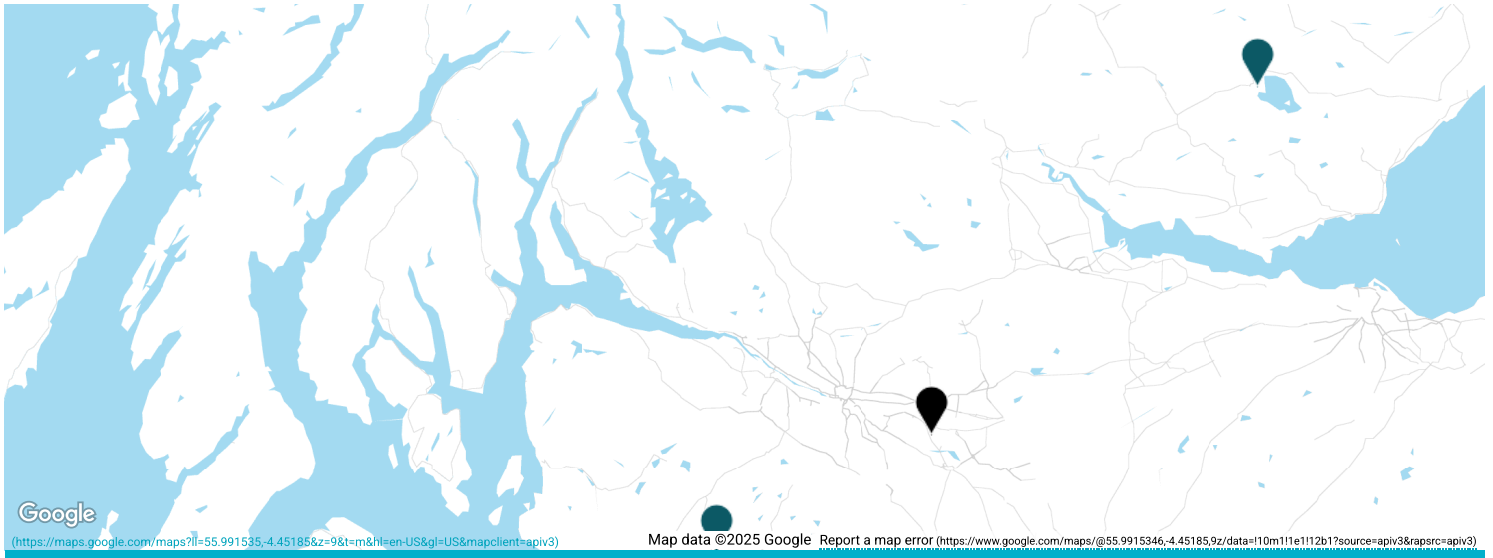




Uddingston

SOUTH LANARKSHIRE

POPULATION **6,180**

Uddingston is in South Lanarkshire. A mining town the pits closed in the 1930s. Since then other industries have been established. These reflect the location of the town on the main route north to Glasgow which was also historically important to the town. Logistics companies, removal companies and transport companies operate from Uddingston. There is also a range of other food industries including Tunnocks and some engineering manufacturers.

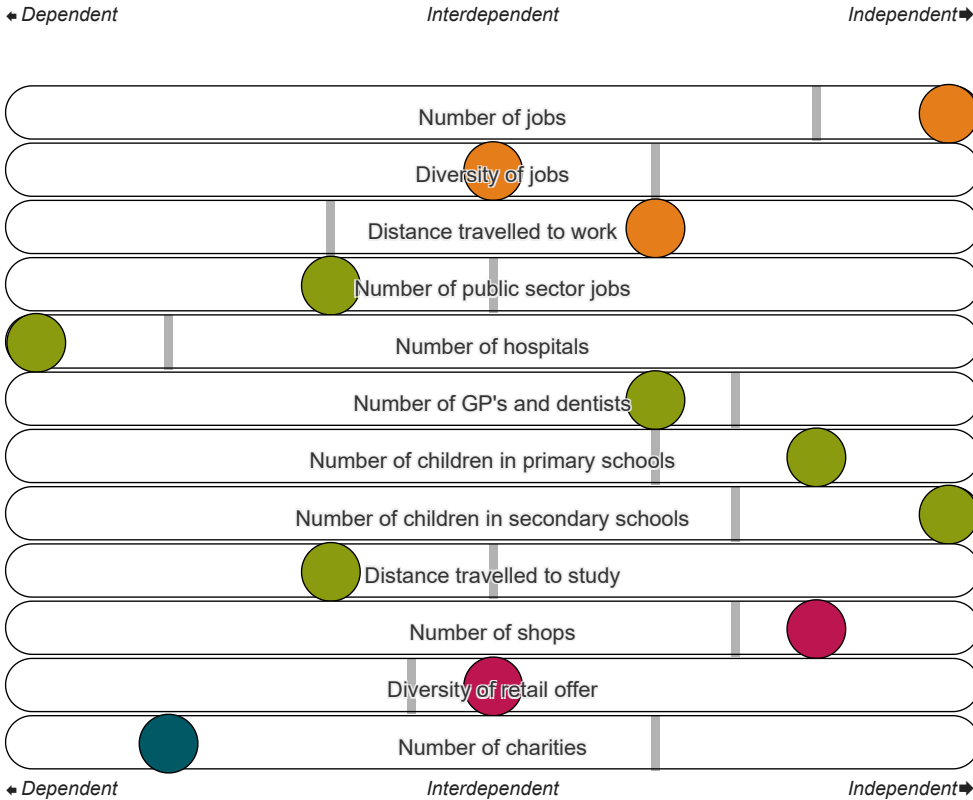
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Uddingston is an interdependent to independent town.

Inter-relationships



Uddingston is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Uddingston is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in secondary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Uddington differs most from its group in the number of charities.

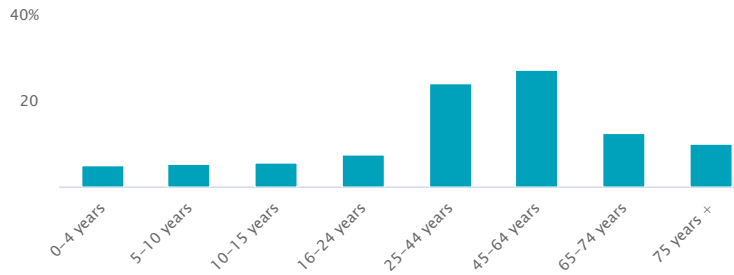

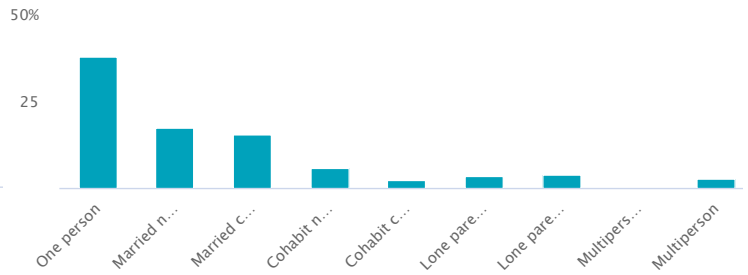

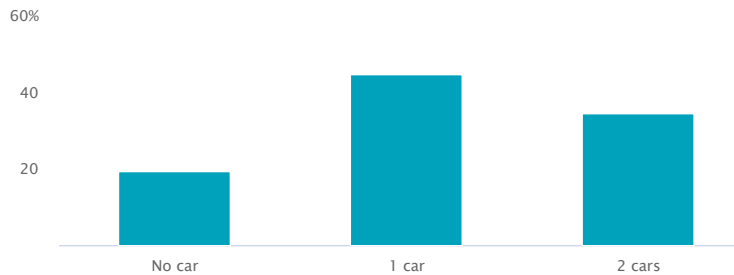

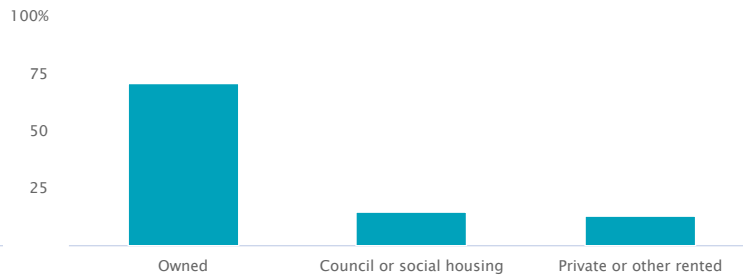
Household composition

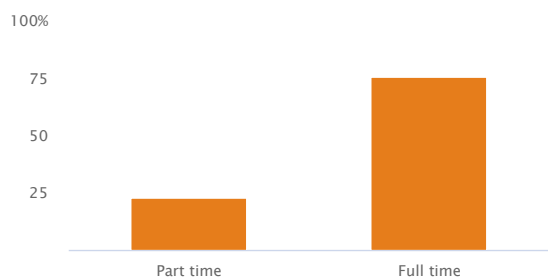

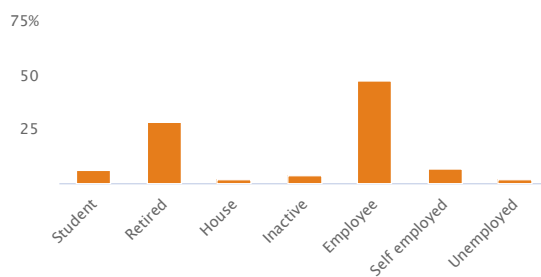
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



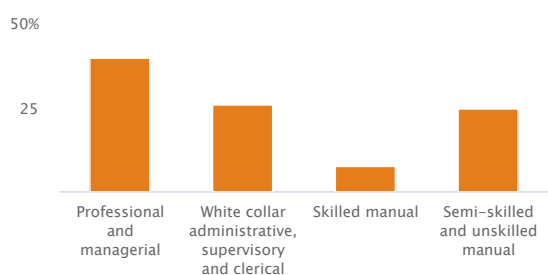
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

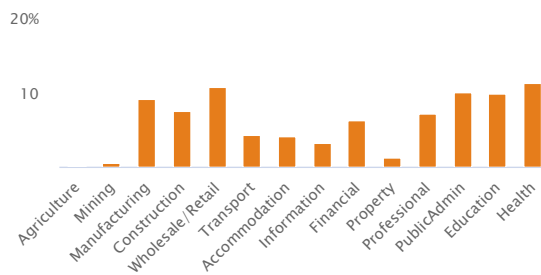


Social Grade

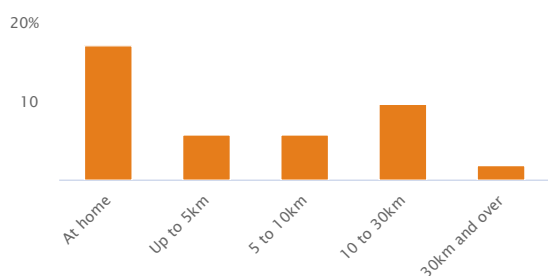
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

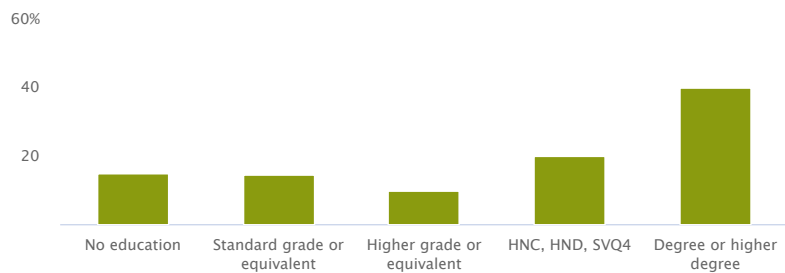


Distance travelled to work

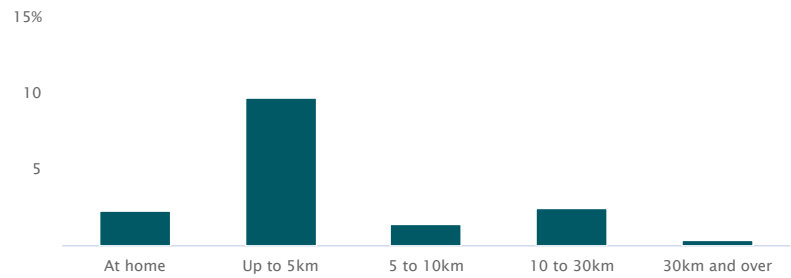
