Wishaw is in North Lanarkshire. It developed from a weaving village planned out in 1794 (originally Cambusnethan and Wishawtown) to become an industrial town in the 19th century with coal mining, iron, steel, smelting and distilling. Lorries, clock, rolling stock (R Y Pickering), sports goods have been manufactured here (including Anderson Boyes). In 1992 the iron and steel industry (British Steel) shut down. North Lanarkshire Council is now the major employer. Royal Mail has a distribution centre in Wishaw. The town has significant local retail and health services.


In large towns, people in this group experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Wishaw is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Airdrie, Bellshill, Blantyre, and Cowdenbeath and Lumphinnans.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






