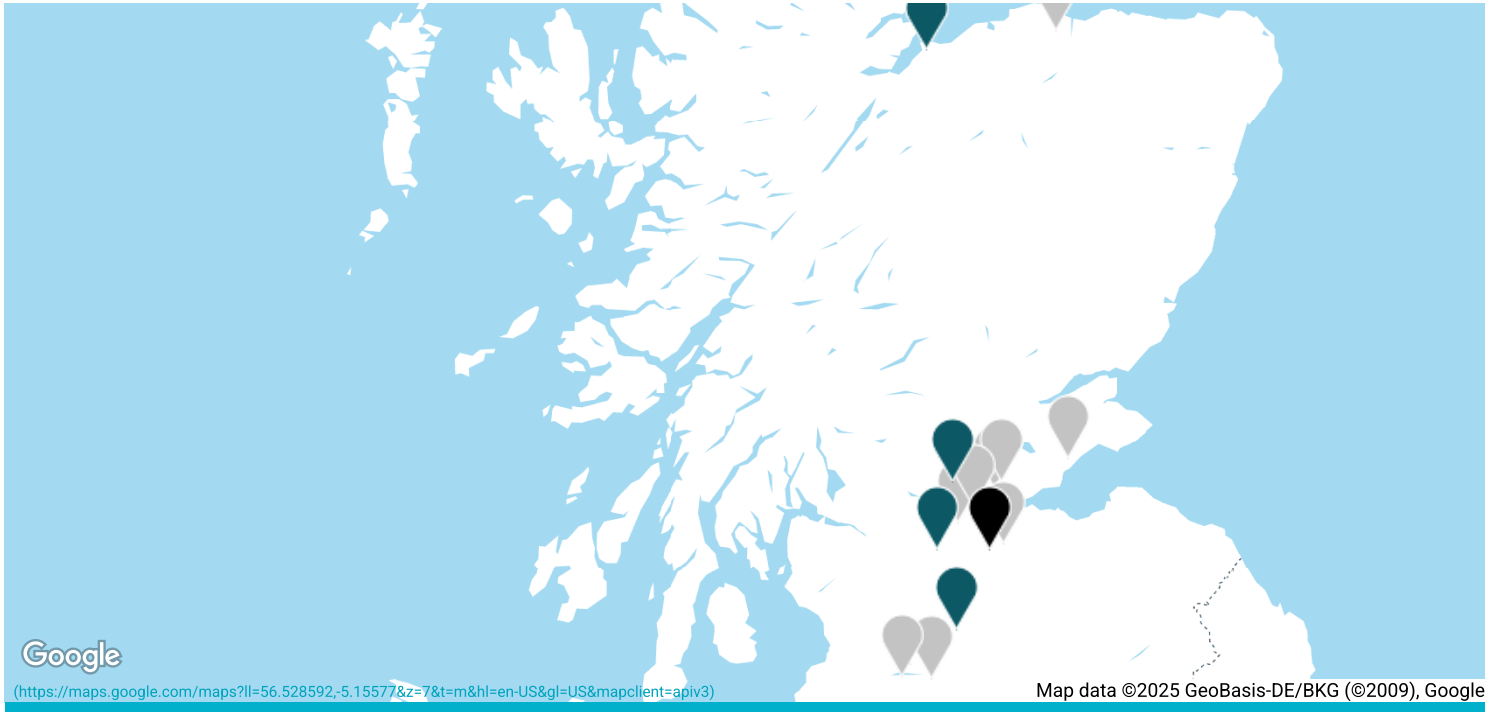




Stoneyburn

Stoneyburn in West Lothian is a former mining village for Foulshiels and Loganlea Collieries. Public housing was built for miners. It remains a residential town with limited service provision.

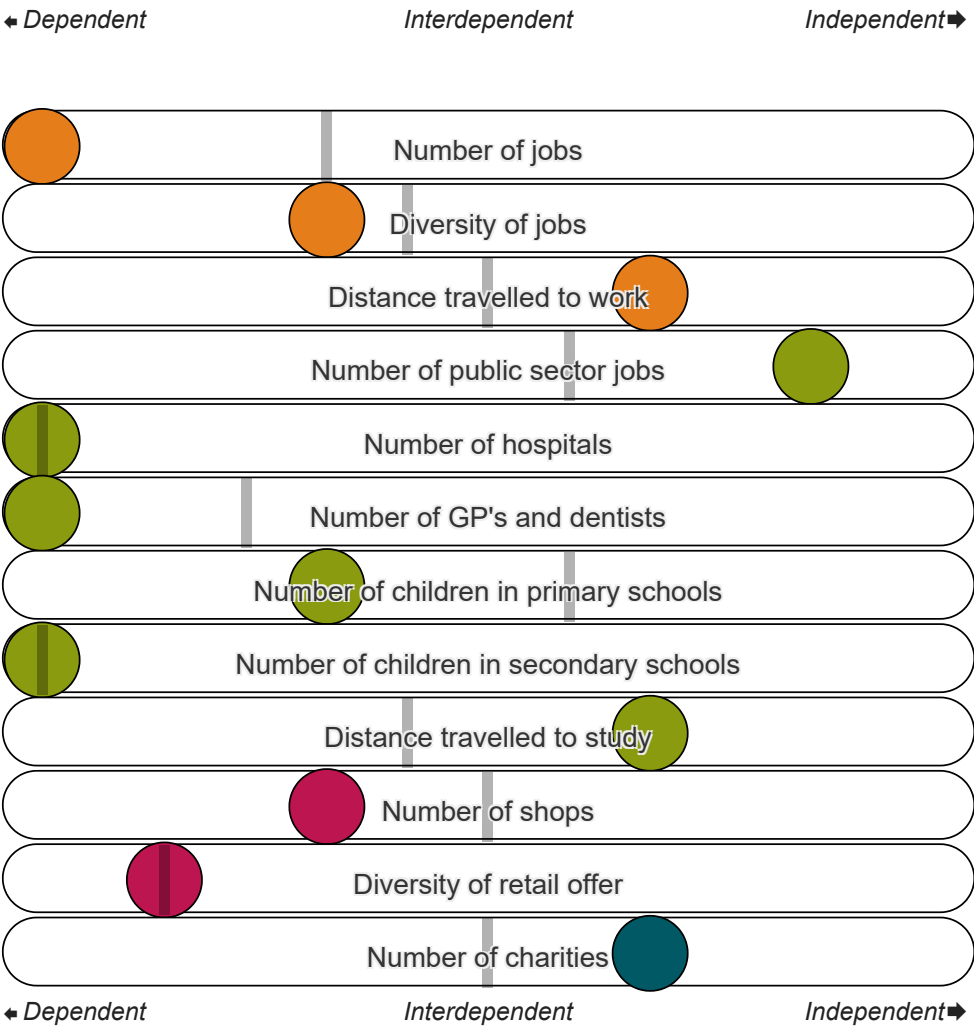
In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Stoneyburn is an interdependent to dependent town.

Inter-relationships



Stoneyburn is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Stoneyburn is grouped with 13 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. Stoneyburn differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

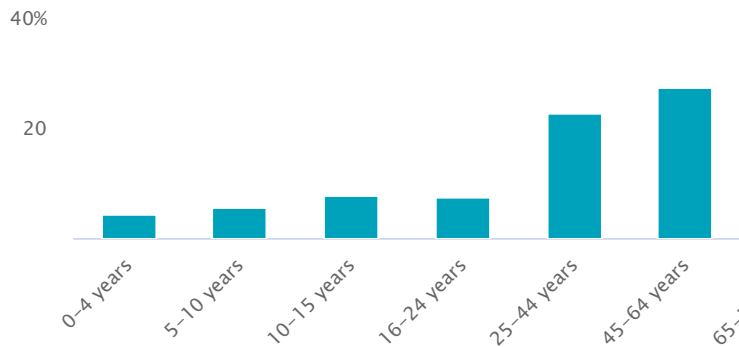

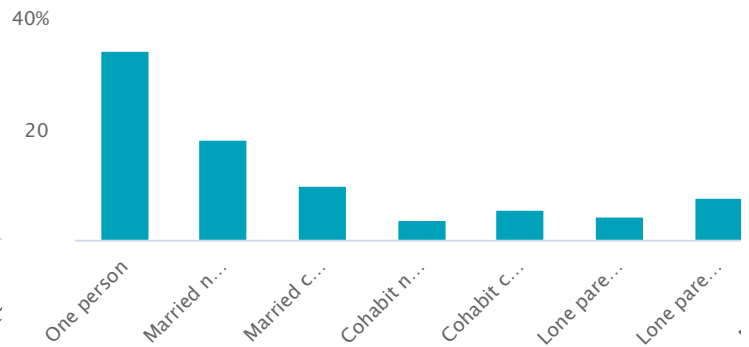

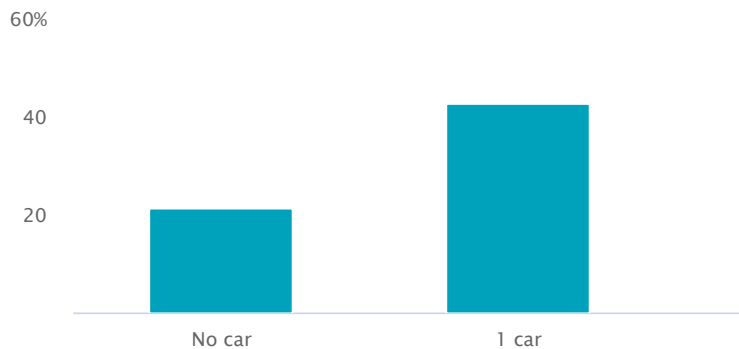

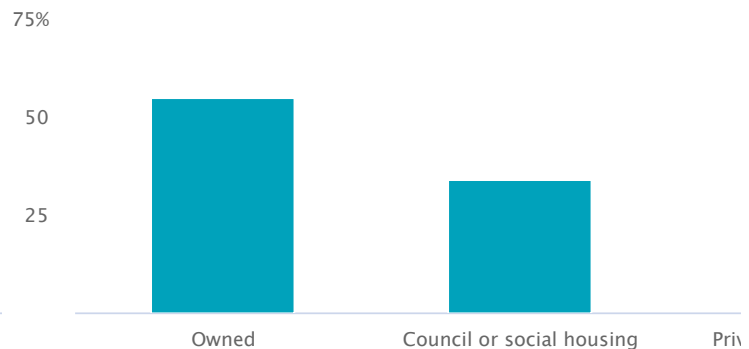

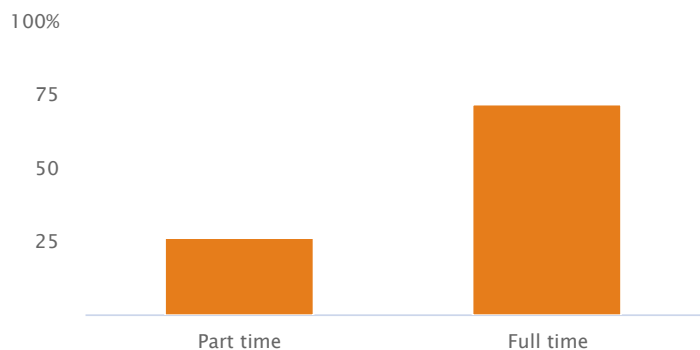

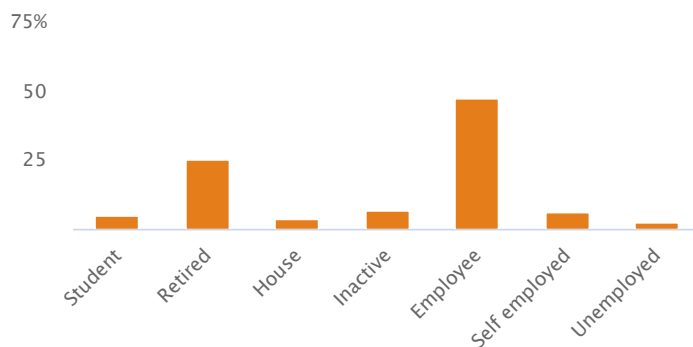
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



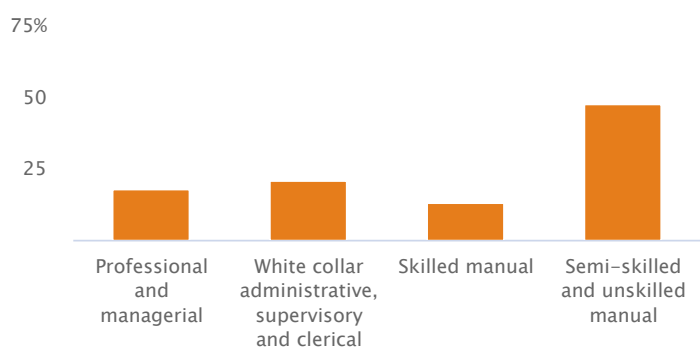
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

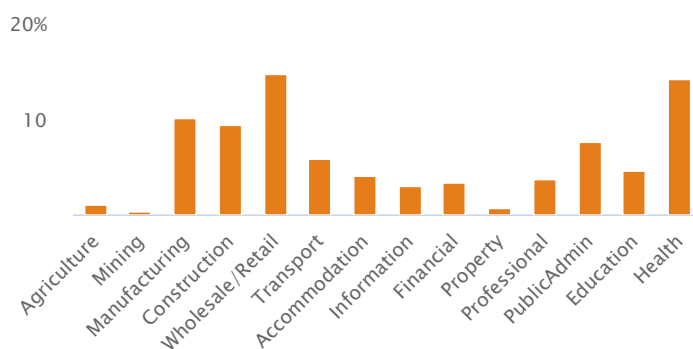


Social Grade

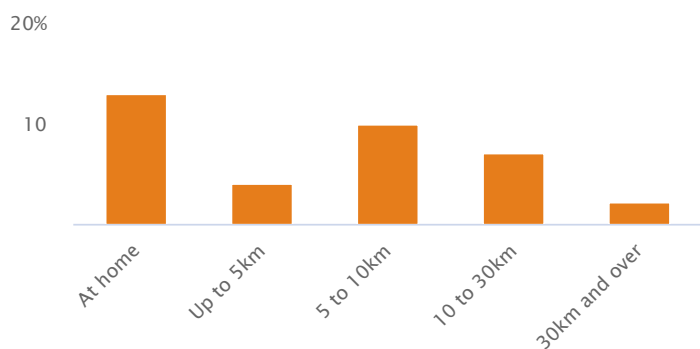
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

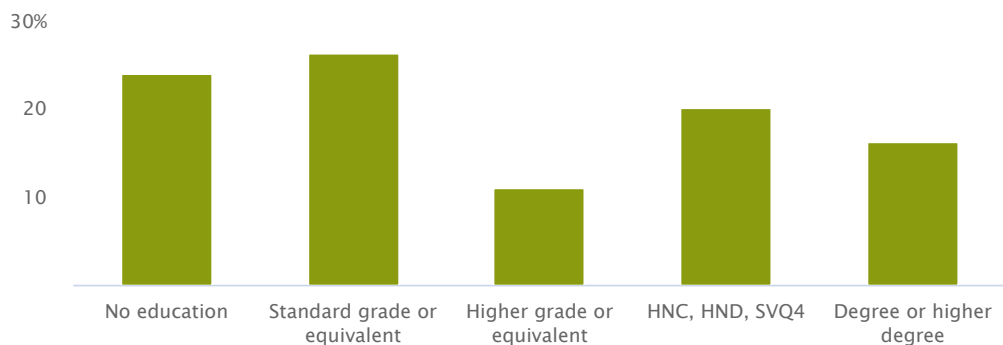


Distance travelled to work

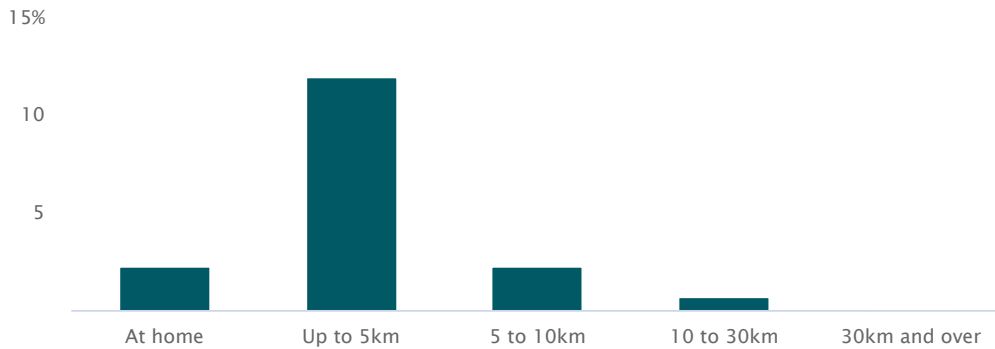
