Westhill is in Highland. It has grown as a commuter town for an expanding Inverness. It is a residential settlement with new estates including executive homes.

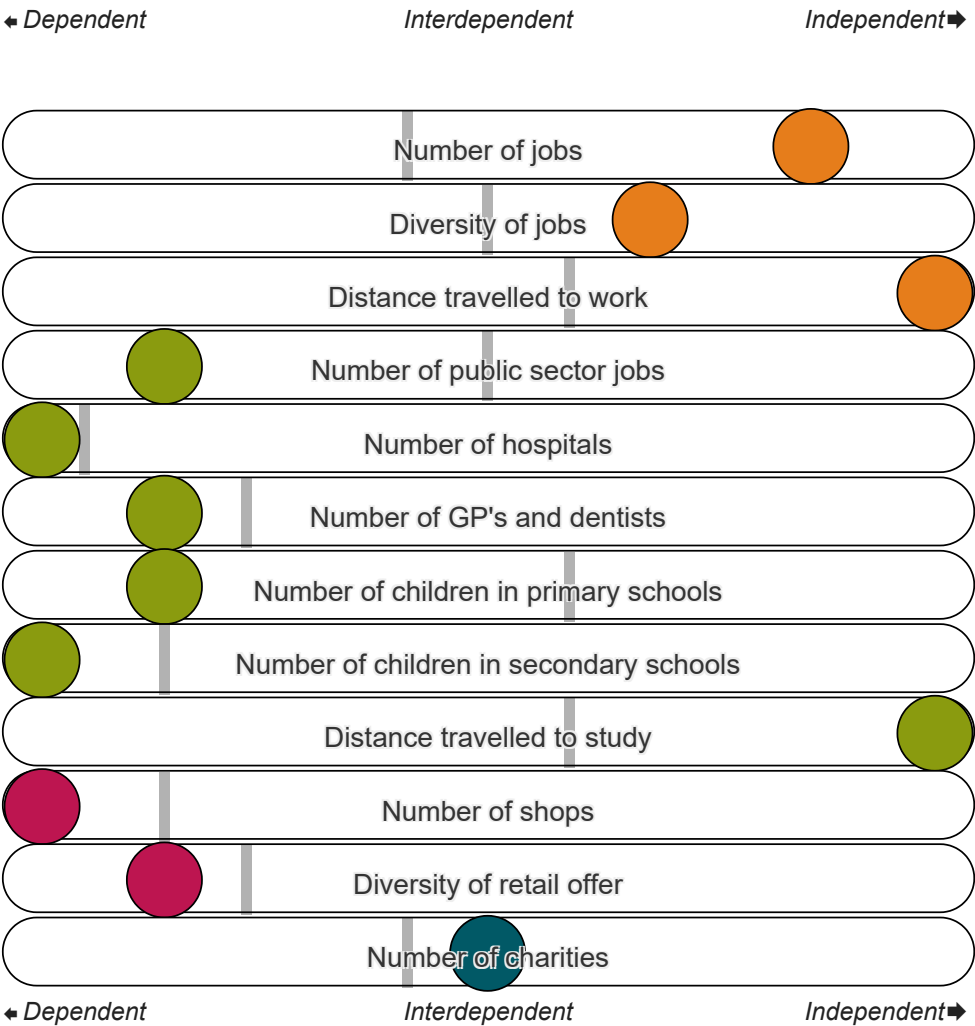
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Westhill (Highland) is an interdependent to dependent town.

Westhill (Highland) is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Westhill (Highland) is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Westhill (Highland) differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs.

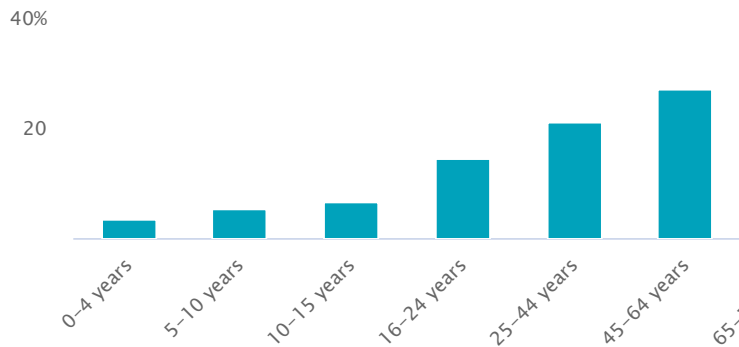

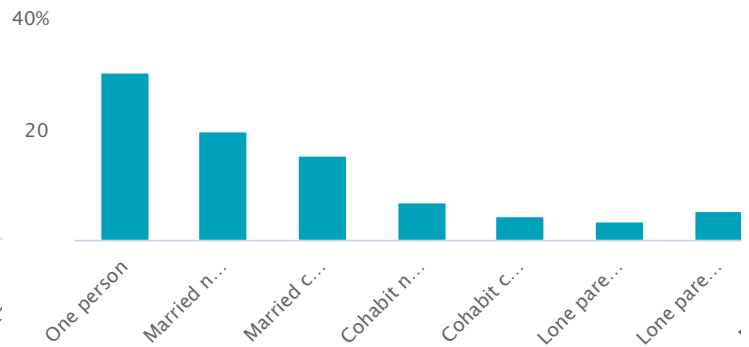

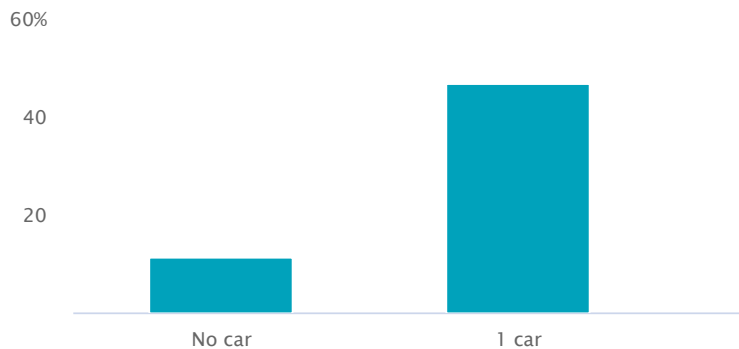

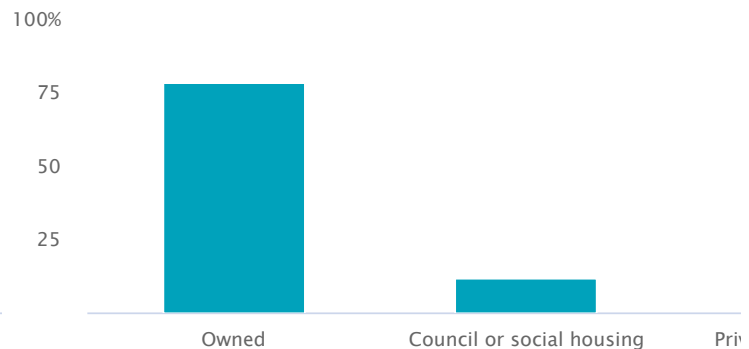

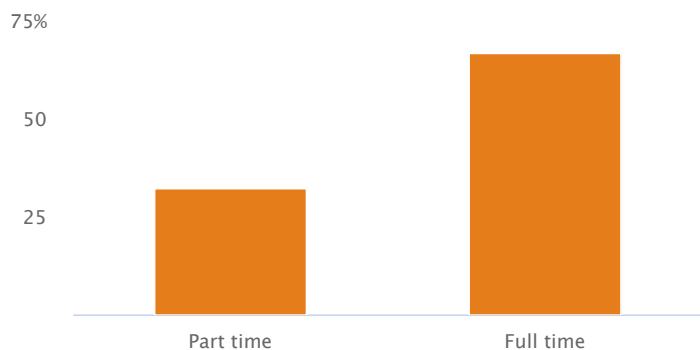

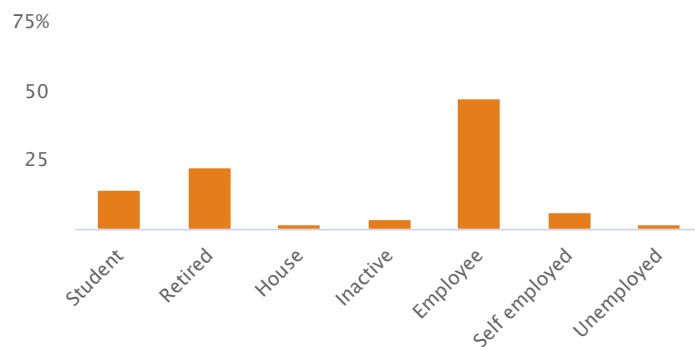
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



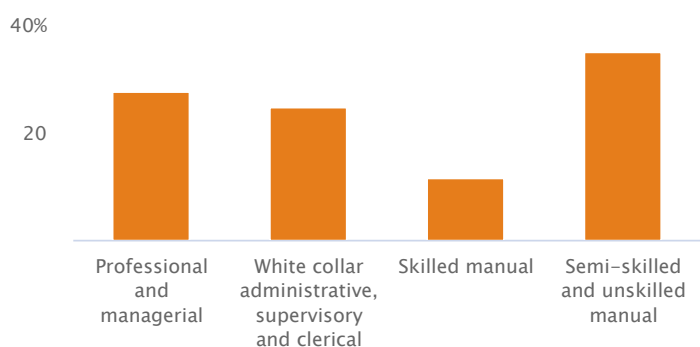
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

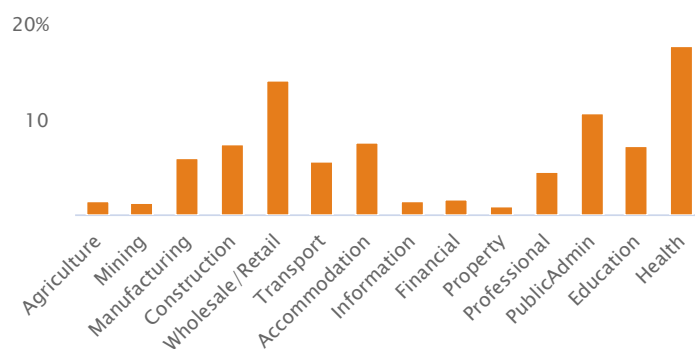

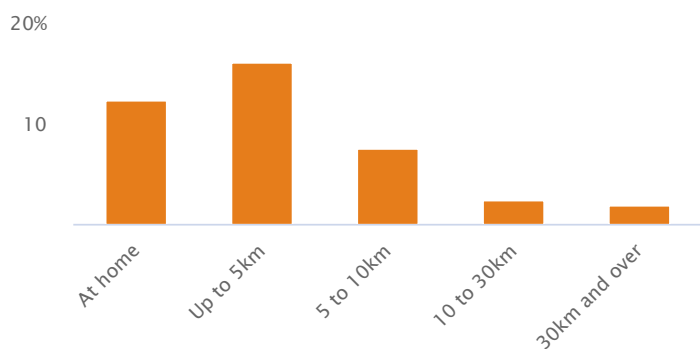
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

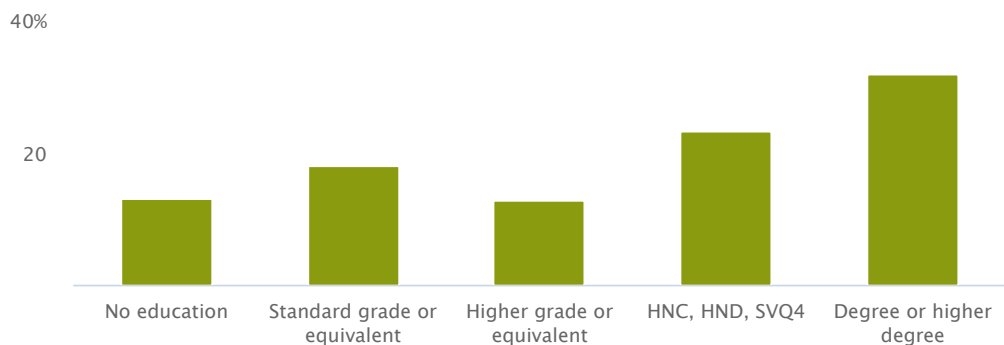


Distance travelled to work

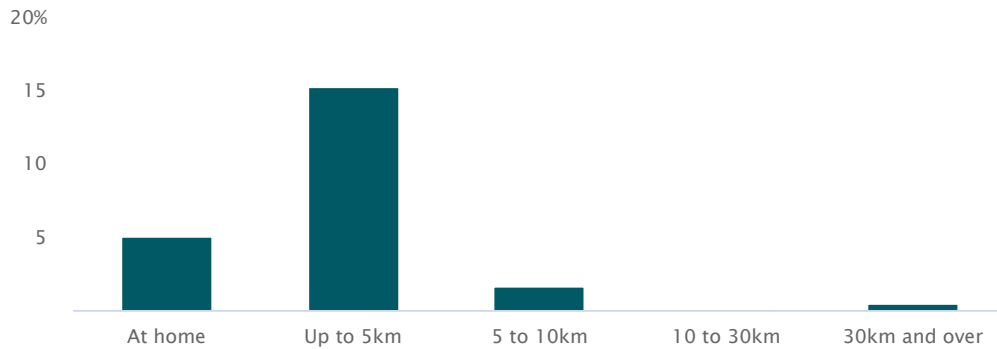
