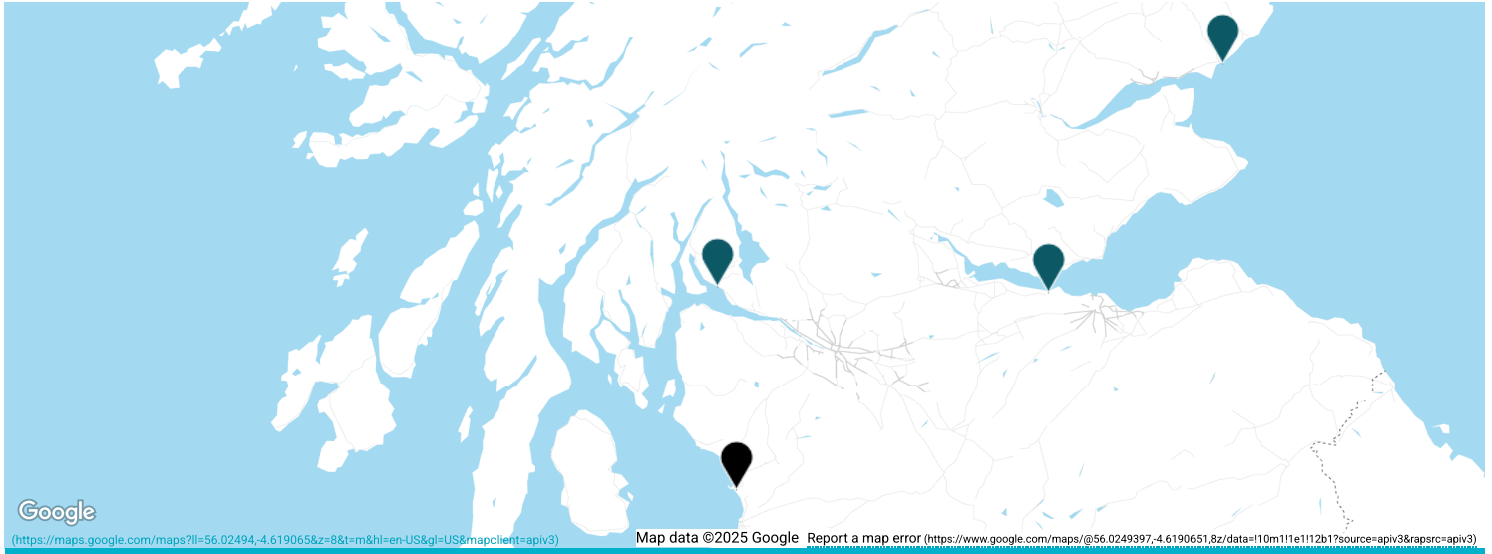




Troon

Troon is in South Ayrshire. Although a port which used to export coal and had some ferry traffic the town has been primarily a tourist town with golf facilities and a beach. It is a popular residential town. It has local services and amenities.

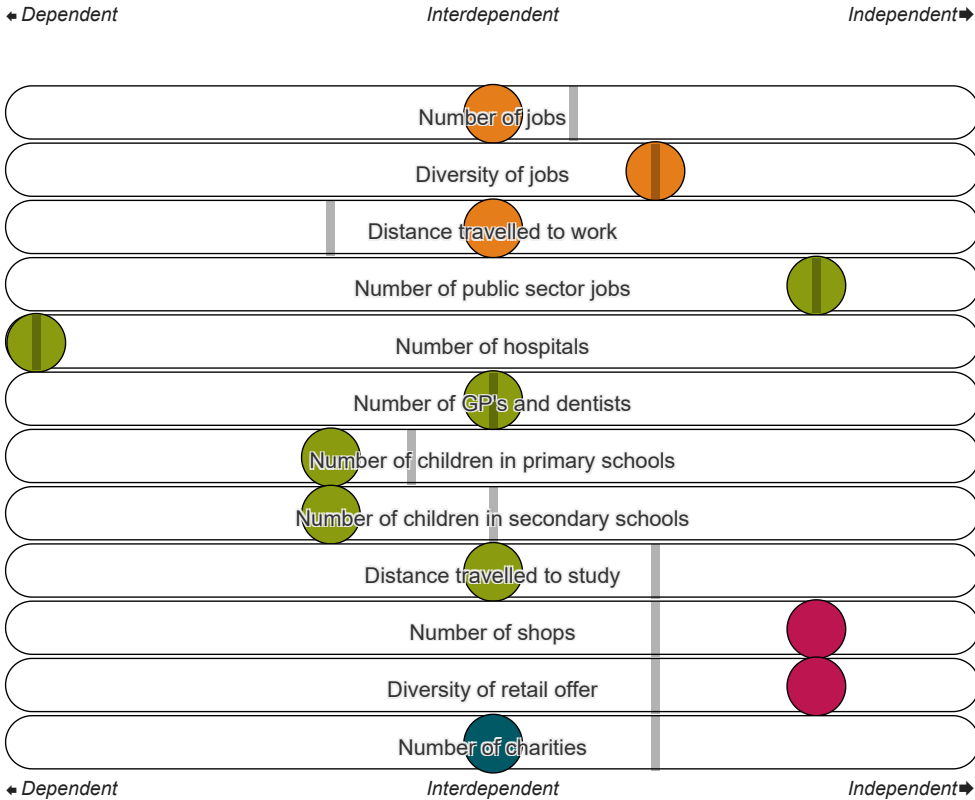
In large towns such as this one, the population typically is older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Troon is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Troon is grouped with 3 other towns. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

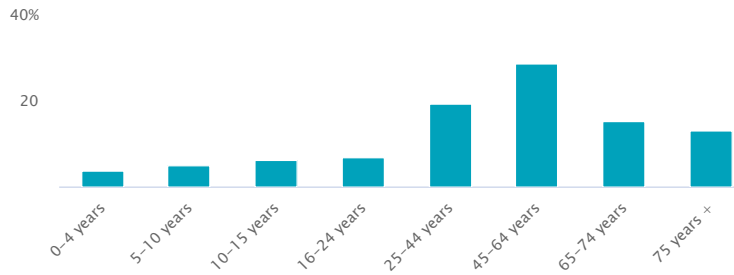

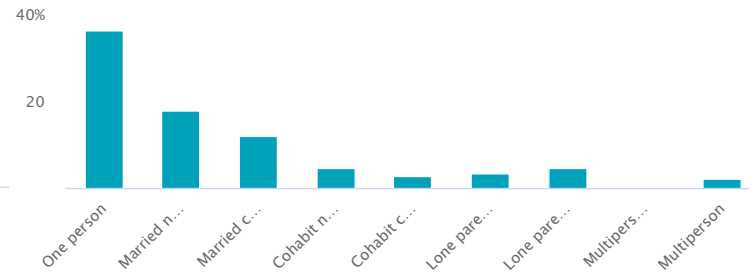

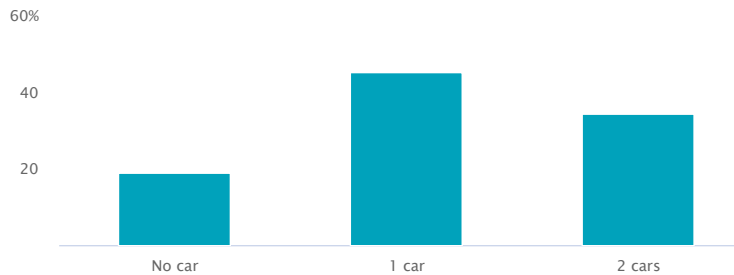

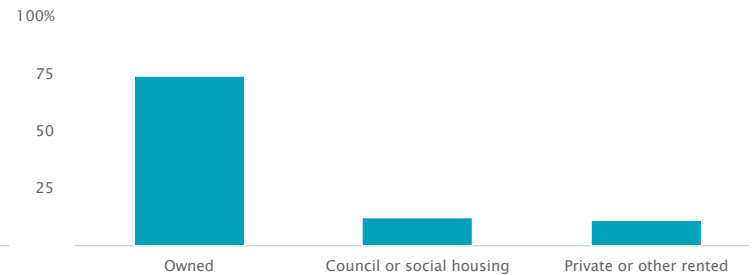

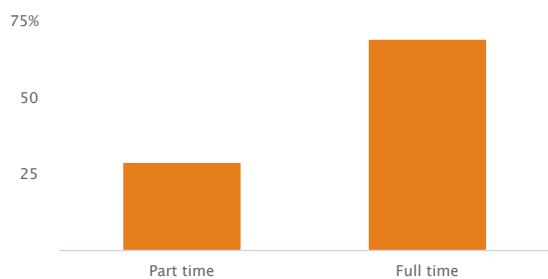

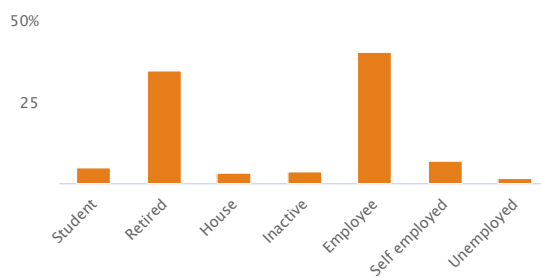
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



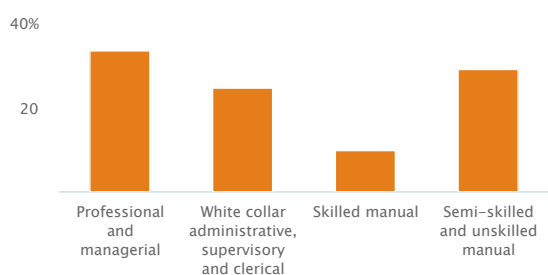
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

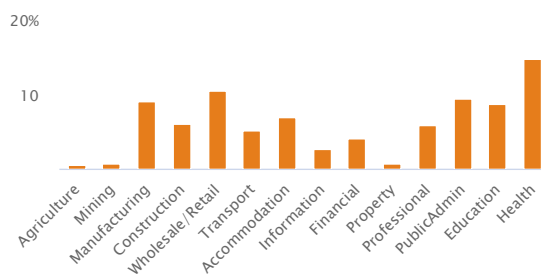

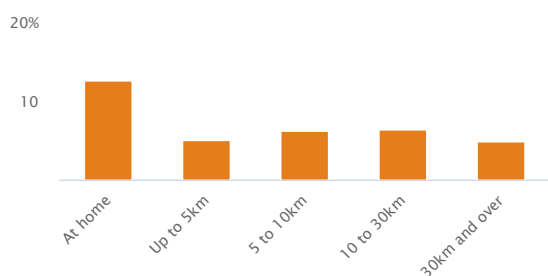
(% households aged 16-64)



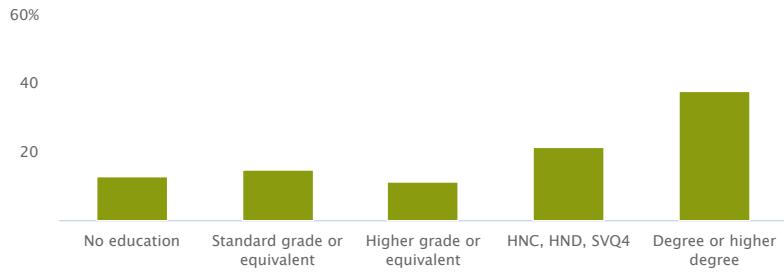
Sector Diversity

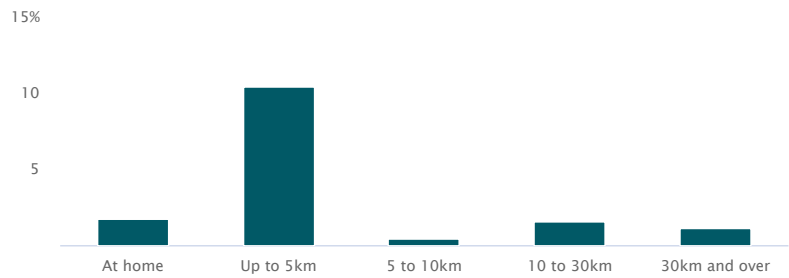
