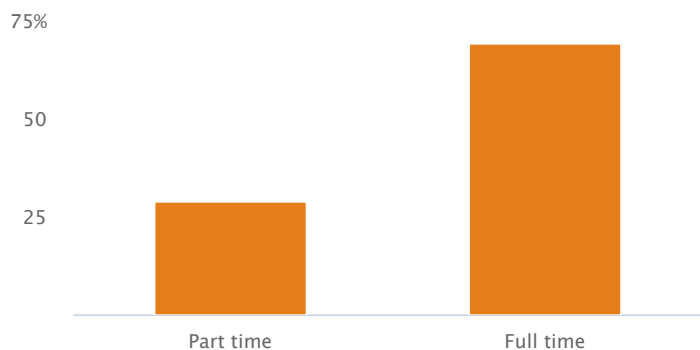

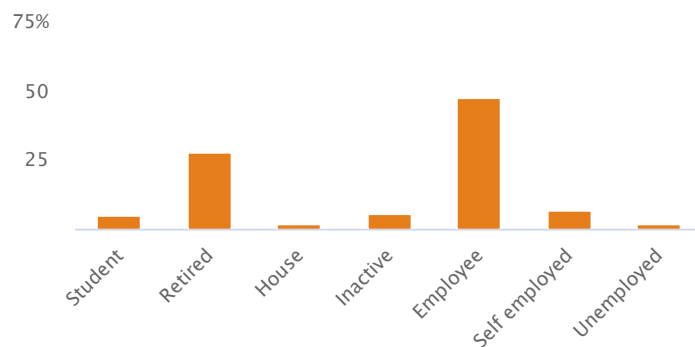
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



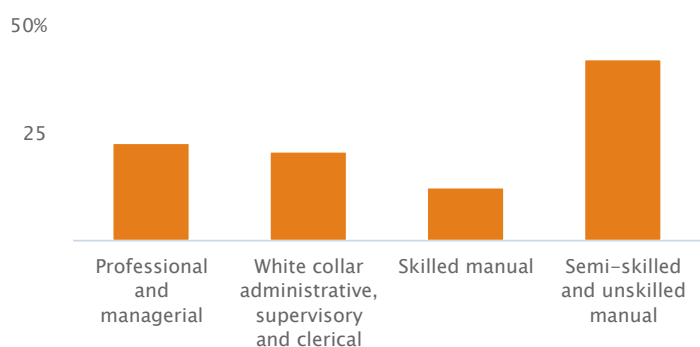
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

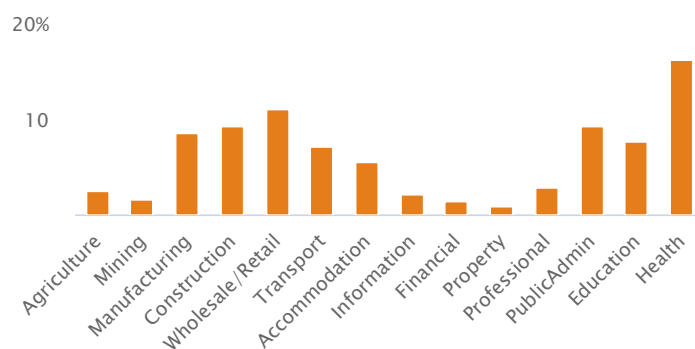


Social Grade

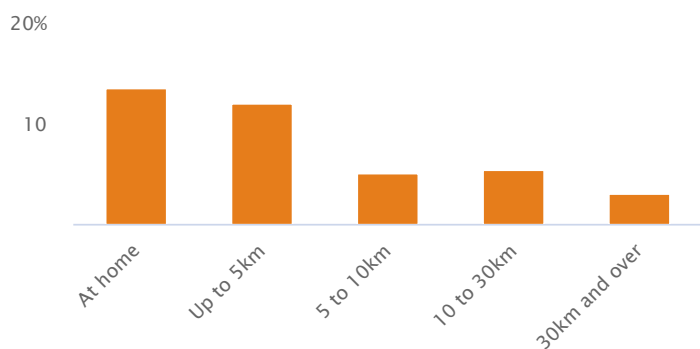
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

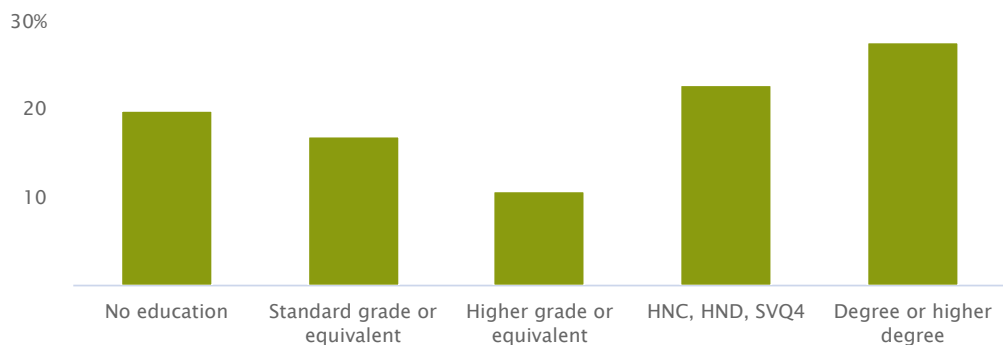


Distance travelled to work

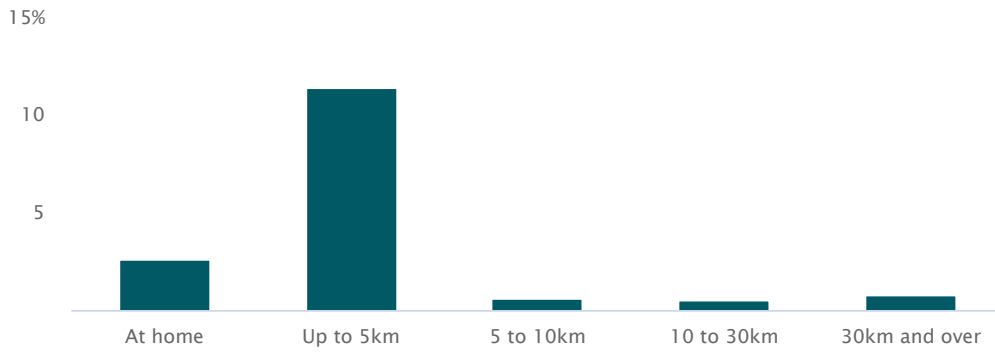
