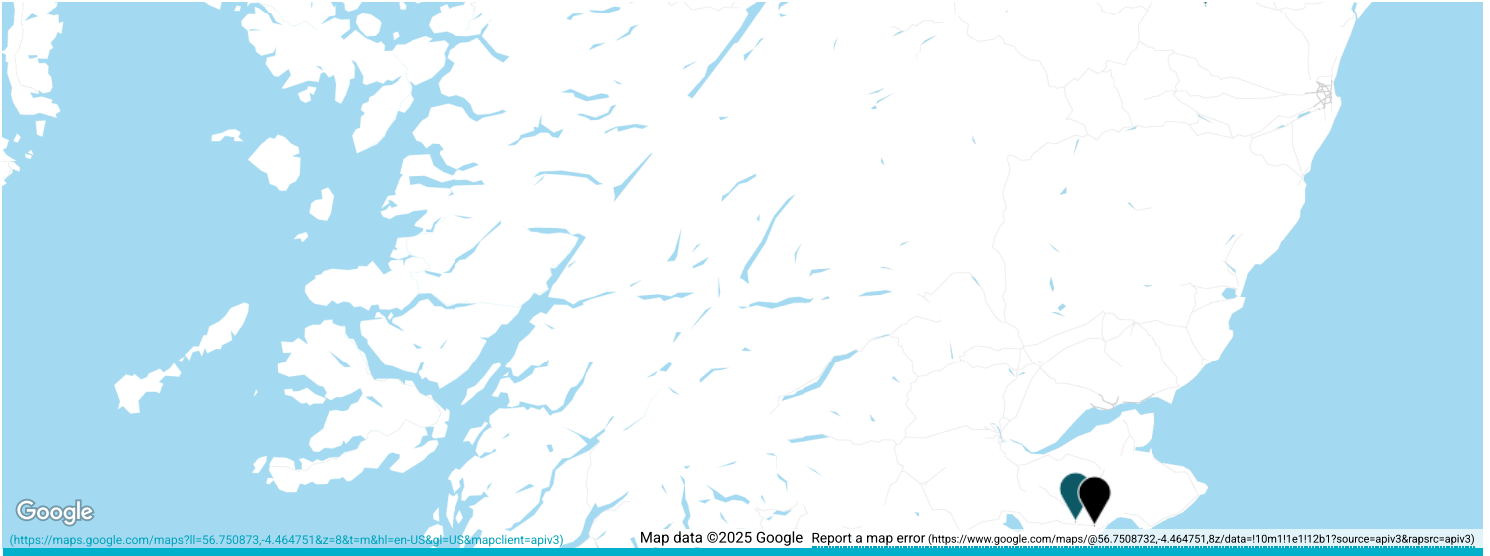

Windygates is in Fife. It was a stopping place on the way to St Andrews. Today it remains on the Pilgrim Way path. It was a hamlet but new housing accompanied the establishment of the Cameronbridge distillery.

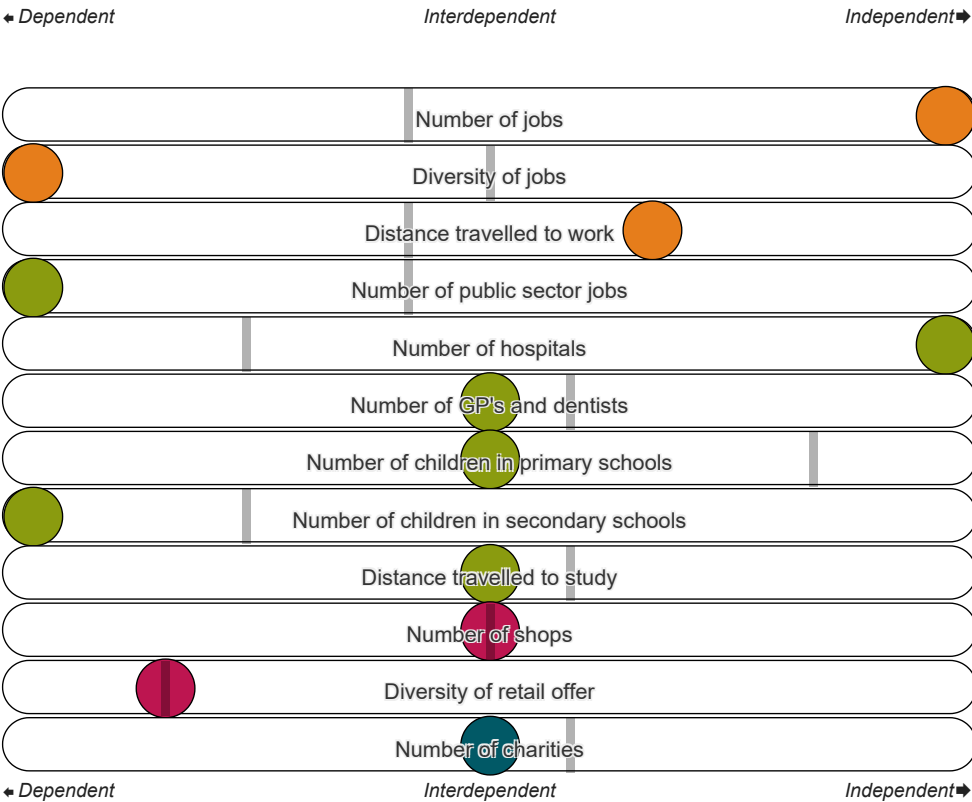
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Windy gates is an **interdependent** town.

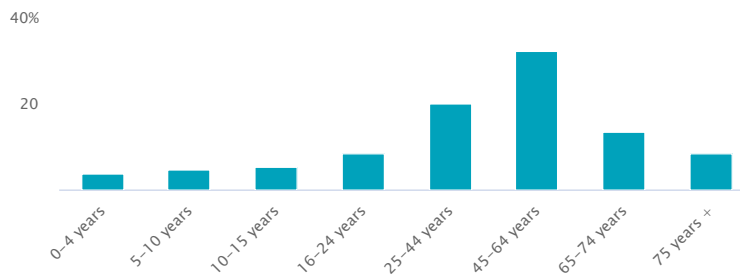

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, and jobs. Windygates differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

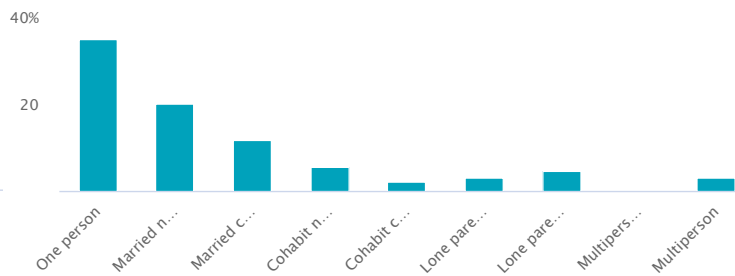

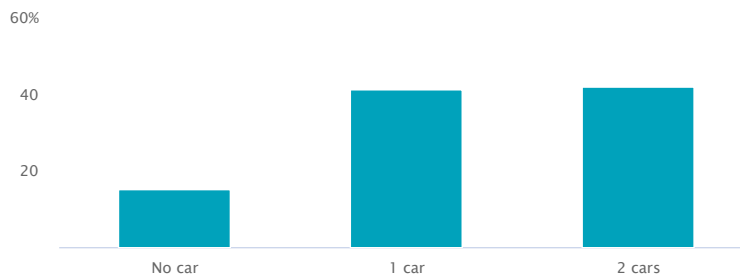

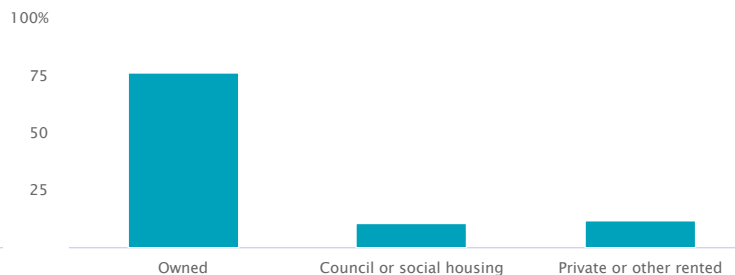
Household composition

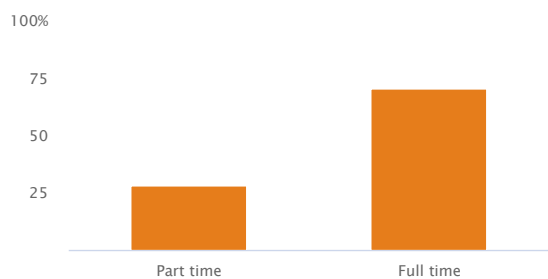

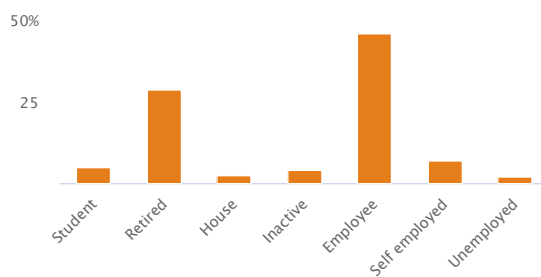
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



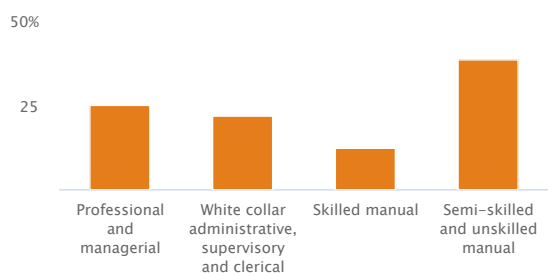
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

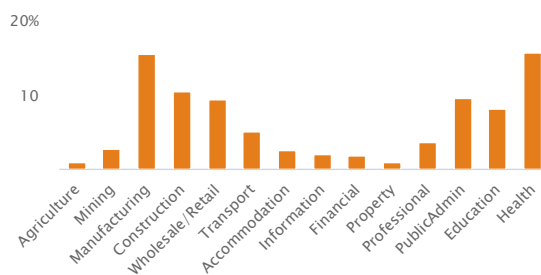

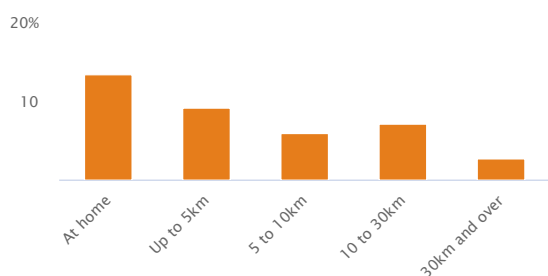
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

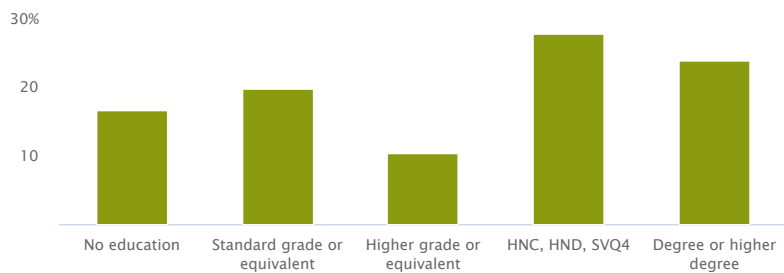


Distance travelled to work

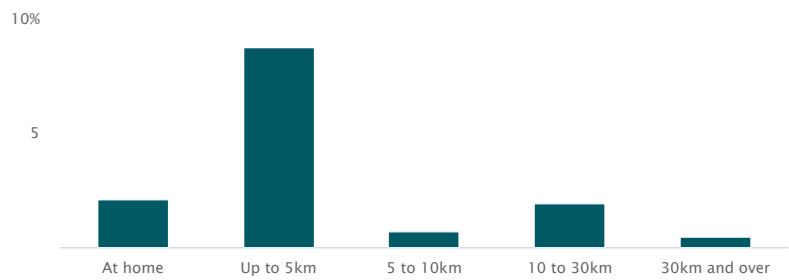
