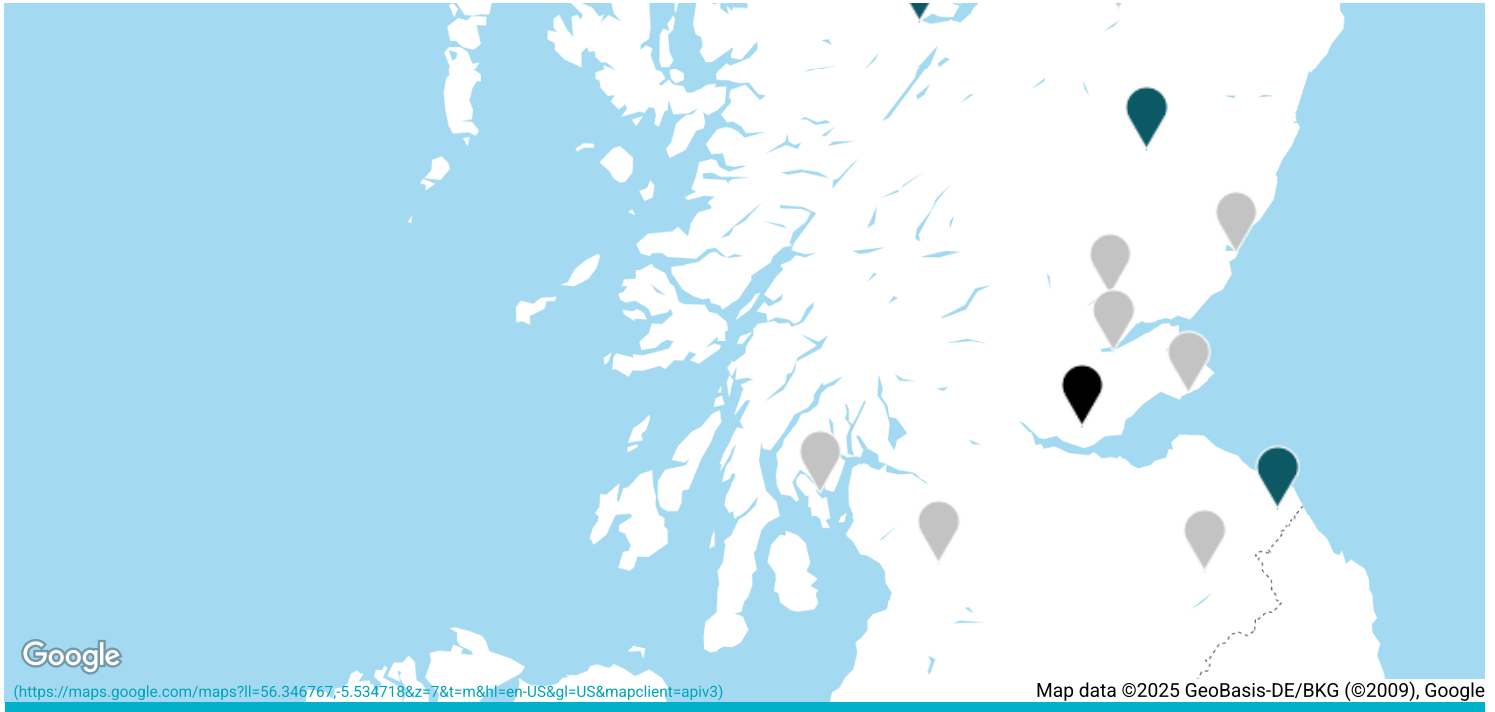




Townhill

Townhill, which is located in Fife, is a former mining town. It was the Dunfermline coal town. Mining ceased in 1970. The town also supplied other needs for Dunfermline - the site of the gallows and later drinking water for Dunfermline. It is a residential town and almost a suburb of Dunfermline.

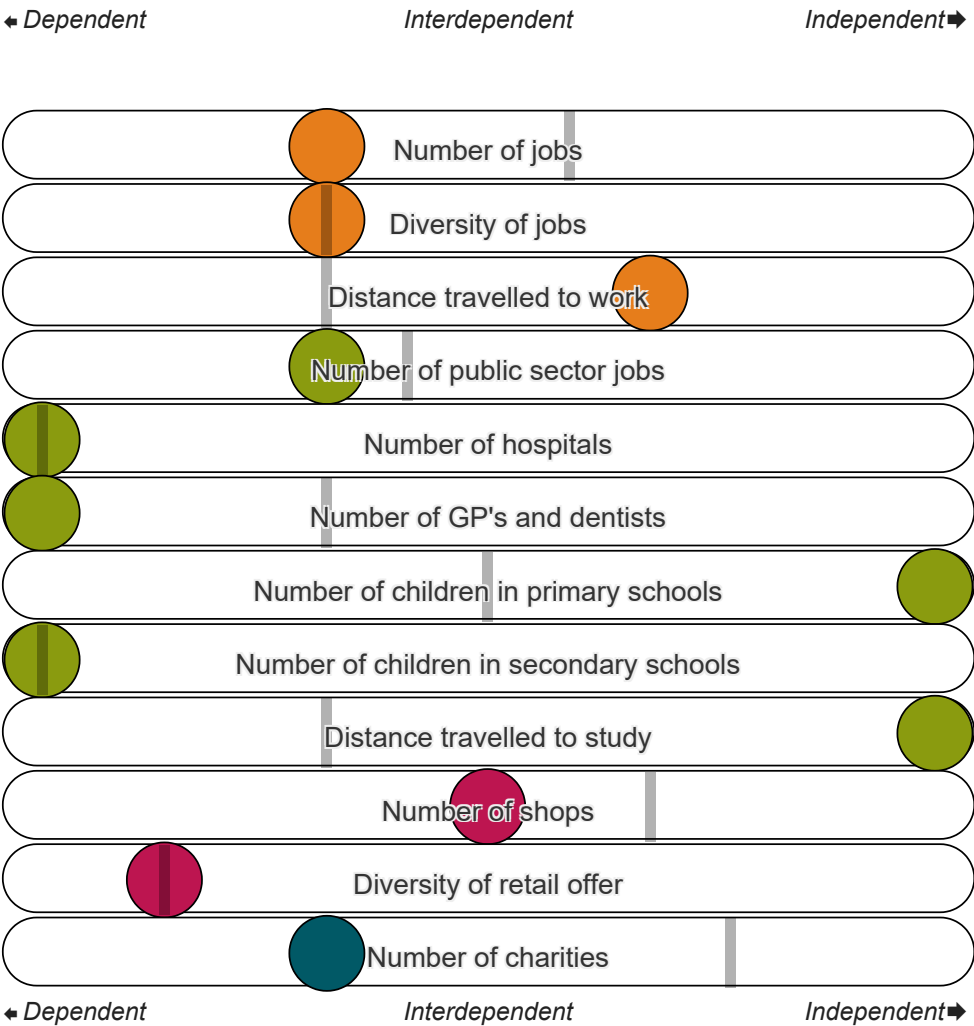
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Townhill is an interdependent to dependent town.

Townhill is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Townhill is grouped with 15 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and children in primary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Townhill differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

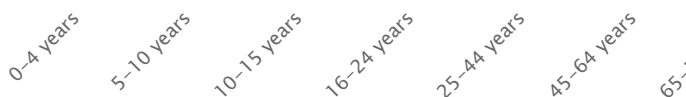

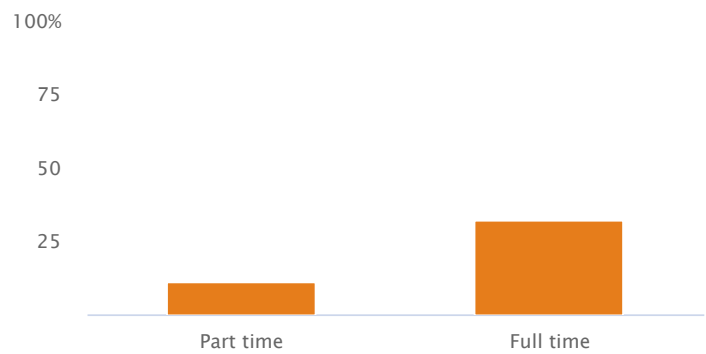

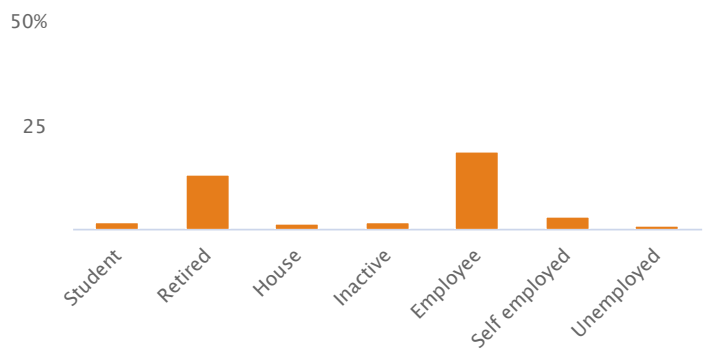
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



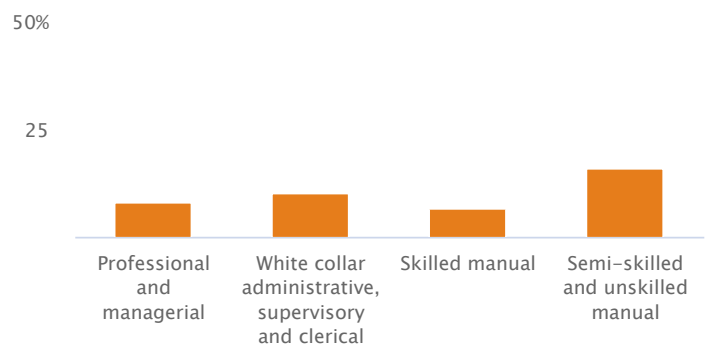
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

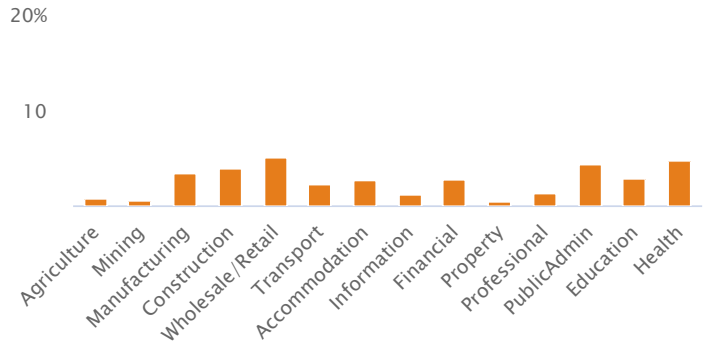


Social Grade

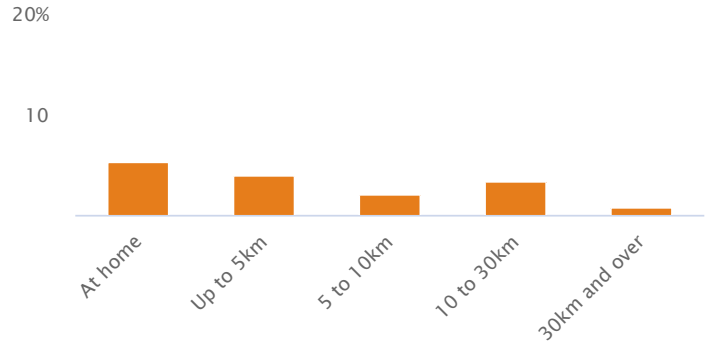
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

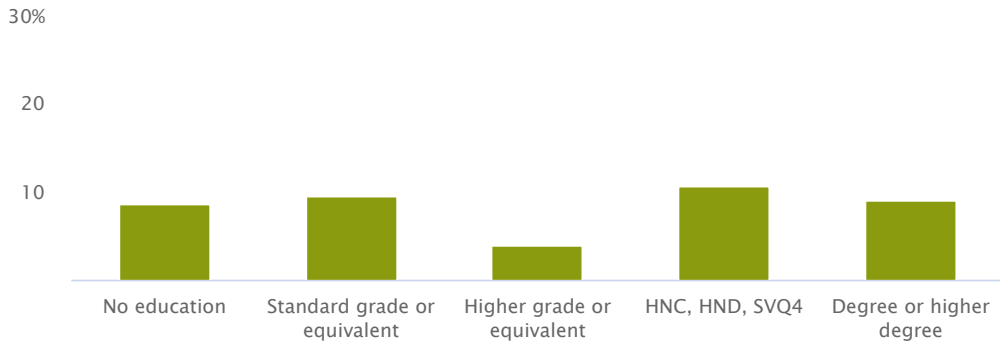


Distance travelled to work

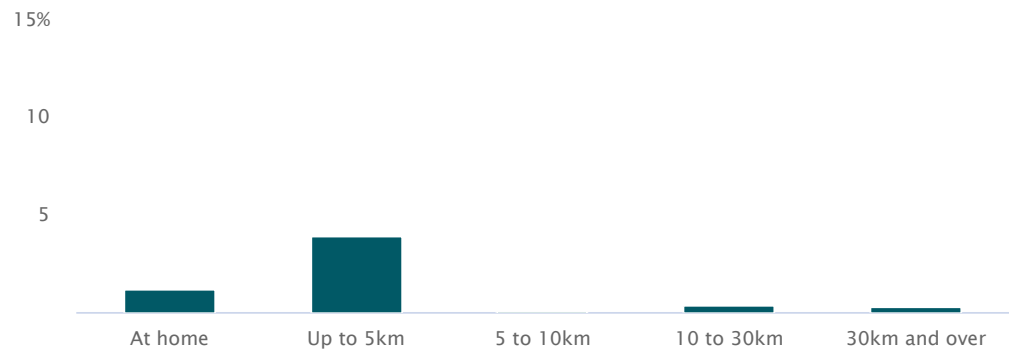
