Waterfoot is in East Renfrewshire. Originally a rural agricultural settlement it is now a commuting settlement with limited service provision.


In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Waterfoot is a **dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Waterfoot is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of charities. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Waterfoot differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools.




Household change 2011 to 2022










