Tarves is in Aberdeenshire. It has grown from an estate village to a suburban town


In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Its most similar towns are Aberlady, Balmullo, Bankfoot, and Cairneyhill.






## **Employment type**

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




## **Social Grade**

(% households aged 16-64)




#### Distance travelled to work




## **Occupation**

(% aged 16-74)






