



# <u>Stevenston</u>

#### **NORTH AYRSHIRE**

#### POPULATION 8,646

Stevenston is located in North Ayrshire. The site has been long settled. The town has an indutrial heritage. The Westfield Colliery supplied coal for the Glengarnock iron furnaces in Stevenston. ICI Ardeer was an explosives factory at Ardeer point. Production began in 1871 and ended in 2008, a year after a major explosion. The town has some manufacturing (including Visqueen polythene) and a business park.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Stevenston is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Buckhaven, Caol, and Linwood.













(% households aged 16-64)




#### **Distance travelled to work**


