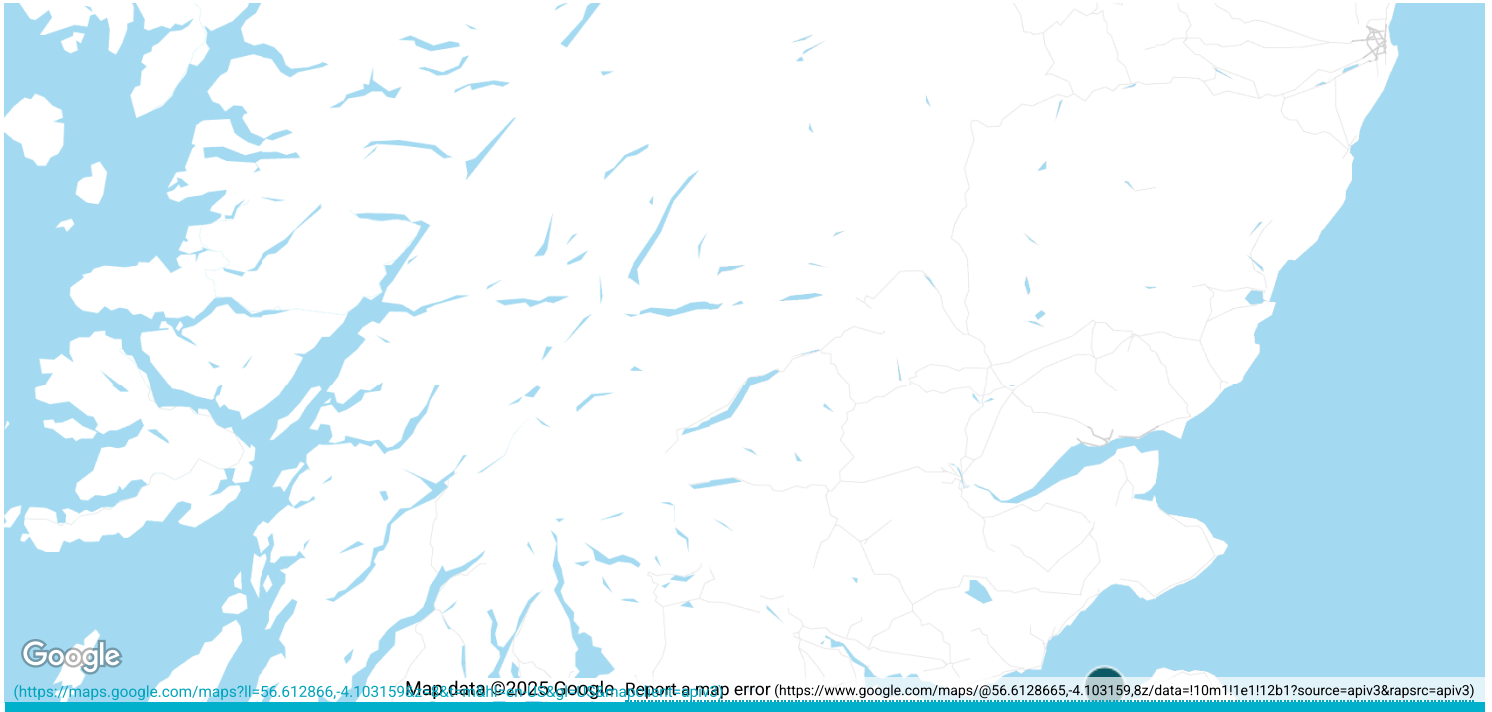




Viewpark

Viewpark is located in North Lanarkshire. It dates from the 1950s when public housing for local miners was required. Viewpark is surrounded by industrial and business parks - Tannochside, Strathclyde Business Park and Righead. These include manufacturers, technology companies and service companies.

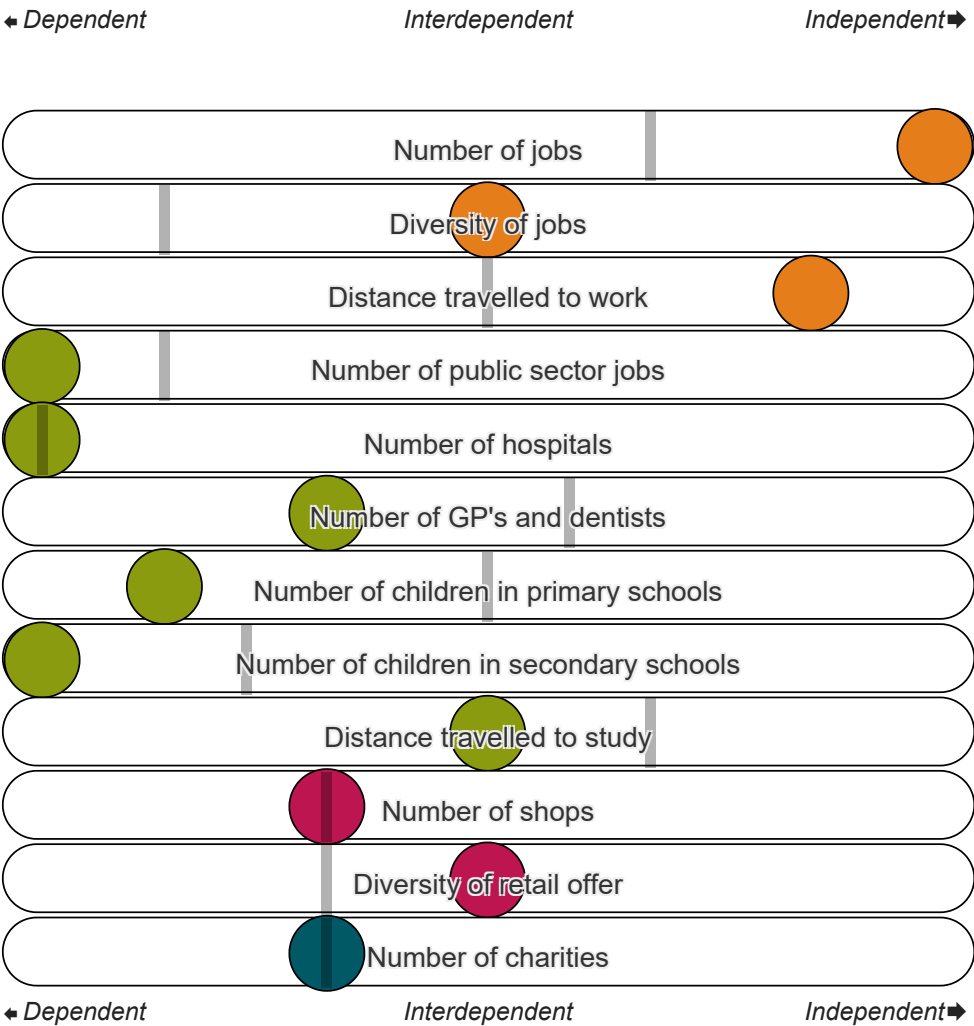
In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Viewpark is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Viewpark is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work. Viewpark differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools.

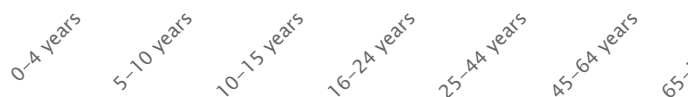

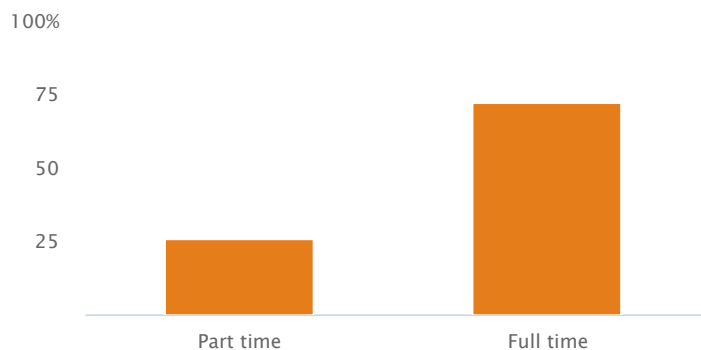

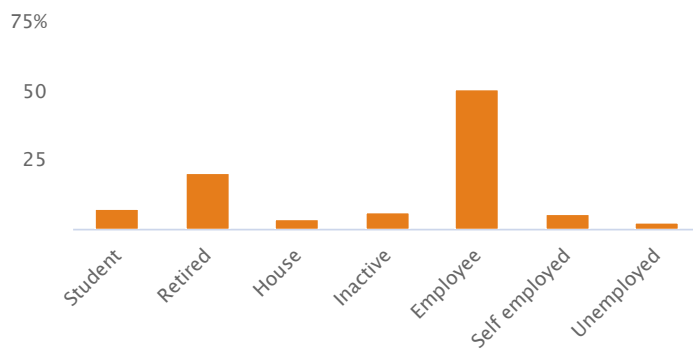
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



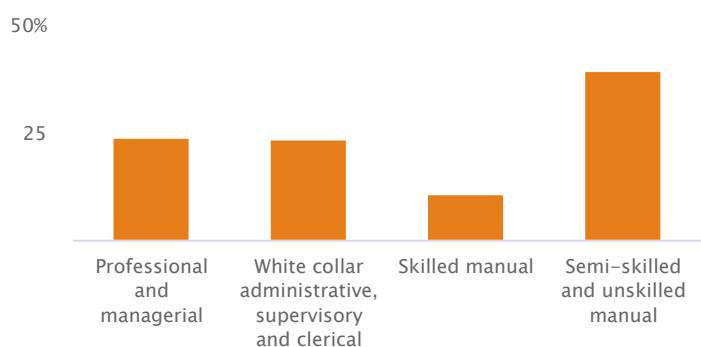
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

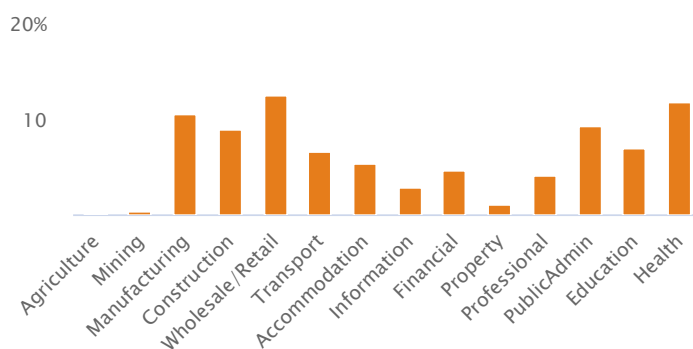


Social Grade

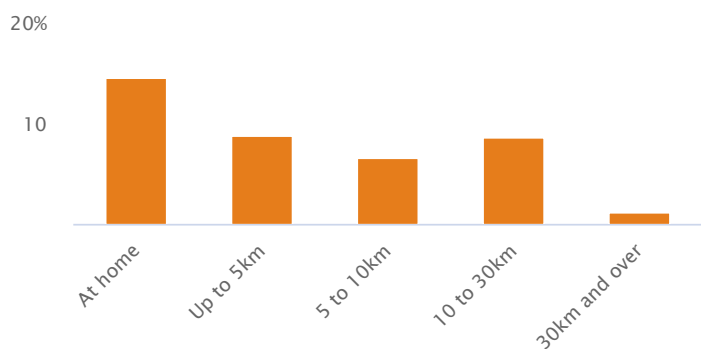
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

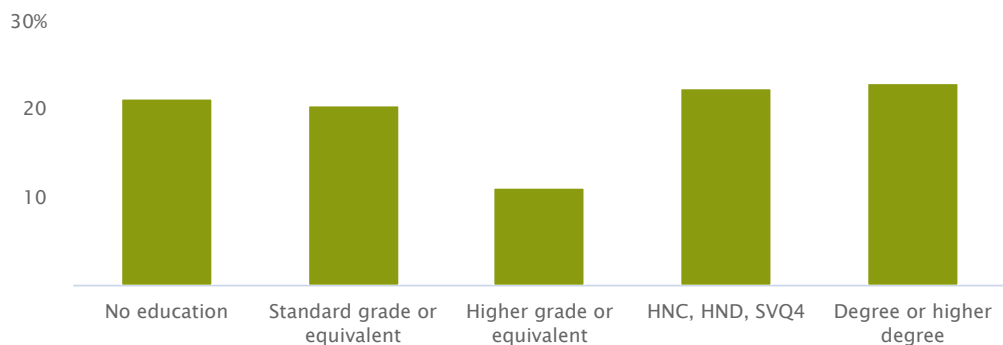


Distance travelled to work

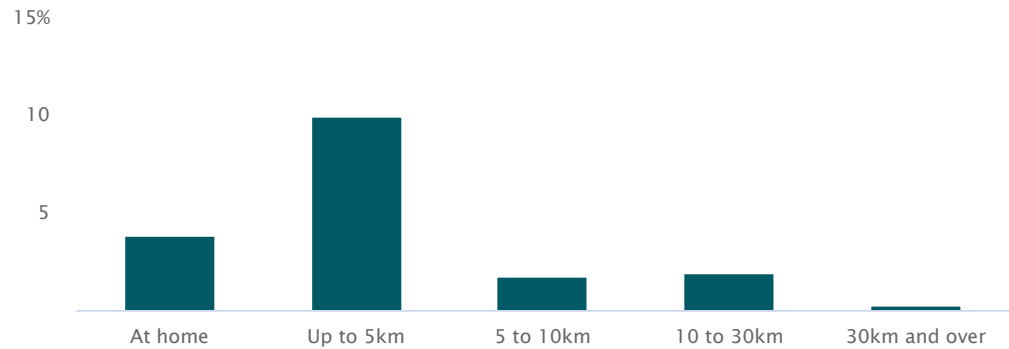
