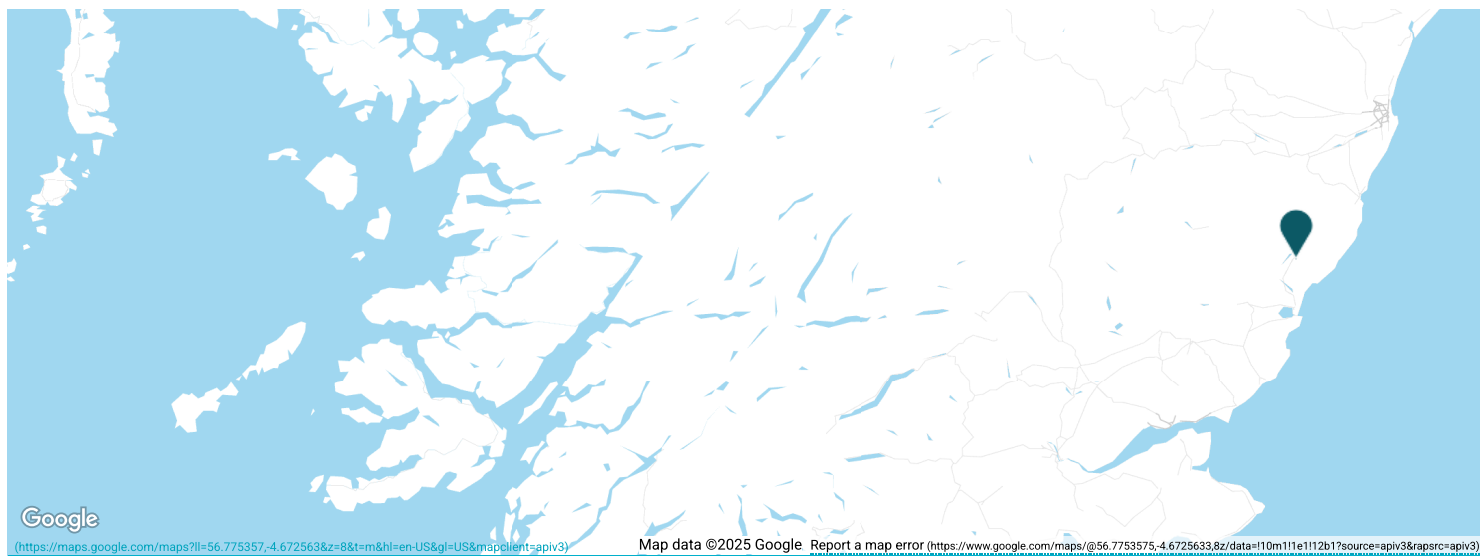




Thornliebank

Thornliebank is located in East Renfrewshire but is nowadays a suburb of Glasgow. In the 19th century the settlement was founded as a calico printing works, bleachfields and quarrying were developed. Spiersbridge industrial and business park has a range of manufacturers, suppliers, local services and office space.

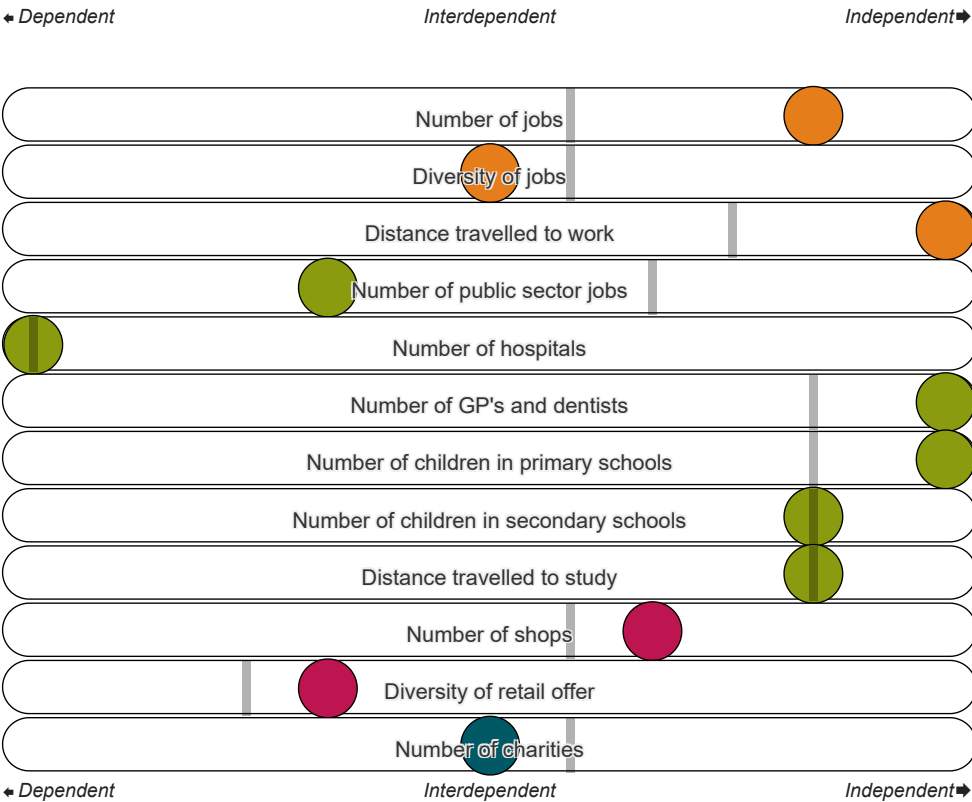
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Thornliebank is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Thornliebank is grouped with 4 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. Thornliebank differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs.

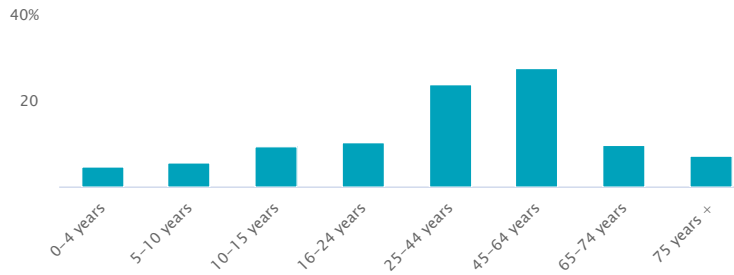

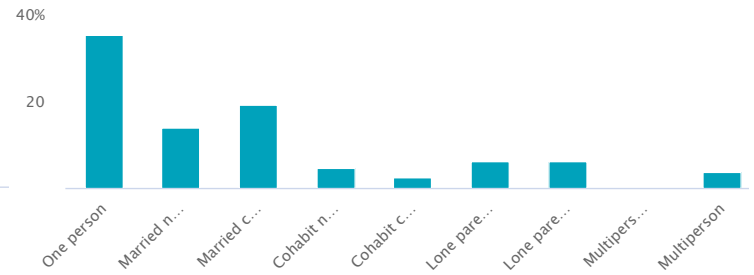

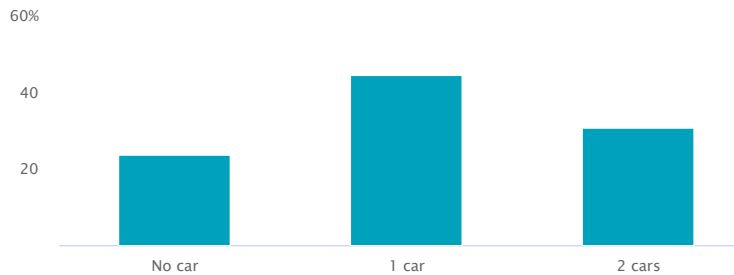

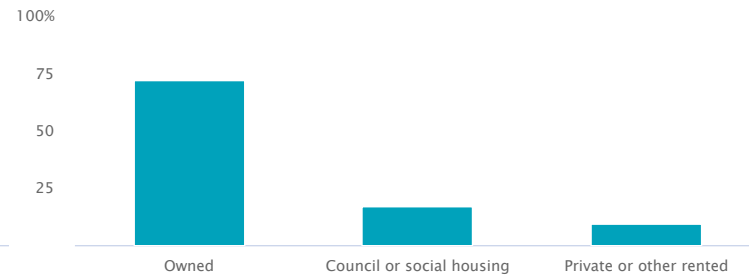
Household composition

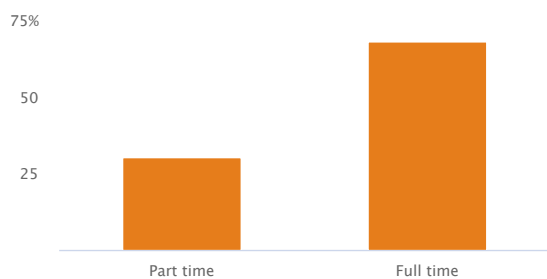

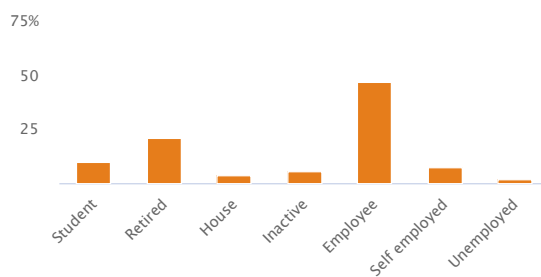
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



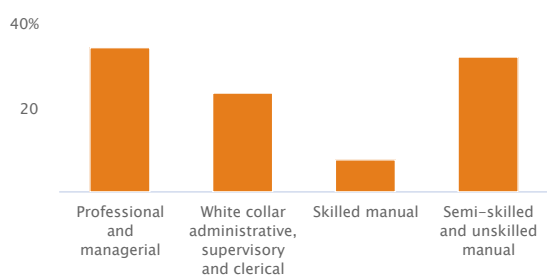
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

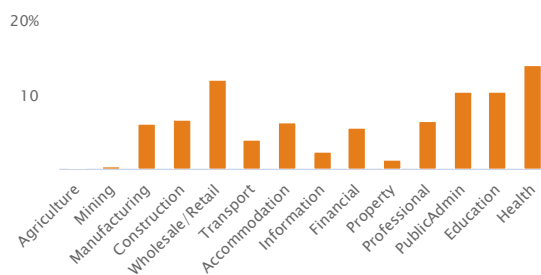


Social Grade

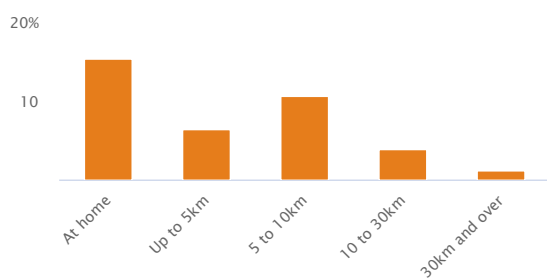
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

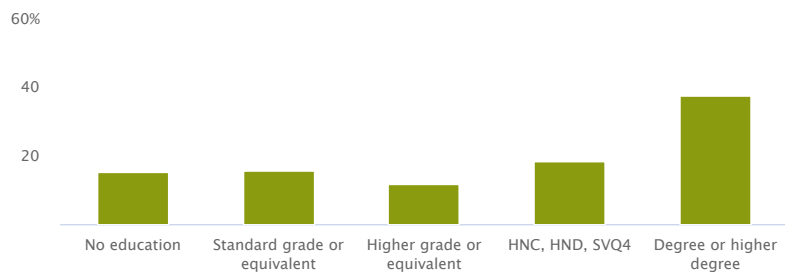


Distance travelled to work

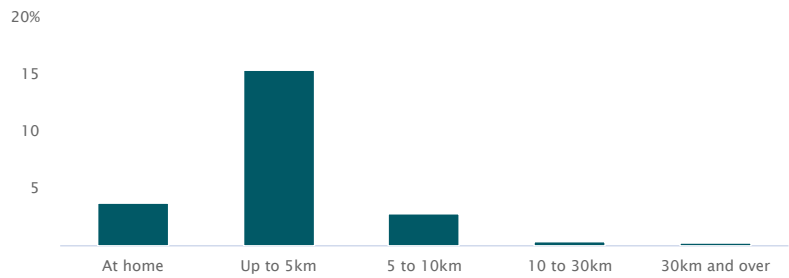
