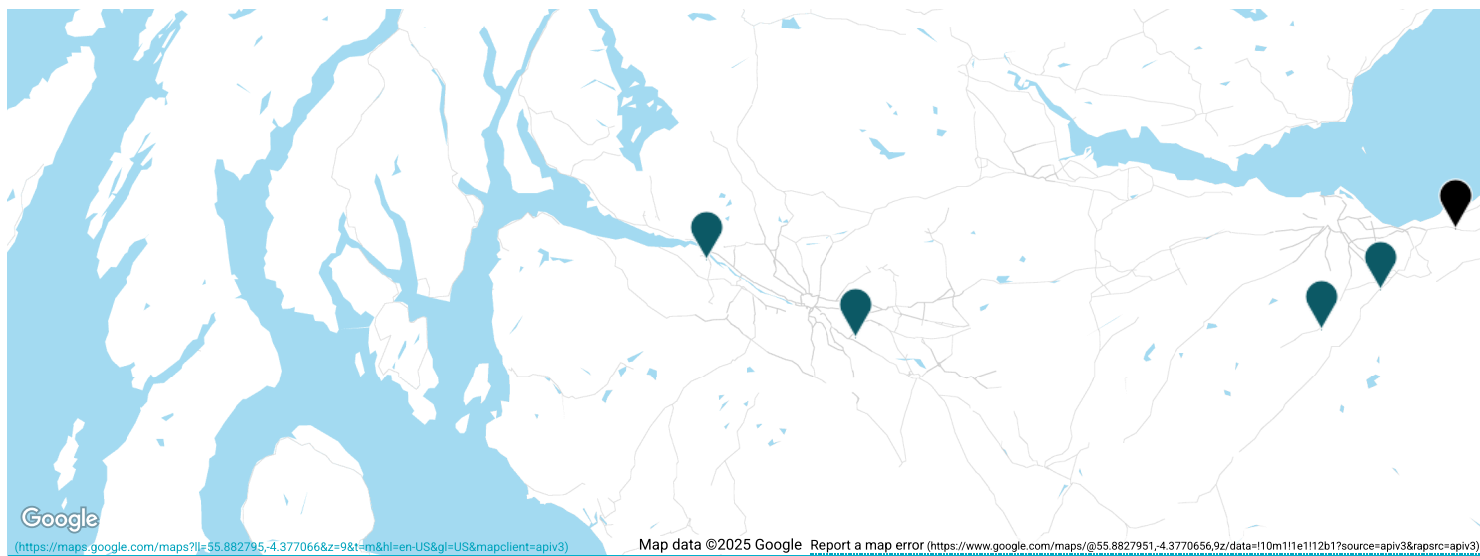




Tranent

Tranent in East Lothian is a town whose identity has been defined by mining. Coal was first discovered in the 13th century. Other industries such as tanning, brewing and distilling also emerged in the town. There is still a distillery. Housing was built as mining expanded. In the 20th century production slowed and the pits shut in 1961 and the opencast mine also closed. It remains a local service centre.

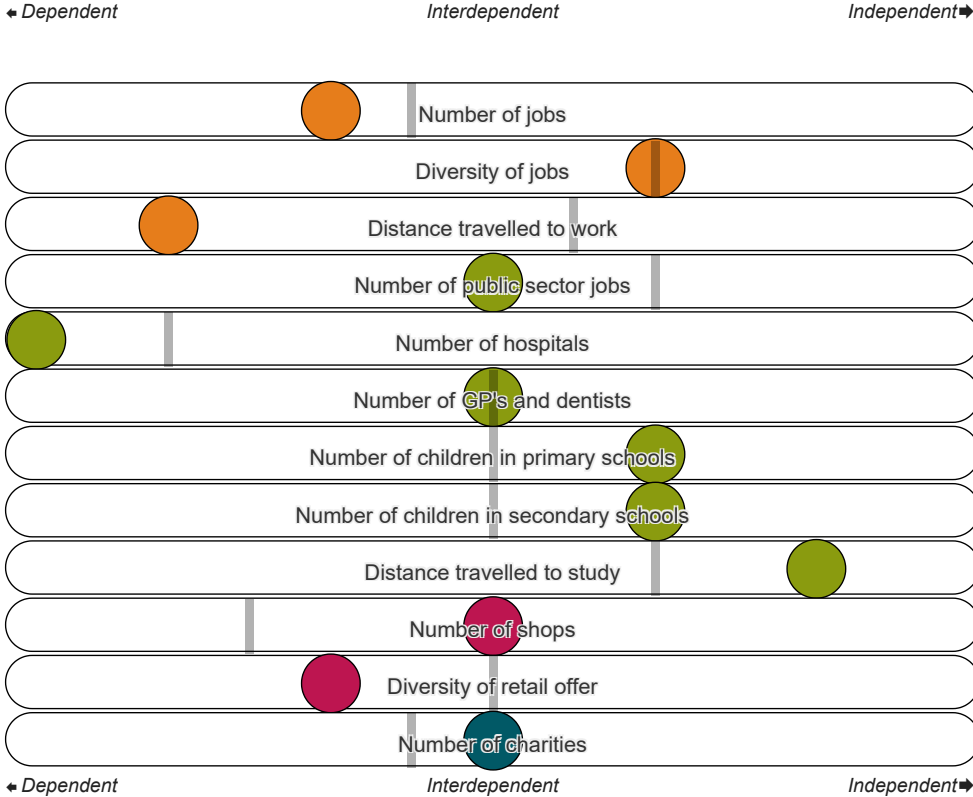
In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Tranent is an interdependent town.

Tranent is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Tranent is grouped with 4 other towns. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

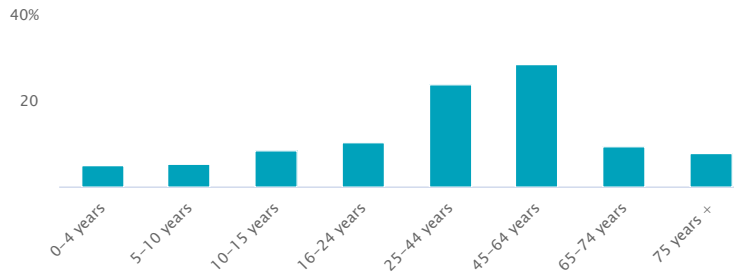

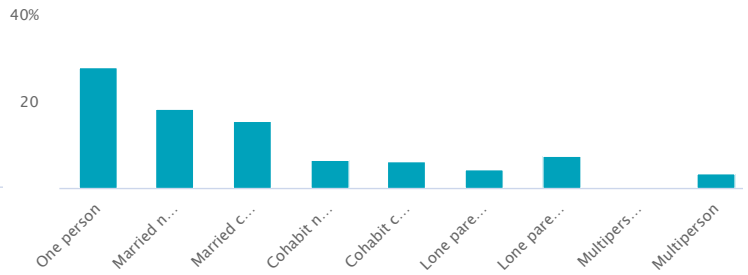

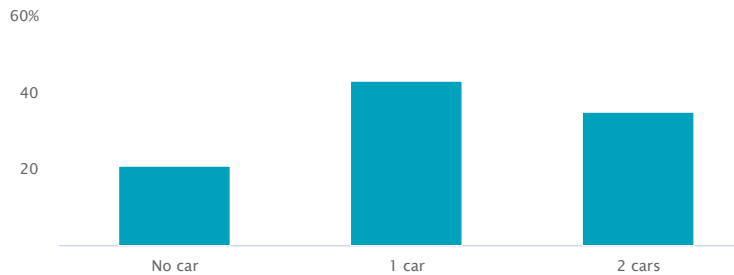

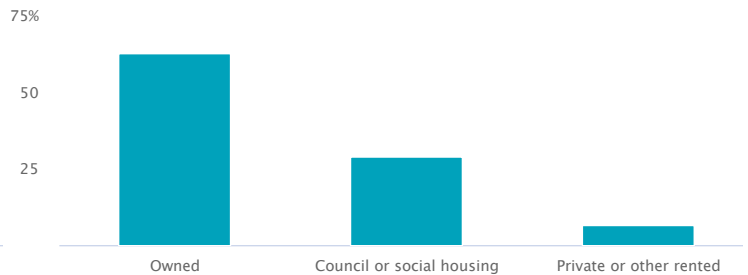
Household composition

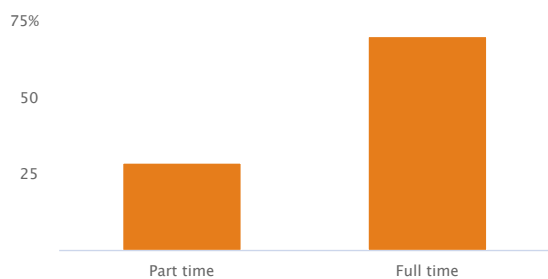

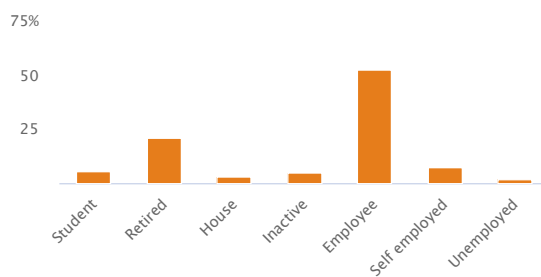
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



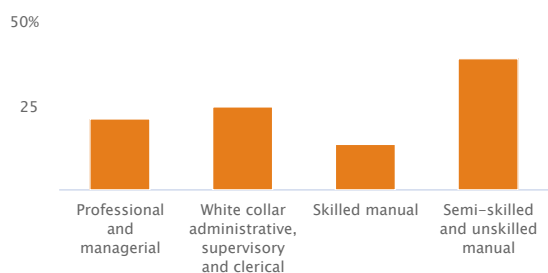
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

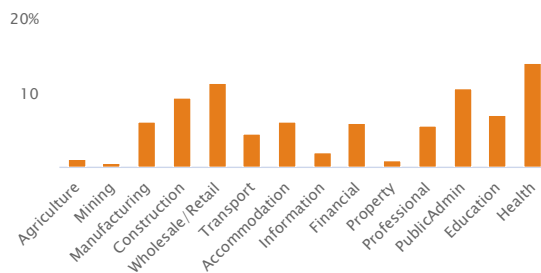

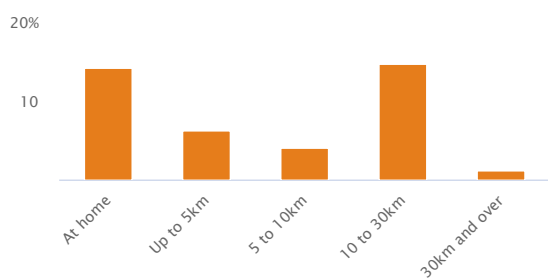
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

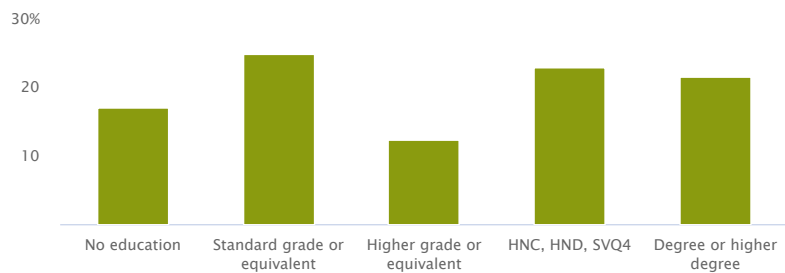


Distance travelled to work

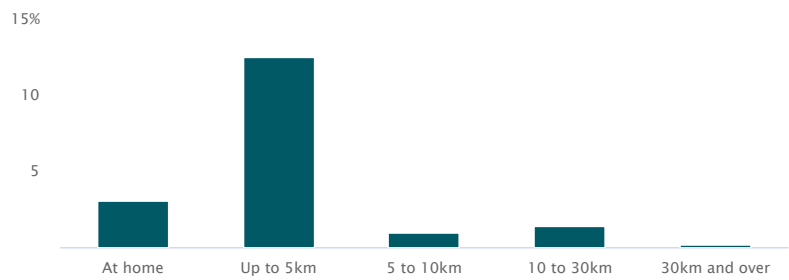
