Wattston and Greengairs is in North Lanarkshire developed as a mining and quarrying town. For a time following the closure of the collieries open cast mining continued. The site is now a landfill site and the methane used for the Greengairs Power Station.

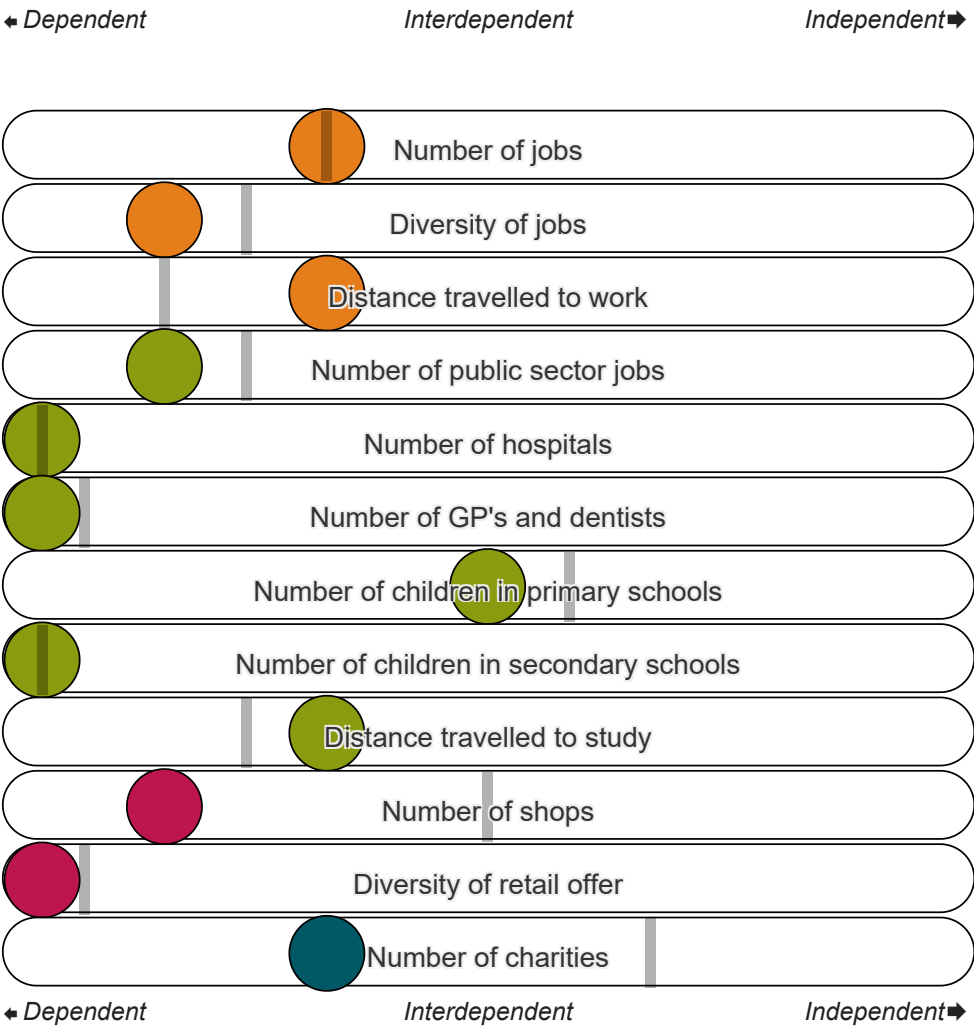
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Wattston and Greengairs is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Wattston and Greengairs is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Wattston and Greengairs is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities. Wattston and Greengairs differs most from its group in the number of shops.

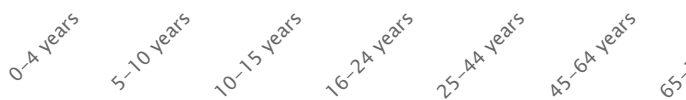

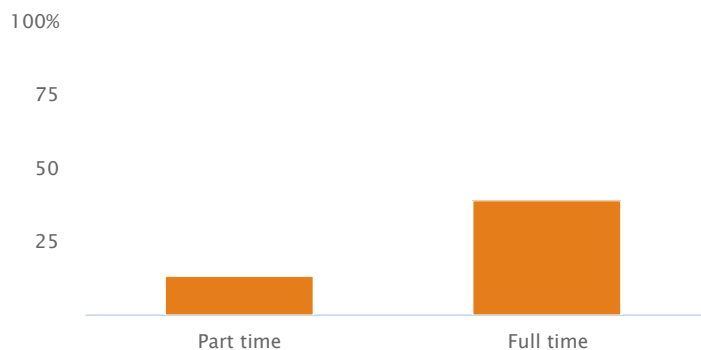

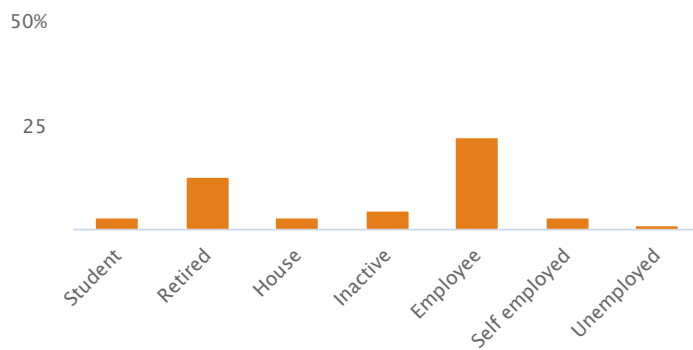
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



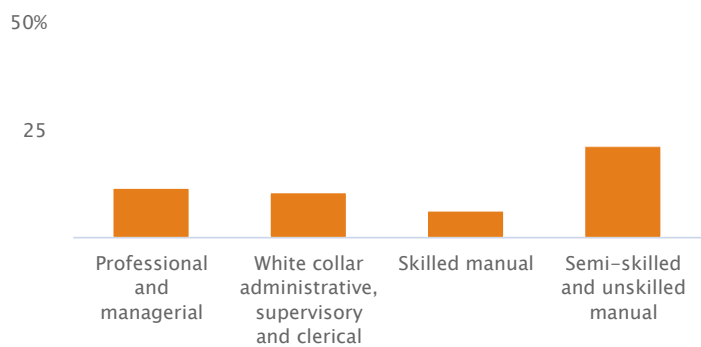
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

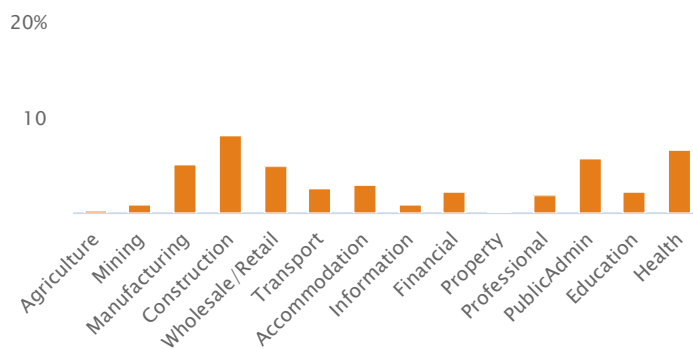


Social Grade

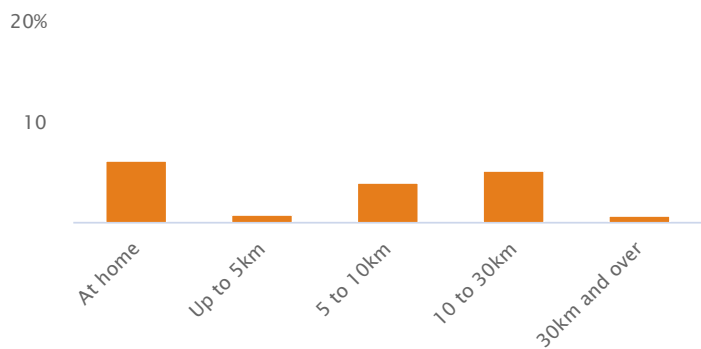
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

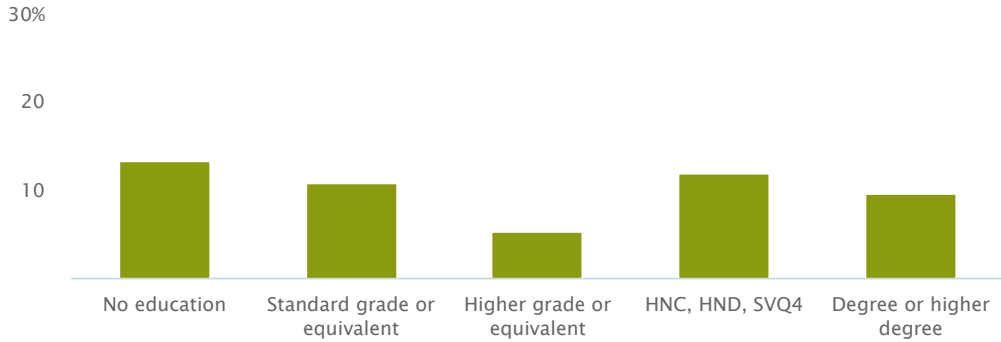


Distance travelled to work

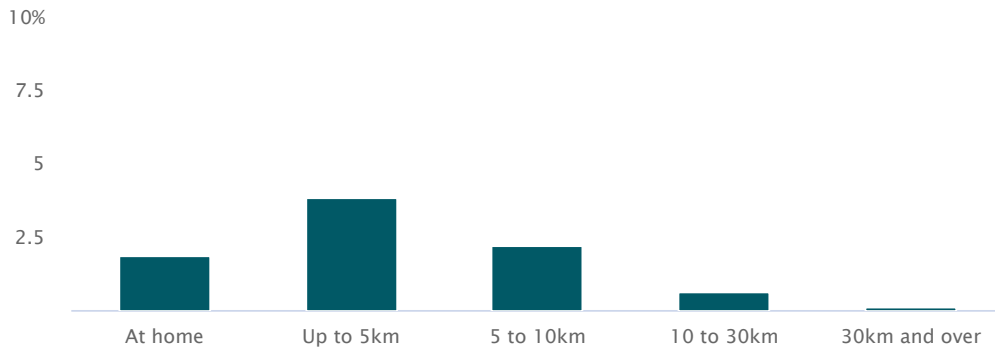
